THE HISTORY CHANNEL • On Aug. 4, 1892,

Andrew and Abby Borden, elderly residents of Fall River

Mass., are found bludgeoned to death in their home. Sus-picion soon fell on daughter Lizzie and the axe she'd just bought. At her trial, the jury only took 90 minutes to decide that such a sweet-looking Christian woman could

ever commit such a heinous crime.
On Aug. 6, 1928, Andy Warhol, one of the most influential artists of the latter part of the 20th century, is born Andrew Warhola in Pennsylva-nia. After being incorrectly credited as "Warhol" under an early published drawing, he decided to permanently remove the "a" from his last name.

• On Aug. 9, 1945, a second atom bomb is dropped on Japan by the United States, at Nagasaki, resulting finally in Japan's surrender. The devastation wrought at Hiroshima had not been sufficient to persuade the Japa-nese War Council to accept the Potsdam Conference's demand for unconditional surrender • On Aug. 3, 1958, the U.S. nuclear submarine Nautilus accomplishes the first undersea voyage to the geographic North Pole. The Nautilus dived at Point Barrow, Alaska, and traveled nearly 1,000 miles under the Arctic ice cap to reach the top of the world. • On Aug. 6, 1964, the United States Congress overwhelmingly approves the Gulf of Tonkin Resolution, giving President Lyndon B. Johnson nearly unlimited powers to oppose "com-munist aggression" in Southeast Asia The resolution marked the beginning of an expanded military role for the United States in Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia • On Aug. 8, 1988, the Chicago Cubs host the first night game in the history of Wrigley Field. The first-ever night game in professional baseball took place nearly 60 years earlier in Des Moines, Iowa.
On Aug. 5, 2002, the rusty iron gur turret of the ironclad warship U.S.S. Monitor was raised from the floor of the Atlantic, where it had rested since it went down in a storm off Cape Hatteras North Carolina during the Civil War. She sank in December 1862 while being towed from Cape Hatteras.

#### **Three Steps Toward Protecting Young Ears**

(NAPS)—According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as many as 16 percent of teens have reported hearing loss possibly caused by loud noisebut you can reduce the risk for the kids you care about.

The Problem

Many young people get summer or afterschool jobs that involve farm work, construction, landscaping or theme parks, all of which can damage hearing. Prolonged exposure to high-noise volumes or even short exposures to high-level impulse sound can damage sensitive structures in the inner ear and cause noise-induced hearing loss and/or ringing in the ears.

#### Some Solutions

"Young employees may need guidance to be safe from hazardous noise," said Dr. Laurie Wells, audiologist, and senior acoustics regulatory affairs specialist for 3M. Here's how:

Step 1: Recognize the lazard. Too few children



#### The louder the noise, the less time a person can safely listen to it before risking hearing damage.

Employers are obliged to provide appropriate hearing protection to workers in hazardous noise environments.

Inexpensive foam earplugs can actually provide the most noise reduction and be the most comfortable if fit and used correctly. Specially designed hearing protectors such as those containing electronics are available for unique environments. Even some ear-muffs use wireless signal transmission that lets workers enjoy a personal listening device or use a mobile phone while maintaining protection from noise. Regardless of which option employers or individuals choose, using hearing protection sometimes requires practice for maximum benefit and comfort.



and parents realize the hazards of excessive noise, perhaps because school programs don't typically cover hearing health. The risk is real and increases depending on the combination of the sound level and the duration of exposure. A general guideline is: If you have to shout for someone to hear you at arm's length, the sound could be hazardous.

Step 2: Take Action. Fortunately, young workers can reduce the negative effects of noise exposure. When possible, reduce the noise at its source. This can be as easy as turning down the volume, keeping equipment regularly maintained or using a quieter tool in place of a louder one. Secondly, move away from the noise when you can.

If this isn't feasible, use hearing protection devices.

#### Step 3: Know Your Rights.

Young workers should expect a choice of suitable hearing protectors, provided at no cost to them, and to be trained in their proper use.

Being aware of noise sources, having appropriately selected and fitted protective devices, and using them correctly will help preserve a young person's hearing for many years to come.

imately an hour and a half, so make sure to plan your meals and pack accordingly. For charcoal grills, you'll need about 50 briquettes to fuel a standard stand-up charcoal kettle-so plan to use 30 briquettes each time you grill for a compact model, like a Smokey Joe.

• Safety First. Always make sure you are grilling on stable, flat ground and are at least five feet away from anything flammable.

• Use Your Head. Make sure you extinguish your grill properly. Your grill should be cool to the touch before you dispose of spent charcoal ashes. Check with your campground to locate the proper place to dump ashes. Store your LP tank in the car in a secure upright position when not in use.

• Stay Grounded, but Reach for the Stars. "There's almost no limits on what you can grill outdoors vs. indoors," says Kolman. "With camping, I would recommend looking for recipes that are a little more portable, have fewer ingredients and are easy to clean up." Don't Forget To Replace Your Vehicle's Brake Hardware

(NAPS)—Brakes are a critical component for maintaining vehicle safety. Whether it's trying to stop your vehicle on an icy, snowpacked road or slowing down on a rain-soaked highway, properly functioning brakes are key to maintaining control of the vehicle.

However, brake wear can compromise vehicle performance and, ultimately, threaten vehicle safety. AAA encourages motorists to have a certified technician inspect their brakes to ensure they are ready for whatever Mother Nature has to offer.

In an article featured on theautochannel.com, John Nielsen, director, AAA Auto Repair and Buying Services, noted that there are several warning signs that motorists should closely monitor to identify and resolve brake wear before it can impact vehicle safety.

"Often, the first sign of worn brakes is a brake pedal that seems to require more pressure to stop the vehicle. Scraping, squeaking or chirpng noises that come from the wheels when the brakes are applied are other signs of potentially excessive brake wear. A car that pulls to the eft or right when the brakes are applied could also mean rouble," Nielsen said.

He further advises con-

He added that, like most mechanical parts, brake hardware will wear out over time and can't function if the parts are corroded or stretched. If brake hardware is worn, it can even cause newly installed brake pads to wear out prematurely, reducing the life span of the pads and shoes.

Brake hardware—including clips, bolts, rubber bushings, rubber seals and springs—is integral to the proper operation of the vehicle's entire braking system.

"It's very common for drivers to leave an auto repair shop with newly replaced pads and shoes, but still experience brake noise because their brake hardware was not replaced," Miller said. "We have a simple message for consumers: For a few extra dollars, you can protect your investment in brake pads and shoes and ensure optimum performance by also replacing your vehicle's brake hardware."





6 Tips for Better Grilled Chicken

• Grease your grill: Chances are you won't have a sticking problem if your chicken has skin, or if it's marinated or rubbed with some oil. But play it safe. Before you light the grill, spray the rack with nonstick cooking spray or brush it with oil or brush it with oil

• Close the top: If your grill has a cover, always cook your chicken with cover, always cook your cincken with the cover down. It will make your grill more ovenlike, and your food will cook more evenly. Also, because the cover cuts off some of the oxygen,

you'll have fewer flare-ups.Be patient: Resist the urge to con-Be patient: Resist the urge to con-tinuously move the chicken around while it cooks. The chicken will cook more evenly (and more quickly!) if you follow the recipe cooking instruc-tions or turn it over only once, mid-way through grilling.

 Test for Doneness: Don't risk serving undercooked chicken. When in doubt, make a small cut into the thickest part so you can be positive that it's no longer pink inside. You also can use a meat thermometer to also can use a meat thermometer to check if your meat has reached a safe internal temperature: 180 F for whole chicken and 170 F for breasts. • Be sure to clean up: Scrape your grill rack after each use; otherwise,

shock, seizures, coma and death. A person who burns about 2,000 calories should get about 8-12 cups of fluid per day. Your fluid intake doesn't have to come just from water. Many foods contain a high percentage of water, and that counts as part of the 8-12 cups of needed fluid. Celery, cucumber, lettuce, summer squash and watermelon are up to 95 percent water. Grapefruit, strawberries, broccoli and tomato are 90 percent to 94 percent water, and milk, yogurt, egg whites, fruit juices, apples and carrots are 80 percent to 89 percent water.

The thirst mechanism can become weak in senior citizens or may be ignored by young children, so they may need to be monitored to assure they drink enough fluids. A good gauge of hydration is urine color.



Watermelon juice contains 92 percent water and 8 percent natural fructose sugar. The flesh and especially the rind are rich sources of citrulline, an amino acid. Citrulline is used to make another amino acid, arginine, which is responsible for removing ammonia from the body and regulating vascular tone and healthy blood pressure. Watermelon also contains a number of other essential vitamins, especially vitamins A and C, as well as the essential mineral potassium.

#### WATERMELON AQUA FRESCA

"Aqua fresca" is Spanish for "fresh water." It is a popular drink in Mexico and the Southwestern United States

every cell and helps protect some body tissues. Water aids in the transport of nutrients and promotes the elimination of waste. According to the book "Nutrition Concepts and Controversies" by Frances Sizer and Eleanor Whitney, by the time you

become thirsty, you already may have lost 2 percent of your body fluid. Mild dehydration is when you have lost 2 percent to 5 percent of your body fluids. Symptoms of mild dehydration include thirst, dry mouth and throat, rapid pulse, low blood pressure, weakness or lack of energy, and reduced quantity of urine. When there is a fluid loss of more than 5 percent, the body has severe reactions, which include pale skin; bluish fingertips and lips; rapid, shallow breathing; weak, irregular pulse; and confusion or disorientation. It can result in

Dark-colored urine indicates a need for more fluids.

After exercising, it's important to replenish depleted fluids, electrolytes and glucose. Almost everything you need to refuel can be found in a serving of 4 cups of juicy, delicious watermelon.





#### Woman Is Fit, Yet Can Barely Stand

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 66-year-old white female, 5 feet, 5 inches tall (was 5 feet, 6 inches), weighing 170 pounds. Even though I use gym weight machines for upper and lower body three times a week, walk daily for two miles and spend 15 minutes on a motion trainer at the gym, I cannot stand up easily after gardening on my knees or getting on my knees on the floor. Is there anything I can do to regain the ability to get up off the floor/ground without a struggle? — S.C.


in the past week, the pain has diminished, but the bulging vein is still present, albeit less tender. Should I have this removed surgically, or will it eventually disappear? — S.D.

ANSWER: A hemorrhoid, a normal vascular structure, can develop a blood clot ("thrombosis"), and then can be exquisitely painful. Often, the clot is removed at the time of examination, giving immediate relief. In most cases, the clot will be reabsorbed within a few days. However, in very large hemorrhoids, occasionally surgery is necessary.

There is some suggestion that thrombosed hemorrhoids may indicate a higher risk for colorectal cancer. You should be sure that you have had a recent colonoscopy.

DEAR DR. ROACH: A few years ago, my granddaughter, who was raised in Costa Rica, got Dengue fever. I heard that if you get it a second time, it can be fatal. Is this justified? I am worried about her going back to Costa Rica for holidays.

Is there a vaccination or specific treatment? — A.R.B. ANSWER: Dengue fever is common, but people who live in areas with Dengue are at much higher risk than travelers. The worst complication of Dengue, called Dengue hemorrhagic fever, happens in people who previously have had an episode of Dengue so the concern for your granddaughter is justified. There is no commercially available vaccine for Dengue (yet), and no specific treatment. The most effective prevention for travelers is avoiding mosquitos by staying in well-screened or air-conditioned buildings, wearing protective clothing and using effective mosquito repellant.

ANSWER: It sounds to me that despite your good exercise regimen, you may have weakness specifically in your thighs - what we call "proximal muscle weakness." There is a very long list of medical illnesses that affect these muscles specifically (my textbook lists 28 different diagnoses), including common conditions such as low thyroid levels and vitamin D deficiency. I would recommend a visit to your doctor for a careful exam of your nerves and muscles to see if my suspicion is correct. Your doctor may suggest a trial of vitamin D.

If no medical cause is found, I would work specifically on strengthening the hip muscles, which extend the thighs. A trainer at the gym can show you those exercises.

DEAR DR ROACH: I am a 65-year-old man, and two weeks ago I developed a painful hemorrhoid almost overnight. I had never had hemorrhoids before.

My primary-care doctor examined me and said I had a "thrombosed hemorrhoid." It is not very large and

#### PICKS OF THE WEEK

Far From the Madding Crowd - Bathesheba Everdene (PG-13) (Carey Mulligan) has a rare opportunity for women of her time — she has enough wealth that she doesn't have to marry for business reasons. She can pick any man she wants, which isn't as easy as it sounds. She's got three very different men on the line, but for each one, there are complexities to the relationship

An adaptation of a romantic and melodramatic English novel hardly seems like the place to look for takes on contemporary love, but in the hands of director Thomas Vinterberg, the country comes to life and the lovequadrangle stays engaging. Carey Mulligan once again shows how she can keep audiences invested in what's going on behind her eyes.

The Salvation (R) - Jon (Mads Mikkelsen, TV's "Hannibal"), a Danish veteran, takes his family to the Wild West to make a new start, but their bright future is robbed by a pair of drunk dirtbags who murder his wife and son. Jon gets revenge on the brutes, but raises the ire of the local boss (Jeffrey Dean Morgan). Jon is hunted by outlaws and commoners alike, but refuses to back down to the evils of the frontier.

This is a hard-nosed Western shoot'em-up with a strong connection to its Spaghetti Western roots. The hero is as stoic as stone, and the boss is as twisted as the devil. It's not blazing a new trail in Western cinema. but it's good for a night of cowboy commotion.

A Little Chaos (R) — In the opulent gardens of King Louis XIV's palace at Versailles, there works a surprisingly modern touch. Sabine (Kate Winslet) is a single garden designer who lost her only child. She's completely



out of place in the elegant palace full

of powdered pandering aristocrats.

As a commoner, her romance with her superior is totally forbidden, but in a time of symmetrical and formal

design, Sabine believes in employing "a little chaos" in her landscapes. It's


