Dr. Robyn's fiancé, Caleb, is a dentist in the US Army and



Beer Brat Skewers with Spicy Slaw

Bite-size bratwurst slices alternate with veggies in this kebab version of the Sheboygan, Wisconsin, classic, which is basted in a beer-brown

- tablespoons cider vinegar tablespoons packed brown
- teaspoon packed brown sugar
- teaspoon crushed red pepper
- teaspoons lower-sodium soy

1. In large bowl, stir 3 tablespoons vinegar, 1 teaspoon brown sugar, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1/8 teaspoon crushed red pepper and 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper until sugar dissolves. Add cabbage; toss to coat.

2. Prepare grill for direct grilling on

3. In 3-quart saucepan, combine beer, soy sauce and remaining 3 tablespoons brown sugar, 1 tablespoon vinegar and 1/8 teaspoon crushed red pepper. Heat to boiling on medium-high, stirring. Reduce heat to maintain simmer and cook 15 minutes or until reduced to 1/3 cup, stirring often

4. While sauce simmers, cut onions, peppers and sausages into 1-inch chunks; thread onto skewers. Grill 10-12 minutes or until onions are tender and grill marks appear on sausages, turning occasionally. Brush two-thirds of sauce all over skewers and grill 5 minutes or until sauce caramelizes, turning. Transfer to serving plates; brush with remaining sauce. Serve with slaw. Serves 4.







• When I was a kid in the 1950s, • Cracker Jack was one of my favorite snacks. I loved the prizes inside each box and have a cigar box full of ones I managed to save. Since I have some duplicates, I would like to find others who collect so I can swap for ones I don't already have. — Paul, Mercer Island, Washington

F.W. Rueckenheim introduced A. his popcorn confection during the 1893 Chicago World's Fair. It was an immediate hit. In 1912, prizes were added to each box, and since then more than 18 billion have been distributed. Almost anything associated with this popcorn, molasses and peanut product is collectible.

Some of the prizes have become extremely valuable. For example, a horse-drawn wagon trinket from the 1930s, \$450; a nodding-head elephant, also from the same period, \$500; magic game book, circa 1940s, \$50; paper whistles, 1940s, \$40; and a miniature grandfather clock, 1947, \$100. Plastic toys from the 1950s generally sell in the \$3 to \$10 range.



after the creator, or "the Ted Williams shift," the guy it was invented for. The story goes that Lou Boudreau, the player-manager of the Cleveland Indians, decided to employ the shift during the second game of a doubleheader with the Red Sox.

Williams, despite his reputation and self-assertion of being the greatest hitter of all time, was a one-trick pony at the plate in that he was a dead-pull hitter. The game previous he had pulled three homers to beat the Indians by a run, and Boudreau, who was considered one of the best hitters in the game, decided it might be a good ploy. Williams had an ego and nobody thought he would drop a bunt to the vacated field to his left. It's interesting that Boudreau's name should come up. He is a bit of a trivia answer. He was the last American League player-manager, and unlike Pete Rose, the last player-manager, he successfully guided Cleveland to its last championship Schmidt pointed out that for many players, it's too late to change. This is ironic because, in the AL at least, the designated hitter rule has finally done what it was marketed to do in the first place, namely extend the careers of aging stars. Alex Rodriguez and Ortiz fit that bill perfectly. But defenders of the shift argue that it's something that will work itself out. Personally, I don't want to see Mark Texeira or Ryan Howard bunt and run every game, and I don't want to explain to my kid why the third baseman is guarding the line - at first base

This is silly. The game only had one flaw, and it was fixed when they instituted the infield fly rule. We say that runners have to remain in the base paths, fielders should field their positions. Enough of this shift.




