Museum Firm Recognized

FLORENCE — The new museum at the Indian mound has been a source of pride for city officials since it opened in 2016. It's also getting attention from the American Institute of Architects, and the Florence firm that designed the museum has taken home a prestigious

The AIA recently recognized Lambert Ezell Durham Architecture with the North Alabama Chapter Honor Award for Design Excellence for its work on the museum. It is the highest award offered by the professional association.

"It's very humbling and a real honor," said Calvin Durham, lead architect on the museum's design. "What's interesting is when other design architects notice the little things you did in the details." details.'

A juried panel of architects from Indiana selected the winners. Among the comments they offered on the museum's design were the large windows that face the prehistoric mound, reflecting its shape. The mound is clearly visible from almost every corner of the museum, and motifs including a map of the Tennessee River and petroglyphs are used

throughout.

Architects also pointed out that the museum is incorporated into a very narrow space because the

property is small.

The 3,438-square-foot museum has an interactive display area that depicts various historical eras of the Native Americans who lived near the mound, a meeting room, and a lobby with more display space.





My wife had a car wreck in September. The man who caused the wreck's insurance company wants to record her over the phone telling them about what happened, should she do it?

David, Florence, AL

The short answer is NO. While you are obligated to cooperate with your own insurance company and give your own insurance company a statement, this does NOT require you to give a recorded statement to the other driver's insurance company. In fact, you should never give a recorded statement until you have consulted with an experienced personal injury lawyer. Insurance companies' claims adjusters are professional negotiators with extensive experience. They are well trained to ask questions in a manner designed to hurt your

claim. Insurance adjusters are trained to save money for the insurance companies. If they can do that by making fault questionable or by establishing that your medical claims are unfounded or unrelated, they may avoid having to pay for the full extent of your injuries.

Usually the insurance adjuster taking the statement is not the insurance adjuster who handles the property damage and the adjuster that handles the property damage claim is not the one that handles the personal injury claim. The one who wants you to talk can be charming. The one who wants to pay you as little as possible won't be.

I also don't believe that these questions really can be answered accurately after an accident. Yet we all know that any inaccuracy will be used by the insurance company to make it appear as if you were lying. The problem is that the impressions left in memory after a sudden accident aren't accurate. There is no substitute for going to the scene with an attorney and foot looking at skid marks, scuff marks and debris left on the pavement as well as having a look at the distances involved. Only after you know the facts should you attempt to state the facts.

NW-SCC will serve limited potential firstincome, generation students at Belgreen, Central, Colbert Haleyville, County, Lexington, Lynn, Rogers, Sheffield, Vina, and Wilson High Schools.

The Math and Science program is the third U.S. Department of Education TRiO grant awarded to NW-SCC in 2017. Phil Campbell Upward Bound and Shoals Campus Upward Bound were two of seventeen programs in Alabama to receive funding in May.

The program is aimed at students between 9th and 12th grades from lower income backgrounds who will be the first in their families to graduate college. The program also encourages individuals to complete a two-year or four-



Four Earn All Conference

BIRMINGHAM - The University of North Alabama volleyball team had four players earn All-Gulf South Conference honors, headline by Lexie **Bradley** being named the 2017 GSC Player of the Year. Jessica Austin joined Bradley as a first team All-GSC selection. Ashtyn Kapovich and Jayden Davila-McClary each received second-team honors.

Bradley was also named GSC Player of the Week for a league-leading five times this season. She led the conference and finished the regular season No. 7 in the nation with a 4.75 kills-perset average. She was also ninth in the GSC with a .286 hitting percentage and fifth with 0.41 service aces per set. She also earned first team All-GSC honors for the second straight year after earning second-team honors in 2015

Austin finished the regular season second in the GSC at 3.73 kills per set. She captures first-team All-GSC recognition after earning second-team honors a year ago. She led the league in hitting percentage throughout most of the year and finished with a .424 average. The senior from Farmington Hills, Mich., started all 32 matches for the Lions.

Kapovich is named All-GSC for the third time in her career. She was a two-time GSC Defensive

Player of the Week this season, totaling 579 digs for a 4.99 per-set average. After starting every match at libero this year, she has moved into second place all-time at UNA with 2,168 career digs. The senior from Lansing, Ill., also set a new UNA career record with 119 matches with

Her per-set average is ninth-best in the country. As the starting setter for UNA, McClary helped lead the Lions to a .253 team hitting percentage. The junior from Winter Garden, Florida., added 57 kills, 25 service aces, 300 digs and 33 total blocks during the regular season.





Manush

T h e Manush home was selected to

showcase the history of Tuscumbia by telling the story of one of its important citizens. The texts included with the ornament offer official Alabama 200 recognition and describe Manush's illustrious career. He played in the American and National Leagues, won the Batting Title in 1920, played in the World Series in 1933, and the All Star Game in 1934.

His lifetime batting average was .330. Manush was the first Alabamian inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame (1964). He was posthumously inducted into the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame in 1972 and the Colbert County Sports Hall of Fame in 2000.

Tuscumbia Civitan Club supports many worthwhile charitable endeavors in the community through sales of the Christmas ornaments and the traditional sale of Claxton Fruitcakes. 




ON YOUR DEBT

The Truth **About Credit Cards**

With the holiday shopping season upon us, I think we need to talk about credit cards and the evil that may lurk in the fine print. It is difficult to checkout at any store lately without the clerk trying to push me to open a credit card. I know their employer instructs them to make these offers and they most likely make a commission on how many accounts they open, but it has become pretty annoying.

What's the Issue?

Many stores, especially around the holidays, will offer a one-time steep discount on your purchase if you open a store credit card account. Then, they suck you in with the future rewards and "benefits" that come with the card. Getting 10, 15, or 20 percent off your initial purchase sure sounds good, but have you stopped to read the fine print? In today's electronic world it only takes a few entries and clicks on the register keypad to be all signed up for your shiny new credit card. Believe me, when you sign your name, you are stating that you have read the "terms" and conditions." But how many of us stop to do that when we are standing in the checkout line with a swarm of other shoppers behind us?

Interest Rates

First of all, let's talk about interest rates. I checked with a few local banks and credit unions, and they generally offer interest rates of 8.00% APR (annual percentage rate) to 12.50% APR or up to 18.00% APR depending upon your credit rating. Most store cards do not care about your credit rating and simply have set interest rates. Many of these cards are owned and serviced by large national financial institutions. According to. www.creditcards.com, most store card interest rates average about 25% APR, and one national retailer is now going over 30 percent! So, here is the problem. With interest rates like these, if you don't payoff that initial purchase, the one where you saved 10, 15 or 20 percent when you opened the card, in the first month before interest kicks in you actually lose that discount! If you make minimum monthly payments, you may end up paying for that awesome leather jacket or cool new pair of boots for years to come!

What You Can Do to Avoid the Trap

Your best bet when in these situations is to stand strong against a pushy salesclerk and refuse the offer to open the store card. If you don't, before you know it, you will have a wallet full of cards and a potential mountain of debt. Don't take the card just for a discount. Odds are if you are already at the checkout line with your items you already have the means to pay for them without taking on a new credit card. It is never advisable to make purchases you really can't afford just because the credit card perk is "an offer you can't refuse."

However, I know that it is easy to accept that deep discount for a few clicks on the register key pad. I have fallen for it myself. It is especially easy when you want to provide meaningful gifts to family and friends during the holidays.

If you have gotten involved with too much credit card debt, even if you can afford the minimum payments, take a look on your next statement at how long it will take you to actually pay off all the debt and interest. It is usually between 13 to 22 years if you are only making the minimum payment. 

No Lookers?

My home has been on the market for months, why is it not being shown?

There could be many reasons for this, but I'll start with some obvious questions first:

1.) Have you looked at your home online? Are there multiple photos of the interior and exterior? According to the National Association of REALTORS, 88% of home buyers look for homes on the internet, thus making your online representation critical to the success of getting your home sold. If a buyer looks at your home online and there are no additional photos or if the photos you have are dark, fuzzy and horrible, it may not intrigue them enough to want to make an appointment to see it.

2.) No compelling feature or benefit that would present value in the eyes of the buyer. There may be several homes in a particular price range competing against you, what does your home have or offer that others don't? For example if you have a pool, a detached workshop or a fenced backyard, you need to be sure that those items are listed in the remarks and have pictures of them. Real estate is competitive. Everyone wants to feel like they are getting the most for their money and so would you. Give buyers a reason to want to see your home.

3.) What does your home look like from the street? Many prospective home buyers will drive by a home first to see what it looks like and/or what is around it. Suggestion: If your home is on the market, keep it lit up at night! I can assure you if a ready, willing and able buyer finds a home they like and are excited about, they're not going to put it off until the next day. Make sure your home looks maintained, clean and welcoming from the street. In order to get them on the inside, they have to like the outside.

4.) Is your home overpriced? Call your REALTOR and get a list of all of the homes in your area and price range that have gone into pending status since the day you listed your home. You also need to see a list of the 4 or 5 homes that your agent feels are the best active competing listings for your home. Remember #2 here as well. How do you stack up against the competition? Price is one of the leading reasons why properties don't get shown. Make sure you know where you stand. *-mr*

Thoughts About Thanksgiving

As we again approach the Thanksgiving holiday it should remind us all that we need to stop and consider how richly blessed we are. Not only that, but we should also be grateful to the giver of "every good and every perfect gift," which is none other than God (James 1:17).

(Philippians 4:4). He too had the right perspective on life.

For over a hundred years Christians have been singing the words, "Count your many blessings, name them one by one." There are a lot of us who could do much better at putting these words into practice!

Medicare Minute

"Types of Medicare Advantage Plans"

There are basically two types of Medicare Advantage Plans. One type is a HMO. HMO stands for Health Maintenance Organization. The other type is a PPO or Preferred Provider Organization. Although both are Medicare Advantage Plans there are some distinct differences in the two.

In most HMO plans you generally can only go to doctors, health care facilities or hospitals that are on the provider list of the plan except in emergency. HMO plans require you to name a primary care provider (PCP). Your PCP becomes the quarterback of your health care. This means you may have to have a referral from your PCP if you want to see a specialist or another health care provider. All HMO plans do not require a referral so this is a question you will want to ask of considering a HMO.

In a PPO plan you also have a defined network of providers. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network but, unlike a HMO, you may have some coverage if you go to an out-of-network provider. You will pay more for using an out-of-network provider versus an in-network provider. Also a PPO plan may give you the option of getting your health care from a provider outside your immediate geographical area whereas a HMO can be more limited.

HMO and PPO plans are similar in many ways. They both have a defined network of providers, both have a copay on most services you receive and except for a few exceptions will both include prescription drug coverage. Finding a Medicare health plan is about finding the plan that is right for you. It's a good idea to research both HMO and PPO plans if you are considering a Medicare Advantage Plan.
