



- **5 INCLUDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER.** Classifieds get results fast and often generate immediate sales. If you cannot be available to answer the phone at all times, be sure to specify special calling times such as "after 9pm" or "before 11am."








SHOCKER

I promised you more information about feeding birds, and I will do that next week, but this has been on my mind since being informed last week about the matter and feel it is important that my readers are also aware of it. It does involve the great outdoors but it is not a good thing.

Apparently back in October of 2016 an individual had his riding mower shot up by rifle fire and then he received shot to his mid section while mowing his field behind his house. It was not a shot or two but many, in fact medical respondents were unable to get to him because bullets where still flying around him when they arrived.

Eventually the target shooters were located a half mile away and were charged with assault and reckless endangerment. They had been shooting center fire .308 caliber rifles across flat open fields with only one hedge row between them and the victim with NO BACKSTOP! They had no idea where their bullets were going after they hit the target which was about 160 yards away from them. The hedge row was about 160 yards behind the target and then there was another open field. Now a small rim fire .22 caliber bullet has a maximum range of 1 ½ miles while a .308 has a maximum range of around 4,600 yards or 2 miles. The Marine snipers consider the .308 a effective killer out to 1,000 yards.

OK, these guys were breaking one of the golden rules of shooting – "Know what is behind your target," and be aware that bullets can ricochet long distances. This is upsetting to us who are responsible shooters but what is more shocking to me is that Judge Alex Renzi in Monroe County dismissed the charges! They got nothing while the victim had half his liver and one kidney destroyed, his bowels torn apart and there was a huge exit hole in his back which resulted in long hospital stay, six major surgeries and two weeks later developing a deteriorating condition that require a trip back to the hospital. This incident happened in October of 2016 and the victim wasn't able to return to work until August of 2017.

No one knows for sure why the judge dismissed the charges but one offering was there are no laws saying you have to have a backstop when target shooting. Well there is no law saying you can't ride a black horse down a poorly lite road on a dark night when it is raining wearing black clothing and having no light or reflector; it is just plain lack of common sense (which seems at a premium now days) and RECKLESS! Not only could you get killed but you could cause a serious vehicle accident! Someone suggested that we should have a law about backstops. We have all kinds of laws now, what we need is enforcement of them and some common sense!

I guess this incident is a very sober reminder how important to obey safe gun handling rules, even if they are not laws. A dangerous spot is the public shooting range on the Bartel-Owen Road in the DEC Tonawanda Wildlife Management Area. Check out the trash and shot up range and road signs noting the directions from which the shots came from and the direction they were going. WARNING, don't drive down that road between noon and sunset! And don't hunt behind the ranges, even way back!

On the lighter side the Orleans County Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs had their annual banquet this past Saturday evening and it was one of their best. Neil Newton was honored with a plaque for his 35 years of representing the Federation as councilman to the NYS Conservation Council and also received an award from NYS Assemblyman Steve Hawley for his devotion to the sportsmen of Orleans County. Retired ECO Capt. Mike Van Durme was also awarded a plaque for his help in getting the rifle bill for deer hunting passed in Orleans County along with an award from Assemblyman Steve Hawley.

ARE YOU LIABLE FOR INJURIES ON **YOUR PROPERTY?**

Property owners have a

responsibility to maintain a relatively safe environment that ensures that those entering the property have a reasonable expectation of not getting injured. This legal concept, known as "premises liability," comes into play when an injury is caused by an unsafe or defective condition on someone's property. Regardless of whether the accident takes place in a store or residence, or on public property, two basic rules determine who is legally responsible. First, the owner of the property has a legal duty not to expose those who enter to unreasonable risk due to faulty design, construction, or condition. 



City dwellers looking to buy rather than rent an apartment may come across real estate listings categorized as "co-ops." While co-ops can exist anywhere, Realtor.com notes that they are most common in big cities, comprising as much as 75 percent of the housing inventory in the borough of Manhattan in New York City. Co-op is short for "cooperative," and people who buy into a co-op are not technically buying property but shares in an entity that owns the property where investors will ultimately live. The bigger the apartment in the building, the more shares the buyer will own. Residents of a co-op

typically elect fellow residents to serve on the co-op board. That board is tasked with making a host of important decisions, including choosing who will and will not be allowed to join the cooperative. Co-op boards may require that applicants meet certain financial requirements. Unlike buying a single-family home, duplex, townhouse, or condominium, people interested in buying into a co-op may have put down no less than 20 percent the value of the apartment where they hope to live. Co-op dwellers will also be expected to pay monthly maintenance fees that go toward insurance, taxes and other building expenses.





Salami and Arugula Pizza

Serves: 4

■ Pizza Topping: ■ Flour, for dusting ■ 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil, divided 1 garlic clove, crushed 1/2 teaspoon fresh rosemary, chopped Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper, to taste

1/2 cup partly skimmed ricotta cheese cup mozzarella cheese, grated

2 cups baby arugula ■1 small shallot, thinly sliced ■ 1/2 lemon, juiced

4 slices salami, cut in half lengthwise

Pizza Dough: 1 3/4 to 2 cups all-purpose flour cup cake and pastry flour 2 1/4 teaspoons instant or bread-machine dry yeast (or 1 envelope) 1 teaspoon salt ■1 1/4 cup very warm water

Directions:

1. To make pizza dough, stir together all-purpose flour, cake flour, yeast and salt in a mixer fitted with a dough hook; make a well in the center. Add water. Mix on medium speed until all flour is incorporated into dough; add remaining flour as needed to have soft, slightly sticky dough. Alternatively, you can mix by hand. Turn out I on a well-floured surface. Let I rest covered for 10 minutes. Divide into thirds.

2. Place a pizza stone or upside-down baking sheet in the oven and preheat to 450 F. Gently flatten dough into a circle or rectangle on a lightly floured surface, creating a rim. Transfer to a cornmealdusted pizza peel or another ■ upside-down baking sheet; ■ I slide dough onto the hot pizza I stone or baking sheet. Bake for 8 minutes.

3. Meanwhile, combine 2 tablespoons olive oil in a bowl with garlic, rosemary and salt and pepper to taste. Remove pizza from oven. Brush with olive oil mixture and top with ricotta and mozzarella. Return pizza to oven, baking until cheese is golden and bubbly, ■ about 6 more minutes.

4. Toss arugula and shallot slices in a large bowl with lemon juice, olive oil and salt and pepper to taste. Top the pizza with arugula salad, salami and shaved Parmesan cheese.

5. Cut into wedges or squares with scissors; serve I immediately. ■
