Notice is hereby given that I, Cheyenne N. DeMarco, the undersigned Collector of Taxes in and for the Town of Nunda, have received the tax rolls and warrant for the collection of taxes for 2018.

In person payments can be made at 4 Massachusetts St, Nunda Government Center, Nunda, NY 14517. Collection hours are as follows:

January - March collection hours: Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m./1:30p.m. to 4:30 p.m.; Thursdays from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Mailed payments shall be sent to PO Box 699, Nunda, NY 14517.

No penalty if postmarked by January 31, 2018; On all taxes received after such date there shall be a 1% penalty for postmark on or before February 28, 2018; 2% penalty, for postmark on or before March 31, 2018.

Pursuant to Section 987 of the Real Property Tax Law, a delinquent notice will be mailed on or after the thirty-first day following the expiration of the period of interest-free payment of taxes. The law mandates that the expense of mailing such notice shall be an additional two dollars (\$2) against the parcel.

Further Notice that pursuant to the provisions of law the tax roll any payments in person or postmarked after March 31, 2018 are payable to County Treasurer plus 5% and \$2.00 and will be returned to the County Treasurer of the County of Livingston on the 1st day of April 2018.

Winter Activities at Letchworth

Winter is here so let your outdoor fun begin in Letchworth State Park. A variety of activities, programs and family oriented adventures provide great options to stay busy in the great winter wonderland outside your front door.

First Day Hikes on January 1st encourage you to start the year off right with an active and informative day of hiking. Four guided hikes are planned through the season: One designed especially for families with young children; a Winter Wander to Ponds hike; an exotic tree hike and a Great Bend Gorge hike. All hikes begin at The Humphrey Nature Center with a 12:30 PM registration. Participants receive a state parks souvenir on a first-come, first-serve basis. Refreshments are served following each hike.

The Genesee Valley Greenway State Park also offers three different hikes along the Greenway including starting points in Belfast, Mount Morris and Scottsville. A new addition to the First Day Hikes is that all participants can enter to win an Annual Empire State Parks Pass for 2018.







March 3rd STEVE CLARKE **TECHNICAL GENIUS IN THE HOLLY FAMILY: Engineers and Inventors** Genealogist

Follow the story of descendants of the Rev. Sylvanus Holly, who in 1816, began part of a typical late-19th Century American migration from New York State towards the Midwest. Through generations, the Holly family's work made major contributions to modern fire-fighting and hydraulic engineering.
