# LLT's production of Neil Simon's "Brighton Beach Memoirs" opens Thursday

After breaking all-time records with its 57th season-opener of "Joseph & the Technicolor Dreamcoat," Laurel Little Theatre continues the season with the Neil Simon comedy "Brighton Beach Memoirs," running the first weekend of November under the direction of Rick Youngblood. Performances are November 2, 3, and 4 at 7:30 p.m. and a Sunday matinee on November 5 at 2 p.m.

The LLT reservation line answers 24 hours a day throughout show week at 601-428-0140. America's favorite comedy writer based this play on his own life as a 1930's Brooklyn teen. Coming of age may not be easy – "but it sure

'Eugene' is the younger son of his closeknit extended family that all live under one roof in a very cramped house in the Brighton Beach section of Brooklyn, New York. The three things that were always on his mind were girls, Yankees baseball, and becoming a comedy writer. This funny play is not only Simon's greatest but also his most moving. As one critic said, "I laughed, then I cried, then I laughed again because I cried."

It originally ran on Broadway from 1983-1986, and made a star out of a young Matthew Broderick, who was playing his first leading role. The production won numerous Drama

Critics' Circle, Drama Desk and Tony Awards. A well-received film version made in the late 1980s featured Jonathan Silverman, Blythe Danner and Judith Ivey in the leading roles.

Laurel Little Theatre's cast of seven includes four LLT alumni and three newcomers making their debut on the Arabian stage. Luke Youngblood stars as the teen-angst-ridden Eugene. Luke is a junior at South Jones High School, where he's a Speech and Debate competitor. He was in several LLT Kids' Camp productions, as well as "The Addams Family."

Eugene's older brother Stanley is played by Carter Poister, a West Jones High School and JCJC graduate who is now attending USM majoring in criminal justice forensics. Poister appeared on the LLT stage in "Beauty & the Beast" and "Joseph."

Long-time LLT favorite Catherine Nowicki is cast as Eugene's mother Kate. Nowicki is a member of Actor's Equity and has performed in shows from Off-Broadway to as far away as Japan, as well as in a handful of movies. For LLT, she has performed lead roles in "Annie," "42nd Street," "9 to 5," "The Glass Menagerie," and most memorably, the hilarious Louise in the five productions of "Always...Patsy Cline" performed in the Pine Belt area.

Jack, the husband, is played by stage new-

comer, Luke Hammonds. After growing up locally, he's back in Jones County after six years away in the United States Marine Corps and is now the HR Director at JCJC.

Also living in the cramped Brooklyn house is a set of relatives - the Morton girls. Playing the mother, Blanche,

is Christy Buckler-Liverett, who has appeared in several LLT shows over the last four decades since her debut as a little child actor in "Alice in Wonderland" in the 1980s. Buckler-Liverett is a professor of education at William Carey University.

LLT alumni Will Hodges is the assistant director. Hodges has appeared in LLT leading roles in "Arsenic & Old Lace," "Running Mate," and "Dearly Departed." He is making his debut on the directing side of the theatre. Hodges is a graduate of both South Jones High School and JCJC and is now a junior at USM majoring in marketing.


saves you over 40 percent off the single ticket prices and allows the use of one or two punches for a production. The 57th Season tickets are still on sale.


