We thank and appreciate everyone who drove Tina to an appointment, watched Jacob while we were getting treatments, made us home cooked meals, cleaned our house, and just ran errands for us. We thank all of the people who I have the pleasure of working with at Groveland Correctional Facility, for donating your vacation time so I could be home when my family needed me the most. I would pass on to Tina the endless inquiries as to how she was feeling. Consistently, she was always so grateful for the care and concern my coworkers displayed toward her.

There is one person that I need to give an exceptional Thank You to, and that is Tina's visiting nurse. We met her when she was assigned to Tina's care mid way thru her treatments. Once Tina progressed into HOSPICE care the visiting nurse's duties were over and she would have been well within her duties to move on. However, Sonya could not abandon Tina. She continued to be available, and would care for Tina on a volunteer basis, and without pay, right up to and after her death. Sonya, your caring touch, your compassionate bedside manner, your skills, your professionalism, and your friendship mean more to Tina, Jacob and I than you will ever know. And for that, we all are so happy to count you as one of our friends. Our family is forever grateful and in your debt.

So again I ask, how do you say thank you when the results of people's love, care and concern are too overwhelming to be able to put into words? The best answer I can come up with is to yes, say the words, but more importantly, follow up those words with paying it forward. To all who were there for Tina and our family at our darkest hour, from the bottom of our hearts,




