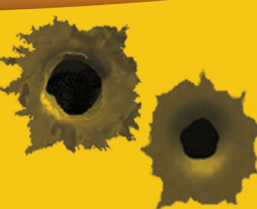

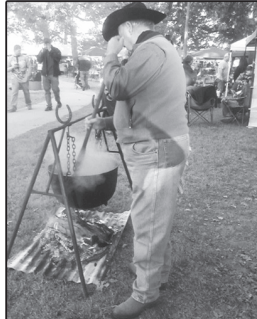

There's been a LOT of outdoor cooking going on in Hopkins County this month, and we're just getting started. The World Champion Hopkins County Stew Cook-off is still ahead with over 165 cooking teams preparing to win the titles.

On the first weekend in October 2017, a Steak Cook-off was held downtown Sulphur Springs, sponsored by Northeast Texas Beef Improvement Organization. 34 ribeye-cooking teams entered the non-commercial category, and a half dozen restaurants entered the commercial category. Taking top honors among the restaurants was Sulphur Springs Country Club. Taking third-place in the non-commercial division was Tim Henderson of Henderson Ranch. (Tim coaches at North Hopkins ISD). First and second place honors went to two family teams called Smokehouse Rats I and II, shown below.



A Chili and a Brisket Cook-off was held in Sulphur Springs on October 21 as part of a Help-a-Child Benefit. Local winners included members of the Sulphur Springs Firefighters Association and Sulphur Bluff Masonic Lodge. Members of the Como-Pickton FFA Chapter won the Ag Mechanics Show. The same chapter also donated a shop-made smoker to the auction which benefited three children's charities.

About 3pm, temperatures suddenly began to drop and balmy breezes became stiff north gales. Sunny skies darkened to clouds. Within an hour, the temperature had dropped more than twenty degrees, and as evening came on, conditions got colder and colder and by dark, wind chill was a very real factor. That didn't deter this old-time cook! Based on past experience with Colorado and West Texas weather, Garland stores inclement weather/protective clothing in the truck year-round. So he simply began to layer and ended up wearing almost everything he had. Moving about like a mummy (I wish I'd snapped a picture!) he kept stirring the pot and feeding the campfire, and turned out one of the best pots of stew ever. It possibly saved lives that night, as not a drop was left over when everyone had gone home.



Halloween Safety Tips...

- Choose light-colored costumes made of flame-retardant materials.
- Avoid oversized shoes, which can make walking difficult, and wigs and billowy costumes, which can easily catch fire and burst into flames.

- Establish boundaries and a curfew for your trick-or-treaters and enforce them.
- Accompany younger trick-or-treaters.
- Encourage your trick-or-treaters to go only to homes that are well lit and accept treats only at the door; they should never go inside a home.
- Check treats before allowing kids to eat them.

A PIECE OF ITALY IN DALLAS

If you want some fresh pasta imported from New York or some buffalo mozzarella imported from Italy, you can find them and wines to match at Jimmy's Food Store at the corner of Bryan and Fitzhugh in East Dallas. Jimmy DiCarlo and his son, also named Jimmy, opened a mom and pop grocery in South Dallas in the 40's and stayed there until 1966 when they moved to the present location.

Grandsons of the founder, Paul and Mike DiCarlo, run the store now. They both grew up in the store, stocking merchandise and learning to work the cash register. "People like our sausage and meatballs," says Paul. "We added sandwiches later and they have gone over real well. At lunchtime we have people sitting on boxes, in the break room, outside, just all over the place enjoying our sandwiches. My sister also makes some wonderful pastries."

Paul's wife has just joined Jimmy's to do bookkeeping. Paul and Mike both have sons who make their living from the store. It is definitely a family business. You don't find many independent grocery stores like this one. As the neighborhood changed over the years, different ethnic foods were added. The store burned in 2004 and a neighboring liquor store let the DiCarlos have some space to sell groceries. When the store was rebuilt and reopened, Paul and Mike decided to concentrate on selling only Italian food and wine. "That's what we know best." About a third of the store's merchandise space is devoted to wine. "We have wines from all twenty wine regions of Italy." Paul goes to a wine show in Verona, Italy twice a year that has a million square feet of wine. His number one seller is Chianti from Tuscany.

Wine tastings occur every Saturday afternoon at the store. When winery owners from Italy come to town, they end up at Jimmy's as the honored guest at a dinner with wine pairings. People sign up for these at the store's website and newsletter. "When you can hear a winery owner talk about his wine, it's special."

The event takes place in the store's break room in the rear of the store. The walls are covered with photos of those dinners. Paul says some are formal, some are casual. One long wall in the room (which holds about fifty people) has a mural of Mount Etna in Sicily, marking Paul's first trip to the place of his ancestors. Jimmy's sausage is made from a recipe Paul's grandfather developed. Meatballs are made from his grandmother's recipe. "My mom made the meatballs until her death ten years ago. She was known as the meatball lady. A lot of restaurants in town use our sausage. Customers see it on the menu so they come to the store to get some."

Paul's brother Mike is in charge of the produce. Paul says he gets up at three or four in the morning and goes to the farmers market to meet with the farmers and get the best fruits and vegetables. "Dallas has gone tomato crazy so Mike makes sure we have really good tomatoes." The store is open every day but Sunday.
