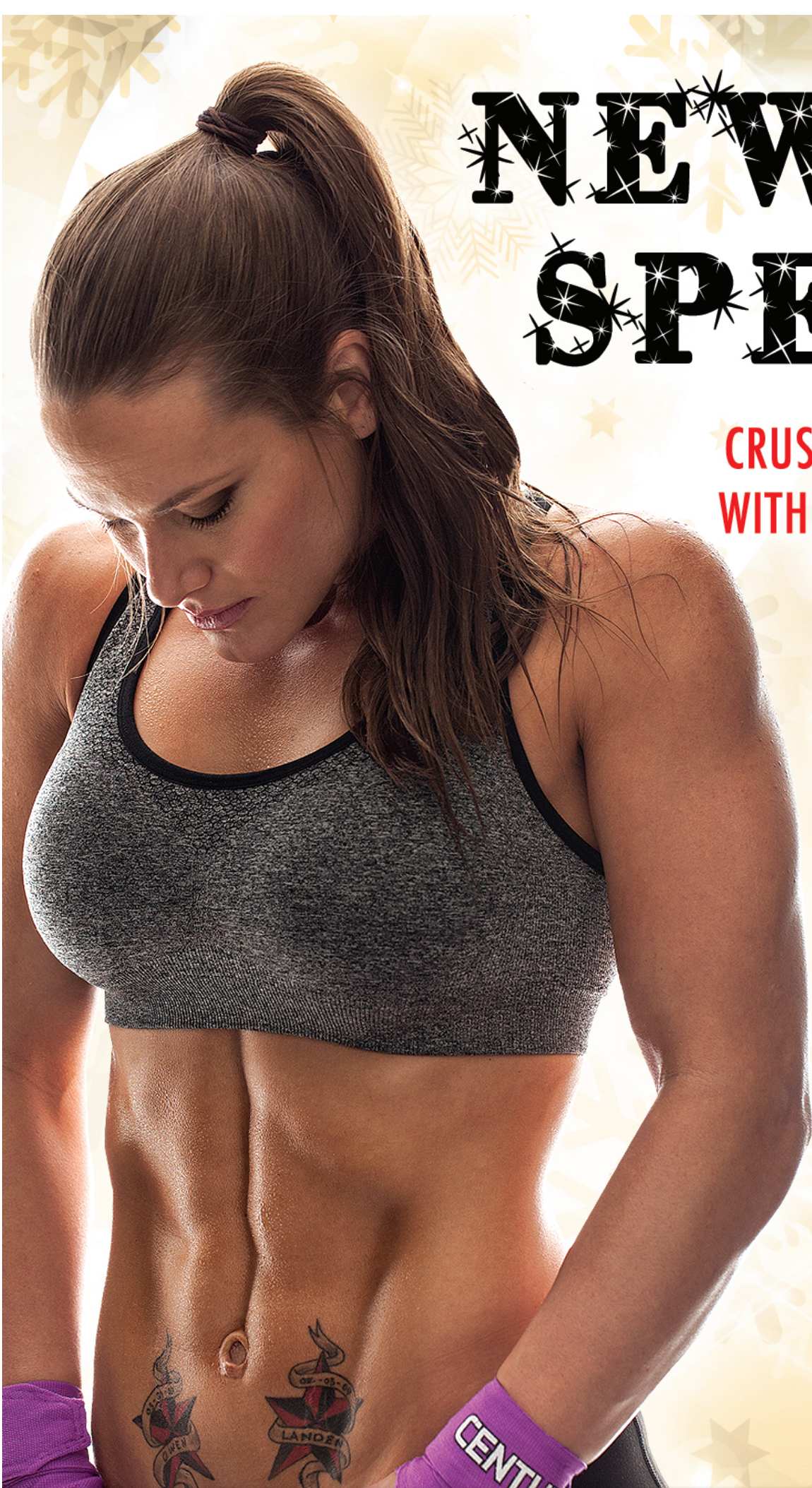

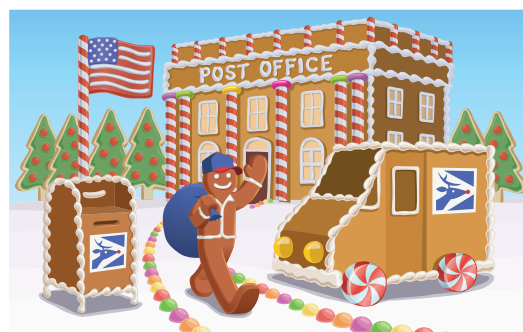

Donna's Day

Creative family fun

Make Marbleized Paper at Family Wrap Party

Whether we're children or adults, we all like to feel useful and part of the holiday festivities. Now's the time to enlist the kids in the fun and creative job of gift-wrapping. But before you go out and purchase rolls of wrap, save money by making a beautiful batch for this year's gifts.

Gather big paper bags from your recycling bin, plus marbles and bright poster paint, and you'll be ready for family fun.

Here's the stuff you'll need:

- One large, sturdy cardboard gift box approximately 12 by 18 inches, or similar container with sides
- several marbles (one for each paint color)
- liquid poster paint in several colors
- spoons (one for each color)
- plain brown paper grocery bags, construction paper or butcher paper
- recycled deli or margarine tubs
- scissors
- newspaper

Here's the fun:

Cover your work surface with newspaper. Cut open the paper bags and trim a sheet to fit the bottom of the box. (Or, if using construction paper or butcher paper, cut to size.) Place the paper inside. Pour a small amount of each color of paint into the containers.

Drop a marble in one of the paint containers. Shake the container gently until the marble is thoroughly coated

with paint, or use a spoon to move the marble around in the paint. With a spoon, drop the marble in the box and shift the box back and forth so the marble rolls in all directions, leaving paint on the paper. Repeat the process, using a different marble for each color of paint desired.

When the colorful, abstract design is complete, remove your paper of modern art and let it dry.

TIP: For smaller packages, "shake and create" gift wrap using a clean, large cylindrical potato-chip can with a lid. Loosely roll a sheet of paper inside the can so that it lines the interior. Using one color at a time, roll a



marble or two in paint (as described above) and drop in the can. Snap on the lid, shake a few times, remove the lid and put the marble or marbles onto newspaper. Repeat with a marble or two in another color. Remove the paper to reveal your art. You might want to paint jingle bells along with the marbles for a fun, festive sound while shaking.

The Kitchen Diva!

From the Heart and Made by Hand

With the holidays approaching, many people begin to feel the financial stress of the season. You can lessen the anxiety by planning purchases in advance. Consider the following tips for a more enjoyable holiday, and remember, some of the best gifts are the ones from the heart and made by hand:

- Make a list of the people you will need to buy for and how much you plan to spend on each person.
- Determine the total that you plan to spend, and if this figure seems too high, make adjustments.
- Avoid the temptation of charging all your purchases with a credit card when you don't have enough money to pay for it. Avoid thinking that you'll just "pay it off later." If you cannot afford a particular item, look for something similar but less expensive, or search for an alternative present. Set a limit and try to stick to it.
- Be wary of store promotions. Offers of "buy now and pay later" sometimes have hidden clauses that allow interest to accrue until your first payment. Read through all paperwork before signing it, and don't be afraid to ask the store clerk questions about the promotion. Remember, if it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
- A donation to a local charity may make more of a lasting impression than a store-bought gift. Use money that you would spend on friends and family to make one larger donation to one specific charity, or give smaller donations to each family member's favorite charity. Call local food pantries, shelters and charities to find out what they need during the busy holiday season.
- Ask others to bring a dish if you're

hosting a family dinner or holiday party.

- Pay attention to return policies, and keep your receipts. If you need to return something later, having a receipt will speed up the process, and you'll have a better chance of getting your money back.
- Shop alone. A tired spouse or child may encourage you to impulsively buy some items so they can get home sooner.
- Avoid high-pressure sales tactics. Know what you're looking for before you enter a store, or tell the sales clerk that you are just looking and will let them know if you need help.

- Search clearance racks for sale items. Shop at discount stores for gifts for children, neighbors and co-workers.
- Don't wait for the last minute to do your shopping. You may be tempted to purchase higher-priced items if you are in a hurry or don't have time to comparison shop. If you spread your shopping out over several weeks, or even months, you won't have to come up with so much money all at once.
- After the holiday season, start saving for the next one. Put aside a little each month, or look for sale items throughout the year that could be saved for the holiday season.
- Be creative with your gifts. Try giving personalized gifts that offer your services for things such as an evening of free babysitting, or make

simple, homemade items like my Chocolate Peppermint Holiday Bark Candy.

Remember, relax, enjoy the holiday season and make memories with the ones you love that are priceless. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

CHOCOLATE PEPPERMINT HOLIDAY BARK CANDY

The pretzel sticks taste like pecans but are far less expensive in this easy-to-make candy. Wrap this candy in clear cellophane paper and use a candy cane and some festive ribbon to tie it up for gift giving!

- 1 teaspoon butter
- 3 (11.5 ounce) packages milk chocolate chips or morsels
- 12 cream-and-mint-filled chocolate sandwich cookies (like Oreos) broken into pieces
- 1 cup small pretzel sticks
- 1/4 cups coarsely crushed or chopped peppermint candies or peppermint sticks, divided

- Line a 15 by 10-inch) jelly-roll pan with wax or parchment paper; grease with butter. Microwave milk chocolate chips in a large bowl on HIGH for 1 to 2 minutes, or until melted and smooth, stirring at 15-second intervals. Gently stir in cookie pieces, pretzel sticks and 3/4 cup coarsely chopped candies. Spread in prepared pan.
- Sprinkle with remaining 1/2 cup coarsely chopped candies. Let stand until firm (about 6 hours). Break or cut into pieces. Store in a cool place up to 3 days. Do not freeze! Freezing the bark will cause a powdery white coating called bloom. Makes 16 servings.

A Sporting view by Mark Vasto

The Mack Code

For the past two weeks, I've shared the core philosophies of Vince Lombardi and John Wooden — widely considered to be the greatest coaches of all time. Baseball, not surprisingly, is a little weirder when it comes to measuring "the best" in any category. This week, we go with the great Philadelphia manager (right there, an oxymoron) Connie Mack. Mack, it should be noted, won more games than any manager in history. He also lost more games than any manager in history.

Mack's code is particularly powerful when you put it into the context of its time. These rules were set down around 1916, a time when women couldn't vote, and ethnic strife and segregation were the norm. Mack loved the world he carved out for himself in between the lines.

Mack was a believer in the "big inning." He preferred power hitters to contact hitters, and even though he is generally credited with the employment of the defensive shift, he didn't like to interfere much play to play. He wasn't a meddler; he wanted a team made up of outstanding players, trained in the fundamentals. He is said to have valued seven things in a ballplayer: physical ability, intelligence, courage, dispo-

sition, willpower, general alertness and personal habits (in particular, his disdained drinkers).

Those who didn't adhere to his code weren't around very long — he even traded "Shoeless" Joe Jackson, a superstar, because he couldn't stand his erratic nature. Mack, however, coached longer than any other manager in history, so it stands to reason that there just might be something to learn from his set of rules.

So once again, for all of you coaches, players or people in need of some sort of self-help, here's another gift for your bulletin board and locker room.

Connie Mack's Code of Conduct

1. I will always play the game to the best of my ability.
2. I will always play to win, but if I lose, I will not look for an excuse to detract from my opponent's victory.
3. I will never take an unfair advantage in order to win.
4. I will always abide by the rules of the game — on the diamond as well as in my daily life.
5. I will always conduct myself as a true sportsman — on and off the playing field.
6. I will always strive for the good of the entire team rather than for my own glory.
7. I will never gloat in victory or pity myself in defeat.
8. I will do my utmost to keep myself clean — physically, mentally and morally.
9. I will always judge a teammate or an opponent as an individual and never on the basis of race or religion.

New DVDs Reviewed in This Column Will be Released the Week of December 28, 2015



PICKS OF THE WEEK

A Walk in the Woods (R) — With a successful career, loving wife and years of priceless experiences, writer Bill Bryson (Robert Redford) still feels lost, and gets a yearning for daring adventure. He's going to hike all 2,200 miles of the Appalachian Trail, from Georgia up to Maine. Even more, he's making the journey with his crazy old pal, Katz (Nick Nolte). The two magnetic septuagenarians grouse and bicker their way through majestic slopes with vague hopes of a meaningful journey.

It's a movie that takes its time, and just like characters' journey, it's not super-clear what the payoff is supposed to be. Redford and Nolte eventually jostle into a chemistry, but the script doesn't get much out of it — mostly harmless slapstick bumbling and old-man odd-couple stuff.

The Perfect Guy (PG-13) — In this steamy-yet-standard thriller, we learn that sometimes finding a guy who is loyal, strong, protective, resourceful and loving can be a very bad thing if he's also wide-eyed crazy. Not long after Leah (Sanaa Lathan) breaks up with her beau Dave (Morris Chestnut), she's romantically rescued by the dashing Carter (Michael Ealy), who is quite possibly the perfect man. His perfection has a gaping flaw though — as Carter gets intensely jealous, turns violent really fast and doesn't really believe in privacy.

The thrills fall flat as the whole movie seems to be holding back. Carter's tone-switch happens so abruptly that it doesn't shock, it just feels forced. While Lathan does an amazing job onscreen, she's muffled by a script that doesn't diverge from the expected.

Bone Tomahawk (R) — Way out in the dusty West, the people of Bright Hope are terrorized by a ruthless cannibal clan. There's been grisly mur-

der and a few abductions, with signs pointing to a bone-chilling tribe of inbred monsters. The town is near-deserted with most of the men on a cattle drive, so Sheriff Franklin Hunt (Kurt Russell) leads an expedition with whatever men he can bring, including a shifty gunslinger (Matthew Fox) and a rancher with a broken leg trying to rescue his wife (Patrick Wilson). This horror Western has all of the great grit and style of an old shoot-em-up, along with the traumatizing brutality of a psycho-thriller.

Heist (R) — Vaughn (Jeffrey Dean Morgan) needs a lot of money to save his dying daughter, and his only chance of getting his hands on that much cash also sounds like the Worst Idea Ever — rob a kingpin played by Robert De Niro. Things go awry, of course, and Vaughn and his heist crew end up escaping (sort of) on a city bus full of civilians. Now they've got the police against them, in addition to De Niro's vicious enforcer, Dog (Morris Chestnut). It's a bit of fast-paced fun, even if you can see the glue-marks where this movie tried to combine pieces of other flicks.

Why Are Cats Such Finicky Eaters?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I find it weird that my two dogs, "Shep" and "Bull," can eat just about anything (I have to hide all the pet food), while my cat, "Trudy," will turn up her nose at most food. And although she's perfectly healthy, sometimes she gets sick after eating wet or fresh food. Why? — *Sarah in Madison, Wisconsin*

DEAR SARAH: Cats' eating behaviors have long been a source of curiosity for both pet owners and the scientific community. Why do they turn their nose up at certain foods and chow down on others? Why do they sometimes throw up after eating? Why do they gnaw on grass when they're meat-eaters?

The answer is: It's complicated, and no one is entirely sure. A recent study, for example, found that cats have some genes that are more commonly possessed by herbivores (animals that eat only plants, like cows). These particular genes help them detect bitter flavors, alerting them to potentially poisonous plants.

This research opens a new avenue into understanding why cats are more picky about their food than dogs — also meat-eaters — tend to be. If cats are detecting a bitter taste in their food then they may be less inclined to eat it. And, a bitter taste also may trigger a vomiting response to safeguard against ingesting what is perceived to be poison.

The study's results could lead to changes in how commercial producers formulate their cat food. Whether that is a good thing remains to be seen.

In the meantime, feeding a finicky cat remains a trial-and-error process. Try small amounts of different foods — dry, wet and fresh — and note Trudy's likes and dislikes.

Good Housekeeping

Easy Christmas Stollen

Ricotta cheese adds richness and moisture to this sweet bread.

- 2/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 8 tablespoons butter or margarine (1 stick)
- 1 cup ricotta cheese
- 1/2 cup candied lemon peel or coarsely chopped red candied cherries
- 1/2 cup dark seedless raisins
- 1/3 cup slivered blanched almonds, toasted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly grated lemon peel
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- 1 large egg yolk

1. Heat oven to 325 F. Grease large cookie sheet. In large bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. With pastry blender or two knives used scissor-fashion, cut in 6 tablespoons butter until mixture resembles fine crumbs. With spoon, stir in ricotta until mixture is moistened. Stir in candied lemon peel, raisins, almonds, vanilla, grated lemon peel, egg and egg yolk until well mixed.

2. Turn dough onto lightly floured surface; gently knead dough 2 or 3 times to mix. With floured rolling pin, roll dough into 10-inch-by-8-inch oval. Fold oval lengthwise almost in half, so that edges do not quite meet.

3. Place stollen on prepared cookie sheet. Bake until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, about 1 hour. Transfer to wire rack. Melt remaining 2 tablespoons butter and brush over warm stollen. Cool completely. Makes 12 servings.

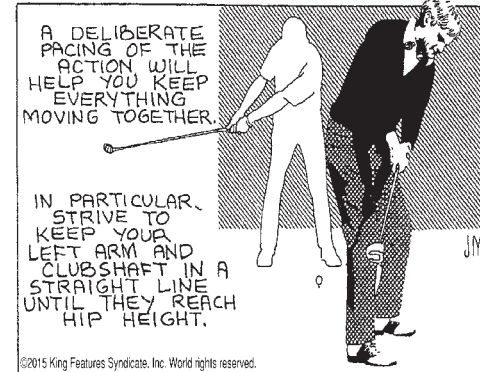
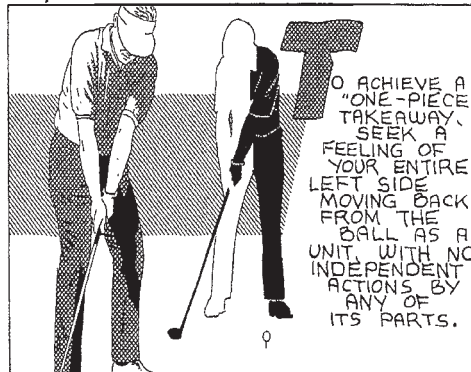
