

I had a wreck in January and I had only had my car a couple of months. It was brand new and the damage was around \$10,000.00. They did not total my car but repaired it. Now, the insurance company wants to settle and I asked the adjuster about diminution in value and he said that wasn't a law.

I am sure that certain insurance companies have contracts with their insureds' that specify what they will and will not pay. If you are making a claim against your insurance company for collision or comprehensive damage to your own vehicle, the contract (that you haven't seen or read) between you and your insurance company will define what their

obligation to pay is and is not.

If you are making a claim against someone else who negligently caused damage to your car and their insurance company is trying to tell you what the law is, don't believe them.

The law of damages in Alabama is simple and straight forward and exactly what you think it should be. If someone through carelessness or negligence damages property that you own, you are entitled by law to the value of the property prior to the damage.

Everyone reading this, if given the choice between two identical cars except that one had been wrecked and the other not, would choose the car had not been wrecked. We all know that if you trade in a car that has been previously damaged, it is worth less as a trade in.

What you are really looking at is an issue of evidence and proof. If you can by the testimony of an experienced car salesperson or automotive appraiser, provide competent evidence of how much less your car is worth in its wrecked, repaired condition then the Court should award that amount of money for the diminished value of your property.



My friend had an older style camera that requires some finagling with the router settings to make the camera work (for you technical people, it involved opening some ports which is a risky proposition if you don't know what you're doing). So if you have old cameras that you installed yourself, and don't know if they are secure, you may want to call a professional to make sure you're not being spied

Newer cameras still have some security concerns just like anything else linked to the internet. Most modern cameras are linked to an online account that allows you to view your cameras through a smartphone, tablet or website. That account is only as secure as your password. So make sure it's a good one and change it from time to time just

Another important task is to update your wireless router. You need to do this whether or not vou have webcams. Explaining how to to that in this liftle column would bore you to tears but you need to verify three

1. Make sure you have changed the default username and password on your wireless

2. Make sure you are using "WPA/WPA2" WiFi security protocol. Older wifi routers may be using the easily-hackable WEP"šcheme.

3. Update your router's firmware. Many routers

have been found to have vulnerabilities that have been patched with firmware updates. Miss any one of these items and your entire network could be open to mischief.

Most of us with cameras use them for outdoor security, so it's not the end of the world if someone peeks in on those. On the other hand, many of you have baby monitors, indoor nanny monitors and such. You need to be sure those are secure.

### **Protecting Our** Citizens

Editor:

A *TimesDaily* article dated February 18, 2018 has the headline "City to Study Salaries, Benefits." This article states that Public Affairs Research Council of Alabama (PARCA) is "comparing pay, benefits, recruitment and other recruitment and other aspects of public safety with ten other cities." The article also states the study will take four months and will cost \$15,000.

A February 21 article also states, "The inability of the police and fire departments attract and retain officers and firefighters is a concern the heads of these departments have been sharing with the Mayor and City Council for a year." May I repeat, "for a Year!"

In another article dated August 24, 2017 "Police Scaling titled, Back

Services," Chief Tyler stated, "We have 26 vacancies now or that will occur soon. We have become a reactive police force instead of a proactive force." The article also stated that Florence pays about \$9,000 less in rookie pay than neighboring Muscle Shoals. Additionally, Muscle Shoals provides firearms for its officers, but Florence does not. Knowing this information, is a study required? The mayor and three council members want a tax increase. Therefore, every dollar is important.

Has the Mayor and City Council given our police and our firefighters and our citizens the proper priority? Well, the February 21 article states sharing of concerns has been going on for a year. Since the August 24, 2017 article and the hiring of PARCA, 180 days have passed. Also, the study will take 120 days; 180 plus 120 equals 300 days. If the discussions began a year ago, as stated, then its 365 days plus 120 which equals 485 days. Once the study is completed, how long will it take for our police force to be a proactive force again?

Each citizen should answer the above question. In addition, will the officers and firefighters receive back pay because of the delay? Also, does the city budget provide for a fully staffed police force at current pay?

### Infrustructure is Needed More

Editor:

We thank Rep. Brooks for holding a rare town hall meeting last month at UNA. He spoke about the worrisome growth of national debt and budget deficits. Yet, he also defended the recent massive tax break for corporations and the weâlthy. He described it as a desperation "Hail Mary" pass that could fail in generating new economic growth to cover the \$1.5 trillion deficit it created. Failure and worsening economic inequality look more likely every day.

Compounding problem is the conservative push to expand defense spending far beyond normal growth – and beyond what most think is justified. The deficit will escalate and pressure will increase to reduce funding for health care and other social programs.

These same Republicans are avoiding action on proposed infrastructure improvement, despite it being vitally necessary and a major initiative of President Trump. Such spending would attract bipartisan support, generate employment, and benefit everybody now and in the future. It would produce safer bridges, better roads, modern schools and airports, etc. Most folks prefer those things to superfluous nuclear weapons and aircraft carriers.

It is disingenuous for Republicans to say they care about reducing debt by stimulating the economy and tax base when they have could funded infrastructure projects instead of passing the tax giveaway. 



### **Medicare Minute**

### "Medicare Part A & B Review"

The past couple of weeks we have discussed Medicare Parts A & B in detail. These are the two parts of Medicare that are received through the federal government. This week let's review what we have discussed.

Although Medicare Part A and Part B are great programs that cover a lot of services there are some things Medicare does not cover. They include most dental care, eye exams related to prescribing glasses, dentures, acupuncture and hearing aids.

Medicare Part A is primarily used to cover your inpatient care. Part A has a \$1,340 deductible for each benefit period, meaning the deductible can be applied more than once in a calendar year. This deductible covers hospital services, including semi-private rooms, meals, general nursing, drugs as part of your inpatient treatment, and other hospital services and supplies. Part A is "free" to most Medicare beneficiaries. "Free" meaning you may not have to pay Medicare to have Part A. It does not excuse the deductibles and co-insurance.

In most cases Part B is used to cover your outpatient services. These include visits to your primary care physician and/or specialist. It also may cover transportation by ambulance, durable medical equipment, preventive services and mental health treatment. Part B also entitles you to an annual "Wellness" visit to a qualified provider. Most Medicare beneficiaries joining Medicare Part B for the first time in 2018 pay a monthly premium to Medicare of \$134. Part B has an annual deductible of \$183 and a coinsurance the beneficiary pays of 20%, after the deductible is met.

To cover the deductibles and coinsurance that Part A and Part B have you would need to look at some type of supplemental policy sold through private insurance companies. These include Medicare supplement plans or Medicare Advantage Plans. mass-shootings non-existent. essentially Several of my classmates carried hunting rifles or pistols in their vehicles. One had a fully-stocked two-gun window rack in his pick-up. No one ever broke in and even though he had a temper, he never thought of indiscriminately killing anyone.

We should look at some of the problems instead of just overreacting to the sensationalized symptoms.

Half the children born in this country today are born to single mothers. Many children in the two parent households only receive a fraction of the nurturing and attention that they really yearn for and need to grow up with values, stability, a strong work ethic, and a sense of right and wrong.

Too many expect their way and cannot take criticism, loss, or suggestion, and our society increasingly says they shouldn't have to. Participation trophies that mindset. exemplify feel should Everyone successful, not just the winners. And they should not have to break away from their electronic devise to achieve it. That is just not reality.

pharmaceutical industry is aware that these drugs do cause violent behavior in at least some instances. Yet, it continues to lobby against any restrictions would limit wholesale distribution


powerful, mind-altering millions of drugs to including Americans, children.



"When somebody's sitting

over there, you get a huge crowd of people going over to help them out."

Bretherick believes that civic and service organizations help people cultivate a servant's mindset that they can carry forward into other areas of their lives. The problem is that people have packed schedules and don't think they can make time for service.

Civic organizations are hurting," he said. "There are too many competing activities and not enough [people] thinking about serving others."

Bretherick believes the key to cultivating a servant mindset is starting early. Through his business, he gives monthly Good Neighbor awards to outstanding students at Mars Hill. The catch is that these awards aren't for academics. Instead, they're for service.

"It's about being a leader, showing kindness, and serving others," he said. "It's the most important award that's handed out every month."

Bretherick wants to expand the Good Neighbor award program to other area schools in the future. Bretherick's service mindset extends beyond his civic and community volunteerism into his personal life. He and his wife, Sarah, acted as foster parents in recent years. While they're no longer active foster parents, Bretherick encourages other families to foster. "I'm a big proponent of the [saying], You're ordinary, but to a foster kid, you extraordinary," he said. you're

As a father of five, Bretherick has invested the past 15 years in coaching his children's sports teams.

"I'm either coaching a soccer team, girls' softball, soccer, basketball, baseball or flag football," he said. "As a parent, you want to coach your kids." Bretherick has coached in Florence city leagues and at Mars Hill. He has also spent time coaching in the Upward Soccer program at Cross Point Church of Christ.

In addition, Bretherick is currently the Chairman of the Board at Mars Hill Bible School.

"Private schools are really declining right now," he said. "It's important that we focus on good, wholesome Christian values. We heed to have a good place for kids to come not just learn about life, but about being a good, Christian person.

He also serves as a deacon and teacher at his church, Stony Point Church of Christ, where he has attended for 52 years. Bretherick is always on hand when he's needed for service and ministry activities.

'I'm the guy who does a little bit of everything-whatever they need me to do," he said.

As an insurance agent, Bretherick gets excited about his career and role in the

community. "Every day, I get to help people. It makes for a happy life," he said. "Most people don't get to do that."








### **One More Olympic Thought**

Well the 2018 Winter Olympic Games have come and gone. As I have said before, I am a big fan of the games and tried to watch as much as I could. The Americans did well, although maybe not as well as the athletes had hoped, but then that is the nature of any sport.

While watching these games I usually try to think of some life application that could be gleaned. So, thinking back over the events there is one thing that particularly stands out to me about the timed competitions, like skiing and bobsledding. That "thing" is how close together the

times were of almost all the competitors. In some events less than a second separated the one who won the gold medal from those who did not medal at all! That's close!

I am sure that we all have laughed when hearing the old adage, "Close only counts in horseshoes, hand grenades and bad breath." However, to lose a competition that you have worked years to win by a hundredth of a second must be heartbreaking.

Thinking about this "close" matter a little more I was reminded of an incident that happened during the earthly ministry of Jesus. A scribe was once listening to some conversations of Jesus with his adversaries and was impressed by his answers. That led him to pose a question to the Lord himself. He asked, "Which is the first commandment of all?" (Mark 12:28). Jesus replied with a passage from Deuteronomy 6: "The first of all commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these" (Mark 12:29-31).

The scribe agreed with the words of Jesus saying, "Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the truth..." (v. 32f). Jesus then spoke these thought provoking words to the scribe, "You are not far from the kingdom of God" (v. 34).

Obviously, this scribe was "close" to being in God's kingdom. How? He knew what he had to do to get in. But what was keeping him out? Not committing to practice what he knew! And to our knowledge he never made it inside. Not because he could not- - but because he would not go in.

Perhaps there are others who are close to the kingdom of God even now. Imagine how heartbreaking it would be to miss out on the eternal prize (cf. 2 Timothy 4:8)!

Some of the people I work with have been buying into a new kind of supplemental insurance that protects against layoffs. It costs about \$30 a month per person, and the full payout if you're laid off is \$9,000. It seems to me you would have to be paying in for of thing. Steve


Dear Steve,

Anytime insurance is there for something you could cover yourself, it's a good idea to stop and remember that every insurance company is still a business. They must cover all the costs of operation, plus make a profit. Believe me, that takes a lot of money.

Statistically speaking, if lots of people cashed in on a policy like this an insurance company would go out of business. We're talking about only \$30 a month to cover \$9,000. That alone tells you not many people cash in. It's gimmick insurance.

On average, you're losing money when you you're buy insurance of any kind. Again, on average, over the scope of your lifetime you'd be better off simply saving money and self-insuring against things like this. The only things I recommend buying insurance for are things you can't afford to cover personally. But you can afford to cover a layoff by saving an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses.

If I'm in your shoes, Steve, I'm not buying that stuff. -Dave
