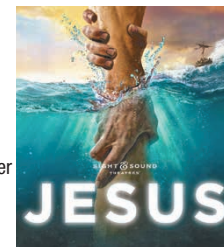

SHERIFFS CALL FOR STATE FUNDING OF ARMED OFFICERS IN ALL SCHOOLS

Albany, NY – February 22, 2018 - The New York State Sheriffs' Association today called upon the State Legislature to include in the 2018 State Budget sufficient funding to provide at least one armed school resource officer at every grade school and high school in the state.

"This will be an expensive undertaking," said Wayne County Sheriff Barry Virts, President of the New York State Sheriffs' Association, "but we owe it to our children, and their parents, to provide a safe place for education to take place."

"We spend many millions of dollars to protect a relatively small number of judges across the state, as we should. Surely we can also find the money to protect our most defenseless people – the children we send off to school each day," Sheriff Virts said.

There are about 4,750 public schools and nearly 2,000 private schools educating students in grades K through 12 in the state. The Sheriffs' Association estimates that the cost of this proposal would be roughly equivalent to that of adding one teacher to each of these schools.

School resource officers (SROs) provide an armed police presence while building relationships with the school community. "The relationship of trust formed with the students often allows the SRO to gain critical timely information and intervene before an issue becomes an incident," Sheriff Virts said.

The number of SROs has dropped in recent years due to the lack of local funding. Some schools already have SROs that are funded by the school district, the county government, or both. "The only way to assure that every student has the protection of an armed officer in close proximity is for the state to provide a reliable funding stream for SROs. Many school districts and local governments are unable to do it due to tax caps and limited funding sources," Sheriff Virts added.

Washington County Sheriff Jeff Murphy is a strong advocate for SROs in his county. "Sadly, many times when law enforcement arrives at the scene of a school shooting, everything is over and all the police officers can do is help the survivors. With an armed officer on duty in the school, such an attack may be deterred, or at least terminated quickly and hopefully without loss of life."

Sheriffs across the state work with their local school districts to "harden" schools as targets. This includes advising schools on hardware and protocol changes to better control access to school buildings, installing security cameras, conducting "lockdown" exercises, and providing "active shooter" self-defense training to school staff and students. Many schools are enrolled in the Sheriffs' Association's Rapid Responder program, which allows those responding to a school emergency immediate electronic access to critical information on the school's layout and infrastructure, staffing and student personnel. "All of these preparations are important," Sheriff Murphy said, "but the MOST important thing we can do is to get an armed deputy or police officer into every school immediately."

The Sheriffs' Association acknowledges that there are many ways to approach this issue. Each school district and law enforcement agency would have to figure out what works best in that district. Some have indicated a preference for stationing an armed security officer at a single school entry point. Others, including Sheriff Murphy and Warren County Sheriff Bud York, support the use of retired law enforcement officers as an economical way of getting well-trained armed officers into schools.

"Any of these would be better than nothing," said Sheriff Virts. "Most Sheriffs feel the BEST solution is to assign active deputy sheriffs or other active police officers to the schools as SROs who would have the freedom to move about the campus, "network" with students and staff, and either head off an incident before it happens or at least be there on scene to immediately respond."

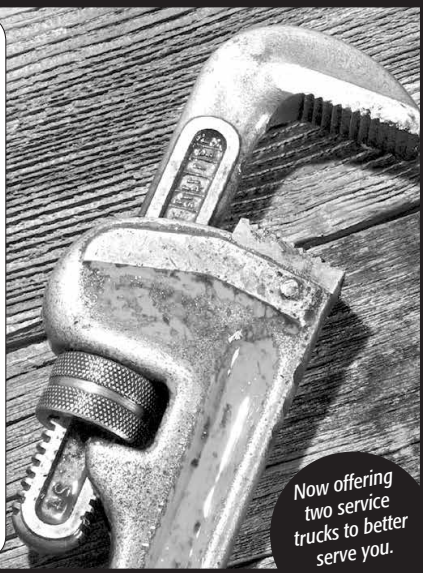

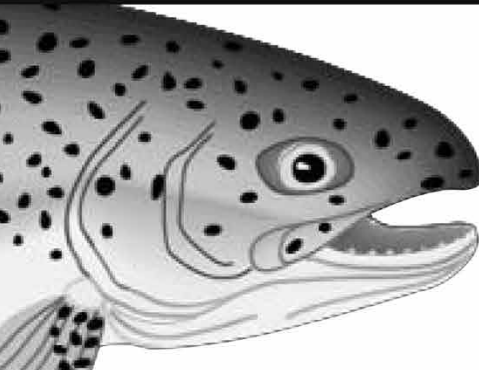

A STRANGE ANIMAL IN MEDINA

He has lost most of his hair on his tail.

Last week I got a email from some folks who live in the city limits of Medina about a strange animal they had been seeing. It had a long tail that was thin except for a "ball" of fur on the end. Their thought was it looked kind of like a fox or coyote except for that tail. My immediate thought was we were dealing with a fox or coyote with the mange.

I drove over to their place and the homeowner and I sat looking out the sliding back door at a small field behind his house. It wasn't long before the animal appeared, and that's what it was, a red fox with the mange. Except for his one hind leg and tail, which was bare and had a ball of fur on the very end, he looked normal. He acted normal too as we watched him listening for a mouse under the snow and then seeing him jump up in the air and go nose first down into the snow trying to catch that mouse.

This fox had the Sarcoptic mange, which is a skin disease caused by the Sarcoptes scabiei mite which is microscopic and cannot be seen with the naked eye. This mite burrows into the outer layer of skin and forms tunnels for them to lay eggs, feces and other digestive secretions. This life cycle lasts about two weeks and then a new population begins which can result in massive infections spreading over the body causing fur-loss and the development of a thick crust of parasite wastage on the skin surface. This causes intense irritation to the skin resulting in the animal scratching and chewing at the infected areas thus helping it to spread. Eventually this weakens the animal, especially in the winter, and leads to the animal acting mindless and eventually dying because of hypothermia and starvation. It is a very slow and ugly death for the animal.

There are a number of types of mange, the first of which is the one described above and is most common. It effects red foxes, coyotes and dogs mostly but can effect rabbits, squirrels and raccoon. Another type is Notoedric mange which is mostly restricted to squirrels and cats. There is one that can infect deer and another that effects birds. There is a form of Sarcoptic mange that is a human specific variety that causes scabies in people.

Can you or your pet get mange from an infected animal? Yes, although in humans and pets it is easily treated, whereas in wildlife it really isn't practical. You or your pets can pick it up when coming into direct physical contact with an infected host. Larvae and nymphs (infant stages of the mites) wandering around on the surface of the skin can also fall off and survive in the environment for several weeks under the right conditions (low temperatures and high relative humidity). These can be picked up by other animals including people and pets (such as free-roaming cats!) when walking in an area where an infected animal has traveled.

Your best defense against this disease for you and your pets is not to get near a mangy animal or walk in an area where a carrier animal may have traveled. Dead animals with the mange should be buried where they are found and gloves should be worn and clothing should be sprayed with a insect repellent before performing this task.

Sarcoptic mange can be a big killer of red foxes and coyotes. The season of the year and weather conditions influence how readily afflicted animals may succumb to the disease. In the winter they typically do not survive but in late spring or summer a healthy animal can survive the infection.

All red foxes and coyotes have a few mites on their bodies but the weak and stressed animals (young, old and injured) are the most susceptible. The mites are often spread at dens when the young are raised. Animals that are healthy, well fed and not stressed seem to be able to overcome any problems of the disease.

Grey foxes, interestingly enough, are resistant to the mange and I have never seen one with it.

In the past this disease has had a large effect on red fox populations but hopefully we won't see that point reached again. If you do see any animals that look to have the mange it is best to contact the DEC and if you can manage to put the animal out of its misery do so and bury the carcass. 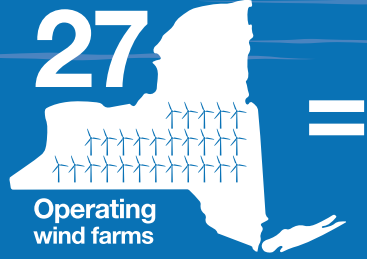

SIGNS OF A STROKE

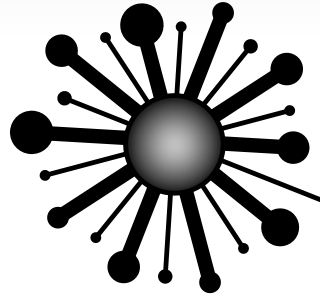

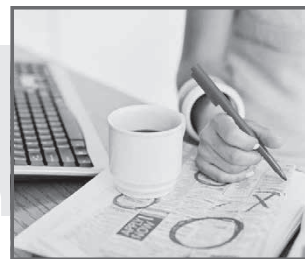

While it's impossible to extend a day from 24 to 26 hours, there are ways for busy men and women to create more time in their day.

1. Embrace organization tools. Whether it's day planners, smartphone reminders or more traditional print calendars with meetings and deadlines written on them, organization tools can greatly cut back on time spent trying to remember and/or confirm meeting times, project schedules, deadlines, and other obligations.

2. Assess your productivity. Some people are most productive in the mornings, while others do not hit their strides until after lunch. Identify the time or times of day when you tend to be most productive, and make an effort to focus exclusively on work during these times. Resist any urge to schedule meetings or conference calls during those times of day when you are most productive, as it can be hard to multitask or focus when discussing projects with coworkers or clients.

3. Minimize distractions. Social media, the internet and texting can distract attention away from tasks that must be completed, ultimately affecting how quickly and efficiently such projects are finished. Make a concerted effort to avoid social media and the internet while at work, and turn off smartphone alerts that entice you to go online. In addition, turn off text alerts if they are proving too great a distraction.

4. Reconsider your commute. Professionals who drive to work but find themselves sitting in traffic on their way to and from work can investigate possible alternatives to driving themselves. Public transportation might not get you to work more quickly than driving yourself, but time spent on a bus or train can be used to work on projects and check and answer work-related emails, clearing up time later in the day. Time spent behind the wheel of an automobile cannot be safely spent working. ■

ARE YOU ENTITLED TO SEVERANCE PAY?

It is a common workplace misconception that workers are legally entitled to severance pay when they are discharged from a job. Whether it is given varies among employers, regions, and industry custom. However, an employer may be legally obligated to pay a worker some severance pay if there is a written contract stating that it would be paid. Otherwise, there may be a promise that employees would receive severance pay as documented in an employee handbook. In addition, although it may be difficult to prove, there may have been an oral promise that an employer would pay a worker severance. If so, the employer who reneged on a promise to pay severance may be sued for breach of contract.

In a few states, employers that conduct large-scale layoffs or plant closings are legally obligated to pay severance, provide continued health benefits, or both, to employees who are laid off. If you worked in one of these states, and your termination was part of the type of layoff that the state's law covers, you may be legally entitled to severance. 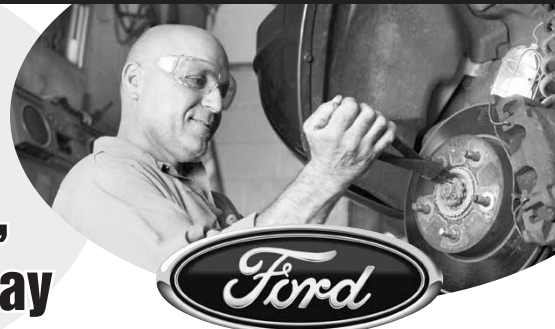

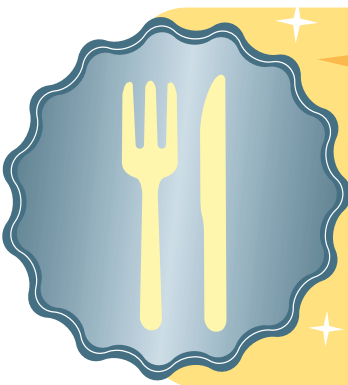

Steamed Mussels in Lemongrass and Basil

Serves 4 as an appetizer or snack

- 1/2 cup chicken stock
- 2 tsp minced lemongrass
- 6 kaffir lime leaves, torn or cut in half (optional)
- 1/2 cup dry white wine
- 1 fresh hot red or green chili, preferably Thai, thinly sliced (deseeded if you want less heat)
- 2 tbsps fish sauce (nam pla)
- 1 tablespoon palm or brown sugar
- 2 small handfuls, about 1/2 cup, of fresh coriander leaves (cilantro), finely chopped
- 1 pound fresh mussels, debearded and scrubbed clean
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 2 tps all-purpose cornstarch dissolved in 1 tbsp water
- Fresh basil leaves for garnish
- Fresh coriander leaves (cilantro) for garnish
- Lime wedges

1. Pour the chicken stock into a wok or large skillet. Add the lemongrass and kaffir lime leaves, if using. Bring to a boil over high heat, then reduce to moderately high.

2. Add the wine, chili slices, fish sauce, palm sugar, and fresh coriander leaves. Stir to combine. When the sauce is gently boiling, add the mussels. Stir to combine and cover with a tight-fitting lid. Cook for 2 to 3 minutes.

3. Remove the lid and gently stir in the mussels. If some of them still haven't opened, put the lid back on and cook 1 more minute.

4. Reduce heat to low and add the garlic and stir gently. Push the mussels to the side of the pan. Add the all-purpose cornstarch mixture to the liquid in the pan, stirring until thickened. Once thickened, stir to combine.

5. Remove from heat. Scoop or slide the mussels into a large serving bowl (or individual bowls). Pour the remaining sauce on top. Garnish with basil and fresh coriander leaves. Serve immediately with lime wedges on the side.

Cook's note: It's best to purchase mussels right before cooking, but if bought in advance keep them moist on ice in the refrigerator. Just before cooking, scrub them with a stiff brush under cool running water and trim off beards if they have them. If any are open, tap the shell. If they don't close tightly, discard them. If they don't open when cooked, also discard them. ■
