

TAXES DUE

Wednesday, January 31, 2018 is the last day to pay 2018 Town & County Tax Bills with no penalty; payments must be received or postmarked by that date. If you have not received a 2018 property tax bill, and your bill isn't paid via an escrow account, please call the Town Clerk/Tax Collector immediately, as the state does NOT allow for the waiving of penalties due to non-receipt of your bill.

Payments can be made in person or by mail at the Town Clerk's office, dropped off in the lockbox at Five Star Bank, or in the locked Dropbox at the Town Hall (24/7) at 103 Main Street.

Payments made February 1 – 28 will need to include a 1% penalty as shown on the tax bills in a box labeled "LATE PAYMENT SCHEDULE ON TOTAL TAX DUE". Likewise, payments made in the month of March are subject to a 2% penalty plus a \$2 Second Notice Fee.

The extreme cold temperatures on January 1st did cause the Genesee Valley Greenway State Park First Day Hikes to be rescheduled for Saturday, January 13th. Three Empire Passes will be given away in a raffle on the Greenway's hikes.

Letchworth is operated by New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation which oversees more than 250 parks, historic sites, recreational trails, golf courses, boat launches and more, which are visited by 69 million people annually.






