

DOUG SMITH PLAYS AGAIN

Tumbleweed Smith



I first interviewed Doug Smith and recorded his playing piano when he was fourteen. It was at his parents' home in Kermit. It has been amazing to watch his career blossom. He has played piano concerts in some of the major cities in America. He composed music for photographer Wyman Meinzer's video titled WEST TEXAS. Doug is 52 now and living in Lubbock. "My music is very dy-

Tumbleweed Smith namic for piano music," he says. "It's loud and rambunctious, not your soothing type of piano. Some of my songs are soulful, though." Doug has played piano since he was two. His first concert was at age six. "I played for the whole elementary school there in Kermit and I knew right then what I was going to do the rest of my life."

PBS did a documentary of Doug and it played on television stations across the country. "I went from playing 20 dates a year to playing 80 to 90 dates a year. All of a sudden I was playing in St Louis, Chicago, Los Angeles and New York. I'd walk out on stage wearing a cowboy hat looking like a hayseed and play concert piano. I never have a playlist; just play what I think the audience wants to hear. It's all my original music. Yamaha picked up sponsorship and made sure I had a piano wherever I went."

In 2007, during his 25th year as a concert pianist, Doug was getting ready to perform on the Austin City Limits television program when he had a wreck in his pickup, resulting in a spinal cord injury. "When it happened I couldn't move from the neck down. Therapy has brought me to where I am today. That's a long way. Nobody ever thought I'd be up in a wheelchair playing piano and recording music again and doing what I do. It's just been a God-given determination not to stay in bed. I can't use the fingers on my left hand so I use the old karate chop method and I'll play with the side of my hand."

Doug is confined to his wheel chair and has to have help to get up and get around. He was in bed two years before he could get in a wheel chair. His wife left him a few years after he was injured. But his spirit is as bright and healthy as ever. He plays every day and has made one album since the accident. That brings his total albums to 14. "My daddy used to fuss at me for making so many albums, but I'm glad I did when I could because I make my living with them now." He has composed 200 songs not yet released. Occasionally he makes a motivational speech.

He had his therapy at Craig Hospital in Denver. "That's where Superman went for his therapy," says Doug. "I figured if it was good enough for Superman it was good enough for me." When hospital personnel learned about Doug's speaking, they invited him to come up there and make a speech. "After I spoke I wheeled up to the grand piano and played Amazing Grace. When I finished, the two thousand people who were there stood straight up and it was the most fulfilling ovation that I've ever had in my life."

I heard a recent recording of Doug playing Amazing Grace. There are significant pauses between musical phrases but the recording is dramatic and makes the listener feel and understand what it took to play that song.



Johnny Lucille Collier

Johnnie Lucille Collier (April 12, 1923 – January 22, 2004), known professionally as Ann Miller, was an American dancer, singer and actress. She is best remembered for her work in the Hollywood musical films of the 1940s and 1950s.

Johnnie Lucille Collier was born in Chireno, Texas to Clara Emma (née Birdwell) and John Alfred Collier, a criminal lawyer who represented the Barrow Gang, Machine Gun Kelly, and Baby Face Nelson, among others.

Her maternal grandmother was Cherokee. Miller's father insisted on the name Johnnie because he had wanted a boy, but she was often called Annie. She began to take dance classes at the age of 5, after suffering from a case of rickets. Her mother believed that these classes would help strengthen her young daughter's legs.

She lived in Texas until she was 9, when her mother decided to leave her unfaithful husband and move to Los Angeles. Because Birdwell was deaf, it was hard for her to find work; however, because Miller looked much older than she was, she began to work as a dancer in nightclubs so that she could support the both of them. About this time she adopted the stage name Ann Miller, which she kept throughout her entire

She was considered a child dance prodigy. In an interview featured in a "behind the scenes" documentary on the making of the compilation film That's Entertainment!

At age 13 in 1936, Miller became a showgirl at the Bal Tabarin. She was hired as a dancer in the "Black Cat Club" in San Francisco (she reportedly told them she was 18). It was there she was discovered by Lucille Ball and talent scout/comic Benny Rubin. This led Miller to be given a contract with RKO in 1936 at the age of 13 (she had also told them she was 18) and she remained there until 1940. In 1941, she signed with Columbia Pictures, where, starting with Time Out for Rhythm, she starred in 11 B movie musicals from 1941 to 1945. In July of 1945, with WWII still raging in the Pacific, she posed in a bathing suit as Yank magazine pin-up girl. She ended her contract in 1946 with one "A" film, The Thrill of Brazil. The ad in Life magazine featured Miller's leg in a large, red, bow-tied stocking as the "T" in "Thrill." She finally hit her mark in Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer musicals such as Easter Parade (1948), On the Town (1949) and Kiss Me Kate (1953).

Miller helped popularize pantyhose in the 1940s as a solution to the continual problem of tearing stockings during the filming of dance production numbers. The common practice had been to sew hosiery to briefs. If torn, the entire garment had to be removed and resewn with a new pair. At Miller's request, hosiery was manufactured for her as a single pantyhose.

Miller was famed for her speed in tap dancing. Studio publicists concocted press releases claiming she could tap 500 times per minute, but in truth, the sound of ultrafast "500" taps was looped in later. Because the stage floors were waxed and too slick for regular tap shoes, she had to dance in shoes with rubber treads on the sole. Later she would loop the sound of the taps while watching the film and actually dancing on a "tap board" to match her steps in the film.

She was known, especially later in her career, for her distinctive appearance, which reflected a studio-era ideal of glamour: massive black bouffant hair, heavy makeup with a splash of crimson lipstick, and fashions that emphasized her lithe figure and

Her film career effectively ended in 1956 as the studio system lost steam to television, but she remained active in the theatre and on television. She starred on Broadway in the musical Mame in 1969, in which she wowed the audience in a tap number created just for her. In 1979 she astounded audiences in the Broadway show Sugar Babies with fellow MGM veteran Mickey Rooney, which toured the United States extensively after its Broadway run. In 1983, she won the Sarah Siddons Award for her work in Chicago theatre.

Miller appeared as a dance instructor in Home Improvement episode "Dances with Tools" (1993).[10] Between 1995 and 2001, Molly Shannon parodied Miller several times on Saturday Night Live in a recurring sketch entitled "Leg-Up!"

Miller married three times, to Reese Llewellyn Milner in 1946, to William Moss in 1958 and to Arthur Cameron in 1961, and in between marriages dated such wellknown men as Howard Hughes, Conrad Hilton, and Louis B. Mayer. During her marriage to Reese Llewellyn Milner, while pregnant with daughter Mary in her last trimester, Miller fell and went into early labor. Baby Mary lived only three hours on November 12, 1946.

Miller died, aged 80, from lung cancer, and was interred in Holy Cross Cemetery in Culver City, California, beside her infant daughter Mary.

For her contribution to the motion picture industry, Miller has a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame at 6914 Hollywood Blvd. In 1998, a Golden Palm Star on the Palm Springs, California, Walk of Stars was dedicated to her. To honor Miller's contribution to dance, the Smithsonian Institution displays her favorite pair of tap shoes, which she playfully nicknamed "Moe and Joe".
