Child and teen checkups may prevent depression and suicide

According to a 2015 study by the National Institute of Mental Health, more than 1 in 10 American teens suffer from depression. By that estimate three million teenagers across America that suffer from this debilitating illness. Suicide is the, "third-leading cause of death for 15 to 24-year-olds," a 2018 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention study revealed.

It is normal for teens to have occasional moodiness associated with hormonal changes during puberty. However, there are numerous factors that can take a normal feeling such as depression and make this symptom much worse and prolonged. Things that can contribute to teen depression are, bullying, academic struggles, peer rejection, substance abuse, and unmet mental health needs. **Depression symptoms**

What does depression in

teens look like? Rarely, will

a teenager ever state, "I have a problem" and willingly talk openly to an adult about their feelings. Symptoms of teen depression can present in many ways such as being socially withdrawn, insomnia, low energy, loss of concentration, low self-esteem, physical discomfort, and extreme sensitivity to criticism and rejection.

Child & teen checkup

"Teenagers should be seen yearly by their doctor for a Child and Teen Checkup (C&TC). A Standard screening can help identify any mental health problems early and get resources in place to help young teens," states Denise Sjodin, Crow Wing County Child and Teen Checkup coordinator.

If you are a teenager concerned about your friend, tell a teacher, school counselor, or school nurse of your concerns. If you are a concerned parent of a teenaged child,

Crow Wing County Community Services expends more than \$166 million dollars annually, of which 3.8 percent, \$6.3 million is funded by the county levy. In 2016, total program costs were \$165,758,773 with Medical Assistance programs being the highest spending area at \$109 million, or 65.7 percent of the total program costs. Social Service programs represent the second largest portion of the total at \$45 million, or 27percent. Income Support programs were 7 percent of the total at \$11.2 million.

While this is a large portion of the county budget, Crow Wing County has seen a significant decrease. For example, from 2010 to 2016 budget, Crow Wing County has reduced tax levy dollars by \$1,122,337 million or a 15 percent decrease.







Tax and social security updates

NewsHopperTM

It's tax time again and most of us are keeping a close eye on the mail box for the last of those tax documents needed to file our annual tax returns.

This year, most seniors receiving Social Security retirement benefits have something to look forward to when they file their state income tax return. The tax reform bill we passed last year reduced and in many cases completely eliminated the state income tax on Minnesota seniors' social security retirement benefits.

Nearly 284,000 Minnesota senior citizen tax returns (single and married filing jointly) will receive tax reductions; approximately 72,000 of those no longer pay any state income tax on their social security retirement benefits.

When the Legislature convened in 2017, the very first bill I authored (H.F. 9) was a complete phase-out of the state income tax on senior's Social Security retirement benefits. The House Tax Committee heard my proposal on Jan. 18 of last year and my bill was laid over for possible inclusion in the comprehensive tax reform bill that was being assembled.

I did not get everything I asked for, since I would have preferred total elimination of the state income tax on Social Security retirement benefits. However, I am pleased to report that we in the Legislature approved and the governor signed a tax reform bill that significantly reduced (and in many cases eliminated) the state income tax on our seniors' Social Security retirement benefits.

If you are one of those many hundreds of thousands of Minnesota seniors that are on social security, please make sure you mention to your tax preparer to factor in Minnesota's new tax policy concerning how much, if any of your Social Security benefits are now subject Minnesota state income tax.

On a separate topic, I also want to welcome Rep. Dave Baker, an Aitkin High School graduate now representing the Willmar area, back to his old stomping grounds this Monday. We will be visiting with Riverwood Healthcare Center and Addiction Recovery Ministry personnel. Dave will be discussing legislation he is chief author of, the "Opioid Family Recovery Act (H.F. 1440)." Dave has taken a leadership role in working on the serious opioid abuse problem we have in Minnesota.

Lastly, the state continues to experience difficulty with the vehicle licensing and registration system. We have created a help web page http://www.house. leg.state.mn.us/DMV/Comment where citizens can submit concerns and get a response back by email.


