



AN OPEN LETTER TO THE RESIDENTS OF ORLEANS COUNTY FROM YOUR HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT'S **ASSOCIATION**

For your safety and well being during inclement weather, you should reduce your speed and drive according to the highway conditions. Winter driving conditions with icy and snow covered roads require more driving care.

If your vehicle becomes stranded, contact the Orleans County Sheriff's Department at 589-5527 and they will notify the appropriate Highway Department.

SNOW REMOVAL

The law regarding the depositing of snow on highways, shoulders is as follows:

"Section 1219 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and Section 214 of the Highway Law of New York State specifically prohibit the placing or leaving of snow, ice or other substance upon any highway (which includes pavement, shoulders and ditches).

As a result, should these practices occur, Police Agencies will be notified of such occurrence(s) with the intent that summonses will be issued to the responsible person or persons.

MAILBOXES

Mailboxes damaged during snow removal:

During and after significant snow storms, Highway Agencies, in the course of plowing, receive phone calls regarding damage to mailboxes, either from snow plows directly or from the force of snow being thrown by the plows. If such damage is indeed caused by snow removal, it is not done intentionally but is an unfortunate consequence of snow removal.

As far as the particular agencies replacing damaged mailboxes, it must be pointed out that there is no statutory or legal authority which grants a property owner or resident along a public highway any right to place a mailbox in a highway right-of-way.


That the mailbox is on town or county right of way as courtesy

Thus, when the necessity of keeping highway open conflicts with the individuals reception of the mail, the latter must stand aside. The owner might even be compelled to remove the box under Highway law #319.

From past experience, we have found that plastic mail boxes do not withstand the abuse of snow from the plows hitting them and are not recommended.

As a courtesy, the Highway Department will place a temporary box so that a resident can receive mail if their box is damaged by the plow but we will not replace any fancy mailbox or post.

Mailbox posts with fancy supports are not recommended as they stick down under the box and give the wing plow something to get hold of. A box mounted directly on top of a treated 4 x 4 is the best. Please note illustrations.

MEDINA K9 UNIT VISITS WITH SECURITY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT CLASSES

Medina Police Department Lieutenant Todd Draper and his K9 partner, Kye, recently stopped in to the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center. The purpose of his visit was to spend time with the Security and Law Enforcement students in Steve Browning's and Dudley Gilbert's classes.

Lieutenant Draper talked to the students about what it is like to work with his K9 partner, who is a Belgian Malinois, and the bond he has with him. "I have had Kye since he was 1 year old when the police department brought him over from Holland. He is 7 years old now and not only do we work together, we live together. "He told the classes that when he was offered his promotion to lieutenant he would not accept it if Kye was not part of the package. Luckily the Medina Police Department honored his request. "When he is ready to retire, I am hoping the department lets me purchase him. The usual deal is that for a dollar they will transfer ownership to me."

Belgian Malinois are used as a working dog whose tasks include detection of odors such as explosives, accelerants and narcotics, tracking humans and search and rescue mission. "This is the breed the Seals used when they went after Osama Bin Laden," Lieutenant Draper told the students. He said Kye is trained for narcotics detection and he uses positive reinforcement to keep him on task. "He has a toy that smells like drugs, so in actuality he is looking for his toy when we are out searching. When he finds drugs I reward him for his work." He told the students that you never cross train a police dog because when he finds something, you don't know what he is detecting. He also said that they work with other states to get drugs for the K9 to smell and get accustomed to. "Drugs are made differently in each area, so it is helpful to expose the dogs to different narcotics." He and Kye gave a demonstration on how he locates drugs and how he is used to takedown a suspect, with Mr. Browning volunteering in that role.

He says that Kye's heightened abilities prove to be a great asset to law enforcement work. "He has a great sense of smell which is about 1000 times stronger than ours and great vision. He is also very athletic. He can jump over a six foot wall." Lieutenant Draper says that Kye is also very social and a great draw to getting the community to interact with him. "Usually when I am walking through an event alone, I won't get a lot of eye contact or people talking to me. When I have Kye with me everyone comes up to us and wants to pet him and interact with us. He is a great public relations tool," he laughs. "I really could not ask for a better or more loyal partner."





· Embrace the positive. Avoid Charity Scams

Nonprofit organizations and charities do extensive work to help people and fulfill their missions.


When commercials, emails or direct mail pamphlets tug at the heartstrings, it's understandable to want to help as quickly as possible. But just as there are scores of legitimate organizations banking on the generosity of willing donors, so, too, are there scam artists hoping to exploit that generosity. These crooks not only prey on innocent donors, they indirectly steal from people affected by disasters poaching donations meant for relief organizations.

The American Grandparents Organization says Americans donate upwards of \$300 billion to charities each year. These include wellknown and well-established charitable groups and crowdfunding sites like GoFundMe. Statistics Canada says Canadians make roughly \$11 billion in charitable donations each year.

While the majority of donations end up in the right hands, charity scammers still manage to victimize unsuspecting individuals. Follow these tips to make sure hard-earned money is going to reputable groups and not to criminals preying on your generosity.

- Start by doing research. Charity Watch and Charity Navigator, each of which is recommended by the Federal Trade Commission, have carefully researched many different charities. This can be the first stop in verifying the legitimacy of a particular charity. Check for a charity's registration number and see if it's registered on the Better Business Bureau website at www.bbb.org/us/charity.
- Don't give to cold calls or emails. It's best to take your time with charitable requests and confirm their authenticity. This may require visiting the website of a particular group or contacting them directly to see how you can help. You never know who is on the end of a phone call or who sent an email soliciting donations. What's more, according to Charity Navigator, cold calls are usually conducted by for-profit telemarketers that have contracted with charities. These contracts are not favorable to the charities - with up to 95 cents of every donated dollar going to the telemarketers.
- Don't give cash donations. Cash is difficult to trace, making it a preferred method of donation collection among scam artists. If a charity is insisting on cash or wants you to make a decision immediately, this should raise red flags.
- · Protect your privacy. Only work with charities that respect your privacy and will not sell your name or information to other groups.
- Request information. Reputable charities will tell you how they will spend your money and if your gift is tax-deductible.
- Be aware of sound-alike groups. Some scam artists create soundalike organizations to trick donors. In such instances, donors believe they are donating to legitimate charities but are really giving to another organization. In 2016, the Federal Trade Commission brought charges against four sound-alike cancer groups, highlighting just how prevalent such faulty organizations are.

Charity scams are prevalent. But by being diligent about researching and gaining information, donors can avoid parting with their money unnecessarily.



Enjoy a Fun New Year's Eve Out on the Town

New Year's Eve is traditionally a night to go out on the town to celebrate with family and friends. Such celebrations tend to be rowdy, as millions of people across the globe say so long to one year while welcoming in the next.

Designated drivers, cabbies or ridesharing services prevent potentially impaired celebrants from getting behind the wheel.

Chocolate-Strawberry Pie

Yields 1 pie

1 pint fresh strawberries, washed, trimmed and halved

1 store-bought (or homemade) chocolate cookie pie crust

2/3 cup sugar

1/4 cup cornstarch

2 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder

1/4 teaspoon minced crystallized ginger

1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg

Pinch of kosher or sea salt

6 large egg yolks

21/2 cups half-and-half

6 ounces bittersweet or semisweet chocolate, chopped

1/2 tablespoon rum extract

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Additional strawberries for garnish (optional)

- 1. Place the strawberry halves in a single layer in the bottom of the pie crust.
- 2. In a medium saucepan, whisk together the sugar, cornstarch, cocoa powder, ginger, nutmeg, and salt over medium heat.
- 3. Whisk in the egg yolks to create a thick paste. Gradually whisk in the half-and-half until the mixture thickens, about 5 minutes. Bring to a boil and cook for 1 minute. Remove from the heat.
- 4. Add the chocolate and whisk until combined. Add the rum and vanilla extracts. Cool the mixture for 4 minutes.
- 5. Pour the filling over the strawberries and up to the top of the crust. Chill the pie for 2 hours or until set.
- 6. Garnish with additional strawberries, if desired.
