Lovely Facts about Valentine's Day

The popular medieval folk belief that birds choose their mates on February 14 made doves a favorite symbol for Valentine cards. The dove was sacred to Venus and other love deities and was known for choosing a lifelong mate.

Nearly 10 new candy "conversation heart" sayings are introduced each year. Recent additions have included "Yeah Right," "Puppy Love," and "Call Home."

Americans spend around \$277 million on Valentine cards every year, second only to Christmas.

On Valentine's Day 2010, 39,897 people in Mexico City broke the record for the world's largest group kiss.

Started by a group of feminists, "Quirkyalone Day" is celebrated on February 14 as an alternative to Valentine's Day. It is geared toward people who "resist the tyranny of coupledness." Another alternate Valentine's Day celebration is SAD (Single Awareness Day), which reminds people that they don't need to be in a relationship to celebrate life.

Lace is often used on Valentine decorations. The word "lace" comes from the Latin laques, meaning "to snare or net," as in to catch a person's heart.[3]

Today is Valentine's Day. Or, as men like to call it, Extortion day.- Jay Leno

Throughout history, there have been approximately eight St. Valentines. Three of them had special feast days in their honor. The two St. Valentines who most likely inspired Valentine's Day are Valentine of Terni and Valentine of Rome, though some scholars speculate they are actually one person.

The rose has historically been a symbol of love. On Valentine's Day, nearly 189 million stems of roses are sold in the U.S.

Famous people born on Valentine's Day include John Barrymore (1882), Jimmy Hoffa (1913), Jack Benny (1894), Carl Bernstein (1944), Renée Fleming (1959), and Florence Henderson (1934).

A kiss on Valentine's Day is considered to bring good luck all year.

The saying "wearing your heart on your sleeve" is from the Middle Ages. Boys at this time would draw names of girls to see who would be their "Valentine" and then wear the name pinned on their sleeve for a week.

Richard Cadbury produced the first box of chocolates for Valentine's Day in the late 1800s.

Traditionally, young girls in the U.S. and the U.K. believed they could tell what type of man they would marry depending on the type of bird they saw first on Valentine's Day. If they saw a blackbird, they would marry a clergyman, a robin redbreast indicated a sailor, and a goldfinch indicated a rich man. A sparrow meant they would marry a farmer, a bluebird indicated a happy man, and a crossbill meant an argumentative man. If they saw a dove, they would marry a good man, but seeing a woodpecker meant they would not marry at all.

Each year 300,000 letters go through Loveland, Colorado, to get a special heart stamp cancellation for Valentine's Day.

There is a town in Texas called Valentine, but for not for a romantic reason. The first train to arrive there happened to do so on February 14

Our wonderful shelter volunteers take puppies and kittens into the playroom for time out of their cages. They play and pounce and have a great time. Sometimes they are in the playroom for a few minutes and sometimes the volunteers keep them out for long periods of time. They find joy in the moment, rather than worrying about when they will be put back in their cages.

Through the years, we have taken hundreds of dogs off chains during neglect investigations or when owners have asked that we pick up their dogs. We have never seen one hesitate to leave the chain and follow us to the car. In fact, they are thrilled to do so, even if they have never met us. They are happy in the moment.

I think of them when I ask my dog if he wants to go bye-bye. His answer is always the same - "Yes, I will go with you! Yay, I'm going someplace!" He doesn't worry about if he is going to the veterinarian or if it is hot outside or if there is snow on the ground. He is committed to going bye-bye.

There is a wonderful gerbil at the shelter now. In typical gerbil style, he loves to shred things. I put a cereal box in one time. He did not look at it, worried about it filling too much of his space or how he was going to demolish it. No, he went right to work. He started tearing it apart, as only a gerbil can do. Naps were taken occasionally in the box, before he absolutely shredded every inch.

We could learn so much from animals. Yes, we need to be concerned about making correct choices, getting things accomplished, and making a positive difference in the world. We also need to learn to take solace in pockets of joy, find happiness in new adventures, and forgetting our troubles by conquering a task.

To My Valentine
 Valentine's Day is a holiday that has its roots in ancient times. But it was celebrated with gifts until the first cards appeared about 1760. Cards were made at home, with drawings, poems, cutouts and other ways of expressing love. Since then, valentines have changed with the fashions and technology, and they are a popular collectible.



This handmade 1930s card is made from store-bought paper lace and features small chromolithographed pictures of children and flowers. The printed cardboard background is made to fit in an envelope. A collector bought it for \$25 about 1980 and felt the message "To Miss Nash" on the back added to the value. It would cost about \$50 today.

In 1848, Esther Howland of Worcester, Massachusetts, started making valentines from pieces of fancy paper lace and printed pictures with handwritten messages of affection. Soon, she was selling valentines to friends, and started a business that lasted until 1880. The style of the valentine can help tell its age. Mechanical cards with parts that could move so a pictured girl could wave her arm were the newest type in the 1890s. Embossing also was popular. In the early 1900s to 1920s, postcards were used. Postage was 1 cent. Die-cut cards that could be punched out of a single sheet of stiff paper were developed around

1900. These often came as a set with 25 cards for students and one for the teacher. Folded cards were in style by the 1930s and these, plus photographs and digital cards, still are sent today. Vintage homemade lacy cards made from paper lace, "scraps" and small shaped and printed pictures sell today for \$10 to \$100 or more. Age, condition and beauty determine the value.

Q: I have a matching set of two High Point Bending & Chair Co. office-style walnut chairs labeled "Pattern No. 6711." They are in good original condition. How do I determine their value?

A: This company started as Siler City Bending Co. in Siler City, N.C., in 1901. It made bentwood parts for carriages. In 1904, it was reorganized by Capt. Malvola Jackson Boling and renamed High Point Bending & Chair Co., after a nearby city. The company made bentwood chairs and other furniture. It became Boling Chair Co. in 1956. It remained open until at least 1999. Your chairs, with swivel seats and rolling casters, are called banker's chairs. The price of your chairs is only about \$15. They are not in a style that is popular today, and old office chairs are not wanted. Wooden chairs are not as comfortable as the new padded or mesh chairs.

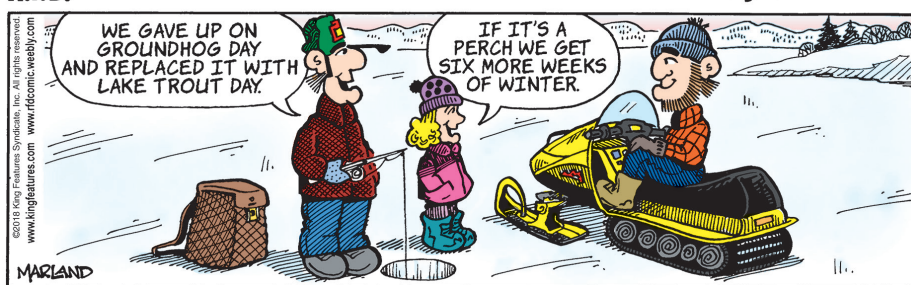

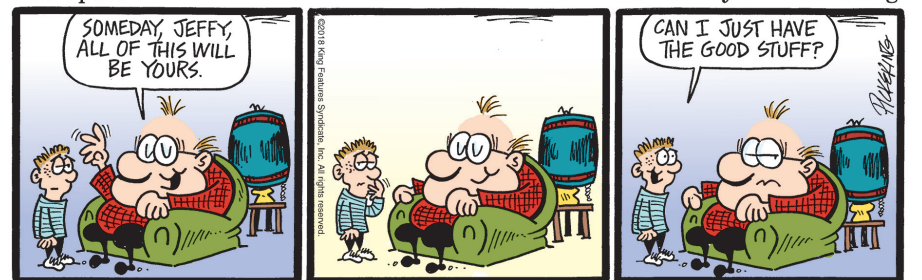

Discharge Upgrades Have Gotten Easier

Veterans who want to upgrade their military discharge now have help. The Department of Veterans Affairs, working with the Department of Defense, has created a new online tool.

There are any number of reasons why a veteran might end up with a less-than-honorable discharge. Events that occurred due to traumatic brain injury, assault or harassment due to sexual orientation, and mental-health conditions such post-traumatic stress disorder are on the list.

For those veterans who wonder if it's worth the bother trying to upgrade, the answer is yes. You'll be eligible for the benefits you earned.

Go online to www.vets.gov/discharge-upgrade-instructions to the How to Apply for a Discharge Upgrade page. Based on your answers to questions, this tool will walk you through whom you need to contact, provide the forms and give tips on appealing your discharge. To begin, click on Get Started and answer all the questions. There are a number of choices under why you want to upgrade your discharge. Undiagnosed PTSD and Traumatic Brain Injury are likely to be the most common reasons.

At the end of the questions you'll get an initial reply. If it says you need to fill out a DoD Form 149, just scroll down to download it.

If you did apply and were approved, you'll be issued a DD215. But you'll want a new DD214 to reflect the changes. Check the instructions for how to get one. If you never did get a DD214, apply at the Get Started link.

Even if you don't get an upgrade, you might be able to have your record changed via a Character of Discharge review process to "honorable for VA purposes." But be aware, it can take nearly a year. Meanwhile, you still can ask for help for service-related conditions.

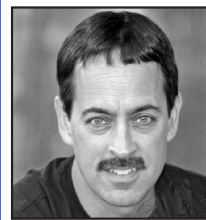

There was only a slight breeze kissing my young cheek, but I smiled with the contented knowledge that it would be enough. My kite had never yet failed to take flight; it was the best in my seemingly infinite neighborhood. Black, my kite was jet black, with a pair of menacing eyes. Slight wind? It may as well have been a hurricane. She would fly, I knew that beyond a doubt.

I could not have been more than seven or eight. The destination was the huge backyard of a church near the home of my grandmother. I often went there to launch my kite, I would fly her for a couple of hours, enjoying the tug of the string and often completely lose sight of her as she climbed. And yet, the consistent tug on the string told me she was still there, assuming her rightful spot in the heavens.

I really cannot say how it happened; and yet I still feel a pang of regret forty years later as I think back on it. One day I launched my indefatigable kite, allowed her to climb out of sight, and then suddenly everything went slack.

My string came drifting back to the earth. The string had broken, and my kite was gone.

Tears stung my eyes as I ran to my grandmother's house. I knew which direction the wind was blowing and, somehow, managed to actually convince my no-nonsense grandmother to drive me around in the car looking for it.

It was a fool's errand. But no more so than the fact that I actually convinced her to put an add in the local paper offering a reward for its return...

I have not flown a kite in years. Decades, actually. Growing up tends to put myriad responsibilities well in front of laying in a field and flying a kite. And no responsibility has consumed the time, thoughts, finances, prayers, and fastings of my wife and myself more so than the raising of three precious children.

We brought each of them home yesterday - eighteen, sixteen, and fourteen years ago. Where did that twenty four hours/decade and a half go? How did my son become a six-foot three-inch high school senior? When did my precocious genius middle child, and lightning-in-a-bottle baby girl become two lovely young ladies?

Where are their car seats? Their play pens?

I can feel the string tugging. They are still on the line, but they are climbing higher each day. I keep hearing the wind whisper words like "college" and "job" and even "date" as they continue to rise. The string is straining. But it will not break, I cannot allow it to break. Something much harder, in fact, will have to take place.

We will actually have to cut the cord.

Mind you, we know this; we always have. From the day my one and only bride found out she was pregnant with our first, we have known, and even

prepared, for the cutting of the cord. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 13:11, "When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things." We have known, and we still know, that our chief job as parents is to prepare our children to move from childhood Christians to adult Christians, from kids who are taken to church to adults who take themselves to church, from minors who are corralled into right behavior to adults who stand right and do right long after their mother and I have, quite literally gone back to the dust from whence we came.

My girls, whom I loved before any other man even knew they existed, will give their hands to some other man. My son, my wife's constant prayer project of decades, will leave her watchful care and stand on his own two wobbly feet that he imagines to be as steady as the white cliffs of Dover.

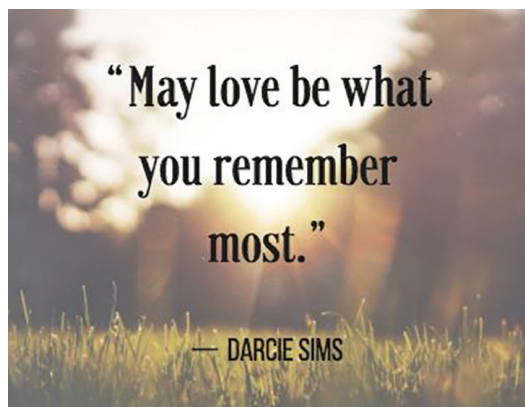

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Package of Crescent rolls
- 1 lb. Ground Italian Seasoned Sausage
- 1/2 lb. Bacon; cut into 1 1/2" pieces
- 1/2 C. Yellow Onion; finely chopped
- 1 Red Pepper; finely chopped
- 2 C. Sliced Mushrooms
- 4 C. Packed Fresh Spinach
- 12 Eggs
- 2 C. 2 % Milk
- 2 C. Shredded Colby Jack Cheese
- 1 Tsp White Pepper
- 1/4 Tsp. Nutmeg
- 1/2 Tsp. Salt

INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 425 Degrees.
- Roll out a tube of crescent rolls onto the bottom of a 13 x 9" glass baking pan.
- Bake for 4 minutes; remove from oven and set aside.
- In a large skillet; saute sausage and bacon together until browned on Medium/High Heat.
- Remove from skillet and place onto a large plate with paper towels to allow grease to drain out. Don't wash the skillet!
- Add meat mixture to the top of the crescent roll crust.
- Using the same skillet with remnants remaining; saute onion and red pepper for several minutes. Add Mushrooms and Spinach; sprinkle with salt and pepper to taste; continue to saute for a few minutes until spinach shrinks.
- Pour vegetable mixture over top of meat mixture in the baking pan.
- Evenly Sprinkle top of vegetables with Colby Jack Cheese.
- Preheat Oven to 350 Degrees.
- In a large mixing bowl; Whisk together eggs, add milk, salt, white pepper and nutmeg; continue whisking until combined.
- Evenly pour Egg mixture over the top of the vegetable mixture.
- Bake for 45-50 minutes until center becomes firm. Allow casserole to cool and firm for 10 minutes before serving.

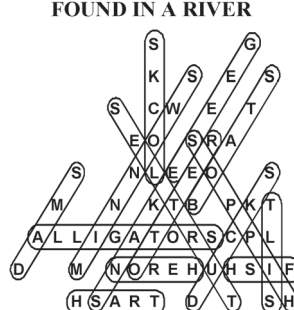

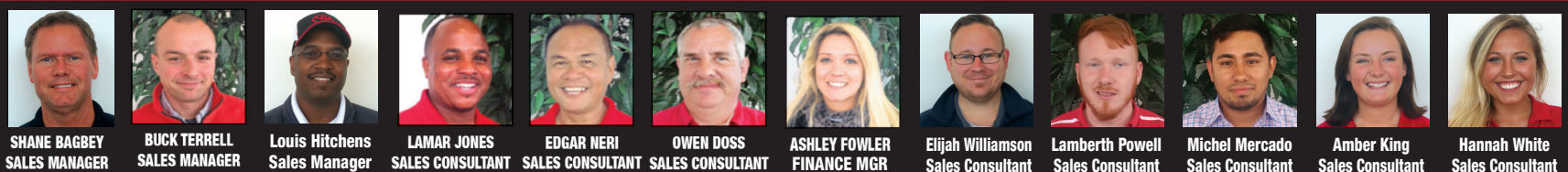
