Comic Collectibles

Comic collectibles remain popular as long as the comic characters are still seen or heard in comic books, cartoons, radio, TV, movies, plays or reruns. And B.O. Plenty, who was an early figure in the Dick Tracy comic strip that started in 1931, has been dropped and reintroduced many times. He married Gravel Gertie, and these two ugly people had a beautiful daughter, Sparkle Plenty, in 1947. Later, they had a very ugly son whose face was never shown in the strip. The tin windup toy by Marx picturing B.O. holding his daughter Sparkle just sold at a Bertoia auction for \$118. The 8-1/2-inch toy shuffles across the floor while his hat tips.

The Dick Tracy characters and inventions still are familiar. The original artist, Chester Gould, drew the strip from 1931 to 1977. Other artists have continued it. His characters, their strange names and the inventions used by policeman Dick Tracy still are popular today. The two-way wrist radio first mentioned in 1946, two-way wrist TV (1964) and Spacecar (1960s) all have become realities.



Comic Collectibles

Some of the plots, names and situations in the old Dick Tracy comics would be considered non-PC today. But the foul-smelling, dirty thief B.O. Plenty has become a popular character. A walking tin windup toy of B.O. holding his beautiful baby Sparkle sold at auction for \$118.

Q. My family heirloom is a divided child's feeding plate decorated with scenes of a girl playing with or feeding her toys. The back is marked "Thompson." What is its value?

A. Your plate was made by CC Thompson Pottery Co. of East Liverpool, Ohio, founded in 1868 and closed in 1938. They made porcelain plates after 1917. The decoration on your plate is a decal called "Dinner-time," which was used by several companies. The dish was made sometime between 1917 and 1938. It would sell in a shop today for about \$20, but should be worth much more to your family.

Q. I bought a modern copy of a tall flower container with 24 tubes to hold flowers that go to a center section. I bought it to use as a flower vase and now I'm told it was used to grow indoor plants in places like Williamsburg. Can you settle a bet about this for us?

A. The name "tulipiere" is used for tall, many-spouted vases like yours, and for a shorter vase with five spouts that looks like fingers on a hand or just a round vase with spouts facing in all directions. The original tulipieres were made of 17th-century Delft. Queen Mary II of England liked flowers in the palace and ordered the vases to be refilled three times a week with cut flowers, including tulips. The many-spouted tulipiere also was used to grow flowers indoors, and each spout was made the right size to hold a bulb partially covered with water. So both of you are right. They held either cut flowers or bulbs now or in the past.

TIP: Use two hooks a few inches in from the edges of a picture to keep it straight on the wall.

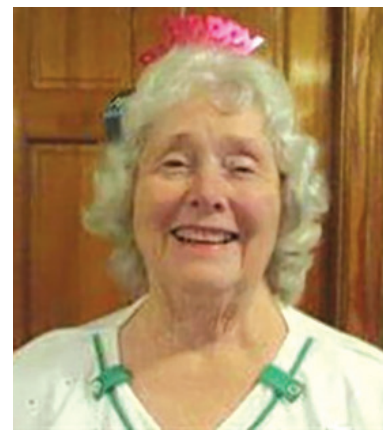

Even Jesus told His disciples in Luke 22:36 to sell their garments and buy swords. But our society seems to be hitting a bad stride right now, one where the only branch in anyone's hands seems to be a switch.

ally of the faith community, and has in only a year's time had a tremendously positive effect on the economy.

That is a pretty wearisome way to live, and very ineffective for the improvement of a society. Constant hatred takes a lot of energy to maintain, energy that could better be spent on more worthwhile purposes.

This principle holds true for race as well. Blacks tend to see only the perceived flaws of whites, and whites tend to see only the perceived flaws of blacks. But where is the olive branch in that? Yes, each race has flaws, but what of the positives? One of the happiest moments of my life was straining to push an elderly white lady's broken down vehicle out of traffic, and suddenly feeling a "thud, thud!" on each side of me as two young black men joined in to help. There is a lot of good out there wrapped in a lot of different skin tones.

Buckle up, I am about to demonstrate how this olive branch thing works.

I disagreed with President Obama on most of his policy decisions. I believe he altered America tremendously, and almost all of those changes were bad. He seemed to me to border on Marxist belief in many things, and to spend more time trying to tear down the power of our country rather than build it up. But I also tremendously admire some things about him. He seems to me to be a devoted husband and father, two things that I regard as precious beyond valuation. He also had a great dignity about him in most of his presidential capacities and communications.

Jesus used this same model of utilizing both switch and olive branch. In Revelation 2-3 He addressed seven churches, and both praised their good qualities and excoriated their wrongs. Without the olive branch, people are much less likely to respond positively to the switch.

For those of you who do not know what a switch is, from personal experience I can tell you that it can be defined as "a small branch from a tree that when carefully applied to a posterior causes psychological maladies such as good manners, respectability, and the desire to obey."

The reason a switch was so effective in the days of my youth, though, was that it was only used when absolutely necessary. On other days there was a whole lot of olive branch going on in my life.

I am guessing that, in a way, people are afraid to extend olive branches. Not for fear of having those on the other side reject them, but for fear of having those on their own side turn on them. But I regard it as a risk worth taking. I intend on never being afraid to stand up and speak the negative truth about anyone in the wrong. But what takes even more courage than that, often, is being willing to stand up to your own side and have something positive to say about those on the other side of the issue.

America could use some olive branches right now.

I am only forty-seven. But that is a long enough period of time for me to be able to compare decades and realize that the level of hatred in our society is almost off the charts right now. Everyone is dividing into camps along racial, political,

Veteran Education Benefits Stolen

Of the five most recent scams listed on the website of the Veterans Affairs Office of Inspector General, three of them involve money stolen from veterans education benefits ... lots of money.

The first file described a welding school that wasn't. A veteran would enroll in the school using his Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits. He received benefits and had his tuition paid. There was no school, however. There was no instruction; there was no hands-on learning. The owner of the alleged school paid the veteran to encourage 20 more veterans to sign up at the fake school, all of them getting benefits, putting more tuition money into the hands of the school.

In the second case, a school provided online courses approved by the Department of Veterans Affairs, except that what was provided to veterans was unapproved online courses administered by others. One of the guilty parties was a former associate dean of a genuine school. The sub-contracted school wasn't an approved company with approved courses, and it wasn't eligible to receive GI Bill benefits. The hiring school grabbed over \$24 million in tuition benefits based on signing up thousands of veterans.

In the third file, a woman stole \$2.8 million from a program that alleged to help older veterans get jobs via computer training. The money came from Veteran's Retraining Assistance Program and was designed to help unemployed veterans between 35 and 60. The woman logged on to the system over 100 times, pretending to be veterans who were enrolled in the \$4,000 course. The VA paid the veterans benefits, out of which they had to pay the woman's \$750 per month fee to continue logging them in.

To those who think they can steal education benefits and get away with it: You're going to get caught, and you're going to jail.

MEDICAL SOCIETY OF VIRGINIA PRESENTS ADVOCACY IN ACTION AWARD TO OPIOIDS IN CENTRAL VIRGINIA WORKGROUP



RICHMOND, Va.— Dr. Peter Kemp, the Medical Society of Virginia (MSV) Political Action Committee (PAC) chair presented the Advocacy in Action Award on Friday, October 20, at MSV's Annual Meeting to Dr. Ann Thomas, representing the Opioids in Central Virginia Workgroup. The Advocacy in Action Award is given to a physician or group in recognition of their outstanding service and contributions to improve health care policy.

The Opioids in Central Virginia Workgroup was founded in 2016 when Centra Health and Ortho Virginia health care providers, Dr. Keith Taylor, Dr. Andrea Stutesman, Shannon Miles RN, BSN, Dr. Ann Thomas, Mandy Cocks, RN, BSN, Jennifer Rudich, LPN, and Carolyn Jacques, RNC, BS, M.Ed. joined together to fight opioid abuse among pregnant women. The workgroup recruited physicians, nurses, social workers, the local community service board, Horizon Behavioral Health, law enforcement, and other local health care providers to expand the initial focus of pregnant women to include all patients dealing with opioid addiction. In July of 2016, the first Opioids in Central Virginia Workgroup meeting convened. The community celebrated the opening of the Lynchburg area's first residential recovery program for pregnant and postpartum women, and their children, on January 1, 2017.

The team's efforts to share resources, promote continuing education, and develop best practices for the local community has enhanced accessibility to opioid addiction treatment for patients. The public health policy model that the Opioids in Central Virginia Workgroup has developed is currently being replicated in other Virginia communities because of its success in the central Virginia area.

A First-Timers Guide to Thanksgiving Turkey

By Angela Shelf Medearis—*The Kitchen Diva*

Preparing a turkey for the first time can be a daunting task, unless you know a few tricks. No matter how many guests are expected -- whether it's dinner for four or 24, allow 1 pound of turkey per person. I never buy a turkey more than 14 pounds, as it's easier to cook two turkeys than it is to wrestle a turkey weighing 25 plus pounds in and out of the oven.

I cook one turkey the day before Thanksgiving. I let it rest and carve it ahead of time, cover it with basting juices and aluminum foil to keep it moist, and reheat it to serve during the meal. I also roast a turkey on Thanksgiving Day. It's my "show" bird -- the one I display whole on a decorated platter. While my guests are serving themselves, I can carve the other turkey without feeling rushed.

When selecting a turkey, it's better to pick an unstuffed turkey for safety reasons, and then season and baste the bird yourself so that you can control the quality of the ingredients. The "pop-up" timer that you find in some brands of turkey usually only pops up when the turkey is overcooked! If you want to use a brand with a timer, leave it in place until the turkey is ready to carve, but use a conventional meat thermometer to check your bird for doneness.

Forgetting to thaw out the turkey is a common mistake that many cooks make during the holidays. Allow approximately 24 hours for every 4 to 5 pounds of turkey, approximately three to seven days before Thanksgiving. Thaw the turkey in the refrigerator on a rimmed pan to catch any drips or in a cooler kept at 38 F.

If you're preparing a turkey for the first time, my recipe for this Easy Holiday Turkey is a great way to begin. Read over the instructions a few days before the holidays, purchase and prep your ingredients ahead of time, and enjoy your Thanksgiving with a lot less stress!

EASY HOLIDAY TURKEY

- 1 (12 to 14 pound) turkey (not self-basting)
- 3/4 cup canola oil
- 3 tablespoons poultry seasoning
- 1 1/2 tablespoons kosher salt
- 2 tablespoons freshly ground black pepper

- 1 stick unsalted butter, melted
- Aromatics:**
- 2 medium onions, peeled and chopped
 - 3 large carrots, chopped
 - 2 large apples, cored and chopped
 - 2-3 sprigs of fresh rosemary, thyme, sage, parsley, in any combination
 - 6 sage leaves
 - 1/2 cup water or chicken broth

1. Adjust the oven racks to the lowest level of the oven. Heat oven to 500 F.

2. Pull the package containing the neck and giblets out of the neck and interior rear cavity of the turkey (neck cavity may be covered with a flap of skin). Set the liver, heart and giblets aside to use for the gravy. Reserve the turkey neck to use with the aromatics for the basting broth.

3. Rinse the turkey with cold water inside and out. Dry the turkey skin with food-safe paper towels. The turkey will not brown if the skin is still wet. The turkey probably will have the legs trussed in a metal or plastic clamp. Release the legs from the clamp and discard the truss. This will allow the dark meat on the legs to cook faster.

4. Rub the turkey inside and out with the canola oil. Sprinkle the turkey all over, inside and out with the poultry seasoning, salt and pepper.

5. Fill the turkey with half of the aromatics -- chopped onions, carrots, apples and herbs. Place the turkey neck and the rest of the aromatics in the bottom of the roasting pan with the water or chicken broth.

6. Place a sheet of aluminum foil on a roasting rack and place it inside of a roasting pan. Using the tip of a knife, poke 20 to 30 holes in the foil. Place the turkey, breast-side down, on the foil-covered rack. Roast for 30 minutes (set the timer on the oven to prevent overcooking).

7. Turn the temperature down to 325 F. Turn the turkey breast-side up and tuck wing tips underneath the bird. Baste, inside and out, with the melted butter and the juices that have collected in the bottom of the roasting pan.

8. Roast for 1 1/2 hours for a 12-pound turkey (a 14- to 16-pound bird will require 2 to 2 1/2 hours; add an extra 15 minutes per pound for larger birds). Roast the turkey until the meat at the thigh (when the thermometer is inserted without touching the bone), the thickest part of the wing and the meat at the breast registers 165 F. At this temperature, juices should be clear, not reddish pink, when thigh muscle is pierced deeply.

9. Remove from oven. Cover the turkey breast loosely with a sheet of aluminum foil, creased in the middle to make a tent, to keep the turkey warm without steaming the crispy skin. Let the turkey rest for at least 30 minutes before carving.

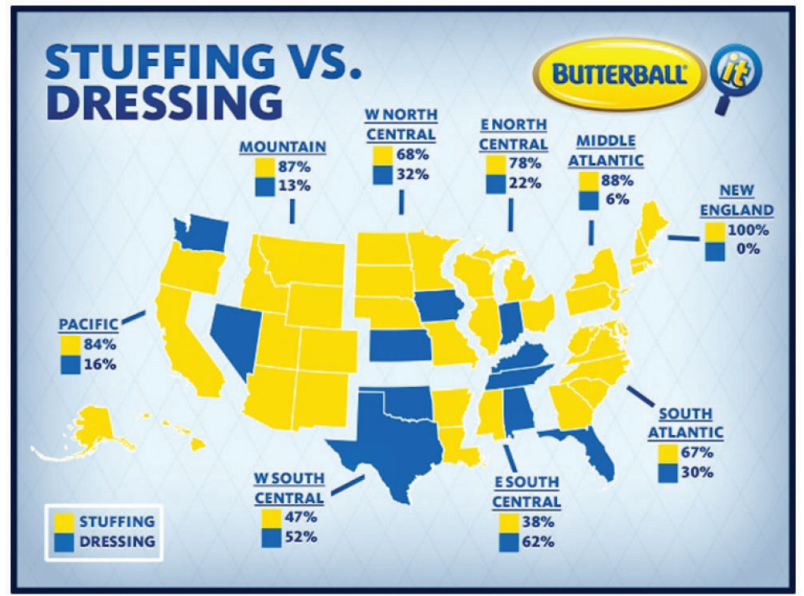

Candied Sweet Potatoes

If you wish, sprinkle with sliced almonds, chopped walnuts or chopped pecans before serving. Or top with tiny marshmallows and broil about 6 inches away from the source of heat until lightly browned.

- 4 large sweet potatoes (12 ounces each), each peeled, cut crosswise in half, and each half cut lengthwise into 3 wedges
- 2½ teaspoons salt
- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine, cut into pieces
- 1/8 teaspoon ground red pepper (cayenne)
- 2 tablespoons dry sherry (optional)

1. Heat oven to 375 F. In 5-quart Dutch oven, combine sweet potatoes, enough water to cover and 2 teaspoons salt; heating to boiling over high heat. Boil until tender, about 10 minutes. Drain.

2. Meanwhile, in nonstick 10-inch skillet, combine brown sugar, butter, remaining 1/2 teaspoon salt and ground red pepper; heat over medium heat, stirring, until butter melts, about 1 minute. Stir in sherry, if using.

Cook, stirring occasionally, 5 minutes longer.

3. Transfer potatoes to shallow 13-by-9-inch baking dish, and top with brown-sugar mixture. Cover with foil and bake 30 minutes, stirring halfway through baking. Remove foil and

bake until syrup is dark and very thick, 30 to 40 minutes, stirring halfway through. Makes 8 servings

Can Nicotine Offer Relief for Colitis?

DEAR DR. ROACH: I just read your column about ulcerative colitis. Many years ago, I read about a possible relief: nicotine. I had a friend who was in dire straits for years, and he was ready to get a colostomy. He had not responded to all kinds of steroids and expensive meds. He was treated with nicotine patches, and in 48 hours he had relief. He wore a patch for at least a year. He moved years ago, but when I knew him, he looked at nicotine as a cure. Any thoughts? -- R.

ANSWER: I learned in medical school that ulcerative colitis could appear or flare after quitting smoking, and that studies were being done to look at nicotine as a treatment. Since then, nicotine has been more extensively studied but has not found a major role in the treatment of UC. It is used occasionally and even more occasionally successful in people who have not gotten relief with more-common treatments. The side effects of high doses cause many people to not tolerate it.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Have you heard of Boswellia? Would you recommend it for arthritic pain? If so, what dosage and how often would be safe? What about negative side effects? -- F.P.

ANSWER: Boswellia, also called Indian frankincense, is an herb that has been used for millennia in India as an anti-inflammatory for relief of arthritis pain. I was able to find a well-done study from 2011 that showed significant benefit in reducing pain and improving function in people with osteoarthritis of the knee. The only side effects seen were minor headache and nausea. Other studies, all small and relatively short, confirmed these results.

Based on these small studies, it appears that Boswellia extract may have benefit in improving pain and function in people with osteoarthritis of the knee. I found products that are labeled as having what the study medicine did (most commonly 100 mg once daily, containing at least 20 percent AKBA, the active ingredient).

However, let me emphasize that supplements are not subject to oversight by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. In February 2015, the New York state attorney general's office accused four major retailers of selling fraudulent and potentially dangerous herbal supplements under their store brands. Of the products they tested, 78 percent did not contain any of the herbs on their labels, and some contained substances potentially dangerous to those with allergies (including wheat in products labeled "wheat- and gluten-free," and powdered legumes, a potential risk for those with peanut allergies). These products were labeled "standardized" and "guaranteed."

It is very frustrating to learn about potentially valuable therapies that offer an alternative to prescription medicines, and have the companies that supply them be untrustworthy. There may be good manufacturers, but with no way of independently testing their products, I cannot give a recommendation for a particular brand. ***
