of Specialist E5 before he was honorably discharged

after serving three years.

He settled in the Washington D.C. area and found employment in the corporate world, eventually establishing an international automation equipment-manufacturing corporation. Several patents were granted for Hugh Speed Packaging Systems and Optical Detection Systems.

Charles established a Real Estate Development Company that built a Manufacturing Plant in Maryland and a Spice Processing Plant in Ghana, Africa.

He obtained a Charter from the National Credit Administration, Union NCUA to open a Federally multi-millioninsured Community dollar Credit Union that was subsequently merged with a larger Credit Union.

**Shirley White Moulton** was high scorer and star player for the 1949-51 women's basketball team at Burrell Slater. Elizabeth Shirley White was born to Augusta and Jimmy White in Tuscaloosa in 1933. She moved to the west side of Florence, Alabama where the family was active in community activities.

Shirley was very popular at Burrell High School where she excelled in sports. Her pleasant personality, radiant smile, beautiful eyes, athletic body, and fashionable dress turned many heads.

She gained even more attention by her great athletic ability to shoot the

In the late 1940's and the early 1950's the rules were different as only one girl from each team was allowed to move all over the court. Therefore, the constant directive for the Burrell Crimson Tigers was to get the ball to Shirley. She made phenomenal shots!

After graduation Shirley moved to New York City with her brother, but she eventually made her way back to Alabama. She was employed by the State of Alabama, Automatic Electric, and Chrysler Corporation.

May 3, 2017. She will be remembered as the best well known in northwest



in the history of the school. Curtis Simpson was an all-conference running back who played from 1945-48. Simpson was athlete extraordinaré, a gentleman, and admired citizen. Curtis excelled in sports at Burrell High School during the late 1940's when he distinguished himself as an outstanding running back in football and center in basketball. He was coached by W.H. Lewis who urged him to accept a

college scholarship.
Curtis is quoted in 1994
by the *TimesDaily* as saying, "Mr. Lewis was a good coach and he demanded your attention. We had a great football team and only lost one game in two years." The reputation of the Burrell Tiger football team was such that the Parker High team of Birmingham backed out of a scheduled game to keep from being defeated.

He was an active combat veteran in Korea after which he served in the Army Reserve. Curtis married Vera Cooper and they parented three children.

Curtis was employed by Rogers Department store and retired from the United States Post Office. He passed away in January of 1997.

Albert "Dusty" Suggs was a legendary halfback and one of the famous Suggs brothers who played in the 1940's. The Suggs brothers were STAR football players. They were Fred, Dock Jr., Lewis and Dusty. Another brother, Joe, played for Sterling She passed away on High School in Sheffield. These brothers were so female basketball shooter Alabama that few people

knew their given names. They were always called by their nicknames or réferred to as "dem bad a--Suggs boys."

Over two Dusty's team at Burrell out-scored opponents 360-55 including 155-0 in 1945. Dusty moved to Indiana

where he attempted to play for the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana. However, racism was as prevalent in the north as it was in the south. He certainly had skills and talent to play college and even professional football, but the 1940's were not the right time for black players

to integrate the game.

After living in Indiana with his first wife and where his sons were born, he moved back to Florence. Dusty passed away in Septémber of 1968.

### **Financial Tips for Retiring Abroad**

Dear Savvy Senior,

What are some financial factors to consider when retiring abroad? My husband and I will be retiring in a few years and are interested in living in a foreign country that's cheaper than the U.S.

Frugal Couple

Dear Frugal,

Retiring abroad has become a growing trend for millions of U.S. retirees who are looking to stretch their retirement savings. Here are some tips and resources to consider that can help you prepare.

Researching Tools

For starters, you can find lots of information and articles on the countries and cities you're interested in retiring to at websites like InternationalLiving.com and EscapeArtist.com.

Another good tip is to talk or network with some expatriates who have already made the move you're thinking about making. They can give you tips and suggestions on many issues, as well as the advantages





and disadvantages and day-to-day reality of living in a particular country. Some popular sites for finding expat resources are ExpatExchange.com and ExpatForum.com.

But before committing to location, most experts recommend that you visit multiple times during different seasons to see whether you can envision yourself living there and not just exploring the place as a tourist. Also, consider these financial factors:

**Cost of living:** Retiring abroad used to be seen as a surefire way to live beyond your means, and for some countries it still is. But the U.S. dollar isn't what it used to be, so your money may not stretch as far as you think. See *Numbeo.com* for a country-by-country cost of living comparison.

**Taxes:** No matter what foreign country you decide to retire in, as long as you're a U.S. citizen you must file an annual tax return reporting all income above certain minimums, not matter where it's earned. For details see the IRS publication 54, "Tax Guide for U.S. Citizens and Resident Aliens Abroad" at IRS.gov/pub/irs-pdf/p54.pdf.

Health care: Most U.S. health insurance companies do not provide coverage outside the U.S., nor does Medicare. Check with the embassy (see *USembassy.state.gov*) of your destination country to see how you can be covered as a foreign resident. Many countries provide governmentsponsored health care that's inexpensive, accessible and just as good as what you get in the states, or you may want to buy a policy through Medibroker (Medibroker.com) or Bupa Global (BupaGlobal.com).

Also know that most people who retire abroad eventually return to the U.S., so you should consider paying your Medicare Part B premiums. If you drop and resume Part B, or delay initial enrollment, you'll pay a 10 percent premium penalty for every 12-month period in which you could have been enrolled.

Banking: Opening or maintaining a bank account abroad has become more difficult because of the Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act, a U.S. law designed to prevent Americans from hiding assets abroad. So, you may have to establish a savings and checking account with an institution that has international reach like Citibank. And/ or consider maintaining your U.S. bank account that you can access online, and get U.S. credit and debit cards that don't charge foreign transaction fees.

**Rent versus buy:** Buying a home in a foreign country can be complicated, so it's usually cheaper and simpler to rent, unless you know you're going to live there for a long

Social Security: You can receive your monthly Social Security benefits almost anywhere you live around the world (see SSA.gov/international/payments.html). Your benefits can be deposited into your bank account either in the U.S. or in your new home country, but there are some exceptions.

The U.S. State Department offers a handy checklist that can help you think through all the issues on retiring abroad. To access it visit Travel.state.gov and search for 'retirement abroad.'

### **Medicare Minute**

### "Signing up for Medicare Part 1"

The most common way to qualify for Medicare is when you are turning 65. You will have a specific time period, set by Medicare, to enroll in Part A and Part B Medicare. This is known as the Initial Enrollment Period (IEP).

If you are qualifying for Medicare by turning 65 you will have a 7 month window to enroll in Medicare. This window is based off of the month you turn 65. It starts 3 months prior to the month you turn 65 and extends 3 months past the month you turn 65. For example, if you are turning 65 in September your IEP begins in June and extends all the way through the month of December. If you are eligible, you may not have to pay a premium for Part A, but Part B will have a premium.

For those electing to sign up for Part B after their IEP a late-enrollment penalty may be assessed. This penalty can last as long as you have Part B and there may be a gap in your health coverage. However, one exception to this rule is being employed and having coverage through your company's group health plan. If this applies to you check with your benefit coordinator, Medicare or contact our office.

In most cases, if you are already drawing your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board benefits you should automatically be signed up for Part A and Part B. If you are not drawing your Social Security or RRB benefits and want to sign up for Medicare you can do so by signing up online at ssa.gov, visit your local Social Security office or give our office a call and we can help direct you.

extremely liberating. This is the time of the year when people set financial goals for the year. Here are some of the more popular financial resolutions and some tips for meeting your goal.

#### Common Financial Resolutions (And How to Achieve Them)

#### 1. Save More Money

If your goal is to save more money this year, I would certainly recommend so. Make saving automatic. Go ahead and set part of your paycheck to be deposited straight into a savings account. It is also helpful to set a manageable goal. Depending on your situation, it might not be reasonable for you to save \$5000 in a year. But, if you save just \$20 a week, you'd have over a thousand dollars saved at the end of the year.

#### 2. Beat Down Debt

The two most common methods are the Debt Avalanche Method and the Debt Snowball Method. In the Debt Snowball Method, you pay off the debt with the lowest balance first. Once paid, you throw all of the money you were paying toward the lowest balance debt to the next lowest balance debt and so on as you work your way up to the larger debts. The Debt Avalanche Method is where you pay off the debt that has the highest interest rate first regardless of the balance so your money goes further toward future balances as interest is a powerful force. When using either of these methods, check with each company or lender to make sure these payments will be applied to the principal.

#### 3. Spend Less

I am a big fan of budgeting. Many people are unaware of how they spend their money each month. This is due to lack of budgeting. First, figure out exactly how much money you bring in every month. Then, figure out exactly how much you spend. You will probably need to track your spending closely for several months. I recommend an online budgeting tool such as mint.com for assistance. After you figure out on what you are spending your money, you will probably be able to easily see how you can cut back.

When it comes to spending less, some have had good success with the envelope system. In the envelope system, you withdraw cash for however much you want to spend in an area. For example, put cash in an envelope labeled "Groceries or Food". When you go grocery shopping, you only spend cash out of that envelope. When you run out of money in the envelope, you're done with spending on groceries for the month. This can provide a good visual as to how to divide an amount of money throughout the month.



The court said lawyers in favor of DACA clearly demonstrated that young immigrants were likely to suffer serious, irreparable harm without court action.

DACA came into being in 2012 as one of President Obama's executive orders. DACA granted minors protection from deportation, a pathway to amnesty and work-permit benefits. It was blatantly unconstitutional and

illegal on several fronts.
Obama's DACA directive stated that immigration laws could not be used against a

group of 1.7 million illegal aliens who consciously and unlawfully chose to violate our sovereign borders. That is not consistent with a President's duty to faithfully enforce the peoples' properly-enacted laws. The changing of such law is supposed to go through congress first. The President is not allowed to create such laws under the guise of executive discretion. In fact, the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires that such an action be presented to the public for notice and comment as well.

### Voter ID Law is Ideal

challenging case constitutionality of Alabama's voter ID law, U.S. District Judge L. Scott Coogler of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Alabama last week ordered the lawsuit filed by Greater Birmingham Ministries, Alabama NAACP, and individual plaintiffs against the State of Alabama be dismissed.

Each of these individuals who volunteered their time to assist the State in gathering the facts deserves special recognition and our gratitude.





the legislative element on DACA, he also bypassed the regulatory elements.

Border-elimination advocates remained silent even though most knew this executive action would have been used long before now if it were it considered legal.

It is so easy for many of us to play semantics with the term illegal, or better yet, eliminate it from our personal vocabulary because we consider it mean-spirited and hurtful.

If my father steals a car

If my father steals a car when I am 14 years old, gets it repainted, and keeps it undetected long enough to where I can drive it when I am of legal driving age, the car is still stolen. The crime has yet to be corrected. When I get pulled over and it is discovered that the car is hot, it gets taken away and I may be arrested. The fact that my no longer having that car may cost me an undue hardship is not relevant.

And although our hearts may say that individual circumstances need to be considered, the fact remains that people are in this country illegally. We fail to realize that as US citizens we can enter no other country illegally. Those countries have serious and swift penalties for doing so, yet we are supposed to turn a blind eye and cover the adverse economics resulting from millions of addition people weighing on our system.

The related issue of the border wall also creates tremendous angst on the left. The proposed expense of \$18 billion over the next ten years to construct 700 miles of new or replacement barriers separating the US and Mexico has many up in arms.



Without even closely crunching the numbers, it is clear that if we eliminate a few million border hoppers over the next ten years, we will more than save the taxpayer the border wall's \$18 billion expense by saving food, medical, educational, and housing expenses.

However, we ALL know it's not about the expenses, the taxpayers' wallet, the safety and security of our citizens, or the sovereignty of our borders. It's about adding to the democrat voter base and keeping downward pressure on worker wages, which benefits corporate fat cats on both sides of the aisle.

Struggles in a good sense: developing my faith as my own and not my parents' faith or my friends' faith and trying to understand the idea of eternity."

Benson said that while his work is spiritual in its conception, it's not in-yourface or trying to make a specific statement. "There's no hidden agenda," he said. "If any deeper

"If any deeper conversation comes about, it's through one-on-one discussion, through someone asking more questions," Benson said.

In graduate school and shortly afterwards, Benson said he worked on projects that had to do with time, a topic that relates to his current work regarding eternity.

"Eternity is the absence of time," he said. "There's a time element in my work that's process oriented, but I'm also conceptually thinking about time."

Benson is an assistant professor of art at the University of North Alabama where he teaches ceramics, sculpture and 3D design. He earned his MFA from New York State College of Ceramics at Alfred University after obtaining his BFA in 2009 from the University of Tennessee.

"I grew up in the studio with my dad," Benson said. "I fell in love with clay because I was around it and studied ceramics both in undergrad and in graduate school. Most of my technical background is in ceramics and handbuilding."

Benson will present a slide lecture at the opening reception on January 21 from 1-3pm. He will also conduct a workshop that will include demonstrations of clay techniques including wheel throwing, slab building and alternative processes. Dates for the workshops will be announced.

The museum is open 9am-5pm Monday- Friday and 1-3pm on Sundays. Admission is \$5 for adults, \$3 for students, and is free on Sundays.



But there was another word that caught my attention as a "Word of the year" in 2017 according to Oxford Dictionary. The word is "youthquake." It is defined as "a



### Questions

A good indication that your home has made it on a buyer's "short list" is if the prospective buyer is asking questions.

Save a step in the consideration process and have this information ready.

How much is Homeowner's insurance? Most people are aware that homeowner's insurance premiums may fluctuate, but the annual amount you are currently paying will at least give the buyer an idea of the range in which they may anticipate paying and how it may affect their mortgage payment.

How much are the taxes? This information is readily available online and most agents will gather this for their buyer, however it doesn't hurt to have this available when the buyer is looking at your home so they can quickly see the amount and how it may also affect their mortgage payment. - mr



### **Oregon Court Denies Bakers**

Editor:

A three-judge panel of the Oregon Court of Appeals on December 28, 2017 upheld a decision by Oregon's Labor Department that fined Sweet Cakes by Melissa \$135,000, forcing Aaron and Melissa Klein to close their belong.

to close their bakery.

The appeals court had the audacity to write, "baking wedding cakes is not speech, art, or other expression" protected by the First Amendment.

The judges further noted the state did not "impermissibly burden the Kleins' right to the free exercise of religion" because it compelled the Christian bakers only to comply with "a neutral law of general applicability."

Oregon law prohibits businesses from refusing service because of a customer's sexual orientation, race, gender, and other personal characteristics."

The Oregon bakery owned by the Kleins declined to bake a cake for a lesbian couple who desired a special cake for their wedding in 2013. The Klein's refusal was based on religious

convictions and conscience.
Subsequently, Oregon's Labor
Commissioner Brad Avakian, whom CNN called a champion of the LGBTQ community, slapped the Kleins with a fine of \$135,000.

Commissioner Avakian said, "This case is not about a wedding cake or a marriage. "It is about a business' refusal to serve someone because of their sexual orientation."

This ruling is a further assault by the state on the couple whose business had already closed.

In addition to the fine Commissioner Avakian placed a gag order on the Kleins, i.e., ordering them to "cease and desist" from speaking publicly about not wanting to bake cakes for same-sex weddings based on their Christian beliefs.

The Kleins did write on their Facebook page, "This effectively strips us of all our First Amendment rights. According to the state of Oregon we neither have freedom of religion or freedom of speech."
A final caveat: The former

### **Traffic Signals Are Poorly Synchronized**

Editor:

In the many years I have lived in the Shoals, I have questioned engineering at state, county and city level. I have received many conflicting reasons for the varied signalization methods and archaic stop lights in the Shoals. The amount of gasoline wasted as motorists wait at senseless red lights has to be astronomical.

The traffic lights cannot be synchronized. In many parts of the country and this state traffic lights are synchronized with one another per the speed limit. The inconsistency of being able to turn left on a green light is incomprehensible. The reasoning of traffic count doesn't compute, nor does distance visibility. I could point out many intersections where these regulations cannot be valid.

As for traffic count, I do not believe Florence has an intersection of more than 25,000 vehicles per 24 hours. Yet, in many parts of the country where intersections have a traffic count of approximately 50,000 vehicles per 24 hours, vehicles may turn on a yellow light while traffic is green. Governor's Drive

Huntsville is another example with a large traffic count. In front of the hospital there are flashing yellow lights for a left turn during the entire green sequence. How many times have motorists in Florence had to wait to turn left when no traffic is coming in their direction? Consider also when motorists have to wait through the complete sequence before they can turn left! Alabama DOT decides whether Shoals motorists can turn left safely by throwing a dart at a board. Will Florence and the Shoals ever have traffic signals which facilitate traffic flow, or will they have stoplights?
