





# **ON YOUR DEBT**

# How Long Should I keep My Income Tax Records?

The answer to that question depends on the action, expense, or event which the document records. Generally, you must keep your records that support an item of income, deduction or credit shown on your tax return until the period of limitation runs out for that tax return.

The period of limitation is the period of time in which you can amend your tax return to claim a credit or refund, or the IRS can assess additional tax. The 7 limitation periods listed below are confusing and reflect the periods of limitation that apply to income tax returns according to the IRS. Unless otherwise stated, the years refer to the period after the return was filed. Returns filed before the due date are treated as filed on the due date.

I have personally kept every filed tax return and all corresponding documentation I have ever filed with the IRS. That would ultimately be my advice to you as well, if for no other reason than helping to prepare future tax returns or making computations if you file an amended return.

Periods of Limitation that apply to income tax returns

The IRS recommends the following.

#1. Keep records for a minimum of 3 years as long as #'s 2, 3, and 4 below do not apply to you.

#2. Keep records indefinitely if you do not file a return.

#3. Keep records indefinitely if you file a fraudulent return.

#4. Keep records for 6 years if you do not report income that you should report, and it is more than 25% of the gross income shown on your return.

#5. Keep records for 3 years from the date you filed your original return or 2 years from the date you paid the tax, whichever is later, if you file a claim for credit or refund after you file your return.

#6. Keep records for 7 years if you file a claim for a loss from worthless securities or a bad debt deduction.

#7. Keep employment tax records for at least 4 years after the date that the tax becomes due or is paid, whichever is later.

If one of your records pertains to purchased property, it is generally advised to keep the records relating to the property until the period of limitation expires for the year in which you dispose of the property. You must keep these records to figure any depreciation, amortization, or depletion deduction and to figure the gain or loss when you sell or otherwise dispose of the property. Another reason to just keep everything forever.

If you have received property in a nontaxable exchange (a trade of some sort), you may be asked by the IRS to prove that you did not gain additional equity in the transaction. Therefore, you would need not only your new property records but the old as well until the period of limitations expires for the year in which you dispose of the new property.

Another thing to considering is keeping documentation for a non-tax purposes. For example, your insurance company or creditors may require you to keep them longer than the IRS does.



# The Best-Laid Plans...

A young preacher had taken some vacation time out of town and had the opportunity to worship at a church as a visitor rather than the preacher on Sunday. He was looking forward to hearing a preacher with more experience than himself to see if he could pick up some skills for his own use.

The older preacher did not disappoint. When he entered the pulpit that morning he appeared rather disorganized and offered an apology. He said that he had been so busy with visiting the sick, counseling, comforting the hurting

and such like the previous week that he had no time left to prepare a sermon. After the apology he walked away from the microphone leaving the audience rather stunned. However, he returned after a short time and delivered a powerful sermon titled "Unprepared To Meet God." His "apology" was used only as an attention getter--and boy did it work!

The young preacher was so inspired and impressed, he could hardly wait to get back home and use the same illustration on his congregation. Thus, when he got in the pulpit the next Sunday morning, he did his best to look unprepared and offered an apology using the same words as he had heard the week before. Unexpectedly though, as he started to walk away from the microphone a little old lady sitting near the rear of the auditorium shouted, "Well, couldn't you just read out of the Bible or something?" He never expected that and was so thrown off balance, he could barely preach! Life is a lot that way. To borrow some famous words: "The best-laid plans of mice and men often go awry." I know of no better case study of this truth than the story of Job. At the beginning of his life, he seemed to have it all together. He earned the top award for righteous living over all the earth (1:1, 8). He was also one of the wealthiest men of his day (1:3). Beyond that, he was blessed with a big family for whom he got up early to offer daily sacrifices (1:2, 5). But even though he was doing all the right things, trouble still came (3:26). It is not necessarily a defect in our plans when they do not come together; the culprit is often the uncertainty of life (cf. James 4:13-15). And when our lives take an unexpected turn (and they all do from time to time), we come to realize what little control we have over our future. So, like Job, may we wisely put our hand in the hand of the One who will see us through the unseen turns on life's road (cf. Job 19:25).

Under Alabama law the operator or a car is not liable for damages arising from injury or death of a guest if they are being transported without payment unless the injury or death is caused by the willful or wanton conduct of the operator.

A passenger can sue but a guest may not. That being said, what often happens in these situations is an insurance adjuster who knows his business pretty well, and knows that particular code section will get on the phone and get a recorded statement. If the person says they didn't pay for gas on that occasion then the insurance company does not have to pay unless other circumstances are present. If the passenger paid for gas or gave some other type of renumeration, then the guest passenger statute will not apply. Also, the Alabama guest statute does not apply to children under the age

of 14 as they really do not have a choice in the matter.

I don't know whether the driver was being reckless or wanton (having a conscious disregard for the safety of others at the time). If the driver was drinking, speeding, reckless driving, racing, etc., the guest statute will not apply. If your son was going with the other boy on a business related purpose to assist him in some way, he would not be a guest in the car. If he paid for the gas to get somewhere, he would not be a guest in the car. If your son and the other boy were car pooling where one paid for gas one week and the other paid for all the gas the next week that would probably get around the Alabama guest statute. One thing to also remember is that should the guest statute not apply to your son's accident, then your personal uninsured motorist coverage will also cover your son.

Up until a few years ago, your personal uninsured motorist coverage would have covered your son and paid for his injuries regardless of whether he was considered a guest or passenger. Uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage is included in your own automobile insurance policies to provide you and members of your family insurance coverage in case you are in an accident with an uninsured driver. Unfortunately, we had a Supreme Court Judge who had also been the CEO of an insurance company and during his tenure on the Court, the rules were changed so insurance companies don't have to pay uninsured maotorist coverage to those injured but considered a guest under the Alabama Guest Statute. By arbitrarily changing the rules, the Supreme Court of Alabama took away you and your son's ability to have insurance coverage in this type of case even though this is exactly the type of situation that uninsured motorist coverage is supposed to pay for. Buckle up, drive safely and as always your referrals are appreciated! 256-764-0112





# **First and Foremost**

The name Ande Jones will always be remembered in the history of UNA sports as one who accomplished remarkable results as an athlete and later as a coach for the Lions. Jones began developing her skills as an athlete at Bradshaw High School when she was a member of the team that won the first State Vollevball Championship for the Bruins.

She was named All-State and All-Region two years in a row for the Bruins. Jones was the first female to play on an all-boy's tennis team at Bradshaw. After

graduation, Jones signed a scholarship at the University of North Alabama. As a badminton player for the Lions, she won State Championships in singles, doubles and mixed doubles.

She was named All-Region and All-State in volleyball for the Lions. Jones later returned to UNA as a coach and set some high standards during her career at the university. She coached the first women's tennis team at UNA that advanced to the Regionals. She also coached the first UNA volleyball team to the Gulf South Conference Championship and led the Lions slow-pitch softball team to the first GSC

Championship. As a coach at UNA, Jones' volleyball teams won six GSC Championships and her softball teams won three GSC Championships while receiving Coach of The Year honors. Jones was responsible for positive changes to the women's programs that resulted in the addition of soccer as a sport, additional coaches, and better travel and facilities.

Jones is a member of the UNA Athletic Hall of Fame and next month will be inducted into the Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame. Ande Jones was not only a great player and coach in several sports but a pioneer in the development of athletic programs at the University of North Alabama.

# **Medicare** Minute "Medicare Part B Coverage"

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$183 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$183 filed on Part B each year and, after the deductible is met, you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you receive.

America stands to suffer as a result of President Trump's 2019 budget, released on Feb. 12. The president has

ne president has proposed again to eliminate or shrink many programs that serve rural America, including those supporting rural businesses, cooperatives, and housing.

Trump is also calling for an investment of \$50 billion in rural infrastructure. However, this could put the onus on states already struggling with the economic fallout of depressed commodity prices.

In addition, the budget slashes working lands conservation programs by proposing the elimination of the Conservation Stewardship Program. The program gives farmers and ranchers opportunities to do such things as plant cover crops or improve pasture land. Eliminating it would do serious damage to our farmers' and ranchers' abilities to preserve water quality and build soil health while also maintaining productive operations.

On a positive note, the president's budget includes proposals that would bring greater fairness to farming communities. For example, the budget targets commodity, conservation, and crop insurance assistance to producers with adjusted gross incomes of \$500,000 or less. A similar proposal would limit the number of people who can register as a farm manager and thereby receive payments.

For too long, the largest farms have had access to more support than small and mid-sized farms. This competitive advantage for large farms has contributed farm consolidation to shrinking and rural These communities. proposals would bring long-awaited fairness agricultural to our communities.

Mostly, Trump's budget proposal would drain support for rural America. We fear these actions represent a lack of understanding of rural America's struggles.

America's struggles. We urge President Trump and our national lawmakers to cease these actions that undercut rural Americans and rural communities.



TV evangelists in many ways, including that fact that he remained blameless in not succumbing to fleshly or monetary temptation that discredited so many others. As much as some would have loved to sully Graham's character with dirt and hearsay, there was none to find.

The primary concern that many had about Graham was that he was a strong supporter of some religious leaders who were not Biblically sound. He gravitated toward a big tent that held a wide disparity in beliefs, something that a student of the Bible knows is not scriptural.

He repeatedly stated he was not conducting to convert crusades people. His associations broadened as his popularity increased. Although his tenets apparently remained sound, he was not one to publicly recognize apostacy other from religious who denounced leaders sound doctrine like the virgin birth, the bodily resurrection, baptism, or the preexistence of Jesus. He

avoided disagreement and potential denominational disassociation that full disclosure at his public appearances may have created.

In a 1999 interview with Patricia Rice of the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch,* Graham said, "Baptism is very important because Jesus taught that we are to believe and to be baptized. But that is up to the individual and the church that they feel led to go to. The churches have different teachings on that... there are some churches that would not insist on baptism. So, I give them the freedom to teach what they want.

"I am not a professor. I am not a theologian. I'm a simple proclaimer... I'm announcing the news that God loves you and that you can be forgiven of your sins. And you can go to heaven...My job from God is not to do all these other things. I am not a pastor of a church. That's not my responsibility."

In his efforts to cover such a wide swath, Graham indeed missed many important opportunities over the years.

Nonetheless, Graham's worldwide crusades, leadership towards desegregation, and his role as adviser to decades of U.S. presidents from Truman to Obama made him one of the premier religious leaders of our time. We'll never see another like him.

Graham never reveled in his public stature and never thought he had earned salvation. He was ever-humble in his work as evidenced during his 2002 Cincinnati crusade when he said, "There were a few times when I thought I was dying, and I saw my whole life come before me... I

didn't say to the Lord, 'I'm a preacher, and I've preached to many people.' I said, 'Oh Lord, I'm a sinner, and I still need Your forgiveness. I still need the cross.' And I asked the Lord to give me peace in my heart"

That didn't prevent the Twitterverse from lighting up only minutes after his death with rhetoric so hateful and angry it would be inappropriate for the lowest of the low.

To show how misled and off-base the faithless Twitter bands are about Graham, if he even chose to wade through the filth and give their Twitter posts a glance, he would calmly respond to those comments in a positive, loving, and encouraging way. Few of us would have the same level of restraint.

That is one reason why Graham was so revered, why some militant faithless couldn't stand him, and why they were the ones who really should have listened.






