

WHAT IS HAPPENING WITH MUSKRATS?

I started trapping at a very early age with rabbits, but soon went after raccoon, skunks and of course muskrats. I even got pretty good at fox trapping, but muskrats and coon were the big thing back then. Catching a mink was more of an accident as there just didn't seem to be many

around. When I came home from the service, fur prices were pretty good and I got back into it. I trapped a few marshes, but did most of my trapping along creeks and the canal in the Pendleton area. Except for winter trapping. Under the ice I did most of my 'rat trapping by boat. One year I took vacation time and trapped a 10-mile stretch of the Oswegatchie River around Ogdensburg on the St. Lawrence River. I would run a 10-mile strip up river one day, camp in a tent that night at the end of the line and then go back down to the original starting point, checking the traps again the next day. The following day was spent in a friend's basement, where the catch was skinned and put on fur stretchers. Then the next two days were spent out on the line again. I caught fox, coon, a few mink, but my main catch was of course muskrats as there were plenty of them.

The 'rat populations started dropping in the 1980s and have never recovered not only around NYS, but all over, and everyone seems to be at a loss as to why that has happened. I no longer trap, but I do a lot of nature photography. I always have gotten a lot of muskrat pictures in the spring around our swamp areas, but for the last few years I rarely see one. Sure the trappers catch a lot, but they did before and that was okay because the muskrat is a very good breeder having two to four litters a year, usually breed their first year and have four to eight young per litter. Actually there are fewer trappers now because the fur market is very low so that is not the problem.

I seem to be seeing more mink now than ever before, so maybe the mink are eating them all. No, I think the mink are just more plentiful now because they are difficult to trap and their fur value is way down and no one targets them much anymore. They are more visible now too because of the low 'rat populations and thus are traveling more to search for other food sources. Mink will hunt anything from mice to rabbits and they are very good at it. Besides waterways they will also hunt in the woods and often far from waterways.

So what is the problem? Well, there is a furbearer biologist in Pennsylvania who may have something and it is related to habitat. Isn't that what wildlife populations always depend on? His thought is that environmental reform may be causing a habitat change for the muskrat; that our efforts to increase oxygen in our waters, stabilize stream banks and improve biodiversity maybe be the root of some of the problem. For example, keeping manure out of farm creeks also removes the nutrients that promote the vegetative cover and food muskrats depend on. So because the 'rat has basically a limited type habitat he can be very effected by those habitat changes. By being just the opposite of a muskrat, a mink has a very large variable habitat and so is not affected as strongly by habitat changes.

Something else has crossed my mind; what part has the invasive non-native vegetative species been having on this habitat change? Our wetlands have been slowly getting choke up with these species. Phragmites, for example, that take away food and cover from the muskrat. It is now gotten to be a big problem in the marshes and those in charge of managing them have only recently began to address that problem. Purple loosestrife is another one that is causing problems in the marshes. In fact, we have a large list of non-native invasive species that are slowly destroying what muskrats need. To the casual observer the marshes look fine, but they don't notice things like the flowering rush, water hyacinth or other invasive species taking hold. However, the wildlife that depends on the native vegetation does and maybe that is why muskrat populations have been going down hill.

Water-level control is also a big issue with muskrats. If water levels are not kept high enough cover and food is lost not only to the 'rats but also to waterfowl and with sparse cover both are highly susceptible to predators.

So will the muskrat disappear or become rare in our waterways? No, they will probably always be around, but unless we soon figure out what is going on and get it corrected they will never return to the numbers that our marshes originally supported. Lost of a healthy 'rat population could have other long-term effects on other wildlife and vegetation in our marshes that we are not yet completely aware of.

I wonder as our world gets smaller and we "improve" on things how much longer will it last. Will there be muskrats to draw the young trapper to the marshes where he or she will learn so much more than what books and colleges can teach about the wonders of nature?





LOST STREAM MAP

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map-known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under Iock and key.





What is Primary Mortgage Insurance?

Primary mortgage insurance, or PMI, protects lenders in the event that borrowers default on their primary mortage by ceasing to make payments, resulting in homes ending up in foreclosure. But all borrowers do not have to pay PMI. Typically, home buyers must make a 20 percent down payment on a home when they buy it. However, some borrowers are unable to put down 20 percent. 



Four Ways Established Professionals Can Improve Their Resumés

Changing jobs can be a difficult decision to make, especially later in one's career. In many ways, landing a new job is more challenging than ever thanks to the technology-driven society in which people live. All of the skills mentioned should be relevant to your career objective and not just added to pad the résumé. Therefore, unless your brief stint waiting tables exemplifies how you developed customer service skills, eliminate it.

3. Choose the right keywords

It's important to optimize a résumé for digital scanning, which has become a major component of the employment sector. This includes using the correct keywords and phrasing so that your résumé will get "flagged." Take your cue from the job advertisements themselves and mimic the verbiage used. Replace the lingo accordingly, tailoring it to each job you apply for. Also, consult the "about us" area of a prospective employer's website. This area may offer clues about buzz words for the industry.

A Tasty, Versatile Bread

Cooks who want a versatile bread that's great for sandwiches and morning toast can try the following recipe for "Molasses Oatmeal Loaf" from Linda Collister's "Quick Breads" (Ryland, Peters & Small). Quick and easy to prepare, this loaf provides a chewy texture and a pleasant tang.

Molasses Oatmeal Loaf

Makes 1 medium loaf

- 2 tablespoons molasses 11/3 cups buttermilk 3/4 cup rolled oats 1 2/3 cups whole-
- wheat flour 1 3/4 cups unbleached
- all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda 1 teaspoon sea salt
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, chilled and cubed
- 1 extra-large egg, beaten 1 8 x 4 x 2 1/2-inch loaf pan, well greased

Mix the molasses and the buttermilk in a large bowl. Stir in the oats and then let soak for 30 minutes.

Preheat oven to 400 F.

In another bowl, mix the flours, baking soda and salt. Add the pieces of butter and rub in, using the tips of your fingers, until the mixture looks fine like crumbs.

Add the beaten egg and the mixture of soaked oats and mix well with a wooden spoon to make a fairly heavy dough. Scrape the mixture into the greased loaf pan and, with floured fingers, press it into a neat loaf shape.



Bake for 10 minutes, then reduce the oven temperature to 350 F and bake for a further 35 minutes.

Turn out the loaf onto a wire rack and let cool to room temperature before slicing.

Keep tightly wrapped and eat within 3 days, or toast. The loaf can be frozen for up to 1 month.
