The Bubbles Are Coming! The Bubbles Are Coming!



Bubbles can make nearly any day more fun.

(NAPSA)—From the 17th century, we've seen paintings that portray children blowing bubbles with clay pipes. And since the 18th and 19th centuries, it has been commonplace for mothers to give their children leftover washing soap to blow bubbles for fun. So how can you celebrate the season of bubbles?

First: GET SOME BUBBLES!

Premier bubble maker Funrise Toys makes Gazillion Bubbles, whose bubble solutions are made right here in the U.S.A. On shelves at all major retailers, Gazillion Bubbles are the biggest, brightest and most colorful bubbles on the market, hands down. And you can ramp it up with their awesome bubble toys and accessories, such as the Gazillion Bubble Monsoon (SRP: \$24.99), the Gazillion Bump & Go Bubble Car (SRP: \$19.99) and the Gazillion Bubble Hurricane (SRP: \$16.99), all available at Toys 'R' Us.

Next: TRY OUT SOME BUBBLE TRICKS!

•**The Bubble Snake:** Cut the bottom off of a plastic bottle. Slip a sock over the cut end of the bottle. (If you like, you can secure it with a rubber band.) Squirt dishwashing liquid into a bowl or plate. Pour some bubble solution onto a plate. Dip the sock end of the bottle into the solution. Blow through the mouth of the bottle to make a bubble snake! Want to make a bubble rainbow? Stripe the sock with food coloring and repeat the trick!

•**The Unpoppable Bubble:** Put a container lid on the table face up. Pour in your bubble solution (Gazillion Bubbles have the reputation of being the strongest on the market) and dip in a straw

so that it's wet halfway up the straw. Touch the straw to the lid and blow a bubble on the lid. Slowly pull the straw all the way out of the bubble. Now, poke the scissors through the wall of your bubble. What happens?

•**The Square Bubble:** Take four pipe cleaners and form them into a square with a wand. Dip the wand in your bubble solution and see what happens!

Finally: TEST YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND BECOME A BUBBLE MASTER!

•**How a Bubble Gets Its Color:** As waves of light pass through the bubble, they get distorted by reflecting off different layers of soap film and are called iridescence. (Gazillion Bubbles is also known to have the most colorful and beautiful bubbles available.)

•**Can You Freeze a Bubble?** A bubble's shell is composed of a layer of water molecules surrounded by two thin layers of soap. Technically, a bubble will freeze below 32 degrees Fahrenheit like all water. The only problem is that bubbles tend to burst after a few seconds, so in order to truly see a bubble freeze, the temperature needs to fall to about 23 degrees for bubble staying power.

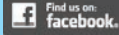
•**Why Do Bubbles Burst?** Anything that fractures the tenuous layer of water molecules can cause a bubble to burst. For example, a gust of wind or an object (like your finger) will easily cause a bubble to burst. Bubbles also burst by simply drying out. Moisture within a bubble causes the molecules to draw closer together, enabling the bubble to stay formed for a longer period of time. This is why bubbles tend to work best in high-humidity environments.

Essentially, bubbles are loved the world over by people of all ages. There are even university studies focused on them. For kids, bubbles are pure fun for spring and summer outdoor frolic. For adults (where you'll find them at events such as proms, weddings and more), they symbolize peace, harmony and beauty.






Childproofing Blinds

Q: A friend told me that the cords on my apartment blinds weren't safe, and that kids or my cat could get tangled up in them. I'm not sure what to do to make them safe — should I replace the blinds? — Val in Duluth, Georgia

A: Window blinds manufactured for sale in the U.S. are required to have a safety feature installed to prevent children or pets from getting tangled up in the pull cords. Older window blinds manufactured before 1991 may not have this feature. The blinds' manufacturer should include instructions for cord safety. If you can't locate them, you can find general information at websites like the Window Covering Safety Council at windowcoverings.org. Look on the pull cords of your window blinds for cord stops. These are small round plastic discs threaded through the cords. Here's how to use them to make the pull cords safer, from the WCSC (www.windowcoverings.org/how-to-retrofit/):

1. Lower the blind to its proper closed length and tug the cords slightly to the right to lock them in position.
2. To install a new cord stop, pinch together a section of the pull cord (near the top of the cord) and slide the plastic disc over the pinched-together cord so that you create a loop threaded through the disc.
3. Keeping the loop large for now, bring the bottom part of the same pull cord through the loop and then tug it into a loose half-knot under the disc.
4. Adjust the disc until it is about 2 inches below the blinds' head rail and tighten the knot. Repeat with the other cords.
5. The bottom of each cord shouldn't hang past the bottom window sash

when the blinds are closed. Shorten them by cutting each cord above the plastic tassel to a safer length, then re-threading the tassel onto the cord and securing with a knot tied on the end.

If you have young children or adventurous pets, consider replacing the blinds with safer cordless models as soon as possible.

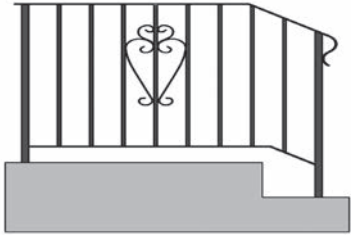

Board Games
 Q. Although I don't consider myself a collector, I buy occasional board games and puzzles when I find good ones at flea markets or garage sales. I currently have almost 50, including "Pollyanna," "Bomb the Navy," "Car 54," "Get Smart" and a 1930s edition of "Monopoly." How can I find out if any of my games are worth keeping? — Steve, Dayton, Ohio

A. Games create a feeling of nostalgia with many collectors, which has, of course, led to an increase in values. For example, your "Car 54" game, issued in 1951, currently is worth about \$300, up at least tenfold from just a decade ago. There are several factors to consider when purchasing older board games. Make certain the game is complete and in good condition. Games that were issued to promote hit TV series are always popular with collectors. Consider "The Beverly Hillbillies," "The Man from UNCLE," "Lost in Space" and "The Waltons," all retailing in the \$25-\$50 range.

Q. In 1971, my wife and I purchased some items from the RMS Queen Mary. They include a ship's clock plaque, telescope and survival kit whistle. All have certificates of authenticity. I must sell these items and would like to know current values. — George, Sun City West, Arizona

A. You might get a sinking feeling when I tell you what I discovered when I contacted several collectors who specialize in ocean liner collectibles. The items you purchased at the gift shop of the Queen Mary might not be worth much more than what you originally paid. To determine present values, you could monitor eBay to see if similar items are being offered for sale, or contact an expert.
