I FOUND A BAT IN MY HOUSE!

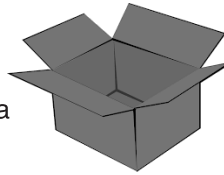
You could be subject to getting rabies vaccinations if the bat is not tested.



Bats are important in the environment but can cause a serious health risk in the home. Bat bites can transmit rabies. Sometimes even if a bite isn't known you might need to undergo rabies treatment, particularly if an exposure could have occurred while sleeping. **Once rabies is contracted it is nearly always fatal.**

If you find a bat in your home:

1. Keep it isolated to one room if possible.
2. Capture the bat if you are comfortable doing so. Wait until it lands and then place a can, plastic container or box over it. Slide a paper under it and then place a cover on top to contain it. You may also contact a wildlife removal specialist to capture it.
3. If the bat is killed, the head must not be crushed or destroyed to allow testing.
4. Call the Livingston County Department of Health, Center for Environmental Health, at (585) 243-7280 / (585) 335-1717. For after hours emergencies, call the Livingston County Sheriff's Office at (585) 243-7100.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) 2017 – 2018

Regular HEAP opens on November 13, 2017.

Emergency HEAP opens January 2, 2018.

Apply for HEAP on-line at myBenefits.ny.gov beginning November 13, 2017.

Applying on-line is easy, applications are received by the agency right away, and allow the applicant to track the application and benefits.

Most individuals or families **receiving either Temporary Assistance or SNAP benefits** on September 17, 2017 will receive a one-time Regular HEAP benefit through that case and do not need to apply separately.

Livingston County residents that are unable to apply online, may request an application be mailed by calling (585) 243-7300. HEAP applications are mailed and accepted starting November 13th at the

It is very important to keep current on your utility bills.

If you fall behind prior to HEAP opening contact the company and try to make some arrangement for payment.

- Non-heating electric shut offs cannot be paid with Regular HEAP Benefits.
- Interviews can be done over the phone as long as a HEAP application has been filed either through myBenefits.ny.gov or in paper form with the agency.
- Do not wait until you are out of fuel to apply for HEAP. Let us know when you are **low on fuel** (less than a quarter tank). Non-utility fuel companies may charge a delivery fee if they deliver “off route” because you are out of fuel. This charge is deducted from your HEAP grant, so you will receive less fuel from your HEAP grant.
- If you have a shut off notice on your natural gas or electric, contact us **prior to being shut off**. If service is shut off, the company does not have to accept the HEAP grant to turn it back on.

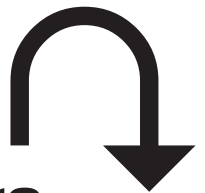
