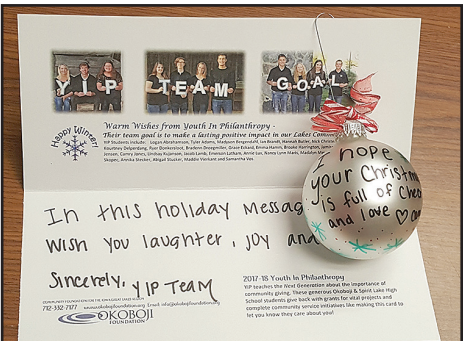

On January 1, 2018, Milford Communications' contracts with local broadcast providers (ABC, CBS, NBC and FOX) are up for renewal. These rates change every year. The local broadcast providers have indicated that they intend to dramatically raise the fees they charge Milford to carry their station on our channel lineup; the **increase could be as much as 40-60% higher!** Milford does not keep or profit from these fees, they are sent directly back to the broadcasters.

This holiday week will see John Senn & Friends performing at the Okoboji Barn Wednesday night from 7 - 9:00, with *The Itty Bitty Boji Band* taking the same stage on the first Wednesday of the New Year... **Thursday night will have The South 71 Trio** at the Little Swan Lake Winery from 6 - 8:00; while Ryan Sather, Dave Rowley, Adam Layman and *Storm Rising* -- with the possibility of even more entertainers to ring in the New Year -- on the stage in the barn, starting at 8:00, Sunday night... **Iowa's longest-running Rock 'n' Roll Band, The Senders**, will bring its 55th year to a close on New Year's Eve and start its 56th year at the Dickinson County Expo Center. The music at the Expo Center also begins at 8:00 Sunday night, with the doors opening "much earlier"...

Research director RD is enamored by the winter weather — or at least by winter music. The song, *I Love The Winter Weather*, written by pianist, composer, and publisher Ted Shapiro in 1941, is one of her favs. ...*Winter Weather* saw its most popular recording made by Jo Stafford in 1955. **While it doesn't relate just to winter**, RD ties one of the multi-talented Steve Allen's most popular set of lyrics to the first of the year. *Moonglow*, which was part of the theme song from the motion picture *Picnic*, was recorded by *Morris Stoloff* and the *Columbia Pictures Orchestra* in 1956 and is an appropriate way to celebrate the New Year and its full moon. Allen was born December 26, 1921... **We're hoping that instead of real snow**, Wednesday is simply Make Cut-Out Snowflakes Day. That said, we'd be happy to just listen to Sammy Cahn and Jules Stein's *Let It Snow, Let It Snow, Let It Snow*; or Irving Berlin's *Snow*, as recorded several times by Rosemary Clooney...

The song Warm in December, was written by Bob Russell and released most recently by Seth MacFarlane on his 2014 holiday album — which was actually recorded in the last week of December in 2013! It was also a part of Julie London's 1956 *Calendar Girl* LP. Going back even further for warmth, RD came up with *I've Got My Love To Keep Me Warm*, another of the great Irving Berlin songs — one he introduced in the 1937 musical motion picture *On the Avenue*, with later versions by *The Mills Brothers* (1949), *Dean Martin* (1959), and *Tony Bennett* (1968). **It was on December 29th, 100 years ago this week**, that a record low temperature of 40 degrees below zero was experienced by the residents of not-too-distant Washta, Iowa. (Being a 'Minnesnowtan', RD had to look that one up on a map!) The day could be commemorated with Frank Loesser's *Baby, It's Cold Outside*, which has seen a variety of duos record it, including *Ella Fitzgerald* and *Louis Jordan* (1949), *Ray Charles* and *Betty Carter* (1961), and *Michael Bublé* with *Idina Menzel* (2014)...

Saturday should be a great day to stay inside and toast marshmallows over a cozy fireplace. Carl Sigman and Peter DeRose wrote *Marshmallow World* in 1949, when it was first recorded by Bing Crosby, then later by *Johnny Mathis* (1963), *Dean Martin* (1966) and others... **The New Year's Eve song** has to be *What Are You Doing New Year's Eve?*, written by Frank Loesser in 1947. You'll find many renditions on *YouTube*... **New Year's Day would bring music** from Irving Berlin's *Holiday Inn*, and Bing Crosby singing *Let's Start The New Year Right*.

Gitchie Girl stark, uplifting

It isn't very often that a book grips you and throws you up against the wall yet leaves you feeling uplifted at the end.

Gitchie Girl, a nonfiction account of a November 17, 1973 horrific mass murder in a rural Northwest Iowa park near Sioux Falls, South Dakota, does just that.

The book by Phil Hamman and Sandy Hamman of Sioux City is written through the eyes of Sandra Cheskey, a 13-year-old girl of part Cheyenne River Sioux ancestry whose life would never be the same after one terrible night. Sandra was along when her boyfriend, Roger Essem, was murdered along with Mike Hadrath and Stewart and Dana Baade by three brothers - Allen, David and James Fryer, the latter who later that same night assaulted Sandra at an abandoned Sioux Falls-area farm.

If all that were not enough, upon reporting the crime Sandra was fingerprinted since she was suspected of knowing more about the murders than she had admitted. Few of the police who interviewed her believed that four boys would be brutally murdered while Sandra, the only witness, would be dropped off by one of the killers at her rural Tea, S.D., home.

Even after the year-long trial was over, Sandra's girlfriends' parents kept them from seeing her.

"Most of the mothers of her former friends no longer allowed their daughters to keep company with the tainted 'Gitchie Girl,' as if the violence that had been perpetrated against Sandra somehow made her a disreputable person."

The Hammans tell Sandra's story compellingly yet compassionately, offering the perspectives of both the horrors Sandra experienced that night alongside the diligent and thorough investigation by Craig Vinson, a small-town county sheriff who believed Sandra's story and rose to the big-city challenge of helping her find the killers and put them away for life.

Perhaps most importantly, the Hammans tell how Sandra found solace through a comfort dog, God and her Native American religion.

Gitchie Girl is a great read not only for anyone who remembers those horrific murders over 44 years ago. It's also a gripping story of how a 13-year-old girl helped solve a crime that rocked the heartland. It's also a survivor's story of how Sandra took the once-onerous title "Gitchie Girl" and wore it as a mantle of endurance and inspiration.
