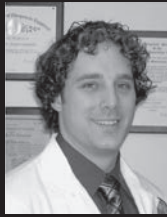

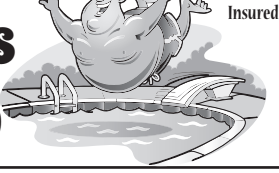

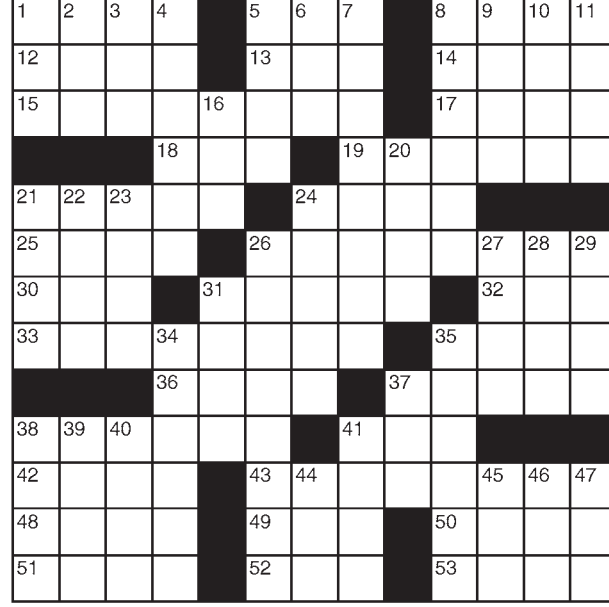

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On May 19, 1836, during a raid, Comanche Indians in Texas kidnap 9-year-old Cynthia Ann Parker and kill her family. Adopted into the Comanche tribe, she lived a happy life with them for 25 years until Texas Rangers recaptured her and forced her to live again among Anglo-Americans. Weakened by self-imposed starvation, she died of influenza.
- On May 18, 1920, Karol Jozef Wojtyla is born in Poland. Wojtyla went on to become Pope John Paul II, history's most well-traveled pope and the first non-Italian to hold the position since the 16th century. Pope John Paul II issued the Catholic Church's first apology for its actions during World War II.
- On May 21, 1932, aviator Amelia Earhart becomes the first pilot to repeat Charles Lindbergh's feat, landing her plane in Ireland after a 2,000-mile solo flight across the North Atlantic.
- On May 23, 1941, Joe "The Brown Bomber" Louis beats Buddy Baer to retain his heavyweight title at Griffith Stadium in Washington, D.C. Baer knocked Louis through the ropes in the first round, but Louis clawed his way back and eventually gutted out a victory.
- On May 22, 1969, the legendary actor, philanthropist and automobile enthusiast Paul Newman makes his onscreen racing debut in the film "Winning." Three years later, Newman launched a racing career of his own, driving a Lotus Elan in his first Sports Car Club of America race.
- On May 24, 1971, at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, an antiwar newspaper advertisement signed by 29 U.S. soldiers supporting the Concerned Officers Movement appears. The ad was in support of the group's members who opposed the departure of the carrier USS Constellation for Vietnam.
- On May 20, 1995, President Bill Clinton permanently closes the two-block stretch of Pennsylvania Avenue in front of the White House to all vehicular traffic, citing the need for security. The road had been opened to traffic for nearly 200 years.

Pecan Lace Cookies

These perfect special-occasion cookies are very delicate and elegant. If you like, they can be given a graceful shape by quickly molding them, while still warm, over a rolling pin. Store, layered between waxed paper, in a large shallow container. They're heavenly with ice cream or sorbet.

- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup light corn syrup
- 3 tablespoons butter, cut into pieces (do not use margarine)
- 1/2 cup pecans, finely chopped
- 6 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract

1. Preheat oven to 375 F. Grease large cookie sheet.
2. In 2-quart saucepan, combine brown sugar, corn syrup and butter; heat to simmering over medium heat, stirring, until butter has melted and mixture is smooth. Remove saucepan from heat. With wooden spoon, stir in pecans, flour and vanilla.

3. Drop batter by level teaspoons, 3 inches apart, on prepared cookie sheet to make 6 to 8 cookies (depending on size of cookie sheet). Bake until lightly browned, 5 to 7 minutes. Cool on cookie sheet on wire rack about 1 minute to set slightly; with wide spatula, quickly transfer cookies to wire racks to cool completely.
4. Repeat with remaining batter. Makes about 36 cookies.

THIS IS A HAMMER

Summer Energy Savings

Q. How can I improve the efficiency of my air conditioner? I change the filter every month, but I haven't noticed much difference in my power bills. — Craig K., Fresno, California

A. Changing the air filter regularly is a great first line of attack in keeping power bills low, along with other benefits like reducing allergens inside your home. According to the Environmental Protection Agency, it doesn't take much dirt buildup on the A/C coil — about 0.42 inch — to reduce its efficiency by as much as 21 percent. That can translate to a cost increase of more than \$200 more per year (from \$518 per year for an average home, to \$725 per year, according to a Permatron release).

But regular maintenance also is important, even for newer units — and that includes outdoor and indoor components of your air conditioning system, such as the outdoor air compressor.

Schedule an annual checkup of the A/C system before summer weather really cranks up. This will run around \$100. Make sure it's performed by a certified heating and air-conditioning professional, who should check the indoor and outdoor coils as well as the compressor and capacitors. The unit's airflow and its cooling capacity also should be checked, along with refrigerant levels. The electrical components need to be checked as well.

Once your air conditioning unit is in tip-top shape, start managing your home's temperature more efficiently. If you haven't installed a digital programmable thermostat, now is the time. Not only does it maintain a home's temperature more precisely, it also can be set to a higher or lower temperature based on when you're at home.

To keep cooler air inside during the summer months, check or update weather stripping around windows and doors, which will help stop air from escaping as rapidly. Your home's insulation also plays an important role in improving energy bills, so have it checked and updated or replaced if needed.

TIP: Use ceiling fans in conjunction with air conditioning to better circulate air throughout the house.

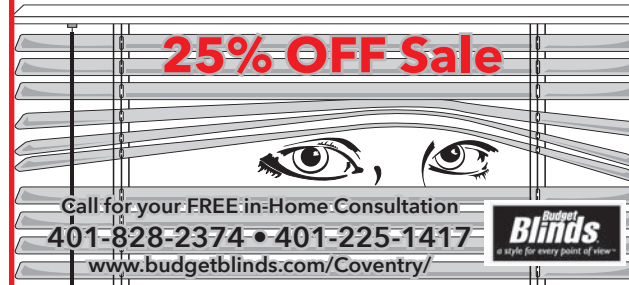

Flow Blue China

Q. I have about two dozen pieces of Flow Blue in the Melbourne and Normandy patterns. I am downsizing, but when I contacted antique dealers in my area there didn't seem to be much interest. The few offers I got were less than what I originally paid. — *Peggy, Austin, Texas*

A. Flow Blue was introduced by Staffordshire, England, potters in about 1825 and remained popular for a century. The name describes the blurred or flowing effect of the cobalt decoration achieved through the introduction of a chemical vapor into the kiln. Oriental patterns were especially favored by collectors.

Flow Blue still is collected, of course, but prices have slumped. A platter in the Regent pattern that might have sold for \$400 a few years ago sells today for only half that. The antique and collectible market is always changing. I suggest you hold on to your pieces until if and when the market rebounds.

A good source is the Flow Blue International Collectors' Club, P.O. Box 5427, Naperville, IL 50567; www.flowblue.org.

Q. I recently purchased about a dozen older fruit jars at a farm auction. Is there a price guide for them? I have several that are obviously old and might be rare. — *Carolyn, Davenport, Iowa*

A. As early as 1829, fruit jars were being manufactured for use in food preservation. At the last estimate, more than 4,000 fruit jars and variations were known to exist.

One of the better guides is "1000 Fruit Jars Priced and Illustrated" by Bill Schroeder, published by Collector Books. It is \$5.95 and is even available as an eBook. Collector Books can be ordered through its toll-free number, 800-626-5420. The guide is updated occasionally, and I believe accurately reflects the marketplace.

Q. I have a membership card to the Jack Westaway Undersea Adventure Club. What can you tell me about it? I picked it up at a garage sale and paid \$5 for it. — *Steve, Littleton, Colorado*

A. During the 1930s, the Jack Westaway Undersea Adventure Club was sponsored by Malt-O-Meal. The club badge was shaped like a diving helmet. According to auctioneer Ted Hake, your membership card is worth between \$20 and \$100, depending, of course, on condition.





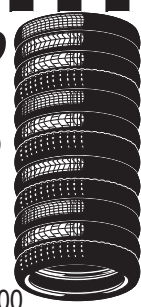

Your Garden

10 Ways To Help Bees And Butterflies Thrive

(NAPSA)—Here's news that's created a buzz. Three-quarters of the world's flowering plants and food crops rely on pollinating insects such as bees and butterflies to help them reproduce.

blooming and to prolong the foraging window for pollinators.

6) Use beautiful native plants such as echinacea, coreopsis, sunflowers and butterfly milkweed for at least 75 percent of your garden.

7) Water, weed and fertilize soil appropriately to create a healthy garden that minimizes pests and diseases.

8) Provide clean water for insects in shallow bowls, birdbaths and ponds, or let fresh water drip over stones.

9) Imperfection is OK! Bees and butterflies may damage leaves and flowers while breeding and feeding. Create areas of natural habitat with old stumps, fallen branches and tall grass for nesting.

10) Help convert small parcels of land into community gardens and green spaces to create closely linked areas for bees and butterflies to visit.

POP, ROCK & SOUL TRIVIA
BY MICK HARPER

This wickedly delightful cookbook features more than 100 recipes contributed by such legendary mystery authors as Sandra Brown, J.A. Jance, Sue Grafton and Mary Higgins Clark. In addition to the recipes, there are full-color illustrations, mischievous sidebars revealing links between food and foul play, and dozens of fun facts, such as lethal plants found in the family garden. Famed English mystery writer Agatha Christie knew a great deal about poisons, using them in the plots of roughly half of her 64 novels.

The cookbook's recipes are divided into seven main sections: Breakfast, Appetizers, Soups & Salads, Entrees, Side Dishes, Desserts and Cocktails.

Kate White, former editor in chief at Cosmopolitan and The New York Times' best-selling author of the Bailey Weggins mystery series, offers insights and facts about major fictional characters. Whether it's a hard-boiled breakfast, thrilling entree or cozy dessert, no one knows as much about the importance of stomach contents as these illustrious members of the Mystery Writers of America.

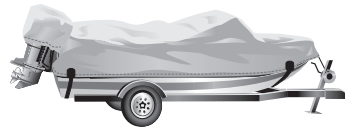



Quick Asparagus Crepes
 For a quick but elegant lunch, dazzle guests with these cream sauce-topped asparagus crepes.

- 2 pounds asparagus
- 1 tablespoon olive or salad oil
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 package (10-ounce) flour tortillas, 6- to 7-inch (about 8 tortillas)
- 1/2 pound Muenster or Swiss cheese, thinly sliced
- 1/2 pound cooked ham, thinly sliced

- Hold base of each asparagus stalk firmly and bend stalk; end will break off at spot where stalk becomes too tough to eat. Discard tough ends; trim scales if stalks are gritty.
- In 2-qt saucepan over medium heat, in hot olive or salad oil, cook flour 1 minute. Gradually stir in milk and salt; over high heat, heat to boiling, stirring constantly. Reduce heat to low; simmer 1 minute. Keep sauce warm.
- In 12-inch skillet over high heat, in 1/2-inch boiling water, heat asparagus to boiling. Reduce heat to medium-low and cook asparagus 3 to 5 minutes until tender-crisp; drain.
- Top a tortilla with one-eighth of cheese slices, one-eighth of ham slices, and one-eighth of asparagus spears; roll up. Secure with a toothpick if necessary. Repeat with remaining tortillas, cheese, ham, and asparagus, working quickly so tortillas do not dry out.
- Place rolls on broiler-safe platter; pour sauce over rolls. With oven rack at closest position to source of heat, broil tortilla rolls 5 minutes or until sauce is lightly browned. Discard toothpicks. Serves 4.


