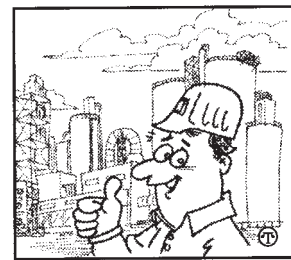

Food For Thought

Hybrids, Heirlooms And GMOs Explained

(NAPS)—If the terms “hybrid,” “heirloom” and “GMO” have you stumped, you’re not alone. When it comes to buying seeds and plants, there’s a lot of confusion, even among seasoned gardeners. Here are a few facts that may help.

Hybrids

First things first: Hybrids are not the same thing as genetically modified organisms (GMOs). Thanks to pollinators such as bees and butterflies moving pollen from plant to plant, hybrids occur naturally in nature. A hybrid is created when two different plant varieties of the same species are cross-pollinated.

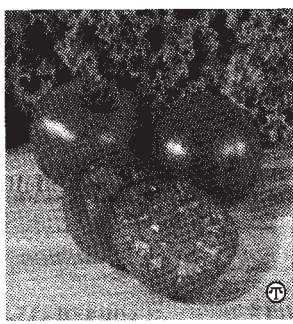
In the same way that dog breeders can cross a Labrador retriever and a poodle to create a soft, fluffy Labradoodle, gardeners can select parent plants that display particular traits to produce offspring that offer improved yield, size, hardiness, color, shape and taste.

The process of selective breeding was pioneered by Gregor Mendel in the 19th century. When it was first used by horticulturists in the 20th century, it resulted in hybrid corn that produced higher yields. Since that point, breeders, researchers and inventive gardeners have been using the process of hybridization to produce fruits, vegetables and flowers with highly selective features. Seed producers such as W. Atlee Burpee & Co. used selective breeding to create iconic vegetables such as the “Big Boy” tomato, a hybrid that displayed such vigor and disease resistance that it shaped the modern era of tomato breeding.

“Hybrids grow well coast to coast with stable and reliable traits across a multitude of growing environments. The dependability of flavor and garden performance is what makes them garden staples throughout the good—and the bad—growing seasons,” said Chelsey Fields, a horticulturist at Burpee.

Heirlooms

Unlike hybrid seeds that

result from selective breeding, heirlooms are open-pollinated varieties prized for having characteristics that haven’t changed over 50 to 100 years. They’re often specific to a particular area and therefore not widely adaptable. Also, unlike hybrids, their flowers and fruits tend to be less vigorous, making them more susceptible to diseases and adverse conditions. Many heirloom seeds were once available commercially and have been saved from extinction by dedicated gardeners who save fresh seeds every year.

Genetically Modified Organisms

GMOs are quite different from both hybrids and heirlooms. GMO seeds are the result of genetic engineering, the process of altering a plant’s DNA in a laboratory setting. This often includes introducing genes from a different species to increase a plant’s resistance to disease or spoilage. It’s important to know GMOs are found only in commercially grown farm produce. Seeds or plants that might contain GMOs are not available to home gardeners in the United States. All of Burpee’s hybrid and heirloom seeds are non-GMO. The company has supplied American home gardeners with the highest-quality seeds since 1876.

Random Acts of Kindness...

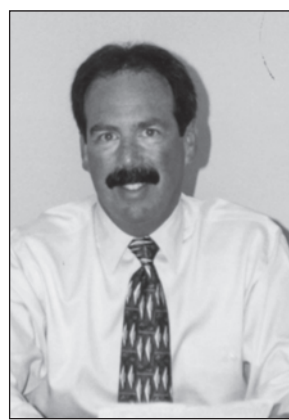

The Royal We

The question was met with a wince of pain that quickly metamorphosed into a look of utter disbelief and disdain.

"Now why on Earth would we ever want to do that?" was the reply.

It wasn't the first time my ol' pardner, the late, great Bill Grigsby, the Kansas City announcer best known for being the longtime voice of the Chiefs and one of the first announcers of the Super Bowl, shot me down. At the time we collaborated on a community newspaper in Kansas City, and I had the swell idea to start a "Royals Review" column to augment our sports section.

"Kid," he said to me, "I paid my dues covering bad baseball when I called the Kansas City A's for Charlie O'Finley, and I wouldn't even take the time to piss on that [man's] grave."

"Why not, Bill?" I asked.

This time he shot me a look of annoyance.

"Because the line is always too damn long!"

Good ol' Grigs ... I set 'em up and he'd knock 'em down. Fine, I said, I'd cover the lousy games myself.

But then the Royals hired Ned Yost. He had flamed out as a catcher in the big leagues, but I knew him as the bullpen coach for the dynastic Braves of the '90s. He was mistreated badly in Milwaukee, and now he had a second chance.

Yost was almost universally panned from the start for the way he handled the pitching staff. He

stayed the course. He made players change positions. Alex Gordon, who looked like a pretty good third baseman, would learn to play left field from scratch. Again, he was panned. And then, whether it was his idea or not, the Royals shook George Brett awake from his front-office desk and made him the team's interim batting coach.

Ask the Royals core players — Moustakas, Gordon, Hosmer, Cain — what it meant to have a living legend and a guy who knew nothing but how to compete to win all the time on the bench, on road trips, on flights, presumably in bars, with them during his short reign.

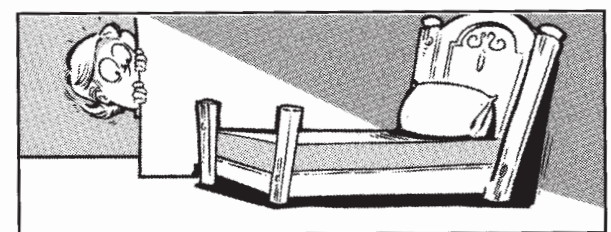
Then they called these anti-monkeyball Royals and their coach stupid for their style of play. Duh? Didn't they know they were not supposed to be aggressive at the plate anymore? That they shouldn't be swinging all the time? That fans wanted on-base percentages and walks? That stealing bases often hurt teams more than they helped? Swinging at the first pitch? No bonafide home-run hitters? Sacrilege!

Challenging hitters with relievers who were always rested and available because Yost was too stubborn to deviate from his plan to use one pitcher for his one designated inning and telling him to throw 1,000-mph fastballs straight down the pipe to challenge the other team's hitters to put the ball in play due to his superior defensive team? Hummm ... on second thought, that sort of made sense, didn't it?

Well Grigs, ol' pardner, we may never get to see these games together but in the long run, it turned out more than just a little bit OK for those that stuck by this franchise, that is, the Royal We. Congratulations, Kansas City. You're a helluva town.

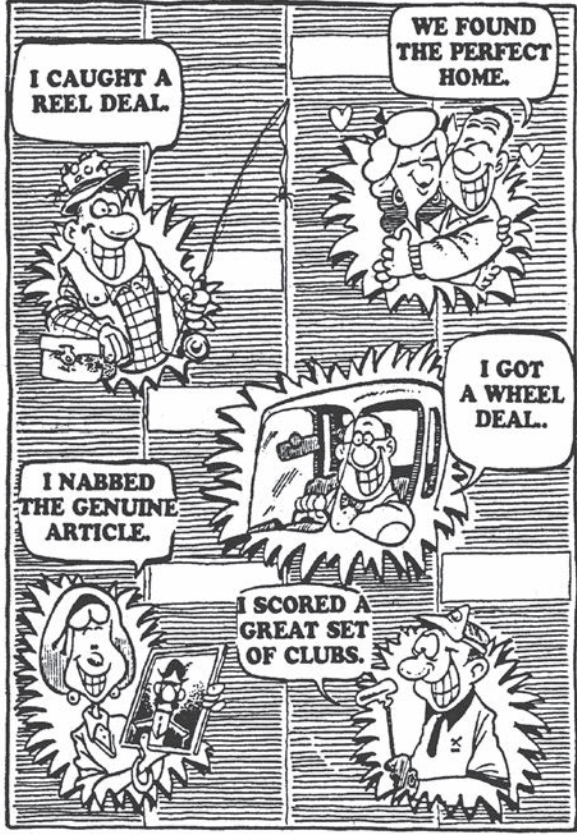

Collecting

Antique Level

Q. I have a 12-inch aluminum level made by Davis & Cook. I paid \$150 for it and hope I got a bargain. — Stan, Athens, Georgia

A. You'll be pleased to know that Davis & Cook levels are extremely rare, especially the 12-inch model. These date back to the early 1900s. According to "Antique Trader Tools Price Guide" by Clarence Blanchard and published by Krause Books, your level could be worth at least \$1,000. Blanchard is president of Antique & Collectible Tools, Inc., and is a nationally recognized expert in this field of collecting. In other words, you made an excellent buy.

Q. My mom was a grade-school teacher throughout the 1930s and '40s. She managed to save about three dozen books for children, including some that are first editions. I would like to sell them and hope you can help me. — Laura, Hondo, Texas

A. Books for children have become quite collectible in recent years, and values have risen accordingly. One of the better businesses that deals in these types of books is "The Prince & The Pauper Bookstore," which has an inventory of more than 250,000 new, out-of-print and simply used titles. Contact is 9740 Campo Road, No. 131, Spring Valley, CA 91977; old-kidsbooks.com; and 800-454-3726.

Q. I began collecting sterling flatware a number of years ago and currently have examples of about 45 patterns. Can you recommend a reference book that is user-friendly? — Ken, Philadelphia

A. There are several guides available, but my personal favorite is "Warman's Sterling Silver Flatware: Value & Identification Guide" by Mark F. Moran and published by Krause Books. This guide features 18,000 listings and values, with 1,200 photos, histories and descriptions. In identifying patterns, it is one of the easier references to use. It is my go-to book when I get a flatware question.

Q. I have a cookie jar in the Franciscan Apple pattern. Can you tell me what is it worth? — Janet, Pueblo, Colorado

A. According to most price guides I consulted, your cookie jar is valued in the \$50 to \$75 range.

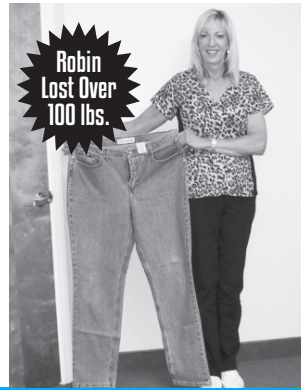

Pumpkin, Spice and Everything Nice

I know that harvest time is here when the colors in the produce section are dominated by dark vibrant greens, warm yellows and rich orange pumpkin colors. Pumpkins are the ambassadors of fall, ushering in the holiday season with its cooler days and longer nights.

The pumpkin plant originated in Central America and was introduced to the Pilgrims by Native American Indians. Pumpkins provide a hefty source of vitamin A, as well as being one of the tastiest forms of good-for-you fiber. The gorgeous orange color indicates significant amounts of beta carotene, also found in carrots, beets and sweet potatoes. Pumpkin seeds are rich in protein, minerals and fiber. They also possess a rich buttery taste that lends itself well to pestos, salad toppings or as a healthy snack.

I like using pumpkin to update traditional recipes like this modern version of Shepherd's Pie. You can make this crowd-pleaser in a baking dish or ramekins ahead of time and reheat it. Time in the refrigerator allows the spices to infuse the dish and the flavors to deepen. Harvest Shepherd's Pie is a wonderful way to celebrate fall!

- HARVEST SHEPHERD'S PIE**
- 1½ pounds peeled cubed baking pumpkin, butternut or kabocha squash
 - 1 pound peeled, cubed Yukon Gold or Russet potatoes

- For the meat filling:**
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
 - 1 cup chopped onion
 - 2 carrots, peeled and diced small
 - 2 cloves garlic, minced
 - 1½ pounds ground lamb or ground beef
 - 1 teaspoon kosher salt
 - 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
 - 1 tablespoon ground poultry seasoning

- 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg or cloves
- 1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1 cup chicken broth
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

- 1/4 cup half-and-half
- 2 ounces unsalted butter
- 3/4 teaspoon kosher salt

- 1/2 cup shredded Parmesan or Cheddar Cheese, optional

1. Heat oven to 400 F with a rack in the top third of oven. Put pumpkin and potatoes on a greased rimmed baking sheet. Roast pumpkin and potatoes, covered with aluminum foil,

mixture and spread evenly into an 11 by 7-inch glass baking dish, or divide evenly into ramekins.

4. Place the cooked pumpkin and the potatoes into a large bowl, and mash together until well-combined. Put half-and-half and butter into a microwave-safe container, and heat in microwave until warmed through, about 35 seconds. Add the warm half-and-half mixture, salt and pepper, and continue to mash until smooth. Stir in egg yolk until well-combined.

5. Top the baking dish or the ramekins containing the meat and vegetable mixture with the mashed pumpkin and potatoes. Start around the edges of the dish to create a seal to prevent the mixture from bubbling up, and smooth with a rubber spatula. Sprinkle with shredded cheese, if desired.

2. While pumpkin and potatoes are cooking, prepare filling. Place the oil into a 12-inch saute pan and set over medium-high heat. Once the oil shimmers, add the onion and carrots, and saute just until they begin to take on color, about 3-4 minutes. Add garlic and stir to combine. Add the ground lamb or ground beef, salt, pepper and poultry seasoning, and cook until browned, approximately 3-5 minutes.

3. Sprinkle the meat with flour and toss to coat, continuing to cook for another minute. Add the tomato paste, nutmeg or cloves, cayenne pepper, chicken broth and Worcestershire, and stir to combine. Bring to boil, reduce heat to low, cover and simmer slowly 10-12 minutes, stirring once or twice until the sauce is slightly thickened. Add frozen peas to meat

6. Place the baking dish or ramekins on a parchment or foil-lined half sheet pan on the middle oven rack and bake for 25 minutes, or just until the topping begins to brown and bubble around the edges. Remove to a cooling rack for at least 15 minutes before serving.

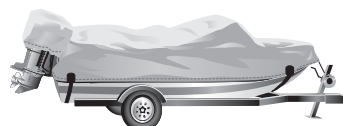

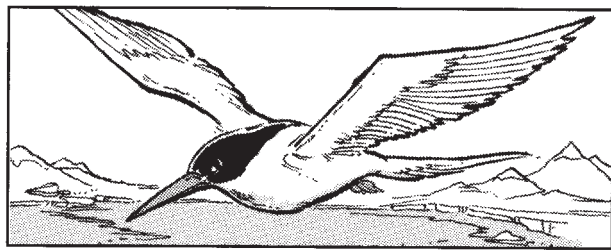
