



She worked on a large board at the front of the room and students came up with their own ideas. They created a character, who wants something they can't have, enemies and friends of the character and then plotted out how the character can journey to achieve their goal. My students showed they thoroughly enjoyed the writing workshop by bringing wonderful ideas back to class that they were proud to share with me and others.

High School English teacher, Karen Jones, was a classmate of Mrs. Berry's and has been reading Mrs. Berry's "All the Truth That's In Me" with her classes for the past three years. Publisher's Weekly calls it, "Suspenseful and haunting." It has also been optioned to become a movie. "Thematically it is very similar to both "The Scarlet Letter" and "The Crucible." It is unusual since it is written in the second person. That is the reason that drew me to it. This was a writing challenge to herself. I love it for seniors because it leads into our understanding of a deeper symbolism like archetype theory and it offers so many parallels to classic literature. One of their challenges as a senior is that they have to choose a book from our classic literature canon. Some of that literature can be really intimidating, so this could be their window in to talk about themes like sacrifice, love, betrayal, societal norms, and repression. We can talk about this all sorts of stuff and this is our entry point. I think it builds their confidence with tackling much harder literature. The fact that Julie graduated from Medina shows them this is what an author looks like. This is what you can grow up to be. That is encouraging, even to someone like me, a teacher, who has hopes of being an author. I want them to think, maybe I can do that too, no matter what I do."

The seniors had many questions to ask her about her process, what inspires her stories and what advice she would give anyone who wanted to be an author. "She is just so energizing and encouraging," says Mrs. Jones. "She comes all the way from Los Angeles to talk to the students and it means so much to all of us." The dedication to her new book says it all, "To the thousands of children who brainstormed with me in creative writing workshops. To answer the question you frequently ask me; yes, this is really how I write a story. This one is for you."

SENATOR GILLIBRAND INTRODUCES LEGISLATION TO PROMOTE CTE EDUCATION

Senator Kirsten Gillibrand and Senator Todd Young (R-IN) have made it their mission to help students get career and technical education skills. They introduced the "21st Century Strengthening On Programs that Cultivate Learning Approaches for Successful Students Act" and the bipartisan House version of the legislation was introduced by Representatives Tim Ryan (D-OH), Mark Takano (D-CA), and Susan Brooks (R-IN). The legislation would give federal funding for equipment for career and technical education programs and give

teachers more training on how to use the equipment.

Statistics show that through 2025, an estimated two million manufacturing jobs could go unfilled because of a lack of skilled workers. In a statement, Senator Gillibrand said, "Technologies like 3D printers, laser cutters and computerized machine tools are transforming American manufacturing and increasing the need for specialized training for manufacturing jobs. To prepare our students with the skills needed for high-tech jobs, this legislation would amend the Perkins Career and Technical Education (CTE) Act to give greater priority to funding for maker education, makerspaces and training for teachers in the application of maker education."

"Many businesses and manufacturers are struggling to find qualified employees," she said while addressing staff, students and guests at Charles D'Amico High School in Albion recently. "This would give students the opportunity to learn the skills necessary to get good paying jobs in the high-tech manufacturing sector." She continued, "These jobs are very important and we rely on them every day, whether it's an engineering job, whether it's to help to repair after a hurricane or whether it's a high-tech manufacturing jobs here in western New York."

David Heminway graduated from the Orleans/Niagara BOCES' Machine Tool program in 1976 and was on hand for the press conference. He went to work for Kodak after graduation and then worked for the NY Canal Corporation for the past 23 years and is currently supervisor of the skilled trades for the canal. "I really hope this opens people's eyes up about what career and technical education can do for students. Today's workforce is very competitive and demanding and this will give students an advantage when they leave high school or go on to college."

The career and technical education programs at the Orleans/Niagara BOCES have grown ten percent in the past five years with students graduating with at a 98 percent rate says their Career and Technical Education Director, Joseph Steinmetz. "I am grateful to Senator Gillibrand for personally delivering this good news and I want to thank her for supporting career and technical education. I am very excited about the federal support for our programs, to expand CTE and to give us the opportunities to be competitive. For the jobs of the future we really need the support, because technology is always changing and technology is very expensive. If you look at students who are in the fifth and sixth grade, those jobs even invented yet. We have to make sure we have the technology to keep students up to date in the training and skills they need so they can get good paying jobs. The jobs of future are going to be skilled trades." He added that BOCES spends about \$150,000 to \$200,000 a year to provide students with the latest technology.

"Our students should be able to take many different paths in order to get a good job and earn a good salary," says Senator Gillibrand. "This bill would help equip more students with the skills they need to get on a path toward good-paying, high-tech jobs when they graduate high school."







Building Co-Ops

City dwellers looking to buy rather than rent an apartment 2-bedroom apartment in Medina, may come across real estate listings categorized as "coops." While co-ops can exist anywhere, Realtor.com notes that they are most common in big cities, comprising parking. Private back yard. No as much as 75 percent of the housing inventory in the borough of Manhattan in New York City. Co-op is short for "cooperative," and people who buy into a co-op are not technically buying property but shares in an entity that owns the property where investors will ultimately live. The bigger the apartment in the building, the more shares the buyer will own. Residents of a co-op typically elect fellow residents to serve on the co-op board. That board is tasked with making a host of important decisions, including choosing who will and will not be allowed to join the cooperative. Co-op boards may require that applicants meet certain financial requirements. Unlike buying a singlefamily home, duplex, townhouse, or condominium, people interested in buying into a co-op may have put down no less than 20 percent the value of the apartment where they hope to live. Co-op dwellers will also be expected to pay monthly maintenance fees that go toward insurance, taxes and other building expenses. ■







Trainers from OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration) recently paid a visit to the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center to talk to students in the Building Trades and Electricity/Electronics programs.

OSHA works with the public to promote safe, healthy and secure workplaces and enhance workers' voice on the job. Since 2003, the alliance has trained more than 8,000 students in the fundamentals of construction safety and health. Training covers the importance of workplace safety, recognition of the major hazards in construction work and building a safety culture within an organization. The instructional base of the safety and health training now includes building trades students and contractors.

Building Trades teacher, Matt Anastasi, took OSHA trainings with Tom Glomb, which allows him to train Orleans/Niagara BOCES employees and students. "He mentioned to me that he had formed an alliance with OSHA and his company, Lehigh Construction, and that they offered these trainings to many other BOCES programs. So I asked him to be a guest presenter because I knew he would offer a unique view of safety perspectives," says Mr. Anastasi. "Gordon Delays has incredible knowledge and training as an OSHA inspector so he is able to give insights as to what a tremendous resource OSHA can be for the workforce, employers and owners in construction."

Mr. Delay brought in many training pieces in fall protection since falls are the number one area of accidents and deaths on a worksite. Students had a chance to try on the protection harnesses. Mr. Glomb talked to the students about his company's approach to safety and how successful it has been. He told them that they noticed more productivity and lower insurance premiums due to a safer workplace.

Mr. Anastasi and Electricity/Electronics teacher, Bill Leggett, were glad to be able to offer their students a ten hour OSHA Construction Industry training. This type of training is mandatory to work on any commercial or industrial worksite. "The card that I will issue will allow our students that ability upon graduation," says Mr. Anastasi. Many employers are excited to see the students have already received this training as they know that they have made safety a priority."

How to Protect Your Confidential

Advice for a Successful Career Change

Individuals change jobs for many reasons, including greater professional satisfaction, money or a change of location. The financial experts at The Balance say that people change jobs more frequently than many people may think, noting today's average worker changes jobs 12 times during his or her career.

It is not uncommon for workers to change careers several times in a lifetime. Potaotes Perfect for the Holiday Breakfast Table

Holiday dinners may get all the glory, but men and women who host friends and family each holiday season know that time spent with loved ones at the breakfast table can be just as enjoyable as breaking bread in the evening. A homecooked meal first thing in the morning is a great way to start the day, and hosts who want to serve up something familiar with a little extra flavor can try the following recipe for "Skillet-Roasted Potatoes with Mushrooms and Pancetta" from Betty Rosbottom's "Sunday Brunch" (Chronicle Books).

Skillet-Roasted Potatoes with Mushrooms and Pancetta

Serves 4

4 ounces pancetta, cut into 1/4-inch cubes (see note)

3 tablespoons olive oil, plus more if necessary

1 pound Yukon gold potatoes, unpeeled, scrubbed and quartered Kosher salt

Freshly ground black pepper

10 ounces cremini or brown mushrooms, quartered

6 garlic cloves, peeled and halved crosswise

2 teaspoons dried thyme

Several fresh thyme sprigs for garnish (optional)

- 1. Arrange a rack at center position and preheat the oven to 400 F.
- 2. In a large, heavy, ovenproof frying pan (preferably cast iron) set over medium heat, sauté the pancetta until golden and crisp, 5 to 7 minutes. Remove with a slotted spoon to drain on paper towels.
- 3. Remove all but 2 tablespoons of the drippings from the pan. (If you don't have 2 tablespoons, add olive oil to make this amount.) When hot, add the potatoes and sauté, stirring, until they start to take on a little color, 5 to 7 minutes. Season with salt and pepper and place the frying pan in the oven. Roast for 15 minutes.
- 4. Remove the frying pan from the oven and add the mushrooms, garlic and the 3 tablespoons of olive oil. Add the dried thyme and season with more salt and pepper. Toss to coat well.
- 5. Return the pan to the oven and roast until the potatoes are golden brown and tender and the mushrooms are softened, about 15 minutes more. Remove the frying pan from the oven and stir in the reserved pancetta. If desired, garnish the center of the pan with fresh thyme sprigs. Serve warm.

Note: If buying pancetta from a deli, ask for it to be cut thickly into 1/4-inch slices. Prepackaged pancetta is often thinly sliced.

Signs of a Stroke

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1) Ask the person to SMILE.
- 2) Ask the person to TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- Ask the person to RAISE BOTH ARMS
- 4) Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- Sudden trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, severe headache with no known cause
