



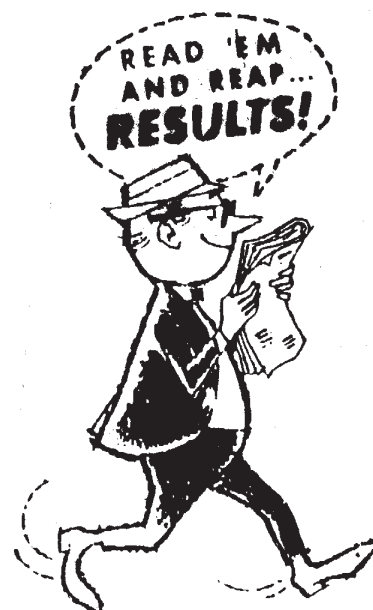

TRANSFER STATION NEWS

Due to increased costs of doing business, the Town Board regrettably has found it necessary to significantly increase the permit fees for the Transfer Station. Rates for 2018 are \$35 for Mt. Morris Seniors (65+), \$40 for other Mt. Morris Residents and \$45 for Non-Residents. New permits are now available at the Town Clerk's office. The Town Clerk will be at the Transfer Station selling permits and refuse disposal tickets on Wednesday January 3rd and Saturday January 6th.

The Transfer Station is intended to be a self-supporting service whose revenue covers the related expenses. It is increasingly difficult to maintain this balance. Therefore, customers should expect an increase in disposal fees in the near future. Again, we ask our recycling customers to do their part to lower costs. The Town has to pay a hauling fee of almost \$300 every time the dumpster of co-mingled recyclables is full. **PLEASE FLATTEN ALL PLASTICS AND METALS.** When items are not flattened, we are paying to haul air!! We need to maximize the amount of material in this container to keep down costs.

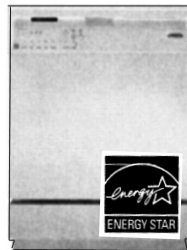

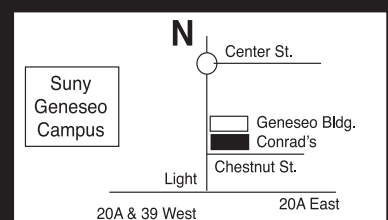

Be Aware of Ticks and the Increasing Numbers of Lyme Disease

With warm temperatures, it is important to be aware of ticks. Ticks generally live in cool, moist environments and can be found in tall grassy areas, moist garden areas, around shrubs and in wooded areas. In 2017, the number of ticks has increased and Lyme Disease reports have doubled.

Lyme disease is spread by the bite of an infected tick. It is very serious and can become crippling or debilitating if not properly diagnosed and treated with antibiotics. Serious risks from Lyme disease can be reduced if the tick is removed within 36 hours. There are several things you can do to protect yourself and your family from tick bites. Below are some basic tips to follow:

- Use protective measures. If you know you will be walking in tall grass wear long sleeves and tuck your pants into your socks and shirt into your pants. Also, try to wear light color clothing so that ticks are more visible. Wear light colored gloves, and a hat to protect your head.
- Apply insect repellents that contain DEET to clothes and exposed skin according to the manufacturer's directions.
- Perform a tick check on yourself, your pets and your children when finished with outside work or play.
- If a tick is found, do not apply mineral oil, petroleum jelly, or heat. Use fine-tipped tweezers to remove the tick. Contact your doctor if there are concerns about incomplete tick removal.

By following these guidelines, you can help protect yourself and your family from Lyme disease.

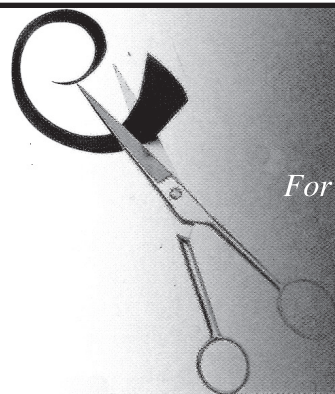

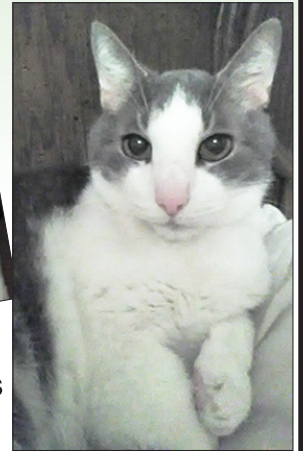
