

### **FACING REALITY**

If a defendant in a civil suit ignored a plaintiff's complaint an accompanying summons from the court, how would the court respond? If it were a criminal case, the defendant would be arrested. This is not the case with a civil suit, however, although that does not necessarily mean that a complaint can be ignored. The sanction for failing to respond to the complaint is that the plaintiff can get the court to enter a "default" against the defendant. This prevents the defendant from entering any defenses on the merits of the case in the future. The plaintiff can then proceed to obtain a "default judgment," which concludes the case against the defendant, and can attempt to enforce it.







### **Create a Sale-Worthy Showplace**

The sentiment "don't judge a book by its cover" can be applied to many situations. When it comes to selling their homes, homeowners should remember this adage as they prepare their homes for prospective buyers.

### Which Renovations are Worth an Investment?

The cost of remodeling a home is easier to stomach when homeowners can expect to recoup a sizable percentage of the costs of the renovation. While basing renovations on their potential impact on resale value may be unwise, return on investment is something homeowners must consider when mulling renovation projects.

Many homeowners wonder which renovations will resonate most strongly with potential For Rent: 3-bedroom apartment buyers when a home is put up for sale. According to Remodeling magazine, homeowners are less likely to recoup their investment in a major kitchen or bathroom remodel than they would with basic home maintenance, such as new siding. That's because buyers are most interested in how the bones of the house - or those elements that keep the house protected and can be costly to fix - were maintained.

Each year Remodeling magazine issues its "Cost vs. Value Report," which highlights the projects that offer the most return on investment. In 2016, the No. 1 project was the Albion area.

installation of fiberglass attic insulation, which could produce 116.9 percent recouped cost and a resale value of \$1,482. Rounding out the top five were manufactured for details. stone veneer for the exterior, a standard new garage door, a steel entry door, and an upscale garage door.

Projects with the least return on investment tended to be more expensive undertakings that offered returns of roughly 57 percent. Such projects included bathroom additions, upscale bathroom additions, upscale master suite additions, upscale bathroom remodels, and deck additions.

For those considering more expensive renovations, keep these figures in mind, courtesy of Forbes.

- A major remodel of a 200-square-foot kitchen can cost around \$113,000, with homeowners recouping 60 percent.
- Replacing 1,250-square feet of siding with new fiber siding can cost \$13,000, but homeowners can expect to recoup 80 percent of that cost at resale.
- Replacing 10 existing double-hung windows with vinyl low-e glass windows is valued at \$14,000, and the return can be between 68 and 73 percent.

There are even renovations that seem like good ideas but can actually hurt the resale value of a home. MSN Money lists these projects as money-wasters for those who want to sell soon.

- · Lavish lighting fixtures can look dated in a few years when trends change.
- Wallpaper or textured walls can be notoriously hard to change, and buyers know that.
- Kitschy renovations, such as 1950s diner tiles, may appeal to only a select number of people. Neutral renovations are better if resale is the goal.
- Many real estate experts warn against converting a bedroom into anything other than a bedroom even for the purposes of a home office. Such conversions can immediately devalue the property. The same can be said about combining two small bedrooms into one larger space.

Homeowners should investigate potential renovations before committing the time and money to something that may offer little value at resale. 🗖



### Four Ways Established Professionals Can Improve Their Résumés



Job applicants of all ages need to customize their résumés to reflect the preferences of today's recruiters.

Changing jobs can be a difficult decision to make, especially later in one's career. In many ways, landing a new job is more challenging than ever thanks to the technology-driven society in which people live. Information is shared faster than ever, and applying for jobs isn't the same as it might have been as recently as a decade ago.

### 2. Aim for the future

Rather than emphasize what you did, highlight what you plan to do. This means giving greater weight to the expertise that will translate into your new position. Chances are you can find skills that you honed in one or more jobs that translate into credentials that can be used on another. All of the skills mentioned should be relevant to your career objective and not just added to pad the résumé. Therefore, unless your brief stint waiting tables exemplifies how you developed customer service skills, eliminate it.

### 3. Choose the right keywords

It's important to optimize a résumé for digital scanning, which has become a major component of the employment sector. This includes using the correct keywords and phrasing so that your résumé will get "flagged." Take your cue from the job advertisements themselves and mimic the verbiage used. Replace the lingo accordingly, tailoring it to each job you apply for. Also, consult the "about us" area of a prospective employer's website. This area may offer clues about buzz words for the industry.

### Set yourself apart

Engage in activities that can improve your marketability. Be sure to list training, coursework, degree, or volunteer efforts that pertain directly to the skills needed for the job to which you're applying. These additions can tip the scales in your favor over another applicant.

Résumés continue to evolve, and it is crucial for applicants — especially established workers — to familiarize themselves with the changes and market themselves accordingly. ■

### Put a Healthy Spin on an Old Family Favorite

Meatloaf is a dinnertime staple for many families. A favorite of adults and children alike, meatloaf can be prepared however cooks see fit, making it a versatile dish for family dinners. Parents who want to enjoy meatloaf with their families and do so while promoting healthy diets can try the following recipe for "Turkey, Vegetable & Oat Mini-Meatloaves with Marinara Sauce" from Michelle Dudash's "Clean Eating For Busy Families" (Fair Winds).

### Turkey, Vegetable & Oat Mini-Meatloaves with Marinara Sauce

Serves 6

Expeller-pressed canola oil spray

- 1 8-ounce package crimini (baby bella) mushrooms (about 2 1/2 cups)
- 1 small yellow onion, cut into eighths
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin oil
- 1 cup dry rolled oats
- I 2 large eggs
  - 1 pound lean ground turkey (or beef or bison)
  - 13/4 cups pasta sauce, divided
  - 3 tablespoons red wine vinegar
  - 1 tablespoon Italian herb seasoning
  - 1/2 teaspoon salt

  - 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Preheat oven to 375 F. Coat a 9 x 13-inch baking pan or 6 mini loaf pans with spray. Pulse mushrooms in a food processor until finely chopped and add them to a large bowl. Repeat with onion and garlic.

Place a large frying pan over medium heat and add oil. When oil is shimmering, add vegetables and sauté for 7 minutes or until water releases and evaporates completely, lowering the heat as necessary. Set aside.

Process the oats until they are of a fine consistency. Whisk the eggs in the bowl used for the vegetables. Add processed oats, turkey, 3/4 cup of pasta sauce, cooked vegetables, vinegar, Italian seasoning, salt, and pepper and stir together with a fork until blended.

Scoop the mixture into 6 mounds on the pan or into each miniloaf pan, about 3/4 cup each. Shape each mound into a 4 x 2-inch loaf. Spread remaining 1 cup of pasta sauce on top of the loaves, distributing evenly.

Bake on middle rack for 25 minutes, turning pan midway through cooking, until loaves are firm or a thermometer inserted in the middle reads at least 165 F. Allow loaves to rest for 5 minutes before serving.

Recipe Notes: You can finely chop vegetables with a knife rather than using a food processor if you prefer.

Whole oats can be added to the meat mixture for a more rustic texture.






