

As part of the final phase of the Capital Project at Holley Central School District, the existing tennis courts at the Middle School/High School (MS/HS) were repurposed as tennis, pickleball and basketball courts. In addition to adding outdoor physical education stations for students, these areas are available for community use when school

is not in session. The remodeled courts opened earlier this month, and students and community members have been using them daily ever since.

Finishing touches are being applied to the new tennis courts installed on another part of the MS/HS campus, but they are not open for use yet.

Through the Capital Project, over \$30 million of improvements have been made to district facilities, at zero impact to taxpayers. "The entire project has provided the district with one of the finest facilities in Western New York," said District Superintendent Robert D'Angelo. "I'm pleased to be able to bring these benefits to our students and community. Our long-term goal for the campus is to maintain it as a state-of-the-art school facility and learning environment. We thank the community for their patience and continued support of this project as we've completed each phase."



Tackle Wardrobe Organization

Cooler weather keeps many people indoors. Although this may cause a bit of cabin fever, time spent inside gives people a chance to tackle some much-needed organization projects without the distractions of outdoor activities.

One task to tackle as winter settles in is sorting through wardrobes and making room for new clothes, as extra clothing can quickly take over a home. In fact, according to the National Association of Professional Organizers, too much clutter, general disorganization and difficulty determining what to keep and/or discard are the primary reasons individuals reach out to professional organizers. FALL HAS FINALLY **ARRIVED**

As mentioned in last week's column, the dry and warm September has given us pretty poor color foliage this fall. I didn't think there would be much color in our area, and the last time I was down to the cabin (near Belfast in Allegany

County) it didn't look too promising there either. However as I drove down on Oct. 20, I didn't expect to see much better color down there. This was good as I have a tendency to go nuts with the camera during the fall foliage peak and I had a lot of work to do at camp.

Usually I start seeing some spectacular color around Arcade and so it was no surprise when nothing caught my attention enough to bring the camera to my eye. However the closer I got to camp the more color I was seeing, but no stopping for photos. I got busy right away at camp with the mowing (about three hours worth) and then headed into Friendship to get a sub. On the way in, I noticed a couple of spectacular ridges and some "shocking" tree colors and so it began. It took me a while to get back to the cabin, but some nice images of fall colors were gotten that I didn't think would be captured this year.

The next day was another beautiful day and the early morning sun lit up the ridge on the other side of the valley that my cabin overlooks. Now I started finding small pockets of color around the cabin and the camera was out again. Lighting is very, very important to capturing fall foliage and the light angle is of course always changing so what looks good right now may not be best for the camera to record. So the spots that look like they have good potential are noted so when light does get right I can return.

Realizing that I had work to get started on (like post the "back 40"), the camera was returned to the cabin. The pack basket was filled with posted signs, some sign boards to replace some that may have deteriorated, flagging tape, marking paint, nails, a hammer, and staple gun. Fortunately I could ride the ATV to the top of the ridge and my south line, but there were some trees down across the trail along with some brush that had grown up so the small chainsaw had to be taken. It had been a few years since this section of the property line had been posted so every sign was replaced. With my arthritic feet bothering me, my right hip not good and what I believe is a damaged right rotor cuff, I staggered off with the pack basket after I rode the ATV as far as I could. A walking stick of course is an essential for someone like me so I don't fall and roll down into the valley!

The summer-like weather was nice until I started to heat up and eventually the shirt came off. I was so glad I had thought to bring water with me; there was none left by the time I finished three hours later.

During my ride up to the south property line, some colorful foliage was noticed and after a rest back at the cabin I decided I earned a photo adventure! This time the camera was taken and very little walking was done (just love the ATV especially at the end of the day!); hell I couldn't walk very well by this time anyways! The more I looked the more unique little pockets of color were found.

The next day another section of the property line was posted, but my legs and etc. cut me short so more was accomplished close to the cabin. In all, a lot was done and I got more fall foliage images then I figured on this year.

By the end of Oct. 23, I had just about used up all my energy and packed up to leave the

Camp is different now than it was way back when. Forty-five years ago I got permission

to hunt this farm and the owner had a cabin that he let me use above my present cabin. Eventually he passed on and I bought about 62 acres of that farm. A camping trailer was put on it, eventually a pond was dug and then a nice cabin with one hell of a view. There was no one else in the area to speak of and it was great. Now there are six different owners surrounding me. Where I seldom saw anyone come up the seasonal dead-end road it has become very different. There have been three logging operations on the 106 acres above me since an "investor" brought it (third time in 10 years) and this time he is taking every tree down to a 13" diameter. He has sold the property to a young Amish couple who have started building a house just above my south line up the abandoned road that goes by my cabin. Good logging operations are good for the forest, but not the way this guy has done it. Of course that is why he is a multi-millionaire.

Another logging operation, by an ill-repute outfitter, is logging 50 acres off my east line now too. Looks like the 45 years I have had deer hunting on this peaceful section of land and the reason the 62 acres was brought is about to change drastically. Oh well, they can't take all the great memories that were built over all those years though!
