E.T. Wristwatch

Q. I have an E.T. wristwatch. What is it worth? — *Carl, Salt Lake City, Utah*

A. Steven Spielberg's "E.T. The Extra Terrestrial" opened in theaters in 1982, the same year your watch was made by Nelsonic. Occasionally this watch pops up in shops and at antique malls and is generally priced in the \$25 to \$100 range. The higher end price is for the watch in its original box and in mint to near-mint condition.

Q. I have a partial set of Harlequin dinnerware, and I wonder what you can tell me about this pattern. — *Mark, Norman, Oklahoma*

A. Harlequin dinnerware was produced by Homer Laughlin China Company of Newell, West Virginia, starting in 1938. The pattern was marketed exclusively by the Woolworth five-and-dime stores and was extremely popular. A special set was issued to celebrate Woolworth's 100th anniversary in 1979. Changes were made so the newer pieces could be more easily distinguished from the earlier ones.

Q. I have an old sewing machine that has been in my family for at least a century. It is a "Household" machine. What can you tell me about it? — *Sally, Portsmouth, Virginia*

A. The company began as the Providence Tool Company in

Providence, Rhode Island. Even in the beginning, the main business was the manufacturing of sewing machines. The company name was changed to Household Sewing Machine in 1890 and continued until about 1906.

Q. I have a porcelain doll that has been in my family since about 1910. The doll needs some repair work. Can you suggest someone who can do this for me? — *Katie, Walnut Grove, Arkansas*

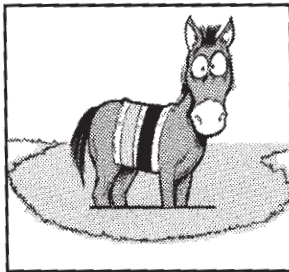



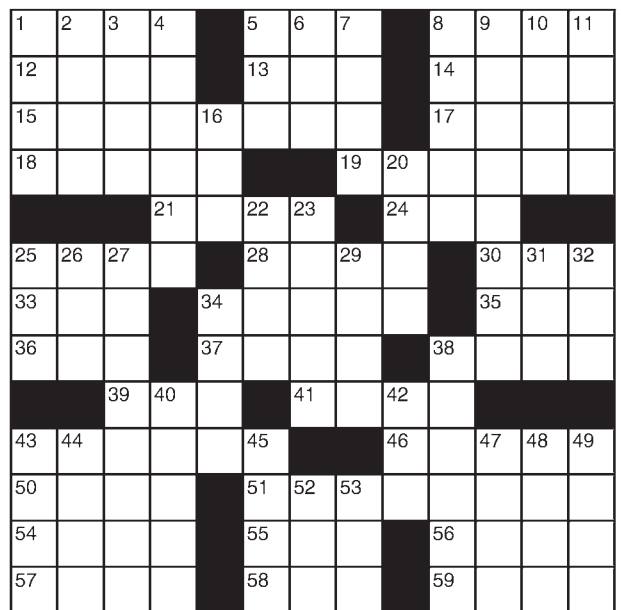

Protecting soil structure, feeding with nutrients from natural and local sources, and increasing the diversity and numbers of microbes and other organisms living in your soil can be helped by:

1. Adding manures for nitrogen.
2. Composting.
3. Using chickens to mix organic materials into the soil.
4. "Mining" soil nutrients with deep-rooted plants.
5. Planting cover crops.
6. Covering the soil with mulch.
7. Using permanent beds and pathways.
8. Using broad forks instead of power tillers.

Top 5 Home Upgrades

Q. What upgrades to our house will pay off the most in the long run? — *Karl V. Melrose, Massachusetts*

A. Many people think that remodeling the kitchen is an expense they can fully recoup (in terms of home value or resale value), but that is not necessarily the case. According to Remodeling Magazine, which puts out a Cost vs. Value chart each year on home remodeling, a major kitchen remodel averaging \$56,768 will recoup 67.8 percent of that cost, or just \$38,485.

However, a number of indoor and outdoor projects will increase the value of your home. Here are five projects on the midrange cost scale that will provide the biggest return for your remodeling investment:

1. Entry door: Replacing your entry door with a steel door will recoup 101.8 percent of the cost. (Replacing it with a fiberglass door will return 72 percent.)
2. Veneer: Replacing the bottom third of your home's exterior siding with manufactured stone veneer will recoup 92.2 percent of the cost.
3. Garage door: Replacing your garage door will recoup 88.4 percent of the cost.
4. Siding replacement: Adding vinyl siding to your home's exterior will recoup 80.7 percent of the cost.
5. Wooden deck: Adding or expanding a wooden deck will recoup 80.5 percent of the cost.


Other projects that have a higher chance of recouping their cost include a minor (below \$20,000) kitchen remodel (79.3 percent), wood window replacement (78.8 percent) or converting part of your attic to a bedroom (77.2 percent). Remodeling your bathroom will recoup 70 percent of its cost.

So, when putting together a remodeling project list, take their lasting value into account. You may decide to downscale that ambitious kitchen or bathroom remodel and shift some of the budget to your home's exterior elements.

TIP: Wood or vinyl windows? Carefully consider the merits of both before deciding on replacement windows. For example, wood windows are aesthetically pleasing, but vinyl windows require almost no maintenance.



Split Decisions

The "Fight of the Century" between Floyd "Money" Mayweather and Manny "Pac-man" Pacquiao was not the fight of the century, and if it was, it won't be for long. Still, the bout will have long-reaching effects for the future of the sport of boxing.

For one, the sport has taken fire from just about every angle imaginable. There's the health angle: People are all too aware of the life-long consequences of being punched in the face thousands of times during a short-lived career. The supply of boxers in America will continue to shrink as interest in the sport wanes and legitimate boxing gyms (not the ones in strip malls that you go to for exercise ... real boxing gyms) go out of business.

But those aren't direct effects of the Mayweather-Pacquiao bout. What Mayweather-Pacquiao did better than anything was remind us of how greedy and tone deaf the sport is. Mayweather received a gazillion dollars for the fight. We've all heard how seats at Caesar's Palace were going for the price points of small cars. Pay-per-view was \$100 for a home, several thousand for a bar or public space. And what did people get for their money?

Exactly what we all knew we were going to get: two great boxers, past their prime, mailing it in. Mayweather, as we all knew going in, was possibly the best defensive boxer ever. He was undefeated and unlikely

to stick his chin out with Pacquiao. Those who thought Pacquiao would win were betting on him breaking through that defense and scoring a knockout or at least landing enough to win on the scorecards. It didn't happen.

Some argued that Pacquiao was the aggressor most of the fight, that he threw the most punches and took the center of the ring. So what? He didn't land any of those punches, and Mayweather landed all of his. Mayweather didn't give the people a show or their money's worth, but he did give a masters-level class in the art of defensive boxing and how to win on points with ease.

Which brings us to another thing about boxing. We still don't know who is responsible for scoring the fight. We don't know their background, what makes them qualified. All we know about the judges is that they're there and they have to use the 10-point must system. Of all major sports, fighting is the only one that does not let either participants or those watching know who is winning during the course of the match.

Boxers who think they may be down on the score card are encouraged to inflict the most savage of beatings upon the head of their opponents, knowing the only way to win is by way of knockout. Most of the time, those efforts fail and usually just end up with that boxer getting hit all the more by the eventual winner. Is this what you want to gamble on? Pay extra money on your cable bill for?

In the end, Mayweather and Pacquiao gave us the answer as to who was the better boxer, but the question it left looms larger than ever before: What, or who, will save the sport?



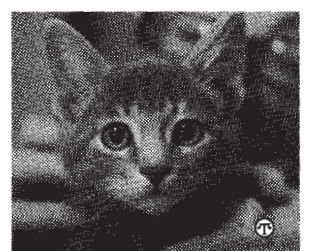

Closing The "Cat Gap" Can Increase Adoptions

(NAPS)—For many, cats and kittens can be an almost endless source of fascination. It's not uncommon for people to confess they can spend hours watching cute cat videos on the Internet and sharing cat photos online.



Experts say that cats are often the victim of negative stereotypes that hamper adoptions.

Unfortunately, it seems this online fascination with cats is not translating into real-life adoptions. Every year, an estimated 8 million pets enter U.S. shelters, and approximately 4 million of them are euthanized because there are not enough homes. A recent PetSmart Charities survey of people's perceptions of cats found that the negative opinions some people have of cats are hurting their image.

sions of cats and 56 percent said that the stereotypes about cats simply aren't true. Additionally, half of the respondents believed that more people would have a pet cat if the stereotypes around cats were removed.

For instance, when asked about the personality and behavioral traits of cats, respondents overwhelmingly described cats as curious, stubborn, moody and aloof. Dogs, on the other hand, were described in much more positive terms, such as friendly, loyal, protective and loving. It's thought perceptions such as these that are making it more difficult for cats to be adopted into permanent homes.

The survey also found that cat lovers may be uniquely positioned to help cats the most. Research shows that by sharing more about their cat online, particularly through social media, cat owners can help to counter the negative stereotypes surrounding cats and show them in a positive light.

Fortunately, there are indications that some people are taking steps to end these misperceptions once and for all. Sixty-six percent of respondents said that too many people have negative impres-

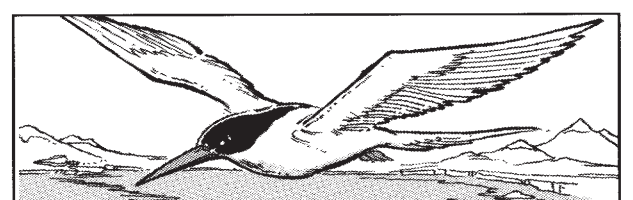


