Bill Allows for Second Job

superintendents. Under existing law, county education superintendents are not allowed to have additional employment of any kind. They are also limited to \$600 in travel expenses annually. City superintendents have never been subjected to either of these restrictions.

The law preventing county superintendents from having additional employment is over 90 years óld.

"We are simply giving our county education superintendents the same privileges that our city superintendents have," according to Senator **Tim Melson**, (R-Florence), the sponsor of the bill.

Senate Bill 153 eliminates the penalty for acquiring additional employment if his or her contract allows it. However, the bill does not remove any power from county boards of education in negotiating the specifics of the contracts with superintendents.





January 21. "You know you've been here too often when the cath lab staff know you by name," joked Payne as he waved to a nurse. All Payne's procedures were performed at Eliza Coffee Memorial Hospital.

North Alabama Medical Center is an accredited Chest Pain Center with PCI and was reaccredited by the American College of Cardiology in October 2017.

Dr. Bill Heaton performed the heart cath procedure on Payne after a recent heart attack. According to Payne, he had a 50/50 rate of survival, but that was a risk he was willing to take. "Dr. Heaton took excellent

care of me over the years and I knew I was in good hands. You could see true, heartfelt concern when he was explaining what he'd be doing during this latest

stent," said Payne.
"The number of heart caths performed here is truly amazing," said Ricky Williams, Cardiac Cath Lab Director. "This illustrates our patient's commitment and frust in the dedicated physicians and staff we have at North Alabama Medical Center."

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, more 730,000 Americans suffer from a heart attack each year. The most common symptom of a heart attack for both men and women is chest pain or discomfort.

Choosing A Doctor Under Workers Compensation

When an employee is injured in Alabama, while on the job, doing their job and notifying their employer of the injury, the employer is required to pay for the employee's medical treatment related to the

That's a lot of information. For instance, the employee has to be doing their job and not engaged in "horseplay" or their own personal business. The employee has to notify the employer that they were injured. Either the employer saw it, was told about it orally within four (4) days or written notice was given

within 90 days. Otherwise, the employee did not give notice pursuant to law. The medical treatment has to be treatment that is results from or is a natural consequence of the injury.

The employer can pick the first doctor and if the employee is dissatisfied, the employee may demand a panel of four (4) doctors chosen by the employer from which to choose one (1).

If the employer's doctor recommends surgery, the employee may ask for a second surgical opinion and again receive a panel of four (4) doctors. Obviously the choice of doctors is important. Some are better than others. Some specialize in different types of treatment. The choice needs to be an informed choice.

Where we see a problem is when, after an injury, a doctor, not an approved treating physician, recommends further treatment. Usually this treatment is with another doctor that's not approved by the employer. This creates several problems. First, if the employer does not preapprove the treatment, the employer does not have to pay for the treatment. Second, if the treatment is the result of an on-the-job injury, Blue Cross Blue Shield or other third party carriers do not have to pay for the treatment. This leaves the employee responsible for the bill. Occasionally people need treatment so badly that they will deny that its work related in order for their Blue Cross to pick it up. If you don't know that it's related or you deny that the treatment is related, it's difficult to come back later and prove that it is related. Good personal injury lawyers give free consultations. 

The grandma went to Walmart, Best Buy and Sams and purchased \$7,000 in gift cards. She intended to buy a total of \$9,000 worth so she could rescue her grandson.

My friend states, "She was scared, barely ate or slept for four days. She thought they were watching her. They had told her that the grandson would call her last night after he got home from jail. She waited all day today, and then finally called my sister

to find out why he didn't call. My sister and I went to Mom's house, she wasn't home. She was out buying those last two gifts cards for the scammers. When (mom) got home, she still wouldn't tell us what was going on. They had her so frightened. She finally told us, only after speaking with the real

Sadly, the grandma was a victim of a technique called "phone spoofing." There are apps you can install on your smartphone that allow you to change your caller ID. This is handy for pranking a friend by

giving them a call from the FBI but criminals can also use it to masquerade as representatives of banks, creditors, insurance companies, or, in this case, the grandson.

Grandma likely received a friend request from a stranger or someone pretending to be a friend of hers. The "friend" was then able to scour her Facebook profile for names of family members. Once they had the grandson's name, they had the bait to take her money.

The scammer immediately used the gift card numbers to purchase merchandise then likely sold that merchandise to convert it into cash. There is no way to track these criminals. Her bank account was cleared out with no chance of recovery and very little chance of apprehending the criminals.

The criminals seem to prey more on old folks because they

know their brains don't work as well as they used to. So this is a warning for all of you to lock down your Facebook page so that only "friends" can see your profile. Don't accept friend requests from people you don't know and remove the names of your children and grandchildren from your Facebook profile. If you have an old person in your life, please watch out for them!





Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part A and B"

Before we begin talking about Medicare Part B I would like to clear up something that was in last week's article concerning Medicare Part A. As I stated in the article Part A has a deductible of \$1,340 per benefit period. I also stated that if you paid into Medicare for 40 quarters that Part A was free to you. I was referring to the fact that you would not have to pay a premium to Medicare for Part A, not that it would exclude you from paying the deductible.

Medicare Part B is the part of Medicare that is billed when you receive services as an outpatient by a Medicare approved provider, such as your primary care physician (PCP) or specialist.

Although a visit to your doctor is the primary way that you will use Medicare Part B, it also covers many other services. We will discuss the other services in next week's article.

If you are turning 65 in 2018, Medicare Part B will have a premium of \$134/mo. Because there is a premium attached to Medicare Part B this coverage is optional. This means you are not required to enroll in Medicare Part B. There are two important things to remember about Part B being optional. First, if you opt out of Part B you will have no coverage under Medicare for your outpatient services. Second, if you decide at a later date to enroll in Part B there can be a late

enrollment penalty applied that will last as long as you live and have Part B. There are exceptions to the late enrollment penalty that we will discuss in future articles.

Working on Six Decades

Dedicated and Persistent have described Betty McCutcheon for her entire adult life

Betty McCutcheon has been serving the Shoals area as an active volunteer and community advocate for nearly six decades. Affectionately referred to as Ms. Betty, she is known and loved by her friends, colleagues, and those for whom she advocates.

Over her 57 years in the Shoals, McCutcheon has volunteered for and contributed to more than a dozen local organizations and causes. McCutcheon is still going strong at 80 years of age.

"It's great to meet people

and get to know them in all the volunteer work I do," she said. "You really learn to appreciate people and what we have here. You come to know your community.'

McCutcheon is a licensed social worker with a Master's degree in social work from the University of Alabama and 21 years' experience with the Department of Human Resources (DHR) plus a cumulative tenure of over 34 years with the state. McCutcheon is now an active volunteer for Shoals CASA (Court Special CASA Appointed Advocates).

recruits, trains, and supports volunteer advocates for children in the custody of the state.

CASA volunteers perform independent court investigations, prepare court reports, submit monthly reports on their cases and testify in court on behalf of abused and neglected children in Colbert and Lauderdale counties. According to McCutcheon, CASA McCutcheon, volunteers have more oneon-one time to devote to the children they help since the state system can often be overwhelmed

with cases.
"The children we work with know we care about them," she said. "These children need someone who is consistent. Some have had as many as three DHR case workers before

coming to CASA." CASA works conjunction with DHR, but CASA volunteers do their independent own investigations. If she gleans information that DHR needs over the course of an investigation, she will provide it. McCutcheon is a dedicated investigator, traveling hundreds of miles when necessary to track down everything she needs for her investigations.

"I've been described as persistent," she said. "And I AM persistent."

McCutcheon has made a lasting impression on the numerous children she's advocated for through her work at DHR and her volunteerism at CASA.

"One of the best moments I can recall in my time at CASA was meeting a lady placed in foster care when she was young who wanted to volunteer," said CASA's executive director, Andrea Holt. "She had high remarks about the case worker who had

helped her when she was a teenager--the one person from the department who she believed really cared and listened to her. When I asked if she remembered the case worker's name, she said it was Ms. Betty.

"It solidified for me how much Ms. Betty has given to other people."

McCutcheon's contributions to the community go beyond CASA. far She currently volunteers for or contributes to the Sheffield Police Department, Room in the Inn Shoals, the St. Francis project at Trinity Episcopal Church, the Shoals Community Soup Kitchen, the Service League (formerly Junior League), Sidney's Safe, and the Shoals Master Gardeners. Through the Master

Gardeners, McCutcheon has facilitated a number of projects in the Shoals area and beyond, including the Sheffield Police Department, Episcopal churches in the area, and Camp McDowell in Winston County.

Her past community involvement is as varied and active as her work is today. McCutcheon was part of the original team that founded Safeplace in 1981. She later went on to volunteer in the shelter and serve on the board. Over 30 years ago McCutcheon was inspired by an outof-state college to start a program to provide study snacks for college students during final exams. The three Episcopal churches in the Shoals have carried the idea forward ever since, providing study snack bags to students preparing for their exams.

McCutcheon also volunteered for the Tennessee Valley Art Center and the Westminster Interfaith Caring Place (WICP) until it closed its doors in early 2015. She is currently a member of the advisory board and will remain involved when the nonprofit reopens in the near future under its new name, Caring Place Adult

Day Services.
"[Caring Place] is dear to my heart; my mother passed away with Alzheimer's," McCutcheon said. "We didn't give up, and didn't disband. We're ready again.

A Lesson From The Olympics

I am a big fan of the Olympic Games. It does not matter if we are talking summer or winter, I enjoy them all and try to watch as many of the competitions as time allows. They bring out my patriotic spirit and I am always rooting for Team USA! On another level I also enjoy the Olympics because they tend to cause counties across the world to put aside their differences for a little while and unite for a common cause which is a beautiful

Beyond the competition of the games I love hearing the backstories of the athletes. Not only are they heartwarming and

inspiring, but there are also a lot of life lessons to be learned from their experiences. Among those, here is one that is worth sharing.

Therese Johaug, a three-time cross-country medalist from Norway was not allowed to compete in the 2018 PyeongChang Winter Games. The reason is that she tested positive for an anabolic steroid known as "clostebol." Hence, she was banned from participating as an athlete, being accused of doping. "Doping" is when you use drugs to enhance your performance in a competition. I think we all would agree that doping should not be allowed, but here is her story.

The drug showed up because it was an ingredient in an ointment that she used to sooth her sunburned lips. In her own words she explained, "I feel I did everything right. I went to an expert who gave me this ointment and asked him if the cream was on a doping list. The answer I got was 'no."

She appealed her case to a Court of Arbitration because she felt that her ban treated her unfairly under the circumstances. Nevertheless, the court upheld the initial ban issuing this explanation: "Ms. Johaug failed to conduct a basic check of the packaging, which not only listed a prohibited substance as an ingredient but also included clear doping cautionary warning?

As I considered this story I thought of how many times people have gotten themselves in trouble (sometimes spiritually) because they trusted the false information someone gave them- - when they could have found the truth for themselves. It turned out bad enough that Ms. Johaug had to miss the Olympics, but consider how much worse it can be when our soul's eternal future is on the line!

It is vitally important that we build our faith on what we know to be true from God's word and not just on what someone tells us it says (cf. 2 Timothy 2:15). May we be like the Bereans who personally "searched the Scriptures daily" to discern truth for ourselves (Acts 17:11).




