





Who Pays for Care at Non-VA Hospitals?

If you have a medical emergency, the first thing on your mind is getting fast care. If that means going to a non-Department of Veterans Affairs hospital, so be it. It's afterward, when the bills come due, that problems arise, especially if no one thought to call the VA to get permission for care at a non-VA facility.

A lawsuit by a veteran has resulted in a big change in the rules. The veteran suffered a heart attack and strokes. He obviously needed quick treatment somewhere, and he got it. He was in no shape to think about calling the VA. He was hospitalized for a long time. Afterward, the hospital wanted a pile of cash from the veteran after his other insurance left a lot

Until now, the VA was let off the hook for any non-VA medical facility costs if the veteran had ANY thirdparty insurance, including an auto insurance policy that provided even a tiny amount of coverage for medical care after a wreck. That loophole left the veteran liable for the whole unpaid balance at the non-VA hospital.

With the new rule, if a veteran has an emergency and has third-party insurance that pays part of the bill, the VA has to pony up a certain amount, based on whether the emergency had to do with serviceconnected versus non-service-connected conditions. That amount also will be determined by the type of insurance, including Medicare. The veteran won't be let off the hook completely when it comes to deductibles, co-pays, etc.

If you're being hounded for payment by a non-VA hospital, tell them about the new regulation and that the VA likely will have to be second payer. They'll know what that means. If you have guestions, there is a dedicated hotline: 1-877-466-7124.



- * Keep makeup brushes in tip-top shape: Wash with a good brush cleaner weekly, and store upright in a jar (bristles up). Don't toss them in a box, bag or drawer with your makeup! They may pick up unwanted pigments and the facial bacteria can compromise makeup!
- * If your dryer is taking a long time to run its cycle and the clothes STILL aren't dry, check your lint trap. Follow the hose all the way to the end, and be sure to check the grate that is in place where the hose exits an exterior wall. Lint can build up here, making it hard for heat and steam to escape. It's also a fire hazard.
- * "In our house, we use nail polish to distinguish whose plastic leftover containers are whose. My roommate and I both bought the same set (a good deal!), and we painted a little X on the bottom and on the top of the lids in contrasting colors. So I only use the red dot ones, and she uses the dark blue." -- M.T.
- * "I purchased a couple glass-cleaning cloths that were nice and big. I used my sewing machine to sew the edges together and make a little sack. It stores my reading glasses, and I can keep them clean and not scratched up." -- R.E. in Missouri
- * "I wanted to use my staple gun to attach a cord along a board for a craft project. I taped a craft stick to the bottom so that the staple would not go in all the way, leaving an allowance for the cord. I just used extra-long staples. It worked great and turned out very secure, and I didn't have to worry about a staple slicing up an electrical cord!" -- F.D. in Texas

Strange Wooden Table

As fashions change in clothing, so do fashions in furniture and design. Norman Rockwell was considered a commercial artist of little value for many years, but now his original paintings for magazine covers can sell for millions of dollars.



This rare table with carved top and sides was made in Minneapolis in 1905. It sold in 2016 for \$24,000.

A strange table made by John Scott Bradstreet (1845-1914) recently was offered at a Cowan auction in Cincinnati. Bradstreet was a leading interior designer, decorator and tastemaker in Minneapolis for many years before he died in a car crash in 1914. The table was in the Arts and Crafts style — sort of. Bradstreet went to Japan many times, and his designs were influenced by Asian arts and bits of many other styles: English Arts and Crafts, Moorish, Gothic, the Aesthetic Movement and the works of Whistler.

The wooden center table sold in the auction was covered with shallow carvings that followed the grain. The technique, called by the Japanese name jin-di-sugi, used cypress, a soft wood that, after a long time in water or mud, develops raised lines in the grain. The wood was then scorched, brushed, carved and waxed, a process that was modernized and patented by Bradstreet. Few pieces like this are known, and many of these are in museums.

The auctioned table had side panels that flipped down to make small display shelves on each side. We looked for more information about this table and the maker, and found that it had sold in 2005 for an estimated price of \$50,000 to \$75,000. This time, the table brought \$24,000.

Hatpins have been made of a variety of materials, can be simple or ornate, and can be as long as 12 inches. They sell today for less than \$15 to a few hundred dollars. Their value is determined by workmanship and the materials. Gold, silver or valuable jewels increase the hatpin's value.

TIP: To clean the stem and bowl of a collectible briar pipe, dip a pipe cleaner in vodka, and push it through the stem. Use a dry pipe cleaner for any pipe but a briar pipe.



4 ways established professionals can improve their résumés



Changing jobs can be a difficult decision to make, especially later in one's career. In many ways, landing a new job is more challenging than ever thanks to the technology-driven society in which people live. Information is shared faster than ever, and applying for jobs isn't the same as it might have been as recently as a decade ago.

One thing that has evolved is the résumé. Although creating a powerful résumé has always been a challenge, writing — or modifying one — for today's digital world requires some insider tips.

Adapting a résumé as one ages and has gained experience can be advantageous. A well-crafted résumé is one way for professionals to demonstrate how their skill set is current and adaptable to today's business climate. 1. Focus on your accomplishments

Rather than focusing on job responsibilities at each job you held, gear the résumé around what you achieved in each position. Rather than state that you were responsible for providing customer service, explain that you built your reputation on conveying difficult technical terms to the layperson, serving as the go-to employee for translating job jargon for outside correspondence.

If you have quantitative proof of how you accomplished something, certainly add it. This can include measures of profit growth, reduction of debt or increase in customer base.

2. Aim for the future

Rather than emphasize what you did, highlight what you plan to do. This means giving greater weight to the expertise that will translate into your new position. Chances are you can find skills that you honed in one or more jobs that translate into credentials that can be used on another. All of the skills mentioned should be relevant to your career objective and not just added to pad the résumé. Therefore, unless your brief stint waiting tables exemplifies how you developed customer service skills, eliminate it.

3. Choose the right keywords

It's important to optimize a résumé for digital scanning, which has become a major component of the employment sector. This includes using the correct keywords and phrasing so that your résumé will get "flagged." Take your cue from the job advertisements themselves and mimic the verbiage used. Replace the lingo accordingly, tailoring it to each job you apply for. Also, consult the "about us" area of a prospective employer's website. This area may offer clues about buzz words for the industry.

4. Set yourself apart

Engage in activities that can improve your marketability. Be sure to list training, coursework, degree, or volunteer efforts that pertain directly to the skills needed for the job to which you're applying. These additions can tip the scales in your favor over another applicant.

Résumés continue to evolve, and it is crucial for applicants — especially established workers — to familiarize themselves with the changes and market themselves accordingly. TF176087

Virginia Farmer Robert Mills, Jr. Named 2017 Swisher Sweets/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year



(Moultrie, Ga.)—Robert Mills, Jr., a first generation farmer who grows tobacco and raises beef cattle and pullet breeder chickens near Callands, Va., has been selected as the overall winner of the Swisher Sweets/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year award for 2017.

As an eighth grade student in an agriculture class, Mills decided to become a farmer. As soon as he made that decision, people told him he could never do it. His determination proved the doubters wrong. Mills now offers himself as an example for young people who face long odds in reaching their goals. His life is also an example of the positive impact that agricultural education and the FFA organization can have on young people.

Mills was named as the overall winner at the Willie B. Withers Luncheon held during the opening day of the 2017 Sunbelt Ag Expo farm show. Mills was chosen as Farmer of the Year over nine other state winners who were finalists for the award.

His farm now encompasses 2,244 acres. His tobacco enterprise is diversified. Mills grows conventional flue cured tobacco, organic flue cured tobacco, dark fired tobacco, and tobacco harvested as a bioenergy crop. Winter wheat is his other main cash crop. He also grows pearl millet and hay.

He hopes to expand his Angus-based beef herd to 400 cows by this coming spring. He raises about 34,000 of the pullet breeder chickens each year. He grows the chickens on contract with a poultry company. His farm receives day-old chicks and Mills keeps them until they reach 21 weeks of age when they are moved to layer houses.

By obtaining the contract to grow chickens, Mills was able to quit his public job and realize his dream of becoming a full time farmer.

This is the 28th year for the Farmer of the Year award. The award recognizes excellence in agricultural production and farm management, along with leadership in farm and community organizations. The award also honors family contributions in producing safe and abundant supplies of food, fiber and shelter products.

Peter Ghiloni, president and chief executive officer of Swisher International, Inc., of Jacksonville, Fla., praised Mills for his farming accomplishments. "Robert is an outstanding farmer who has become a role model for others who want to farm," said Ghiloni. "It is an honor for our company and our Swisher Sweets cigar brand to recognize Robert and his farming accomplishments."

Ron Carroll, marketing vice president with Swisher, represented the company in presenting the cash award to Mills. Carroll visited Mills and his farm along with the farms of the other nine state winners during the judging tour. "Robert is truly an inspiration, and he has overcome many obstacles during his journey to become a full time successful farmer," said Carroll.

Mills expressed his thanks to Swisher and the other award sponsors. "I am a first generation farmer who started farming at an early age with basically no financial resources," said Mills.

Mills grew up in a suburb of Danville, Va. He grew his first vegetables at age 13, bought a tractor at age 15, and worked for a while for another farmer. He grew his first tobacco in 1995, bought his first farm in 1998, started raising cattle in 1999, and began farming full time in 2001.

As he expanded his farming enterprise, he borrowed money and paid back the loans. Before he started farming full time, he worked in a farm supply business and later as a conservation specialist for the Pittsylvania Soil & Water Conservation District.

Robert Mills, Jr. was selected for the honor by three judges who visited his farm and the farms of the other state winners during early August of this year.

The judges this year included farmer Thomas Porter, Jr., of Concord, N.C., who was the overall winner in 2011, Charles Snipes, a retired Extension weed scientist from Greenville, Miss., and beef cattle rancher Cary Lightsey of Lake Wales, Fla., who was the overall winner in 2009.

Porter served as this year's senior judge. He said that Mills impressed the judges with his determination to farm and with the diversity of his tobacco crops. "Robert Mills has an amazing story to tell, from his beginning in farming up until the present," said Porter. "He is an avid advocate for agriculture and is very active in community and agricultural affairs. He truly has a passion for what he does and is very deserving of this most prestigious honor."

Robert and his wife Cynthia have two sons. Cynthia works off the farm as an information technology resource teacher. Their older son Logan wants to farm, and their younger son Holden wants to be an on-the-road John Deere mechanic. Both sons are already great mechanics, according to Palacet.





My son now towers over me play, and he, having no at six feet three inches tall and is also developing some adult-sized wisdom. But I can still vividly remember the days when both his stature and his judgement were much smaller.

He was about ten years old. I have met very few ten-year-old boys who did not think that they were nearly superhuman, and my son was no exception. One of his areas of abundant overconfidence was in anything sports related.

My oldest daughter, though, a year his junior, has never had any particular use for sports. She started talking in full sentences at fourteen months old, using words like "contemplating" by age two, and was reading very advanced books every day by age four. They could not have been more different.

On the day I am musing over, I came home to find my daughter bouncing through the yard, beaming from ear to ear like she had just been made queen of the world. When I came inside, though, from my son's room I heard weeping and wailing that could have emanated from Dante's Inferno. Dana just nodded and said, "Go talk to your son..."

When I entered his little domicile I found him face down on the bed, sobbing uncontrollably. It took me a while to make out what he was moaning through his sobs, but finally I discerned "ALL sniff sniff MY sniff sniff MONEY!'

Then the story began to unfold. He had been playing with the football in the front yard. Karis asked to

She accepted his offer. He rared back with all of his perceived Thor-like might and fired the ball at her.

She caught it. And was instantly \$127 worth of birthday money richer.

Only a parent will likely understand how you can be broken hearted for your child while at the same time be desperately trying not to laugh. I eased out of his room and found my daughter.

This child has forever been the most tender hearted, trusting, easy to please child. I would never demand that she return the money. All I did was to ask her what she thought she should do at that moment. She only took a second to say, "Well, if it was me, I would want somebody to be nice and give it back, so I guess I should do that."

And she did. With no hesitation or sadness at all. Then I took her aside one more time, opened my own wallet, pulled out some hidden money I had tucked away in case of emergency, and gave it to her. I did not tell her I would do that ahead of time; I wanted to see if she would do right just for the sake of doing right. When she did, I responded as I believed the Lord himself would have done so had he been standing there at that moment.

In addition to having his "gambling habit" forever broken, my son learned to

love and respect his sister a little more that day. My daughter learned that when you do right just for the sake of right, you end up with blessings that have no guilt attached to them.

Philippians 2:3-4 says, "Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others."

If we parents raise our children to esteem others better than themselves and to consider the feelings and needs of others rather than just selfishly focus on themselves, we will have accomplished more than a billionaire who leaves a legacy of mountains of cash to his offspring. If we help them to join what seems to be the "me generation," though, if we teach them to always look out for number one, we will be doing them and the world they will live in a huge disservice.

Do you think we can puff their little heads up so big that they think the world revolves around them, and then expect them to become soldiers, preachers, police officers, fire fighters, nurses, and other fields that offer little pay for mountains of service? Do you imagine for so much as a moment that we can treat them as divas when they are children and end up producing anything other than adults who still behave as divas?

Don't bet on it.

HOLLYWOOD - Women's advocate and Oscar-winning actress Mira Sorvino joined the "Me Too" campaign in October in an interview with Ronan Farrow (son of Mia Farrow), revealing that she had been sexually harassed by producer Harvey Weinstein. She confessed, "I've lived in fear of Harvey Weinstein for the last 20 years." Weinstein's company, Miramax, was the distributor of Woody Allen's "Mighty Aphrodite" (1995), for which she won an Oscar, and when he asked for a meeting with his star in his hotel room, she went. But after refusing his advances she slowly began to learn that she'd been put on his "blacklist" and found it difficult to find roles of the caliber such as the one for which she won an Oscar.

Mira must have thought when "Romy & Michele's High School Reunion" (1997), with Lisa Kudrow, hit it big and made \$30 million that everything was all right. But it wasn't. The 36 films that followed were nowhere near the caliber of films an Oscar-winning actress should be making. Instead, they were films trying to trade off HER Oscar success. She knew something had to be done and her advocacy for women has paid off. The Screen Actors Guild and the American Federation of Television and Radio Artists have launched a hotline for industry performers who've experienced similar situations. Pandora's Box is opening wide! A small consolation was her recent guest-starring role in "Modern Family."

The hot new actor making the award circuit is Timothee Chalamet of the controversial "Call Me by Your Name," opposite Armie Hammer (in love scenes), which opened Nov. 24 in only two theaters in New York and two in Los Angles, and in "Lady Bird," with Saoirse Ronan, which also

opened in only four theaters on Nov. 3. Both films did so well they expanded to a larger number of theaters each week with "Call Me" earning \$7.2 million of its \$3.4 million cost and "Lady Bird" earning \$32 million of its \$10 million cost.

The award nominations, for both the actors and the films, will increase the number of screens, and they soon will go wide in most cities. Chalamet is second billed to Steve Carell in "Beautiful Boy" (Brad Pitt's a producer), and he is getting first billing ahead of Selena Gomez, Elle Fanning, Jude Law, Diego Luna and Liev Schreiber in Woody Allen's new film, "A Rainy Day in New York.

His first big role was in "Interstellar" (2014), in which he received no billing, and now he's top billed in a Woody Allen film! Any aspiring young actor has got to dream, "I'll have what he's having!'







Melt chocolate as directed on package. Using fork, dip one cookie truffle at a time into chocolate. Tap back of fork 2-3 times against edge of dish to allow excess chocolate to drip off. Place on wax paper-lined tray. Refrigerate 30 minutes, or until chocolate is set.

Spoon melted white chocolate into small, re-sealable plastic bag. Cut small piece from one bottom corner of bag. Close bag tightly then pipe lines on truffles to resemble football stitching. Let stand until chocolate is set.

Note: Cookies can be stored in covered container at room temperature up to 5 days.




