DOE Rates Kilby at 99

FLORENCE – A recent report card form the State Department of Education shows UNA's
Kilby Elementary School scored
a 99 out of a possible 100 points.
The DOE's Education Report
Card grades each school in the

state on academic achievement, academic growth, and student attendance. The results were calculated using students' performances on the ACT Aspire assessment from the spring of 2017 in grades 3–6. Kilby earned 100% in each

area except absenteeism. Kilby was the highest scoring elementary school in Lauderdale county.

A total of 1,247 schools were measured in Alabama with only 26 (2%) of the schools in the state scoring 99 or higher. Kilby Laboratory School is

the only laboratory school in Alabama and serves as a site for University students to engage in meaningful interdisciplinary teaching, research, and service opportunities.





This is just one of many things that our youngsters can teach us about life-both physical and spiritual. Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part A Part 2"

Last week we discussed how Medicare Part A will cover you if you are admitted into the hospital. A hospital, under Medicare, can be acute care hospitals, critical care hospitals, inpatient rehabilitation facilities, long term care hospitals or mental health care.

The one aspect of Medicare Part A we get the most questions about is coverage at a skilled nursing facility (SNF). To be covered by Medicare at a SNF certain criteria has to be met. First, of course, is you must have Medicare Part A. Next your doctor has determined that you need daily skilled care given by, or under the supervision of, skilled nursing or therapy personnel. Your skilled nursing care will have to be in a SNF that is certified by Medicare.

What a lot of people don't know is that you must have a "qualifying" hospital stay to be covered at a SNF. Under Medicare a "qualifying" hospital stay is at least a 3-day inpatient stay prior to being admitted to the SNF. If you go to the ER and are held one day for observation and are admitted into the hospital for two days this does not constitute a "qualifying" hospital stay. If you are admitted on a Monday and discharged the following Wednesday this is not a "qualifying" hospital stay. In the two examples above those are 2-day inpatient stays. A good rule of thumb is you must be admitted as inpatient for at least three midnights.

You also need to know that Medicare Part A will only cover you for 100 days at a SNF and only 20 of those days are at 100%. In other words days 1-20 are covered at 100%. Days 21-100 you will pay the first \$164.50 per day and Medicare pays the rest of the cost. Starting with day 101 you will pay 100% of the bill.





North Alabama's includes road schedule Southern Utah, a 2017 FCS Playoff participant, and at defending FCS National Champion North Dakota State. The Lions' other four road games are at Alabama A&M, Campbell (N.C.), Jackson State (Miss.), and at Incarnate Word (Texas).

The six road trips combined will have the Lions traveling almost 5,000 miles this season.

Second-year UNA head football coach, Chris Willis, said the 2018 schedule will be challenging.

"Moving up to the FCS being an independent next year made it challenging to get a schedule," Willis said. "We're very happy that we were able to get five home games, and I'm sure our players will be excited about getting to travel to places we don't normally play like Utah, North Dakota, North Carolina and

"We're also excited to have Alabama A&M back on the schedule. That will be a great game for our fans," Willis said. "We're also playing North Dakota State, which is the Alabama of the FCS as the program everybody is chasing. Southern Utah was a playoff team a year ago in the FCS and that will be a tough opener."

UNA opens its 2018 season at Southern Utah on September 1 in Cedar City,

Robotics Event at UNA Feb. 24

FLORENCE-The University of North Alabama will host the 2018 UNA Robotics Competition, Saturday, February 24 from 1-5pm in Flowers Hall on UNA's campus. This will be the first time UNA has hosted an event like this, which will feature more than 200 students on 45 teams from more than 20 schools and three states.

"Coding is the language of our world," said **Lee** Brownell, AMSTI specialist and event coordinator. "Nearly everything you interact with daily is computer controlled. We all need to know more about how and why they work. Additionally, the skills students learn while coding can improve their learning in other areas," he

Teams must bring their own robots to compete which have to fit in a 13x13x13 inch cube. Teams will then compete in three fields, each with a different puzzle. Teams are unaware of the puzzles until the actual competition.

Each team has three hours to score as many points as possible with 90 seconds on each station. Students can retry any field as many times as they want within the three-hour time limit. Additionally, the robot must be autonomous.





I had an on-the-job injury and waited a little over two years to have surgery and now the workers compensation company says I can have the surgery but nothing else. What can I do? Were they supposed to tell me I had a

The insurance company has no duty to tell you to sue them or advise you in any way. I don't think they could tell you wrong and trick you into not filing. At any rate if you don't ask and you don't know and you don't file within the time limit then your

case is over before it started. The law regarding injuries is extensive and fairly complicated. I have seen cases where lawyers missed deadlines or allowed their client to give a full release when

a partial release would have made their client a lot of money. In most cases there is a two year statute of limitations. If you wait more than two years, in most cases, you have no claim. In an on-the-job injury claim, the statute of limitations is two years. However, if the injured worker received temporary total benefits (money while recovering) for a specific injury, the statute begins to run on the date the last payment is made.

I would not want to wait more than two years. It makes me nervous. In your case there is sort of a divided statute of limitations. I don't think this is well recognized but after two years and a day you gave up your right to a lot of tax free money in the form of weekly payments and then a final settlement, the amount of which is determined by many factors such as your previous wages and benefits, as well as how well you recovered from your injury after surgery.

However, I do think that in a workers compensation case, and specifically a workers compensation case, you are still entitled to medical care after two years and could enforce that right in court.

I also believe that as time goes by facts and evidence are lost and medical causation required to be proven becomes far more difficult.

Talking to a lawyer that handles injury cases is usually free. I find it enjoyable to meet people and discus these issues and if I like the case and want the job I say so and if

I don't I say so. I don't mind answering questions.

ON YOUR DEBT

The "G" Notice

We have even had cases where a debt collector lies and says that a partial payment was made in order to revive the statute of limitations. The debt becomes collectible where the collector can never prove a payment was made and our client shows that no payment was ever made to the debt collector. Debt Collection Makes Recent News

The reason this has now come to the forefront is because of the recent case from the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals. Importantly, following that decision, the debt collector applied for a Writ of Certiorari to the U.S. Supreme Court which was denied.

QUIT JOB FOR SCHOOL?

Dear Dave,

My wife and I have \$72,000 in debt from student loans and a car loan. We're trying to pay off our debt using the debt snowball system, and we each make about \$45,000 a year. She's a teacher, and she's planning on going back to school for her master's degree, but she's thinking about quitting her job to do this. She'll be able to make more money with the additional education, and she would only be unemployed for two years. The degree program will cost us \$2,000 out of pocket per semester for two years. Does this sound like a good idea?

Dear Chris,

There's no reason for your wife to quit her job to make this happen. Lots of people — especially teachers—hold down their jobs and go back to school to further their education.

Towever, there were teachers—hold down their outstanding costs of \$1,500 with the funeral services we had to pay out of pocket, I'm not sure trying to make it on one income when you're that deep in debt is a good idea.

Whatever you do, don't borrow more money to make this happen. Cash flow it, or don't do it. We're talking about \$8,000 total, and you've got \$72,000 in debt hanging over your heads already. My advice would be to wait until you've got the other debt knockeď out, then save up and pay cash for school. could slow down your debt snowball, and number with the increase



use some of that to pay for school, but I'd hate to see you lose the momentum you have when it comes to getting out of debt.

The choice is yours, but don't tack on anymore student loan debt. I know her income will go up with a master's degree, so from that standpoint it's a good thing to do. But if you do a good thing a dumb way, it ends up being dumb!

PRE-PLANNING EXPLAINED

Dear Dave,

My grandmother passed away a week ago. She was 98, and I know both she and my grandfather had pre-paid for their funerals in 2004. However, there were because she had outlived the insurance policy attached to the pre-payment plan. I know you say it's always better to pre-plan, not pre-pay, for a funeral. Can you refresh my understanding of this?

Rebecca

Dear Rebecca, Let's use a round figure, and say the cost of a funeral is \$10,000. What would \$10,000 grow to 25 years from now if it were invested in a good mutual fund? Now, juxtapose that

in the cost of a funeral over that time. The average inflation rate of consumerpurchased items is around four percent. So, the cost of funerals, on average, has risen about four percent a year. By comparison, you could've invested that money, and it would've grown at 10 or 12 percent in a good mutual fund.

Now understand, I'm not knocking folks who are in the funeral business. But lots of businesses that provide these services realize more margin in selling pre-paid policies than they do in caskets. In other words, they don't make as much money selling the casket as they do selling a pre-paid policy on the casket.

Do you understand my reasoning? If we knew the exact date she pre-paid, and how much she prepaid, that figure invested in a good mutual fund would be a whole lot more than the cost of a reasonable funeral. It's the same principle behind the reason I advise folks to not prepay college, or just about anything else, that's likely far into the future. The money you could've made on the investment is a lot more than the value of prepaying. Pre-planning, on the other hand, is a great idea for many things including funerals.

I'm truly sorry for your loss, Rebecca. God bless you all.





Create a profile: When you join a matchmaking site you'll need to create a personality profile that reflects who you are, including recent photos, hobbies, interests, favorite activities and more. If you need some help, sites like *ProfileHelper.com* can write one for you for a fee.

Use caution: When you register with a site you remain anonymous. No one gets access to your personal contact information until you decide to give it out, so be prudent whom you give it to. Before meeting, you should chat on the phone or video chat a few times, and when you do meet in person for the first time, meet in a public place or bring a friend along. And if someone asks for money, don't send it. Online dating/sweetheart scams are out there so be aware. If you want to be extra cautious, you can even do a quick background check on your date at *MyMatchChecker.com*.

Don't be naive: In an effort to get more responses, many people will exaggerate or flat out lie in their profiles, or post pictures that are 10 years old or 20 pounds lighter. So don't believe everything you see or read.

its unique wet climate and mystical history. This area also features UNESCO World Heritage registered sacred sites and pilgrimage routes. The beauty and mystery of her home region has been a strong influence on Ozaki's work.

Most recently, Ozaki has been experimenting with her own imaginary world based on scenes of decay and renewal in nature. Should I Buy A Home Warranty?

How many times do you go and buy something and get asked if you want to purchase the "extended warranty"? Sometimes it can be a tough decision because it usually is at a price that you might have to think about whether or not its a good investment.

When it comes to a home warranty, its a no brainer in my opinion. The cost of a one year home warranty usually ranges from \$500-600 depending on the amount of coverage you get, and can easily pay for itself with one repair.

Some of the most frequently asked questions we get about home warranties are usually about the coverage itself.

Ok, so how does this all work? Well, let's say you purchased a warranty when you bought your home and 3 months after you move in your water heater stops working. Basically, you'd call a 1-800 number provided to you by the warranty company and inform them of your problem. They then call a local contractor or service provider that will come out and assess the situation. You pay them a nominal service call fee (usually \$65-95) and the warranty company takes care of everything else.

On small repairs, the benefit might not out weigh the expense. However on a large repair item like a heating or cooling unit, you'd be excited about writing a check for \$75 for a \$900 repair... And I have definitely seen this happen.

On most warranties, the roof, brick, and exterior/ structural things are not covered. For the most part, they cover mechanical things like electrical, plumbing, heating, air conditioning, water heaters, exhaust fans, trash compactors, dishwashers and ovens.

A home warranty is one of those things that if you don't use it, you might think it was a waste of money. But I look at it this way: I'd rather have it and not need it, than need it and not have it.

He was in the top five in MVP voting for five seasons, and was a three-time league batting champion. The switch-hitting Rose had a career .303 batting average and three World Series rings.

impressively, he was a 17time all-star.

The problem is that Pete Rose is banned from baseball for life and his name is not even allowed on the Hall of Fame ballot.

Rose had a penchant for gambling and he made the mistake of gambling on baseball very late in his playing career and later as a manager.

anyone has indicates Rose bet against any of his teams. There are exceptions and situations that as a coach or manager could be bad for individual player health (overusing a pitcher or playing an injured player for example). But overall, I can't think of a better way to get the best effort from a player than for him to bet on his own team to win.

Baseball history has been tainted with several scandals over the years, but nothing that Rose did impacted his statistics as a player. They stand on their own, unlike many who were very closely associated with the steroid era of the late 90's and early 2000's and are eligible for election into the HoF.

Rose's records have none of those controversies.






