UNINVITED CHARACTER AT CAMP

I was returning to the cabin when I spotted him up in a big oak tree. I immediately headed to the cabin to get the .22. He is not protected in New York State, and his kind can cause a lot of tree damage and can be a real nuisance around camps and other buildings with their gnawing on anything that has traces of salt.



Porcupines are a real nuisance and are not protected by law.

This mammal is slow, awkward, not too bright and not exactly cute. His claim to fame and survival is his 30,000 or so quills that cover his back, flanks and tail. These quills can be very painful when they are stuck into another creature messing with it.

The quills are actually highly specialized hairs that vary in length from 5 inches on the back to much shorter ones on the head and tail. They have a sharp tip and are loosely attached on the skin. The tip consists of tiny overlapping scales that are raised on the edges and point towards the rear. They act like the barbs on a fishhook and once embedded in flesh make the quill difficult and painful to remove.

Because of these scales the quills have a tendency to work their way forward and thus deeper. Quills that are not removed have actually been known to travel through an appendage and come out on the other side or in a different area. The biggest danger is that an animal that has a face and mouth full of quills will not be able to hunt or eat properly and may die.

Several myths exist about these quills. One is that if you cut the end off it will be easier to remove. This is not so and may actually hinder removal. The best way to remove these quills is to put a few spoonfuls of vinegar on them where they enter the skin and wait 5 to 10 minutes and then repeat. A few minutes after this second application pour mineral oil over the quills. The vinegar removes the lime from the quills and they soften. The mineral oil will help the quills to pop out much more easily.

The other myth is that they throw their quills. What really happens is that they come out of the skin easily if touched or bumped. If he whacks you with his tail you will get a lot of quills stuck on you and may think that he "threw" them.

The "porkie" is a rodent and will weigh from 12 to 20 pounds and some times go as high as 30 pounds.

They only have one young a year and when it is born it will weigh about a pound. It is born with quills, which are soft at birth but shortly harden. They can climb and eat solid food only hours after they are born. Its main source of food is his mother's milk of course. The den is usually in a hollow tree.

With all those nasty quills how do they mate? Very carefully! Actually the female stands with her quills flatten, raises her hindquarters and moves her tail to the side. The male then mounts her from the rear-carefully!

They are known for their gnawing, which is what usually gets them in trouble. His incisors are large and sharp and quite capable of cutting through tree bark to get to the tender inner layer. The removal of the outer bark may result in them girdling and killing the tree. They love salt and will gnaw on anything that contains a trace of it such as snow tires, the siding of cabins, sweaty clothing, gloves and wooden tool handles. I know of one case where they actually got into a cabin by gnawing through the floor from underneath.

In the summer and early fall they will consume grasses, clover, buds, water plants, apples and acorns. In the winter the diet is limited to the bark of hardwoods and their buds. They also have a fondness for hemlock twigs.

You would think because they get much of their food up in the trees that they would be good climbers but that is not the case. It is not uncommon for them to fall and injure or kill themselves.

The porcupine has only two real enemies, humans and fishers. The fisher will actually go out of his way to kill a porkie. When I trapped in the Adirondacks a dead porkie was always used for bait to attract them to the set.

Personally I have not seen any porkies in this areas but they are found in our Adirondacks and the Southern Tier. Should you run across one keep clear of him and don't let your dog get near him if you don't want a big veterinary bill and put him or her in a lot of pain!

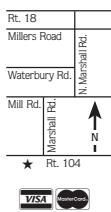

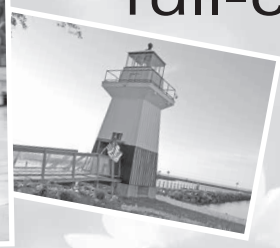
Monsters, superheroes and wild animals walked the halls of Orleans/Niagara BOCES' Roy Hart Learning Center for their Halloween Week.

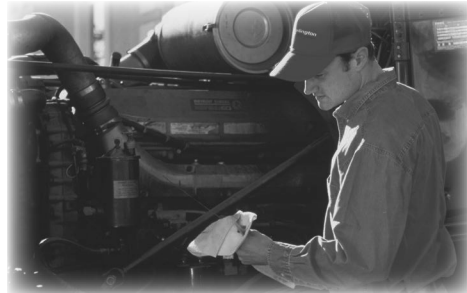

SUCCESSFUL DRUG TAKE-BACK EVENT

On Oct. 28, 2017, the Orleans County Sheriff's Office once again participated in the National Prescription Take-Back Event that was sponsored by the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration. The collection event yielded over 773 lbs of unused medication and sharps. Pomegranates

Pomegranates are an ancient fruit steeped in tradition that impress modern food enthusiasts thanks to their tart taste and various health benefits. Primarily in season in North America between September and February, pomegranates are typically stocked during the holiday season when they can be enjoyed as part of festive meals.

Native from the area now known as Iran and the Himalayas in northern India, pomegranates have been cultivated since ancient times throughout Mediterranean-influenced areas of Europe, Africa and Asia. Historians believe Sicilians were likely the first to introduce pomegranates to the rest of Europe, while Spanish conquistadores likely brought the pomegranate to the Americas.

Because they begin to ripen at the end of summer close to the Jewish New Year, pomegranates were often used in decorations and blessings for New Year's celebrations, according to the Madera Chamber of Commerce, which hosts a pomegranate festival each year in November. The pomegranate also played a central role in the foundations of some religions, including Christianity, Judaism, Greek Orthodox, and Hinduism. Sometimes referred to as "The Fruit of Life," pomegranates were believed to spring from The Garden of Paradise and represent fertility and rebirth. Some early Christians also associated the fruit with resurrection and eternal life.

The name pomegranate is derived from a Latin word meaning "seeded apple," a reference to the fruit's appearance. Pomegranates grow on shrubs or small trees and form large fruits that are filled with anywhere from 200 to 1,400 seed berries. The seeds are edible, while the remainder of the rind is usually discarded.

Enjoying the pomegranate out of hand is a social endeavor. Families often gather around the table, where the pomegranates are scored and then the clusters of seeds and juice are lifted out of the rind to be enjoyed. Even though this process is laborious, many people enjoy it while engaging in conversation.

The seeds also can be pressed to produce pomegranate juice, which is now a part of many health beverages. The resource Health says pomegranates are full of potent antioxidants, such as polyphenols and anthocyanins, which also are present in red wine. These compounds protect the body from damage caused by free radicals. Certain studies show that pomegranate juice can target bacteria in the mouth, helping produce healthier teeth and gums. Research also suggests that pomegranates have anti-inflammatory properties that can help relieve muscle soreness.

Data from Purdue University says parts of the pomegranate plant, including the bark and roots, have been used for medicinal purposes. Extracts of the bark, leaves, immature fruit, and fruit rind have been given as astringents to treat diarrhea, dysentery and hemorrhages. Dried, pulverized flower buds have been employed as a remedy for bronchitis. ■

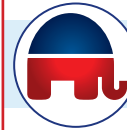

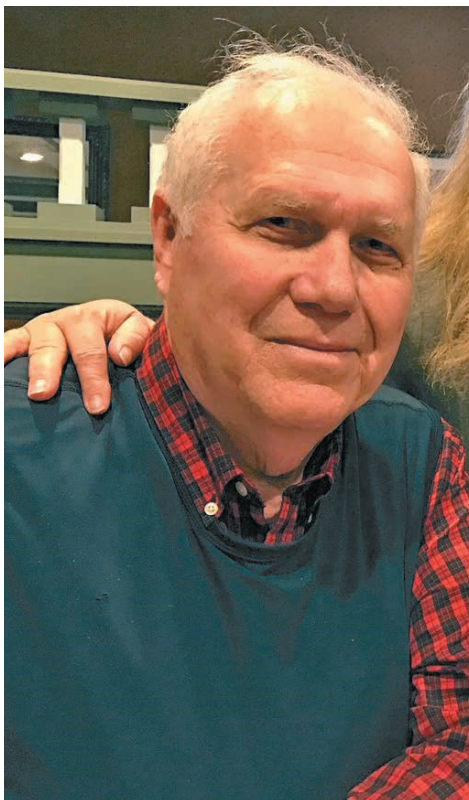

Which Renovations are Worth the Investment?

The cost of remodeling a home is easier to stomach when homeowners can expect to recoup a sizable percentage of the costs of the renovation. While basing renovations on their potential impact on resale value may be unwise, return on investment is something homeowners must consider when mulling renovation projects.

Many homeowners wonder which renovations will resonate most strongly with potential buyers when a home is put up for sale. According to Remodeling magazine, homeowners are less likely to recoup their investment in a major kitchen or bathroom remodel than they would with basic home maintenance, such as new siding. That's because buyers are most interested in how the bones of the house - or those elements that keep the house protected and can be costly to fix - were maintained.

Each year Remodeling magazine issues its "Cost vs. Value Report," which highlights the projects that offer the most return on investment. In 2016, the No. 1 project was the installation of fiberglass attic insulation, which could produce 116.9 percent recouped cost and a resale value of \$1,482. Rounding out the top five were manufactured stone veneer for the exterior, a standard new garage door, a steel entry door, and an upscale garage door.

Projects with the least return on investment tended to be more expensive undertakings that offered returns of roughly 57 percent. Such projects included bathroom additions, upscale bathroom additions, upscale master suite additions, upscale bathroom remodels, and deck additions.

For those considering more expensive renovations, keep these figures in mind, courtesy of Forbes.

- A major remodel of a 200-square-foot kitchen can cost around \$113,000, with homeowners recouping 60 percent.
- Replacing 1,250-square feet of siding with new fiber siding can cost \$13,000, but homeowners can expect to recoup 80 percent of that cost at resale.
- Replacing 10 existing double-hung windows with vinyl low-e glass windows is valued at \$14,000, and the return can be between 68 and 73 percent.

There are even renovations that seem like good ideas but can actually hurt the resale value of a home. MSN Money lists these projects as money-wasters for those who want to sell soon.

- Lavish lighting fixtures can look dated in a few years when trends change.
- Wallpaper or textured walls can be notoriously hard to change, and buyers know that.
- Kitschy renovations, such as 1950s diner tiles, may appeal to only a select number of people. Neutral renovations are better if resale is the goal.
- Many real estate experts warn against converting a bedroom into anything other than a bedroom - even for the purposes of a home office. Such conversions can immediately devalue the property. The same can be said about combining two small bedrooms into one larger space.

Homeowners should investigate potential renovations before committing the time and money to something that may offer little value at resale. ■

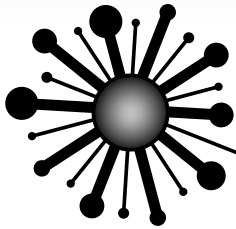

How Families Can Prepare for Downsizing to Smaller Homes

During the housing market crash of the first decade of the 21st century, many families learned to get by with less. For some of those families, less lavish living fit like a glove, prompting them to change their lifestyles for the long haul.

Downsizing to smaller homes was a move made by many families over the last several years. - Don't just discard, donate or sell. One of the hidden benefits of downsizing to a smaller home is the chance to make some money by selling those items you won't be needing after you move into your new digs. Schedule a yard sale and give ample notice to neighbors or fellow community members so you can get as much as possible for the items you no longer need. If money is no object, donating your unwanted items to a local goodwill store or another charity is a great way to ensure your possessions find their way into the homes of people who truly need them. When getting rid of personal items, only discard those items that are no longer functional. If they can still serve a purpose, then someone can benefit from using them.

- Promise to revisit the decision down the road after moving. Families who are downsizing for a lifestyle change as opposed to out of economic need can promise to revisit the decision together in the future. Families may be quick to adjust and be grateful for the change, while others might realize their decision did not produce the desired results. Promising to revisit the decision once the dust has settled can give everyone some peace of mind and make the transition that much easier. ■
