Medicare Minute

"Prescription Drug Plans 2"

When looking at a prescription drug plan the first thing that most people look at is how much the plan cost. There are drug plans that cost less than \$20. There are also plans that cost more than \$100. Conventional wisdom tells us that something that cost \$100 has to be better than something that cost \$20, but when talking about Medicare prescription drug plans this isn't necessarily true. You have to look deeper than the premium of the plan to see if it's the right fit for you.

One important part of a drug plan is the deductible phase of the plan. A deductible is the amount of money you must pay out of your pocket before your plan will begin to pay. For example, if your plan has a \$400 deductible you may have to pay the first \$400 before the plan will pay. The good news is plans treat deductibles differently. Some plans have deductibles on all tiers of drugs. On some plans the deductible only pertains to tier 3, 4 or 5 drugs but not tier 1 or 2 drugs. Other plans have no deductible at all. The way to know if your plan has a deductible on the prescriptions you are taking is to look at the plan's Formulary to find your drug's tier and the Summary of Benefits to see if you have a deductible.

You will also want to know if the plan requires you to pay a coinsurance on any of your prescriptions. A coinsurance is a percentage you will pay on your prescription. A lot of plans have a coinsurance on tier 4 and tier 5 prescriptions. This means if you have a coinsurance of 20% on your prescription, and the prescription retails for \$500, you would pay 20% or \$100. Next week we will look at copays, formularies and provider

Former WLAY **Bldg at Auction**

MUSCLE SHOALS-The National Auction Group, Inc. is conducting an Auction of two commercial buildings on 2nd Street in Muscle Shoals December 5. One of those is the former WLAY radio station building which is listed as an historic landmark by the Alabama Historical Society.

WLAY AM-1450 is legendary in the music business. **Mitch Self** was one of the principal owners of WLAY for years. The station was licensed as WNRA (National Recovery Act) in 1933. It was where **Sam Phillips**, the Father of Rock 'n' Roll, got his start in the radio business in the 1940s, and it's the site of the first commercial recording session in Muscle Shoals, with **Bobby** Denton's "A Fallen Star," in 1957. The station was cutting edge playing rhythm and blues, country, and the rock 'n' roll when AM radio was the source for new music. A close relationship with Rick Hall and FAME Studios allowed it to often be the first to air many iconic hit songs.

The building on 2nd street housed WLAY's AM, and later its FM stations and sales and business offices for half a century. The building has since been enlarged and extensively renovated since that period.

The auction on December 5 takes place on site at 520-522 2nd Street at 11am.

ON YOUR DEBT

Beware of **Predatory** Lending While Shopping during the Holidays

The biggest shopping time of the year is among us and many people across the nation will be out shopping for holiday gifts, and the urge to spend is stronger at this time of year than in any other season. Unfortunately that urge is what can make us easy targets for "predatory lenders".

Predatory Lending

Predatory lending is any lending practice that imposes unfair or abusive terms and that convinces a borrower to accept a loan that they really don't need or can't afford. At this time of year, many lenders offer special holiday loans to help cover the expense of shopping. My hope is that the next few paragraphs will help you recognize and protect yourself against predatory lending practices.

Loan Flipping

Loan flipping is a lending practice that disguises itself as debt consolidation. A customer is urged to refinance one or more existing loans into a single large loan. However, the lender may include a higher interest rate or additional fees. If you receive offers to consolidate, be sure to pay attention to the interest rates and to the total amount of payment. You may find yourself paying a larger overall amount than you were by paying your existing debts individually.

Balloon Payment Loans

Balloon payment loans may also be a sign that a lender is trying to take advantage of you. A lender may offer great terms on a loan but include one or more large payments later in the loan term. Predatory lenders will include payments that are so high that you can't afford them when they come due. Then the lender will offer to refinance the remaining debt into yet another loan, including refinance fees and/or a high interest rate. Be aware of any balloon payments that may be part of a loan structure. A good rule of thumb is that if you couldn't afford to pay the balloon payment today, then don't count on being able to make that payment in the future.

Negative or Minimal Amortization

Negative or minimal amortization is another deceptive practice that can be disguised. Negative amortization happens when your monthly payments aren't enough to cover the interest that accrues. If this happens, then you can wind up owing much more money than you ever borrowed in the first place. Minimal amortization would be a situation where your payments are only just enough to cover the interest, essentially leaving you in financial limbo. Your payments don't actually go toward lowering the amount owed so unless you pay extra each month the debt will last indefinitely. Always check the loan documents carefully to see how much of your monthly payments are going toward interest and how much is being paid on the principal loan balance. If the monthly payments seem too good to be true, they

I was injured by a driver who has a revoked license when they ran a stop sign. Their insurance company says they may not have insurance because of the revoked license. The other driver was driving a borrowed car that had insurance. Is it true that there may be no insurance?

Julie, Sheffield, Alabama

A revoked license does not cancel insurance. However, there are situations where people are such bad drivers that they are "excluded drivers". If someone is driver excluded from the insurance on the car that caused the accident, then there is no insurance coverage. Exclusions from coverage of named drivers are valid in Alabama.

The next thing a lawyer would look for is whether or not the person that

owned the car was aware of how bad a driver the person that caused the accident was. Alabama allows a lawsuit against a person who allows someone drive their car if they know (or should know) that this person is likely to cause an accident. The most common facts that give rise to this type of suit is letting someone who has been drinking borrow a car. The same would hold true for someone loaning a car to someone under the influence of drugs. If a person has reason to know that the person borrowing their car is impaired and the impaired driver hurts someone, the owner of the car can be

This cause of action is known as "negligent entrustment" and it includes the idea that the owner knew that the driver was incompetent, inexperienced and/or reckless and proof that this driver legally caused harm to another.

Talk to a good personal injury lawyer and always remember to notify your insurance company of the accident. Occasionally, insurance companies will claim they were not notified of a claim for uninsured motorist coverage, and this just creates a needless problem in your claim for insurance that you paid for.

In baseball, he was selected the Lions Most Valuable Player as a junior and was one of the most consistent players in school history.

After graduation, Frost became head basketball coach at Appleby Junior High where he compiled an amazing 214-18 record in just six season including winning two Junior High State Championships. During one stretch, his teams won 64 consecutive games. When Bradshaw started their school program, Frost was named to head up the basketball program while also serving as an assistant principal.

Over the next seasons, the Bruins won His 1976 253 games. Bruins team won the Class 4A State Championship. That year, Frost was named Alabama Coach of The Year for all classifications. served as president of the Alabama High School Athletic Association and started the first basketball camp for children ages

Along with Bubba Scott, Frost founded the annual Alabama-Mississippi All-Star basketball game. Frost left sports to enter the political arena and was elected Mayor of Florence for his fifth term just months before he died. Frost lost his battle with leukemia just two days before he was to be inducted into the Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame and just four days before he was to be inducted into the Alabama High School Sports Hall of Fame.

In 2000, Frost was inducted into the UNA Athletic Hall of Fame. Eddie Frost was truly a Shoals legend and a dear friend.



Sales Contract

Most REALTORS in the Shoals Area use the Real Estate Sales Contract provided by the Shoals Area Association of REALTORS. It is common throughout the Real Estate Industry for Brokers of Real Estate Companies to adopt and use forms provided by the local and state associations.

Members of such associations typically will form committees to study forms used in day to day operations, and together with the advice of an Attorney will usually come up with a form that fits the marketplace. Agents will then use these forms as advised by their Qualifying

The Real Estate Sales Contract used in most transactions in our market consists of eight pages and twenty-seven paragraphs, which cover everything from how much the sales price will be to when it will close and what type of financing, if any, the buyer will obtain.

When buying or selling a piece of real estate, it is imperative to use some form of a sales contract. Lenders almost always require a contract, signed by both the buyer and the seller because it clearly explains all terms of the agreement.

Most people think that agreeing on the sales price is the only part of a sales contract, however there are many other terms that both parties have to agree on in order for it to become a fully executable document.

Terms of a typical contract will usually include:

-Purchase Price

-How much Earnest Money is being held

-When it will close

-When the buyer will take possession of the property

A sales contract can also have contingencies, or things that must happen or the buyer must be satisfied with in order to close. Those may include:

The buyer obtaining a loan A home inspection

An appraisal Lender required repairs

Survey

A Wood Infestation Inspection Report (aka Termite Letter) Clear Title work/ Title Insurance Policy

There is also usually a "catch all" paragraph located at the end of the sales contract that would specify any additional terms such as whether the sale is contingent upon the sale of another home, or whether the buyer wants to ask the seller to leave a playground set, etc...

If you're buying or selling real estate, be sure you're using a sales contract so that everyone is on the same page on all terms of the agreement. A good friend once told me "The best way to avoid a misunderstanding is to have a good understanding" -mr

about McCain and Vicki Iseman, a lobbyist 30 years his junior. Iseman had business before the Commerce Committee which McCain chaired, and the two spent an inordinate amount of time alone together. The mere appearance of impropriety should have cost McCain his chairmanship, yet he unequivocally dismissed unequivocally those accusations.

McCain also obtained a marriage license for his current wife, Cindy, a woman seventeen years younger in March 1980, a month before he divorced his first wife, Carol.

Recently while studying through Mark's account of the gospel I noted several instances where Jesus was sought by

people who went to extraordinary means to get to Him. They probably would have given up, had it not been for their personal interest. For example, there was Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, who fell at the feet of Jesus and begged earnestly for the healing of his twelve-year-old daughter who was at the point of death (Mark 5:22f). Further, there was the Syro-Phoenician woman, a Gentile, who begged Jesus and the apostles persistently to cast out the demon that plagued her daughter (Mark 7:25f). Also, we might consider the woman with the flow of blood who was broke- - but refused to be broken- - and made it her mission to touch the garment of Jesus to be healed (Mark 5:25f). All three of these had far more than a casual concern for their situation.

Several years ago I had the privilege of sitting in on a lecture given by Jim Bill McInteer. I do not remember the title of the lecture, but I will never forget the challenge of one of his points. He asked, "How would you feel if the church where you worshiped were to go out of business? How would it affect your life?" I did not have to do a lot of thinking to conclude that it would break my heart to see such a thing happen. I am sure that most of you share my sentiments and that we would be willing to go to great measures to prevent such a tragic thing from ever happening. Why? Because the church is such a vital part of our lives- - especially our home congregation!

But who are the people who are most likely to get involved in the local church to keep it moving onward and upward? Those who are the brightest and most gifted? Perhaps, but most likely the better answer is: Those who feel a personal indebtedness and appreciation for the salvation they have received through Christ (cf. Romans 1:14-16). So, if you feel somewhat "disconnected" and not as committed to the church as you should be, you need to make a personal investment. Surrender your heart fully to the cause of Christ and the rest of you is sure to follow!




