blowers, string trimmers and hedge trimmers are in good shape.

Historic Newspapers

Q. I have a collection of news-
papers covering the deaths of
Princess Diana and John Kennedy,
Jr. I also have several issues about
the Boston Red Sox 2005 season and
special Jackie Kennedy tribute edi-
tions. Thanks for any information.

A. The newspapers you have
would probably retail for less
than \$25 each. Even though you
didn't list the names of the papers, I
assume all were published in the United
States. Certain French and British
editions covering the death of Princess
Diana command higher prices and are
considered more collectible.

ers.com.

Q. I have a painting on oil cloth of
a dancing girl with veils painted
in such a way that it looks several
dimensions deep. It is old, but I can't
find an artist's signature. What can
you tell me about it? — *Beverly, New
Smyrna, Florida*

A. This technique is called
"gauche," sometimes spelled
"gauche." Although in some ways it
is similar to watercolor, it is different
in that the materials used are modified
so that the ratio of pigment to water is
increased. This gives the piece a much
greater reflective quality and is why

your dancing girl appears to be lay-
ered, because technically it is. To find
out about the value of your artwork,
you should consult a professional art
appraiser.

Q. I have inherited a 1957 Chry-
sler 300 automobile. I do not
plan to sell it but would like to find
other owners so I can learn more
about this model of Chrysler. — *Ed,
Memphis, Tennessee*



Honoring American Agriculture On March 18

(NAPSA)—"In no other country do so few people produce so much food, to feed so many, at such reasonable prices."—President Dwight D. Eisenhower

President Eisenhower's words ring as true today as they did more than 60 years ago.

Preparing Your Lawn And Garden Equipment For Spring: Tips From The Outdoor Power Equipment Institute

OPEI Reminds Consumers To Use Only E10 Or Lower Fuel In Any Lawn And Garden Equipment

(NAPSA)—Spring is on its way, and soon, home and business owners will be cleaning and preparing lawn and garden equipment.

"Many are so eager to pull out lawn and garden equipment once spring arrives that they sometimes forget basic steps to ensure the powerhouse of the equipment—the engine—is in good working order," said Kris Kiser, president and CEO of OPEI.

"One challenge is that most fuel contains some level of ethanol, which contains corrosive alcohol. If you left that fuel in the tank over the winter months, you don't want to use it in the spring. It may damage your equipment. You need to drain it and put in new fuel that is E10 or lower," advises Kiser.

Whether it's a mower, trimmer, blower, chain saw or pruner, the Outdoor Power Equipment Institute (OPEI) offers tips to help users avoid fuel-related problems and ready their equipment to operate safely.

Check the fuel tank. If fuel has been sitting all winter long in the fuel tank, do not use it in the spring. Drain it responsibly and put in fresh fuel. Remember to dispose of this fuel properly.

Use only E10 or lower fuel in your outdoor power equipment. Do not use gas with more than 10 percent ethanol (E10) in outdoor power equipment. Some gas stations may offer 15 percent ethanol (E15) gas or other fuel blends, but this higher ethanol fuel is dangerous—and is in fact illegal—to use in any small engine equipment, such as lawn mowers, chain saws, generators, and all other lawn and garden equipment.

Don't leave fuel sitting in the tank for more than 30

days. Untreated gasoline (without a fuel stabilizer) left in the system will deteriorate, which may cause starting or running problems and, in some cases, damage to the fuel system.

Inspect your equipment. Check for loose belts and missing or damaged parts. If you find anything concerning, replace the parts or take your equipment to a qualified service representative.

Drain out the old oil and put in fresh oil. Remove the oil drain plug in your lawn mower and catch the old oil in a container. Replace the plug and refill the engine with oil recommended by the product manufacturer. Properly dispose of the oil you drained.

Install clean air filters. Your engine and equipment will run much better with clean filters. Paper filters need to be replaced. Some foam filters can be cleaned and replaced.

Sharpen your cutting blade. Have your lawn mower's cutting blade sharpened so you can get a clean cut on your lawn. Your lawn will be healthier and your lawn mower will operate more efficiently, too.

Clean your equipment. If you did not clean your equipment before storing it, there may be dirt, oil or grass stuck to it. Give your equipment a good spring-cleaning. A cleaner machine will run more efficiently and last longer.

Review your manual. Now is a good time to read the operator's manual and familiarize yourself with the controls and what they do. Make sure you know how to stop the machine quickly if needed.

Car Care Corner

Top Ten Family Travel Battery Care Tips

(NAPSA)—To help you avoid getting stranded with a dead car battery on your next family road trip, Gale Kimbrough, also known as “Mr. Battery,” offers these suggestions:
Helpful Hints
1. Take a few minutes to read about your battery in your car’s manual and become familiar with the type of battery it is, where it is and how it can be cleaned safely.
2. At the start of each new season, check the battery to make sure it is still fully charged for the excursions ahead.
3. When working with your car battery, wear protective eyewear, remove all jewelry and wear long sleeves to protect your arms from battery acid discharge.
4. Perform a visual inspection to see if the battery case is showing signs of extreme bulging, cracking or leaking. Replace your battery if you see any of these signs.
5. If your battery has removable filler caps, open them and check the water level in each cell. If the level is low, add distilled water (not tap water) until the plates are covered, preferably to one-half inch above the plates. This prevents the buildup of sulfate crystals, which can reduce the overall battery charge and performance.
6. Avoid overfilling, because heat can cause the electrolyte solution inside to expand and overflow.
7. Clean up the connections by removing any corrosion and lead oxidation and make sure to brush the dirt and grime off the case.



Checking the battery is a wise move before any long car trip.

8. To remove the battery cables, first disconnect the negative cables and then the positive. To reinstall the cables, first connect the positive cables and then the negative.
9. Be sure the battery is mounted securely in place to minimize vibration. Excessive vibration is harmful to the battery plates and terminals and could lead to battery failure. After completing reconnection, use a protective spray on the terminal connections.
10. Have your battery and electrical system professionally tested every three to six months, especially prior to heading out on a trip or extreme changes in temperature.

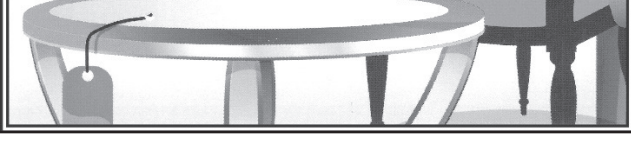

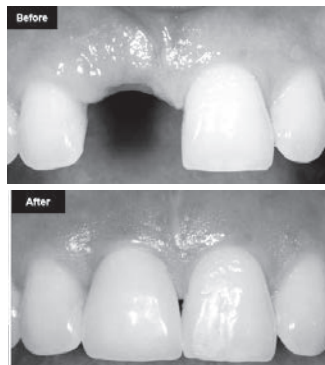

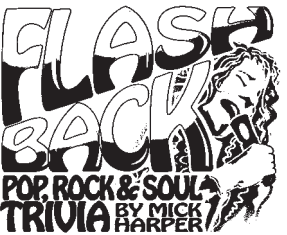
