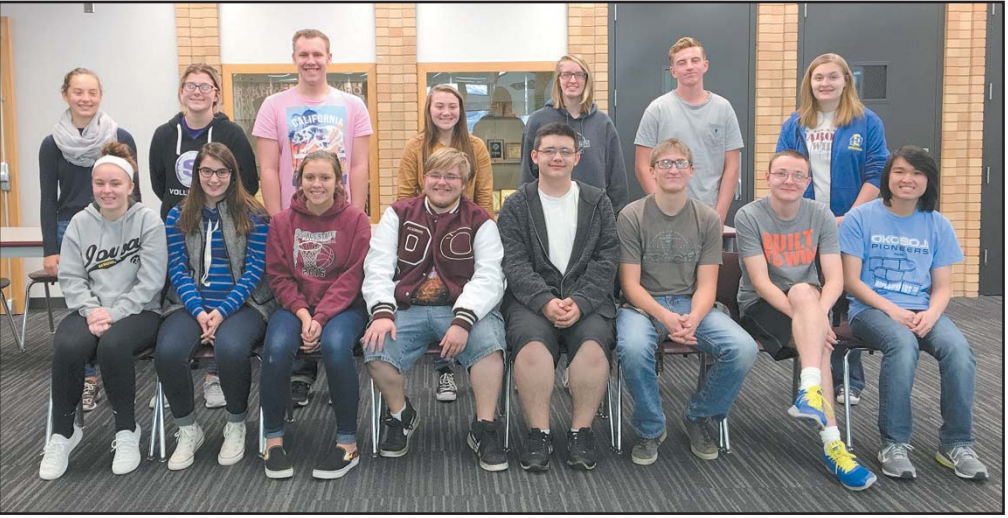

Restore The Park Campaign Receives CAT Grant

The Enhance Iowa Board awarded a Community Attraction and Tourism (CAT) grant to Arnolds Park Amusement Park yesterday at their meeting in Grand Junction. The \$935,000 grant was awarded for Phases 2 and 3 of the Restore the Park campaign. These two phases include the expansion of the Maritime Museum, the renovation of the Majestic Pavilion, and a new Roof Garden.

Phase 2 of the project was started shortly after Labor Day this year with the expansion of the Maritime Museum. The expansion will include new space for the Iowa Rock and Roll Music Association Museum, new offices for the Okoboji Foundation, Iowa Great Lakes Chamber of Commerce, and the Okoboji Tourism Association. A 60% increase in space for the Iowa Great Lakes Maritime Museum is also included in this phase and will house the recent donation of the original Funhouse Slide, Sugar Bowl and Barrel from Grapetree Medical, along with other area and park history.

The restoration of the Majestic Pavilion was started the first week of October. This project will include new restrooms, flooring, windows, kitchen facilities, audio visual, ticket office, and administration facilities for the park. Phase 3 of the project begins after Labor Day in 2018 with the demolition of the current Roof Garden and the building of a new Roof Garden. The new facility will have the look and feel of the original Roof Garden with updated amenities to make it a much more functional space.

Charley Whittenburg, CEO of Arnolds Park Amusement Park said after the meeting, "Arnolds Park would like to thank the Enhance Iowa Board. We would also like to thank the community members and businesses who are supporting this project. Also, all the local governments who recently stepped up and put financial commitment behind this project. Without their support we would not have been able to obtain this grant."

Sen. Bob Corker, (R) Tenn., Sen. Jeff Flake, (R) Ariz. and Pres. Trump

Much was said this week by two Republican senators about President Trump.

In a CNN interview, Sen. Corker said: "When his term is over, the constant non-truth telling, the name calling, the debasement of our nation is what will be remembered and that's regretful." Also: "I think world leaders are very aware that much of what he says is untrue." Also: "I think that he's proven himself unable to rise to the occasion...I don't think that that's possible. He's obviously not going to rise to the occasion as president." Corker also announced that he will not run for reelection as he cannot support the direction the administration is taking the country.

In a speech on the senate floor, judged by some to be the most important political speech of 2017, Senator Flake said the following: "We must never regard as normal the regular and casual undermining of our democratic norms and ideals. We must never meekly accept the daily sundering of our country -- the personal attacks, the threats against principles, freedoms, and institutions, the flagrant disregard for truth or decency, the reckless provocations, most often for the pettiest and most personal reasons, reasons having nothing whatsoever to do with the fortunes of the people that we have all been elected to serve." He also said "It is often said that children are watching. Well, they are. And what are we going to do about that? When the next generation asks us why didn't you do something? Why didn't you speak up? What are you going to say?" And finally: "The notion that one should stay silent as the norms and values that keep America strong are undermined and as the alliances and agreements that ensure the stability of the entire world are routinely threatened by the level of thought that goes into 140 (tweet) characters--the notion that one should say and do nothing in the face of such mercurial behavior is ahistoric and, I believe profoundly misguided."

Some Republican leaders, including President Bush and Sen. John Mc Cain voice similar opinions along with an increasing number of members of congress. So...now what? What happens next?

A silent auction will offer gift baskets, works of art, jewelry, and more. Bidding closes at 10:30am on November 18.

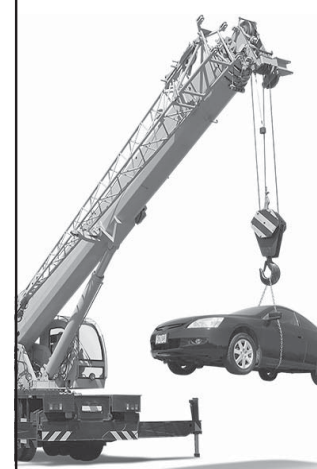

Working Toward Climate Solutions at Iowa Lakeside Lab

Climate-solution advocates launched a five-state regional gathering on the weekend of October 13-15 at the Iowa Lakeside Laboratory north of Milford. The Citizens Climate Lobby is a bipartisan organization focused on building political will for climate solutions by enabling personal breakthroughs in the exercise of personal and political power. The conference emphasized working together to address climate solutions with a regional approach focused on best practices in agriculture, water quality and expanded wind and other renewable energy sources.



Local explorer, writer and photographer David Thoreson opened the conference with a keynote session titled "The Great Adventure to Save the Planet: Creating a New Era of Sustainability". He demonstrated the connections between excess carbon and the degradation of atmosphere, oceans and water quality, and discussed how recent scientific advances have come up with solutions to both water and climate issues. He ended his presentation stressing the potential of agriculture to establish the Midwest as an economic powerhouse and leader in climate solutions through sustainable growth.

Saturday morning featured climate-advocate training for those new to CCL and the bipartisan approach lead by national CCL Program Director Madeleine Para. Saturday afternoon emphasized the changes facing our agricultural community with a "Listening to Farmers" panel. Five local farmers related their efforts to shift to more sustainable techniques such as conservation, filter strips, low till, cover crops, organic production, prairie strips and other measures. This session was intended to help the public better understand the complexities of agricultural issues and to build bridges between farmers and consumers in finding workable and equitable solutions to our common climate challenges.

The evening ended in a spirited fireside discussion of many issues moderated by David Thoreson with Iowa State Senators David Johnson and Rob Hogg.

With the regional conference over, the next CCL event goes national with the fourth annual Citizens Climate Congressional Education Day. Devon Piersma, member of the Iowa Great Lakes Chapter of the Citizens Climate Lobby and Sioux City native, will join hundreds of other climate advocates in Washington DC and represent Iowa's Fourth Congressional District. Participants will celebrate CCL's tenth anniversary and meet with their members of congress to ask them to pass a Carbon Fee and Dividend Bill. The proposed national carbon fee and dividend policy would put a price on carbon pollution and refund all money collected as a dividend to US households.

The Iowa Great Lakes CCL is one of 435 active chapters nationwide. Whether you are brand new or a seasoned CCL chapter member, conservative or liberal, climate skeptic or climate activist, there is something for everyone within this unique and growing grassroots organization. PRINT MARKETING vs DIGITAL MARKETING

CONSUMER BEHAVIOR & NEUROMARKETING PRINCIPLES

One of the most common questions that I get from new clients is "should I focus on digital ads or print ads?" There is no easy answer to this question, but my general answer to that question is both. And, for the clients that want to move completely digital, there is new data out that suggests you should put the brakes on that thought and rethink.

Why? Simply put, it's about how our brain works. In a recent study, based on brain scans, a print ad appeals more to the part of the brain that has the highest correlation with advertising effectiveness than a digital ad. Brand recall is up to 70% higher in print advertising than in digital media. In a study that measured 1,400 campaigns using a variety of ad venues, print advertising resulted in the highest return on ad spending. Consumers are 70% more likely to remember a company name from a print ad than a digital ad. There is also a 75% print ad recall, (meaning they remember the ad) in comparison to a 44% digital ad recall.

Generally speaking, consumers tend to be more relaxed and focused when they read print magazines or newspapers. As a result, they are less likely to be distracted by other options and they therefore make decisions more quickly and are generally more likely to feel satisfied with purchases they make in this mindset.

Researchers are just starting to understand the neurological pros and cons of online versus print advertising. But, it may come as no surprise that print and digital media excel in different areas. One of the most notable benefits of print ads is that they are better at stimulating emotions and desires. Engaging with a physical ad can also improve recognition and recall because paper stimulates more senses and is therefore more real to the brain. And for those of us trying to build a brand that connects emotionally with our customers, to create brand loyalty, it builds a case for continued print ad spending.

So, you may still be thinking, who reads print anymore? It comes as no surprise to me that based on this study, magazine readers are wealthy and well educated. However, they also found that the Millennial did not get lost, as data shows 95% of Americans under the age of 25 still read print magazines. And that's the real story.

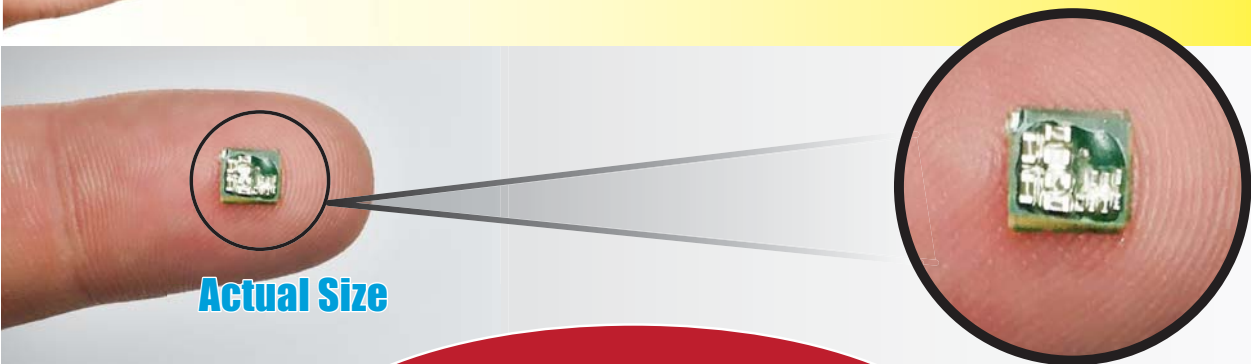





The Passing on of Native American History
