

to discuss the possibilities of bringing a TEDx talk to the Shoals.

TEDx is an offshoot of the TED conference which was founded in the mid 1980's. The early emphasis was technology and design, consistent with its Silicon Valley origins. However, it has since broadened its focus to include talks on many scientific, cultural, and academic topics.

"We felt like this was the perfect time to bring something like this to the Shoals," said Wes Wages. "Florence is known as the Renaissance City and it feels like there has been a renaissance of sorts here in the last few years."

It appears that a combination of "makers," have been leaving their mark on the area.

"And we wanted to meet them," said fellow event organizer, Chris Anderson. "We wanted to get to know them and find out what it is about them and the area that has allowed their ideas to flourish," he said.

That spawned the idea

for TEDxWilsonPark and the theme for the event, "Making Change."

"To do this we're bringing together a stellar, wideranging lineup of innovative thinkers and doers to share their ideas with the Shoals and the world," said Curation Committee Chair Janyce Fadden.

"The goal of TEDxWilsonPark is to bring together bright minds to give talks that are idea-focused on a wide range of subjects, to foster learning, inspiration and wonder – and to provoke conversations that matter," she said.





Workers compensation is there to pay your medical bills and pay 2/3 of your wages while you are off work. The 2/3 of your wages is known as temporary total disability or TTD. That is supposed to approximate your true wages because that pay is tax free. In real life, people find TTD to

be less than their wages and they end up short on money unless they have savings or a spouse that has an income.

Your employer is saving money by accommodating your restrictions. Everything that you cost them from medical bills to the final settlement will be recovered by the insurance company in the form of increased workers compensation premiums. Nonetheless, many employers treat workers well and welcome them back to work while others are not so kind. Many employers don't want an injured employee on their premises and really resent an employee that gets hurt.

I talk to people that are injured on the job every day, several times a day. Often people who get hurt want to tell me why it is the employer's fault or a co-employee's fault that they were hurt. I explain to them that under the law of workers compensation, they don't have to prove who was at fault. There is an interesting case where an employee had a trip and fall injury and could not say why they had a trip and fall injury or what they tripped over and the court held that that was not a work related injury even though it happened on the job at WalMart.

Under the Workers Compensation Act if you have a permanent injury, typically after surgery, you will be entitled to some payment for that permanent injury. If you make a full recovery, and I hope you do, and the doctor gives you no restrictions and a zero impairment rating and you haven't had surgery, after your medical bills are paid and your TTD is paid and your mileage is reimbursed that probably concludes your claim. If you do have a permanent injury, depending on what part of your body was injured, you will have a claim for payment. Under certain circumstances, workers have the right to insist on vocational re-training for a job more suitable for them after their injury.

# How to Find Volunteer Opportunities in Retirement

Dear Savvy Senior,

What resources can you recommend for locating interesting volunteer opportunities? Since I retired, I've been doing some volunteer work but most of the opportunities I've tried haven't been very satisfying.

Unsatisfied Volunteer

Dear Volunteer,

For many retirees, finding a volunteer opportunity that satisfies your interests, utilizes your talents and matches your availability can be challenging. To help you find an interesting and satisfying volunteer opportunity, here are some tips and online tools that can help you search.

#### **Getting Started**

Volunteering is a great way for retirees to make a positive contribution to their community and stay actively engaged, not to mention it's good for your health too. But how can you find the right opportunity for you? Start by asking yourself some basic questions like: What types of organizations or activities are you interested in? What kind of skills can you offer a volunteer organization? How much time are you willing to give? What do you want to gain from your experience (for example, meet new people, learn new skills, help those in need, exposure to a particular issue)?

Once you get a general idea of what you'd like to do, there are dozens of volunteer websites that can help you search for different opportunities in your area.

Most sites work like search engines that let you choose an area of interest and type in your ZIP code or city and state. The sites will then give you a list of opportunities that you can check into. Depending on your interest and expertise, here are some top websites to help you get started.

General volunteer matching sites: To find a wide variety of volunteer opportunities in your community, check out *VolunteerMatch.org*, *IdeaList.org* and *AllForGood.org* – a Point of Light website (the world's leading volunteer service organization) that lets you search for local volunteer opportunities or start your own project and invite others to help you. Also see *HandsOnNetwork.org*, another Point of Light enterprise that connects volunteers to opportunities through more than 250 volunteer centers throughout the U.S.

**Retiree volunteer sites:** If you're interested in opportunities targeting older adults and retirees, some good options include AARP's *CreateTheGood.org*, along with *SeniorCorps.gov*, which matches retirees with community projects and organizations that need experienced volunteer help.

Senior Corps offers three different programs: RSVP, which has a variety of volunteer activities with flexible time commitments; the Senior Companion Program that brings together volunteers with homebound seniors who have difficulty with day-to-day living tasks; and the Foster Grandparent Program that matchers volunteers with kids in the community that have exceptional needs.

Government-sponsored sites: There are also a number of government-sponsored websites that can help you look for different volunteer opportunities. To locate dozens of general options in your area visit Serve.gov. To find natural and cultural volunteer opportunities in places like national and state parks, see Volunteer.gov. 



# ON YOUR DEBT

## **How Long Does It** Take to Receive Your Federal Tax Refund?

The IRS will generally issue most

refunds in less than twenty (21) calendar days. However, many different factors can affect the timing of your refund after they receive your return. Even though the IRS issues most refunds in less than twenty (21) days, it is possible your refund may require additional time to process. You also have to remember to take into consideration the time it takes for your financial institution to post the refund to your account if receiving electronically or if you are receiving via US mail, the travel time through the mail system.

What do you do if it been longer than 21 days and you still have not received your refund?

Some tax returns take longer to process than others for many reasons, such as when a return:

- 1. Includes errors;
- 2. Is incomplete;
- 3. Is affected by identity theft or fraud;
- 4. Includes a claim filed for an Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or an Additional Child Tax Credit (ACTC) -

According to the Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes (PATH) Act, the IRS is required to hold EITC and ACTC refunds until mid-February. The IRS expects the earliest EITC/ACTC related refunds to be available in taxpayer bank accounts or debit cards if you chose direct deposit will approximately February 27, 2018, and that is only if there are no other issues with the tax return.

- 5. Includes a "Form 8379, Injured Spouse Allocation", which could take up to 14 weeks to process;
- 6. They in general need more information from you to process the return and if this is the case they will contact you by mail and let you know specifically what is needed to process your return.

#### Should You Call the IRS?

I generally say "NO" unless you are trying to increase your blood pressure or you are really bored. In all seriousness, you should only call if it has been:

- 1. Twenty (21) days or more since you e-filed your
- 2. Six (6) weeks or more since you mailed your return, or when
- 3. Where's My Refund? tells you to contact the IRS. Where's My Refund? is a great research tool and will update you on the status of your refund. To utilize this IRS site, you will need the following:
  - a. Social security number or ITIN
- b. Your filing status (Single, Married Filing Jointly, Married Filing Separately, Head of Household or Qualifying Widow
- c. Your exact refund amount (Found at the bottom of page two (2) on your copy of your Return)

If you want to use a mobile device to check your refund status, then use the following link IRS2Go app and download it.

# Medicare Minute "4 Parts of Medicare"

Did you know there were four parts to Medicare not two? Did you know that two of the parts you can get through the federal government but the other two parts, if you choose to take them, must be purchased through private insurance companies? # A Different Kind of Sickness

My young granddaughter went to her first sleepover last weekend. She enjoyed it and made it fine, but as it is with most youngsters, the first time away from home can be a bit of a challenge.

As she told of her experience, I was reminded of a story I once read of another little girl who spent the night with a friend for the first time. Not only was it her first time to stay overnight with this friend, but her first night to ever be away from her parents. The mother of the friend knew that it might be a little difficult

for their guest so she kept an eye on her.

The young child did fine until it got close to bedtime – and then it became obvious that she was not content. She grew quiet and tears started to well in her eyes. The mother of her friend asked, "Honey, are you homesick?" The youngster looked up and

While these two terms could be used interchangeably, there is also a distinction that can be made between them. "Home" sickness is usually a longing to be in comfortable and safe surroundings of which we are familiar. According to WebMd, we are contagious a full day before we have any We remain symptoms. contagious for 3-7 days after we start feeling sick. Kids may be able to spread the virus until all of their symptoms fade.

The flu is spread through droplets in the air. Little beads of moisture that contain the flu virus during a sneeze or cough can travel up to six feet. We are exposed to the flu virus when we breathe the droplets in or if they land in our mouth, nose, or eyes. We can also get it if we touch a place those droplets land like a desk, counter top, doorknob, chair back, stair railing, or your arm - and then touch our face. The virus can live on hard surfaces for up to 48

The flu-season is not over. So, let's be courteous should we be unfortunate enough to contract it. We should stay home for at least 24 hours after your temperature goes back down on its own. That means without the help of medicines like fever reducers.

The flu shot may help to a point, but it is no guarantee you will not contract it. Flu medicines may help us feel better, but we can still make

other people sick.
So let's do everyone a favor and act responsibly. We should spare our co-workers and classmates if we are sick. The Lord knows when we are strong in the faith so it will not be an issue for us or our children missing church one week. Older folks who are

generally much less active do not need to be exposed to week's worth of everyone's contagious contacts on one of the few days they get out during the week.

When mom and dad have the flu and grandma and grandpa take the redcheeked kids for a few days, they may already have the

virus. It is not time to drag the kids out to Wal-Mart on a Saturday so that several hundred others can come into contact with the virus.
We can't stop the flu, but

a little common sense can certainly slow the spread of it and save others the same miseries and inconveniences.

# BOSS SAYS GET A CREDIT CARD

Dear Dave,

I recently got a new job that requires monthly expenses of almost \$5,000 that are reimbursed. I can't swing that kind of money right now, and my company told me to get a credit card to cover things. I'm trying to get out of debt, and I don't like this idea. What should I do?



Dear John,

Your company should be fronting the money for these expenses. When you talk about the cost of doing business, it's the responsibility of the company not the employee — to pay expenses.

If I send someone on the road to make money for my company, I pay the bills. It doesn't matter if you're talking about hotel rooms, airfare, or rental cars, those are my expenses. If it's someone who travels a lot, we give them a company debit card. If it's just an occasional thing, we'll give them money out of petty cash. But a company shouldn't treat its employees this way. That's just plain wrong.

It's a mystery to me how some segments of Corporate America have sold her finances, because she and her financé want to make an offer on a house. The bank won't



their employees on the idea of being the company bank. Ultimately, the decisionv is yours. If you don't mind covering your company's expenses and getting reimbursed, but you don't want to go into debt, you'll have to save and build up a \$5,000 business expense fund in a separate checking account. This should be used only for business expenses, and what's spent should be replenished immediately when they reimburse you.

You're in an unusual spot, John. Personally, I think this is an unprofessional way to run a business. But if you like your job, and want to stay without taking on any more debt, the good news is you'll only have to fill up your expense account one time.




