## THREE PACKET ROAST

## Ingredients

1 (. 7 ounce) package dry Italian-style salad dressing mix 1 (1 ounce) package ranch dressing mix
1 (. 75 ounce) packet dry brown gravy mix
1 (3 pound) boneless beef chuck roast

## Directions

Whisk together the water, Italian dressing mix, ranch dressing mix, and brown gravy mix together in a bowl until smooth. Place the beef roast into a slow cooker, and pour the sauce over top.
Cook on Low until the roast is easily pierced by a fork, 6 to 8 hours.

## MEDITERRANEAN POT ROAST

## Ingredients

1 boneless beef chuck roast (3 lb)
1 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
1 large garlic clove, finely chopped


1/3 cup sun-dried tomatoes in oil, drained and chopped
1/2 cup sliced pitted Kalamata or ripe olives
1/2 cup beef flavored broth
1/2 cup frozen pearl onions

## Directions

1. Spray 12-inch skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium-high heat. Cook beef in skillet about 5 minutes, turning once, until brown. Sprinkle with salt, Italian seasoning and garlic; remove from skillet.


2. Place beef, seasoned side up, in 4-to 5-quart slow cooker. Spread tomatoes and olives over roast. Add broth and onions.
3. Cover and cook on low heat setting 5 to 6 hours or until beef is tender.
4. Remove beef from slow cooker; cover and let stand 15 minutes. Slice beef; serve with beef juice and onions from slow cooker.

## ITALIAN POT ROAST

## Ingredients

1/2 lb sliced baby portabella mushrooms
1 onion halved and sliced
$3-5 \mathrm{lb}$ beef chuck roast trimmed 1.5 oz pkg garlic and herb sauce mix you can substitute pesto mix OR italian dressing mix
1/2 teaspoon red pepper flakes 2 cans (14.5oz) Italian-style diced
 tomatoes drained (or undrained for more gravy)
8 oz can tomato sauce
2 tablespoons cornstarch
2 tablespoons cold water

## Instructions

Put your mushrooms and onion in your crock pot. Place your roast in your crock pot.
Sprinkle your sauce mix and red pepper flakes evenly across your roast.
Pour tomatoes and sauce over top.

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Cover and cook on low for 8-10 hours, it is done when your roast is cooked through and very tender.
Take your roast out, cut into large chunks and keep warm. Skim the fat from the cooking liquid in your crock pot and discard the fat.
In a coffee cup, mix together your water and cornstarch until smooth.
Pour into the juices in your crock pot and stir until combined well.

Cover and cook on high for 20-30 minutes, until your mixture is thickened, stir once.
Add your roast chunks back into your crock pot.
Cover and cook an additional few minutes until everything is heated through.

## TEXAS PULLED PORK

## Ingredients

1 teaspoon vegetable oil
1 (4 pound) pork shoulder roast
1 cup barbeque sauce


1/2 cup apple cider vinegar
$1 / 2$ cup chicken broth
1/4 cup light brown sugar
1 tablespoon prepared yellow mustard
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
1 tablespoon chili powder
1 extra large onion, chopped
2 large cloves garlic, crushed
$11 / 2$ teaspoons dried thyme
8 hamburger buns, split
2 tablespoons butter, or as needed

## Directions

Pour the vegetable oil into the bottom of a slow cooker. Place the pork roast into the slow cooker; pour in the barbecue sauce, apple cider vinegar, and chicken broth. Stir in the brown sugar, yellow mustard, Worcestershire sauce, chili powder, onion, garlic, and thyme. Cover and cook on High until the roast shreds easily with a fork, 5 to 6 hours. Remove the roast from the slow cooker, and shred the meat using two forks. Return the shredded pork to the slow cooker, and stir the meat into the juices.
Spread the inside of both halves of hamburger buns with butter. Toast the buns, butter side down, in a skillet over medium heat until golden brown. Spoon pork into the toasted buns.

directed towards another, it actually has self in mind. For example: "I love you because you make me happy." Eros looks for what it can receive. If it does give, it gives in order to receive. If it fails to get what it wants or expects, bitterness or resentment could develop. Eros would be considered a conditional type of love.
Agapē: Love that is not kindled by the merit or worth of its object, but it originates in its own God-given nature. God is love! Love delights in giving, keeps on loving even when the loved one is unresponsive, unkind, unlovable, and unworthy; it unconditionally continues to love. Desires only the good of the one loved. It is a consuming passion for the well-being of others.
Well my friends, God "Agapē" us! The Word proves it:
John 3:16 For God so LOVED the world that He
GAVE His one and ONLY Son, that everyone who believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. Romans 8:38-39 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor principalities, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Valentine's Day is a pagan holiday, but it is an opportunity for Christians to focus on what love is all about. We must remember that to live without love is not to live at all!

Hello Gardeners, February is the month we prune back rose bushes, and in the Wiregrass area we generally try to get the job done around Feb. 14th, Valentine's Day. The Rose Gardens of Dothan Area Botanical Gardens are maintained by the Wiregrass Rose Society, and volunteers are welcome to come and learn from the experts. Each bush is carefully pruned of all but the main canes, and leaves are removed. Any shoots thinner than a pencil are cut off at the base. This encourages the energy to go toward the root development. In a few weeks your rose bushes will send out healthy, robust new growth. Well-
