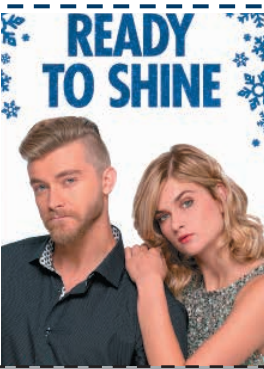

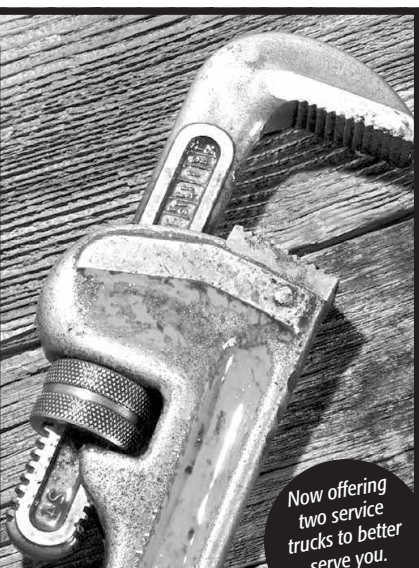

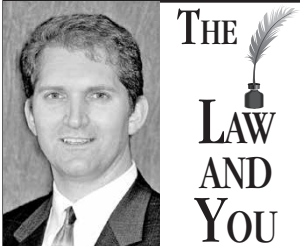

DEER MEMORIES

They give us many memories.

Deer season always gives you memories
that you can look back on, and during this
season's opening many of them flashed through
my mind as the day passed along. They were not
only memories of past deer hunts, but waterfowl
hunts, upland game hunts, fishing expeditions
and trapping adventures. Many were of the
times my Dad and I hunted together and later when my son began to join me in the great
outdoors.

My heart wasn't into deer hunting the opening day this year, not just because the
weather was terrible, but there were issues with the landowner above me who was doing
things above my camp that would drastically affect my place and my enjoyment of it. There
was something else too, but I just couldn't put my finger on it.

Even though weather conditions were poor, I was pretty well set up with a ground blind
that was much more comfortable than a tree stand in these conditions. Besides, it was a
short distance to fall from the swivel chair in a ground blind then it was from 16 feet up in
a tree stand!

I have always been lucky and usually get a buck opening day. I have gotten some
nice ones to boot, but the first memory was of my son getting his first deer not too far
from where I sat this opening day. At that time he wasn't old enough to deer hunt, but had
waterfowl and squirrel hunted with me and had proven himself a good shot and handled
a gun safely. He could lay those slugs in a tight group on a deer silhouette target very
well. So a second tree stand platform was placed next to mine in a twin trunk oak tree so
we could sit side by side. We had brought a small bird feeder filled with sunflower seeds
with us and the chickadees entertained us as we waited for our chance at a buck. Then
suddenly a fork-horn buck materialized on my son's side. I told him to grab my gun (I had
not allowed him to have his own gun yet) and don't take too long to get off a shot. His shot
was good and we watched as it ran out into the field and then turn in to the brush thicket
where we found it shortly after we started trailing it. The emotional thing about it was
that a beautiful 10-point buck that his Grandfather had shot, a few years before his death,
had run quite a distance leaving a poor blood trail and ran into this same thicket where I
eventually found it dead. My son's first buck had fallen in almost in the exact spot that the
10-point had! I had wet eyes as this was explained to him and he too soon had the same
condition. We both figured Grandpa had been with us on his first buck hunt. That field was
named "First Buck" and has given us many bucks since.

Another memory that popped up was when a nice eight-point was coming straight up
a steep slope toward my tree stand. He would look up the slope then put his head down
and sneak up toward my stand. My thought was to put a bullet between his shoulder
blades when he put his head down, but just as I pulled the trigger he suddenly lifted his
head from a low position, blocking the spot that was being aimed at. The slug hit one
of the long points on his rack and he went down like a lead balloon (the shock actually
momentary knocked him out), but he quickly recovered and was up on his feet. He ran a
short distance, stopping at a place that only left a small spot between two trees to shoot
through, but my slug hit him too high and he was off again. Getting out of the tree, the
chase was on, but he only offered a couple more poor shots, the last of which dropped
him, but did not kill him. As I approached him, he made an effort to get up and at that time I
realized I was out of shells (I rarely carry more than five slugs and in the excitement forgot
there was one more in my pants pocket). Well, when he finally got up and started running
for the adjacent field I was right with him leaving my shotgun behind. He would run and
fall, run and fall, and eventually the gap closed. Coming up behind him the antlers where
grabbed just as he was trying to get up again and I jumped on his back and scissor locked
my legs around his stomach behind the rib cage. I twisted his head like the cowboys do
when taking down a steer that seemed to paralyze him and got my knife off my belt and
finished the job. After he died without much of a struggle, I got up off of him and there was
another hunter standing there looking at me. "Where the hell is your gun?" With a smile
on my face I said "I like to run them down!" He walked away looking quite bewildered.

The next tale involved a buck while duck hunting. A friend of mine and I actually
lassoed a buck and then let it go during deer season. Better tune in next week to hear the
rest of that story!

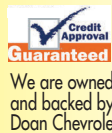

We assure you it will eventually be done. How long it will take is, to some degree, up to the community Charlie proudly called home.

Recognition of Charles Howard's significance is a link to a rich local history that has limitless potential for Albion and Orleans County. Unlocking that potential requires accepting the proposition that something few of us understand very well can be magical once we allow ourselves to "Believe."

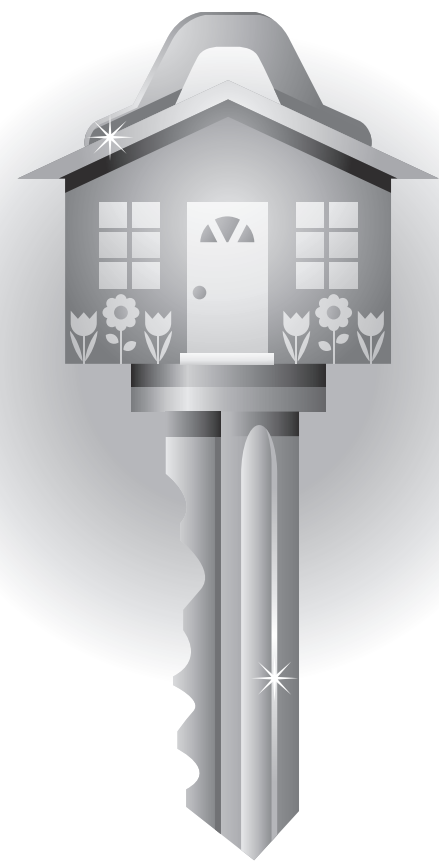

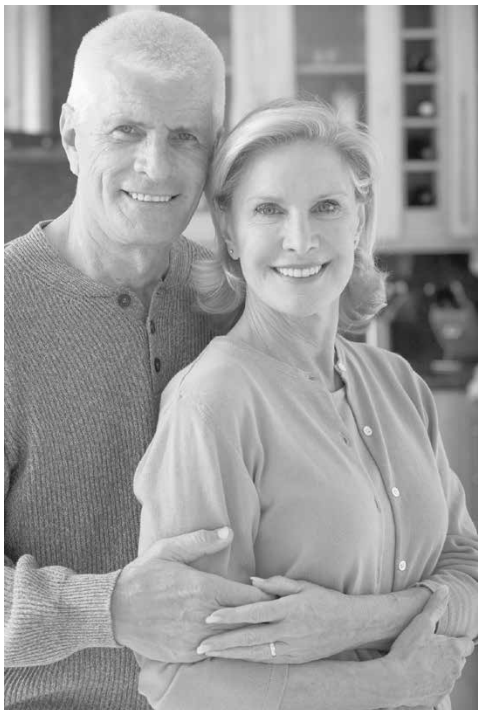

Pros and Cons of Reverse Mortgages



Reverse mortgages enable seniors to retire comfortably in their own homes. But that comfort does come with some drawbacks.

Chances are you have come across an advertisement for a reverse mortgage and have probably wondered what this type of mortgage is all about. Geared toward seniors, reverse mortgages are growing in popularity and inspiring the curiosity of older homeowners.

A reverse mortgage is a loan offered to people over the age of 62 that enables borrowers to convert part of the equity in their homes into cash. People of retirement age may find that their limited income can make monthly expenses more difficult. Reverse mortgages were conceived as a method to helping people at this stage in life use the money they put into their homes to pay off debts or cover routine living expenses. The loan is dubbed "reverse mortgage" because instead of the homeowner paying money to a lender as is customary with a traditional mortgage, the lender makes payments to the borrower. What's more, the borrower is not required to pay back the loan until the home is sold or vacated. As long as a person is living in the home he or she is not required to make any payments toward the reverse mortgage loan balance. However, the borrower must remain current on insurance and tax payments.

When a person takes out a reverse mortgage, he or she may borrow a portion of the market value on the home. As of 2012, the maximum loan amount available in the United States was \$625,000. Any outstanding existing mortgages are paid off with the proceeds of the reverse mortgage, and either a lump sum of the balance or monthly payments are established. A homeowner may also opt for a line of credit with the reverse mortgage proceeds. Here is a more in-depth look at the pros and cons to reverse mortgages.

Pros

A reverse mortgage enables seniors to live in their homes for the rest of their lives without fear of mortgage payments. Because there are no payments being made during the life of the loan, borrowers do not have to meet income requirements or credit checks.

As long as the borrower continues to maintain residence in the home, he or she is still eligible for the monthly payments received through the reverse mortgage. This money can be used for any purpose and is tax-free. Borrowers can opt to modernize their homes or make safety improvements. The funds can also be put toward medical expenses or travel or to help family with their own financial needs.

Because the government insures the reverse mortgage program, borrowers need not worry about receiving their payments. Should a lender fail to make a payment, the borrower is eligible for that money and a late fee as well.

Another benefit of reverse mortgages is they protect homeowners against falling home prices. If the value of the home drops after the loan is negotiated, it will not affect the equity value assessed for the life of the loan.

Cons
One down side to reverse mortgages is that the loans have higher up-front fees than other types of financing. Borrowers have to pay not only an origination fee and closing costs, but mortgage insurance costs as well. These initial costs can be several thousands of dollars.

Unlike a traditional mortgage, where the balance gets lower and lower over time, with a reverse mortgage, no payments are being made on the loan. This means the loan balance simply gets larger over time depending on how much money is drawn from the home's equity. At the end of the loan, when the homeowner moves from the property or the premises is vacated upon the borrower's death, the value of the estate decreases based on the pay-off value of the reverse mortgage loan. Heirs will pay off the mortgage by selling the home and will only inherit the remaining money after the reverse mortgage lender has the loan satisfied. This means men and women will be leaving less money for their heirs, but those heirs will not be personally liable if the home sells for less than the value of the mortgage. The mortgage lender has to claim a loss and request reimbursement from the Federal Housing Administration.

Something many seniors may not be aware of with regard to reverse mortgages is that these loans can affect eligibility for some need-based programs. Although Social Security and Medicare are not affected, Medicaid and other government assistance programs can be affected if a senior has a surplus of funds from a reverse mortgage that are not spent during the month.

A reverse mortgage is a long-term solution. People who are looking for a short-term fix will find that this type of loan probably doesn't meet their needs. Furthermore, it is hard to be approved for reverse mortgages on newly purchased homes. Lenders usually like to see at least six months or a year chain of title on a property before issuing a reverse mortgage.

Many seniors often find reverse mortgages confusing. Seniors may unwittingly agree to a loan without fully understanding the scope of the reverse mortgage. It is advisable to seek counseling on reverse mortgages before applying for one. ■

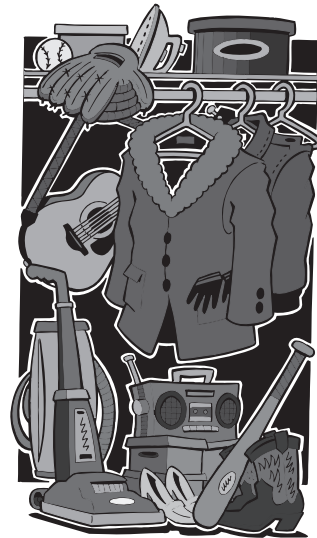

A More Organized, Functional Garage

Homeowners who park in their driveways may find that their garages have become crowded, cluttered spaces in which searching for tools can feel like scouring a haystack in search of a needle. Organizing a garage can create extra room in a home while affording homeowners the chance to protect their vehicles from the elements. Homeowners who want to turn their garages into something more than cluttered storage units can employ the following strategies to transform these largely overlooked areas into more valuable spaces.

- Choose the right day. Garages tend to be separate from the rest of the homes they're a part of, meaning the only way to organize a garage is to first remove all items from the garage and into the driveway. Because items removed from the garage will be exposed to the elements, homeowners should choose a day that's temperate and sunny to clean their garages. If possible, homeowners should opt to organize their garages in late spring, summer or early fall when there are additional hours of daylight. This protects homeowners from having to work in the dark should the job take longer than they initially anticipated.

- Discard or donate duplicate items. Duplicate items are some of the main culprits behind cluttered garages. As garages gradually become more cluttered, homeowners may buy tools they already have simply because they cannot find their original tools. When organizing the garage, create separate piles for duplicate tools, placing still-useful items in a pile that can be donated to neighbors, local charities or organizations and another pile for old tools that are no longer useful.

- Host a garage sale. Homeowners who want to organize their garages and make a buck at the same time can host garage sales. Make only those items that are still functional available for purchase, and let neighbors and bargain hunters do the bulk of your organization work for you.

- Designate areas of the garage for certain items. Once the items that won't be going back into the garage have been sold, donated or discarded, organize the garage by designating areas for certain items, making sure to separate items that can pose safety risks. For example, store kids' bicycles and outdoor toys in a corner of the garage that is opposite the corner where potentially dangerous items such as power tools and gas cans will be stored. Keep the center of the garage open for vehicles.

- Periodically park cars in the garage. Homeowners who are comfortable parking their vehicles in their driveways can improve their chances of maintaining organized garages over the long haul by periodically parking in the garage. Doing so not only prevents the gradual buildup of clutter that can slowly take over a garage, but also protects homeowners' automotive investments. ■

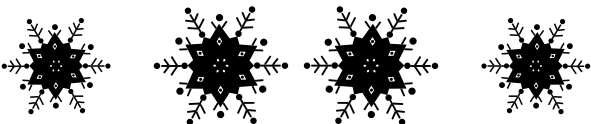

Effective Cover Letters

A strong cover letter may not guarantee you land a good job, but a poor cover letter may guarantee you won't. On its own, an effective cover letter can catch the eye of hiring managers tasked with finding worthy candidates among stacks of applications, while a poor cover letter may ensure hiring managers never even glance at an applicant's resume.

An effective cover letter should be concise, conveying an applicant's work history and goals in a few paragraphs or less. The following are some additional ways men and women can craft effective cover letters.

- Address a specific person when possible. When responding to a job posting that listed a specific contact, address your cover letter to that person rather than beginning the letter with, "Dear Sir or Madam" or "To Whom It May Concern." Personalize each cover letter you write so the hiring manager does not get the feeling that you are sending out cover letters en masse. Make sure names are spelled correctly and job titles are accurate.

- State your purpose early on. The purpose of your letter, which is to state the job you're seeking, should be made clear early on. Hiring managers often handle the vetting process for a host of positions at their companies, so the earlier the hiring manager knows which position you're applying for the better. Hiring managers may become frustrated when applicants don't make their intentions clear or do so in the final paragraph instead of the first.

- Explain why you are a qualified candidate. While it's good to note your work history, your resume will do the bulk of that legwork. A cover letter is your opportunity to show how your work history makes you a qualified candidate for a specific position. Remember to be concise but relate a specific example that illustrates how your work history would help you thrive in the position for which you're applying.

- Exhibit some knowledge about the company to which you're applying. An effective cover letter should help you stand out among your fellow applicants, and expressing some knowledge about the organization can do just that. The goal here is to illustrate how you and the organization are a good fit, so you don't need to go overboard or be too specific. But hiring managers are likely to be more impressed by applicants who do their homework and show a knowledge of the company than applicants who submit a form cover letter where the company is scarcely mentioned.

- Be cordial in your closing. A cover letter should close with a cordial request for an interview or a friendly way of indicating you look forward to a company's response to your application. In addition, thank the reader for his or her time and mention you would be delighted to answer any questions he or she may have.

An effective cover letter can go a long way toward making a strong first impression on a prospective employer. Men and women should look at their cover letters as their first opportunities to connect with a company and write their letters accordingly. ■

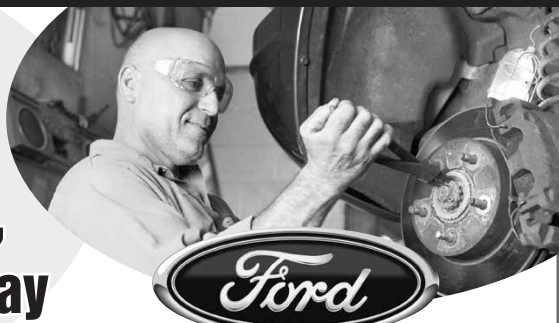

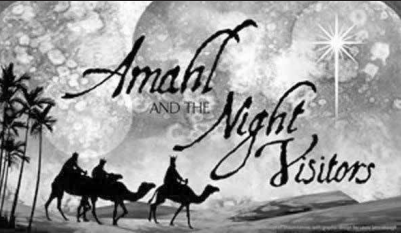

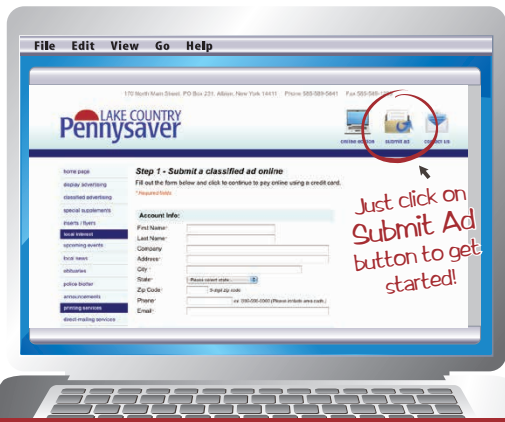
