Live tree care

- Store the live tree outside in a shady, wind-free area. Select its permanent outside spot and dig the hole before the ground freezes. Keep the soil from the hole covered and dry.
- Check for critters on the trunk and branches before bringing inside, then set the tree up in a cool area away from heat sources. Keep the root ball lightly moist. Decorate your beautiful live tree!
- On a mild day, remove decorations and root coverings and place the tree into its hole, with the base of the trunk at ground level. Fill in with the dry soil from the hole. Mulch around its base, and water well. Protect the young tree from harsh winds. — Brenda Weaver

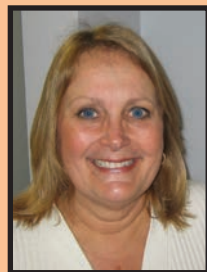

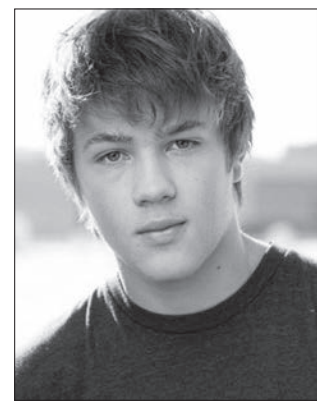

Q. I just read your interview with Regina King, and I love the little tease she gave me about what to expect for the second season of "American Crime." Can you give me any more details? — Catherine F, via email

A. I spoke recently with series newcomer Connor Jessup — he plays Taylor Blaine, the character whose plot this season centers on — and he gave me a few more details about the new season, which premieres Wednesday, Jan. 6, at 10/9c. He told me: "The second season kicks off with a completely new story and completely new characters. This year it focuses on a private school and a public school in Indianapolis, and the inciting crime is that my character — who starts the season as kind of a financial-aid scholarship student at the private school — accuses a few of the other students, players on the basketball team, of sexually assaulting him at one of the school's parties."

That happens even before the series begins. The entire season is an exploration of the ramifications and the ripples that accusation, that crime, has on the victims, on the accused, on families, on the community and on the school administration. It's really a mural of what a crime does in a community like this."

Connor told me what he thinks sets this show apart from other TV series in the crime genre: "The good thing about 'American Crime' is the plot is obviously there, and the plot keeps things moving, but the core of the show is the human plot, the human element. There are procedural elements, but they are happening in background — the core of the show is how the ramifications of how all these cracks start to appear in the community."

Q. This season of "The Leftovers" was fantastic. Will it be back for another? — Jake T, via email

A. HBO recently announced that "The Leftovers," which just wrapped its critically acclaimed sec-

ond season Dec. 6, will indeed be back for a third and final season, most likely in fall 2016. Series executive producer Damon Lindelof said: "The most exciting thing for us as storytellers would be to bring 'The Leftovers' to a definitive end ... wildly ambiguous but hopefully mega-emotional."

READERS: More than a year ago, I reported on rumors that Steve Perry was ready to make a comeback to the music scene after a video of him appearing on stage with the Eels in May 2014 singing "Open Arms" went viral. I am thrilled to report that these rumors have become a reality. Steve recently told KSWD in L.A.: "I finally went into the studio in March, and I've been in there ever since, just trying to finish this record." He does not have a set release date yet, but says he's looking forward to finishing it. "I want to get it done probably in the early part of this coming year."

mixture of greens along with pieces of pork is an integral part of African and African-American culinary history. During times of slavery, if greens were served one day, the leftover pot liquor and a pan of cornbread often made the meal for the next. My vegetarian version for preparing a mess of greens retains the flavorful soul of the recipe, but is much healthier.

While I don't personally believe in luck or eating certain types of food on

Does Eating Greens Bring in the 'Green'?

For many people, the new year is a time for making resolutions and eating certain foods for "luck." On New Year's Day, eating greens, black-eyed peas and cornbread are thought to bring financial reward. While I'm not superstitious, I do believe in the health benefits of eating greens.

Greens include any vegetable in the cabbage family that doesn't form a compact head, like collards, mustards, turnips, spinach and kale. There are several varieties of tasty and unusual types of greens, so be bold and experiment! Dark, leafy greens such as spinach, kale, collards and mustard greens are an excellent source of many nutrients. Greens contain high amounts of vitamin A and iron, as well as some calcium. Greens also are packed with antioxidants and are a wonderful addition to any diet.

If the stems of the greens are tough, don't throw them away. There are nutrients in the stems, so chop them up into small pieces and freeze them. You can add the stems to soups and stews, saute them with your onions or add them to various dishes just the way you add in carrots.

Pot liquor, the highly seasoned liquid that is left after the greens are cooked, is full of vitamins and minerals and is a nutritious drink.

The practice of combining different types of greens is called a "mess of greens" in the South. Cooking a

1. Wash greens thoroughly: Remove any brown spots or blemishes, and wash the greens in cold water approximately 3 or 4 times to ensure they are clean and free of insects. Roll the cleaned greens up and slice them into smaller pieces so they'll cook evenly. Remove and reserve any large stems.

2. Using a large pot, season the onions with salt and sweat them in the olive oil over low heat for about 10 to 12 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add the garlic, jalapeno, sugar, salt and pepper to the pot, and saute the mixture for about 5 minutes. Add the greens and water to the pot and continue cooking for 45 minutes to 1 hour over medium-low heat, stirring once after about 30 to 40 minutes.

3. Test the greens for tenderness by piercing the stems with a fork or knife. Cook for another 10 to 15 minutes, if needed. Season with the remaining salt and pepper. Place the greens in a bowl with the pot liquor. Serve with the sun-dried tomatoes and the oil, if desired, and the traditional Southern condiments: vinegar, hot sauce, hot peppers in vinegar, or wine vinegar, and chopped onions.

Have nuts leftover from holiday entertaining? Don't just stick them in the back of a cupboard. Because nuts contain a high percentage of oil, they can become rancid. You can store opened containers at room temperature for up to a month. But after that, place nuts in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to six months or in the freezer for up to a year.

To freshen any type of nuts before you eat (or cook with) them, toast on a baking sheet in a 350 F oven for 10 minutes, or place nuts in a small bowl and microwave on High for 1 to 1 1/2 minutes.

Don't Forget Quiet When Shopping For A Gas Furnace

(NAPS)—No question about it—comfort is top of mind when homeowners are in the market for a new gas furnace. Everyone wants to be warm and cozy when outdoor temperatures begin to fall, and they want that comfort delivered quietly. That's why it's important to add quiet operation to your list of requirements as you shop for a new furnace.



Here's a fact about furnaces you won't want to keep quiet about: The more efficient a furnace is, the more quietly it runs.

Several factors affect the noise level of a gas furnace, beginning with the unit's efficiency rating. In the case of gas furnaces, efficiency is expressed as an annual fuel utilization efficiency (AFUE) rating. AFUE ratings range between a minimum of 80 percent to a maximum of 98.5 percent and represent the ratio of fuel that is converted into usable heat. In other words, the highest-performing furnace converts 98.5 percent of its fuel into heat. The remaining 1.5 percent is lost through the exhaust. Generally speaking, the more efficient a furnace is, the quieter it operates.

Modulating gas furnaces maintain an ideal temperature by modulating heating levels in small increments. Comfort is dramatically increased as the furnace adjusts its level of operation up or down to offset the rate at which heat leaves your home. At the same time, operation is considerably quieter—in the case of variable-speed models, as much as 24 times less noisy than conventional furnaces.

Single-stage, two-stage or modulating technology also impacts furnace sound levels. Traditional single-stage gas furnaces operate much like a lightbulb—they are either on or off. This can create highly noticeable fluctuations in temperature and sound in your home, as the unit turns on and off frequently.

Finally, the size of ductwork can impact sound levels. So when you select a furnace, be certain your ductwork is large enough to accommodate the airflow (measured in cubic feet per minute, or cfm) the furnace pushes. Ductwork that is too small can result in whistling sounds throughout the system.

1. Heat oven to 350 F.
 2. Spread the cashews in one layer on a cookie sheet and bake for about 6 minutes, or until warm and lightly toasted.
 3. Combine the rosemary, brown sugar, salt, melted butter and cayenne pepper (if you wish an extra kick) in a large bowl. When the cashews are heated, immediately pour them into the bowl with the spice butter mixture. Toss thoroughly.
 4. Cool and serve. Store in an airtight container up to two weeks.

Note: If you prefer, substitute 1 tablespoon pure maple syrup for 1 tablespoon brown sugar.

Civil War Hymnal

Q. I have a copy of "Army Hymns Written for the First Regiment, New England Cavalry" by Chaplain Friederich Denison. It is a small, pocket-size book and was originally published in 1861 in Providence, Rhode Island. I wonder if it is valuable. — *Jonathan, Walla Walla, Washington*

A. I found your book referenced in "Warman's Civil War Collectibles: Identification and Price Guide" by John Graf and published by Krause Books. According to Graf, your hymnal is worth about \$85. As with most collectibles, condition is extremely important. If a cover or pages are missing, that value might be less than half.

recording is probably valued in the \$5-\$10 range.

Q. I have inherited a Flow Blue pitcher, eight-sided and featuring an Oriental scene. It is ironstone and is about 5 inches all. Do you have any idea of its value? — *Barbara, Casper, Wyoming*

A. According to several collectors I have consulted, Flow Blue pieces are worth less than they were just a few years ago. For example, a Flow Blue platter that might have sold for \$450 a decade or two ago now might bring only about \$250. With that in mind, I would think your pitcher would be valued in the \$95 to \$150 range.

Q. I have a 78-rpm copy of Bing Crosby's "White Christmas," Decca 18429. I have been offered \$25 for it. Keep or sell? — *Stan, Midvale, Utah*

A. "White Christmas" was first issued by Decca in October 1942. An estimated 100 million copies of the song sold in some 350 versions. Simply put, it remains one of the most popular songs ever. Ironically, it was written by Irving Berlin while he soaked up the sun poolside at the Biltmore in Phoenix. "White Christmas" was selected for the NARAS Hall of Fame. Keep or sell? Since so many copies were sold, I suggest you sell it. Your

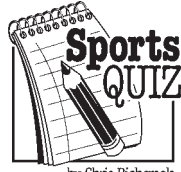
