

### What you can do to help a lost pet come home

We have a large notebook at the shelter that is filled with reports of lost dogs and cats. A dog will sometimes just follow a scent his nose has picked up, sometimes they have been scared by other animals, and sometimes they just wander away. Cats who are allowed outside can also become frightened by other animals or loud noises and run away in fear. In addition, cats do get into car engines and are given a very dangerous ride to destinations far away.

There are many reasons why dogs and cats become strays. The best line of defense is to provide a collar and identification information. Even in areas that permit dogs to wander require a current city or county tag. Microchipping a pet is becoming increasingly important because of the increase in people picking up strays and either keeping them or placing them in rescue groups.

If the worst happens and your dog or cat is missing, contact all animal shelters within a 50-mile radius. It may be very helpful to make copies of a recent picture and take them to the shelters. Sometimes, owners describe an animal and the person hearing the description gets a different picture in their mind. Coming to the shelter is always advised.

Social media is helpful, but do not rely on it exclusively. Walk or drive through your neighborhood several

times each day, and ask mailmen, delivery people, and anyone you see if they have seen your pet.

Most veterinary clinics will allow notices about lost pets to be placed on a bulletin board. Place advertisements in local newspapers and with radio stations. Include a lot of information about your pet, including age, sex, size, breed, and color. It is sometimes wise to leave out one identifying feature so if someone calls claiming to have found your pet, you would be able to spot calls from people who merely seek a monetary reward.

A reward for finding a returning a lost animal is always a good idea, and should be included on all notices and advertisements.


### **Butterfly Jewelry**

Colorful butterflies are admired and even the inspiration for expensive, valuable jewelry. But, many people are annoyed or even afraid of "bugs," and few would want a caterpillar pin or bracelet. In earlier centuries, all sorts of insects and small creatures found in nature were popular. Ladybugs bring luck. Frogs are most appropriate as gifts for travelers. They bring good luck and a safe return. Snakes, perhaps because they shed their skins each year, represent fertility and health. A snake biting its tail represents eternity. Queen Victoria was given a snake ring in 1839 as an engagement ring. There are many antique or vintage gold and jeweled snake bracelets, rings or necklaces. But the butterfly is perhaps the most popular because of the beauty of the design. And, the butterfly represents change and a free spirit. A 4 1/2-inch Russian butterfly pin, made in the early 1900s, sold at the New Orleans Auction Gallery in 2016 for \$5,000. It is made with rubies, sapphires, emeralds and old mine-cut diamonds set in 14-carat gold.

Patrons in the mall had mixed reactions as I came by with my oxygen mask, IV, and eye patch. My head was tilted down at an angle, my hands were trembling. My white hair, old man hat, and pajamas rounded out the picture.

I was clearly a man with not long to live.

Lest you worry, please allow me to put your mind at ease. I am actually quite well, and have been remarkably healthy for all of my forty-seven years. There will likely come a day when I have to send out a request for people to pray for God to heal me if it is his will. But on the day in question, I was actually in disguise, and for a very good reason.

It was our fourth annual Mall Tease Manhunt. The two teams of young people from our church are sent out on a two or three county chase, following one clue after another, until they finally arrive at a large mall somewhere. When they arrive, they must come into the mall and find me, and the first team that does earns 100,000 points for their yearly competition. My task is to disguise myself so well that, even when out in plain sight, they will not know who I am.

In this case, it was mission accomplished. In fact, the disguise was so believable that I achieved something almost unthinkable; a family member who has known me literally my entire life did not recognize me. I wheeled right by him, and he thought I truly was a sick old man.

It gets even better. A moment or so after I wheeled by him, one of the teams came by him and he stopped them.

"Listen," he said, "I know you are going to be stopping people and talking to them to see if they are the Preacher. But there is a really sick old man in the mall being pushed around in a wheelchair. Whatever you do, don't bother him at all, that isn't the Preacher."

When the other team finally discovered me, the team he warned away from me was, to put it mildly, annoyed with him. Their laughing yet pointed instruction to him was, "Next time do two things: drive faster, and don't talk to us!"

Things like this take an enormous amount of work, literally weeks and weeks worth of preparation. But investing in the lives of young people is worth it a thousand times over.

For me, though I enjoy the fun as much as any of the kids, God made sure there was much more to it than just fun. As my preacher friend was wheeling me quietly around, those silent moments brought a very loud thought to my heart; one day this will be real. If Christ tarries his coming, I will one day literally be facing death. We all will.

Hebrews 9:27 says, "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:". Every one of us lives in dying bodies. Since Adam himself we have all been born with an expiration date to these fleshly containers that house our souls. We will have an accident and die. or be killed and die, or get sick and die, or get old and die. The question is, will we be ready for death, and for what comes next.

As a minister, I have been around death and the dying for many years. I can tell you with certainty that not everyone meets death with the same attitude. I have been at the bedside of those with a look of sheer horror in their eyes. I have also been at the bedside of people who lifted their arms to heaven, smiled, and breathed a last breath here only to inhale celestial air a split second later.

Paul did not fear death. The former Christ-hater came to know him as his Lord and Savior. And after spending the rest of his life serving him, right before he died said "I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand."

That is the kind of fearlessness that a real child of God can have as they meet death.



Having a great year is Dwayne Johnson, whose "Jumanji" film (he's also executive producer), which opened Dec. 20, cost around \$100 million and grossed \$121 million in its first three days. He's by far the busiest and highest-paid star in Hollywood today. He executive produced the sci-fi monster film "Rampage," with Naomi Harris and Joe Manganiello, opening April 20, and produced the action film "Skyscraper," with Neve Campbell, coming July 13. In addition, he's currently filming "Fighting With My Father," with Vince Vaughn and Lena Headey, hitting screens Sept. 14, and of course "The Fast & the Furious 9," due April 2020. The Rock caterpillar has become the Dwayne Johnson butterfly.

Dec. 27 marked the first anniversary of Carrie Fisher's passing. As "Star Wars: The Last Jedi" kills it at the box office, with grosses of \$900 million, she must be smiling from beyond.

Three of the original four stars of "Star Wars" — Harrison Ford, Carrie Fisher and Mark Hamill — each received 0.25 percent of the profits, while Sir Alec Guinness negotiated and got 2 percentage points. Assuming their percentages were raised with their salaries for each picture, they all became very rich from the franchise.

The final coroner's report on Carrie Fisher's death revealed that she had sleep apnea and fatty tissue buildup on her artery walls. In addition, they found cocaine, heroin, opiates and ecstasy, which they suspect may have contributed to or caused her death. But "The Last Jedi" is not her last film because she filmed "Wonderwell," with Rita Ora and Vincent Spano, about the high fashion and modeling world, prior to her death. Her daughter, Billie Lourd, has admitted, "She battled drug addiction and mental illness her whole life!" You know she and her mom, Debbie Reynolds, who died the day after her, are "Singin' in the Rain" in heaven.



Raking In the Cash With Relocations

---

While Department of Veterans Affairs chief David Shulkin is doing a good job, there is one place he needs to focus his laser gaze: relocations and the cash paid out to those who move within the VA ... and those who pocket the money.

A recent VA Office of the Inspector General report details -- on many pages, covering many years -- how one VA employee managed to get piles of money in a relocation that he never made.

Let's call him Dr. A. Years ago, Dr. A applied for a VA job clear across the country. He was paid nearly \$20,000 for Temporary Quarters allowance. His boss approved the change of position. Furthermore, Dr. A's salary was dramatically increased because different geographical regions have varying base salaries depending on the cost of living.

But Dr. A didn't move. He stayed where he was, at the heftier salary, and telecommuted. Basically, he phoned it in. He did put in two days a week at his home location, while, on paper, living on the other coast. This went on for over three years.

When the jig was finally up, Dr. A claimed not to know he'd been given nearly \$20,000 in relocation money (all of it within one month). His wife thought it was his annual bonus.

Technically he was assigned to the other coast, where he also supposedly lived. How then could he claim travel money for traveling to his own home? During the time he was living on one coast and claiming to live on the other, Dr. A also made dozens of trips on the government dime. The VAOIG, as of this writing, has handed it back to the VA with recommendations. Dr. A owes the government a lot of money. Unfortunately, he's likely not the only VA employee cashing in this way.





I nigh Numbness Likely Due to Trapped Nerve

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 65-year-old male who has developed a lack of sensation in the lateral front half of my right thigh. The numbness involves strictly the skin. There is no loss of strength, function or balance in my leg. My gait is normal, although I find that if I go on a long walk, the skin will begin to "tingle."

When I went to an orthopedic surgeon, he suspected that the condition could be caused by a disc problem. Although an X-ray did show some stenosis, it was not definitive.

I suspect I caused the problem by years of sleeping on my right side in a curledup position, resulting in entrapment of the nerve. The orthopedist, however, says he generally sees this condition only in obese people, which I am not.

How likely is it that my condition is of spinal origin rather than an entrapped nerve? If the condition can resolve itself gradually by avoiding activities that contribute to the problem, what does "gradually" mean? Do stretching exercises help relieve the entrapment? -- J.C.B.

ANSWER: What you are describing is meralgia paresthetica, the compression of the lateral femoral cutaneous nerve, which can be compressed as it passes under the inguinal ligament, exactly as you described. Your orthopedist is correct that this condition is more common in the overweight or obese; however, I have seen it in both people who are losing weight and people of normal, stable weight. It is more common in conjunction with diabetes, and it has been reported after longdistance walking and cycling.

Because of the area involved in your numbness, it is very likely to be meralgia paresthetica and not spinal in origin. It does usually resolve, but it does so over the course of months, typically. Stretching would seem to make sense, but as far as I know, it hasn't been shown to work.

If it isn't getting better, an injection into the nerve usually is effective. This is commonly done by an anesthesiologist or a pain-management specialist.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Can you please give me some information on Elhers-Danlos syndrome? My daughter and two granddaughters have it. -- E.E.H.

ANSWER: Ehlers-Danlos syndrome is actually a group of uncommon genetic disorders, with very stretchy skin, flexible joints and tissue fragility as common features. There are six different kinds of Ehlers-Danlos, and each is different in regard to what tissues and organs it most affects. Most are caused by mutations in genes for collagen and related structural proteins. They can be inherited or not (in which case they are new mutations).

Flexible joints (often but wrongly called "double-jointed") and excessively stretchy skin are almost universal in EDS. The excess joint movement can cause dislocations and chronic joint pain resembling fibromyalgia. Other commonly associated conditions include prolapse of the mitral valve, hernias and, in the vascular type of EDS. aneurisms.

The prognosis in EDS depends to a great extent on the subtype. I would suggest that you go with your daughter and granddaughters to their doctor (if they agree) to learn more about their particular type.


