


### COLORING FOR ADULTS AT HOPE LIBRARY

- On Jan. 9, 1776, writer Thomas Paine publishes his pamphlet "Common Sense," setting forth his arguments in favor of American independence. Pamphlets were an important medium for the spread of ideas in the 16th through 19th centuries.
- On Jan. 12, 1926, the two-man comedy series "Sam 'n' Henry" debuts on Chicago's WGN radio station. Two years later, after changing its name to "Amos 'n' Andy," it became one of the most popular radio programs in American history.
- On Jan. 11, 1935, American aviatrix Amelia Earhart departs Wheeler Field in Honolulu on a solo flight to North America. Hawaiian commercial interests had offered a \$10,000 award to whoever first accomplished the flight. The next day, after traveling 2,400 miles in 18 hours, Earhart landed safely in Oakland, California.
- On Jan. 10, 1941, President Franklin Roosevelt introduces the lend-lease program to Congress to help Britain beat back Hitler's advance while keep ing America only indirectly involved in World War II. By the end of the war, more than \$50 billion in funds, weapons, aircraft and ships had been distributed to 44 countries.
- · On Jan. 8, 1962, at the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C., Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece, the Mona Lisa, is exhibited for the first time in America.
- On Jan. 14, 1973, the Miami Dolphins defeat the Washington Redskins 14-7 at the Los Angeles Coliseum in Super Bowl VII, becoming the first team in NFL history to finish with an undefeated season.
- On Jan. 13, 1982, an Air Florida Boeing 727 plunges into the Potomac River in Washington, D.C., killing 78 people. The crash, caused by bad weather, took place only 2 miles from the White House. Investigators said the plane had to wait too long after being de-iced before it could take off, allowing new ice to accumulate on the wings.



### The Spirit of Giving

This year proved to be an especially challenging one for pets. From dev-astating hurricanes in Texas, Florida, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands to the ongoing wildfires in California, dogs and cats and other house pets in these areas have faced sudden stressful evacuations, or even been abandoned as their owners rushed to leave

Shelters across the country have responded by opening their doors to influxes of shelter animals moved from disaster areas, which made room for evacuee pets. While they've done a fantastic job of getting abandoned and stray animals into safe shelters the increase in activity has been quite a challenge for many.

This holiday season is a great time to consider donating to or helping a pet-care organization. Whether it's a national pet rescue group like the Humane Society, or the shelter down the street, consider giving something Every nonprofit could use cash, but if you can't spare it, check out the websites of local or regional pet-care groups or shelters for a list of items that they need. For example, some shelters need clean, gently used blan-kets for new arrivals.

You also can look into local volunteer opportunities. These vary widely depending on the shelter's current needs, and some opportunities are limited to those over 18. Contact shelters directly to get up-to-date info on what they need. Either way, you can make a big difference to a lot of pets waiting for new homes.





#### You've Got to Have a Team First

Legend has it that Herb Brooks, America's "Miracle" hockey coach, once said, "All-Star teams don't win." It's hard to argue with Mr. Brooks,

may he rest in peace. But of course, what he generally espoused isn't always the case. Plenty of teams, in all sports, have fielded a group of "all of them are stars," and of course, they've won. Somebody's got to win. of dissecting sports is that conviction and chemistry are what matters most. Seth Davis' tour-de-force about John Wooden, "A Coach's Life," brims with that senti-ment. If you ever read the book, keep a pad and pen handy because almost every other page features a remark

that is worth repeating.

I'm reminded of this because of the Giancarlo Stanton trade to the New York Yankees. The Yankees are, once again, an all-star team. I know it sometimes gets tiresome to talk about them, but you have to admit, the team does have a penchant for the team does have a penchant for making headlines. Stanton's statistics show that he

the Yankees back at the top of the baseball world. This was a team that was only a few outs from being in the World Series last season. Now, in addition to Aaron Judge, a mod-ern-day Mickey Mantle, they've added a guy that gets a hit 25 percent of the time he steps up to the plate, and more than 25 percent of those hits are out of the park ... waaaay out of the park.

of the park.

But does that mean the Yankees will actually win? Not necessarily. For whatever reason, the Yankees decided to dump Joe Girardi for Aaron Boone, a Yankee legend, yes, but a rookie manager. Perhaps the brass of the Yankees saw something that couldn't be denied in Boone, but it should seem that the team might want to bring in a Joe Torre type ... want to bring in a Joe Torre type ... someone like, say, Joe Torre ... to navigate this young club.

The reason for the season is to see

how things shape up. We can tell how things will go pretty much from the start. Can these amassed talents congeal into a winner? Page 220 of "A Coaches Life" would seem to hold

the answer.

When asked about the best team in when asked about the best team in the collegiate world in the early '60s, the national coach of Yugoslavia, Aleksander Nikolic, told writers that Wooden's UCLA team was the best. Writers scoffed at this. The team seemed in turmoil, fighting each other for the ball and lacking a big man.



#### Sewing Bird

Sewing was an important part of the life of a woman during the 17th and 18th centuries. There was no sewing machine; everything was hand-stitched. Iron "grippers" sometimes were used to hold one end of the fabric while it was hemmed or embroidered. An improvement, the first "sewing bird," was invented by Charles Waterman in 1853. It was made of brass, iron or, later, steel. The tool was clamped to a table and the bird held the fabric taut. It acted like an extra hand.

Improvements were added to this sewing tool, including emery balls to sharpen needles, spool holders, drawers, winding reels for thread, pincushions, thread cutters and clamps made in fancy shapes like dogs, snakes, cherubs or dolphins. Variations of the sewing tool continued to be made by Singer Sewing Machine Co. until the 1980s. The sewing machine was invented in 1854, but it took many years to sell enough machines so that the sewing bird was no longer necessary. Copies are made today mainly for collectors or as decorations.

Early sewing birds sometimes were given as love tokens. The groom-to-be gave a sewing bird to his future bride long before the wedding so she would think of him while she sewed her trousseau. An elaborate 18th-century sewing bird made of brass and iron sold at a Skinner auction in 2016 for \$1,046. It had a feathered bird and a pincushion.

**Avoid Surprise, Winterize** 

(NAPS)—As the weather gets colder, winterizing your vehicle should be a top priority. The nonprofit Car Care Council recommends that motorists perform a six-point winter maintenance check of areas that are particularly affected by driving in rough weather.

"A vehicle that's properly prepared for the elements can help you avoid an unplanned road emer-gency when the weather takes a sudden turn for the worse."

Six-Point Vehicle Check

1 Battery—Cold weather is hard

Six-Point Vehicle Check

1. Battery—Cold weather is hard on batteries, so it's wise to check the battery and charging system for optimum performance. Because batteries don't always give warning signs before they fail, it's advisable to replace batteries that are more than three years old

2. Antifreeze-Antifreeze (coolant) should be flushed and refilled at least every two years in most vehicles. Don't add 100 percent antifreeze, however. Surprisingly, full-strength antifreeze actually has a lower freeze point than when mixed with water.

3. Brakes—Have the brake system checked. Brakes are critical to vehicle

checked. Brakes are critical to vehicle safety and particularly important on icy or snow-covered roads.

4. Tires—Check the tire tread depth and tire pressure, including the spare. If you'll be driving where snow and ice

are a problem, consider special tires designed to grip slick roads. Check tire pressure weekly, as tires lose pressure when temperatures drop.

5.0il—Be diligent about changing the oil at recommended intervals and check the fuel, air and transmission filters at the same time. Consider changing ters at the same time. Consider changing to low-viscosity oil in winter, as it will flow more easily between moving parts when cold. In subzero driving tempera-tures, drop oil weight from 10W-30 to

5W-30 as thickened oil can make it hard

6. Lights and Wipers—Make sure all exterior and interior lights are work-ing so you can see and be seen. Check the fluid level in the windshield washer reservoir and replace wiper blades that are torn, cracked or don't properly clean your windshield

In addition, the council recom-mends a thorough vehicle inspection by a trusted professional service technician as winter magnifies existing problems such as pings, hard starts, sluggish per-

or rough idling.

Drivers should keep their vehicle's gas tank at least half-full to decrease the chances of moisture forming in the gas lines and possib'y freezing and stock an emergency kit with an ice scraper and spow brush immore cables flashlight snow brush, jumper cables, flashlight, blanket, extra clothes, bottled water, dry
