Popular Kids Can Help Curb Bullying

(NAPSA)—Contrary to previous research that suggested that as stu-dents' popularity increased so did their bullying behavior, many parents may be surprised to learn the results of a recent study from Princeton, Rutgers and Yale Universities. It found that popular kids who publicly stand up against bullying may actually help more than school officials' efforts to curb the behavior. While this new research is hopeful, targets of bullying are more likely than nontargets to consider suicide, which leads to nearly 4,600 young lives lost each year, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Signs Your Child Has Been

Bullied Warning signs that children have

experienced bullying include depression, anxiety, loneliness, changes in sleep and eating patterns, and loss of interest in activities they used to enjoy. They may also experience a decrease in academic achievement and participation.

Long-Term Effects Of Bullying
Those who were bullied and survive the challenging tween and teenage years may face mental health issues in adulthood, including from anxiety and depression, and may even consider self-harm

and suicide later in life. While all children face conflict, disagreements among peers can usually be resolved in some way; how-ever, experts say, it's the repetitive nature of bullying that can cause harm. Even as kids start standing up for each other, parents must remain involved and watch what their kids say and do face-to-face and online. Consistent and early intervention at schools and in the home can help mental health issues in adulthood as a result of bullying.

During October, which is Bullying Prevention Month, and throughout the year, you can encourage your children to stand up for their peers. One way is to approach bullying from a strength stance and teach youths to be upstanders, not bystanders.



not bystanders—when they see bullying can have a lifelong effect.

What Kids Can Do Children should be encour

aged to say something if they see bullying behavior. By standing up and saying that it's not OK, they will show others that bullying will not be tolerated.

• Kids should also get a responsible adult involved and properly report the bullying incident. Bystander silence won't help curb the bullying behavior.

 Befriending those who are bullied can go a long way. While there are many reasons bullies pick their targets, those who seem ess vulnerable may no longer be targets.

• Participating in school zero

tolerance policies can help shape the future of bully prevention methods. As kids are empowered to stand up for each other, administration and faculty as well as parents should reward the good behavior instead of only punishing the bad behavior.

 To help even more, children can actively participate in antibullying activities and projects.





Two Keys To Protecting Water Wells

(NAPSA)—Over 15 million U.S households rely on private, household wells for drinking water, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports.

If your family is ever among them, you should know how to protect your water quality. Two of the most important considerations are a proper well cap and plugging any abandoned wells on your property, advises the National Ground Water Association.

Why Cap A Well
If an active water well is not capped properly—or if an abandoned well is not plugged properly—it can be a direct pathway for contamination from above the ground to groundwater used by well owners for drinking. Private well owners are responsible

for making sure their wells are propercapped and any aband their property are properly plugged.
What makes for a properly capped

vater well? Not just any covering do on top of the well casing, that vertical pipe that extends above the ground in a

- water well. A proper well cap should:

 Be bolted or locked, so it cannot be easily removed
- Have a rubber seal to prevent anything from infiltrating the well where the cap is joined to the well casing


 Be in good condition.
 A well cap that lacks a rubber seal or is cracked or otherwise broken can allow bugs, vermin, bacteria or other types of contaminants above the ground surface into the well, while even a tight-fitting well cap that is not bolted or locked can be jarred loose or removed by someone other than the well owner.

Well caps should be installed by a water well system professional and any well cap maintenance or replacement should be done by a professional. Also, a well system should be disinfected when a well cap is installed, repaired or

How To Plug An Abandoned Well

It can sometimes be a challenge to find abandoned wells on your property. Some abandoned wells are less obvious than others. Look for:

· Pipes sticking out of the ground Small buildings that may have been

- trouble for homeowners. Depressions in the ground
 Concrete vaults or pits
- · Out-of-use windmills
- Additions to an old home that might cover up an abandoned well.

Old, abandoned wells can also be found by consulting your neighbors and maps, property plans of property ti tle documents. A water well system professional may do additional checkingincluding a records check—for more information about abandoned wells.

To properly plug an abandoned well, the professional should:

- Remove all material from the well that may hinder proper plugging
- 2. Disinfect the well
- 3. Use a specialized grout that both keeps surface water from working its way into the borehole and prevents water from different levels in the subsurface from mixing.

How Much Will It Cost? This depends on several factors in-

cluding the depth and diameter of the well, the geology of the area and the well's accessibility and condition. Learn More
