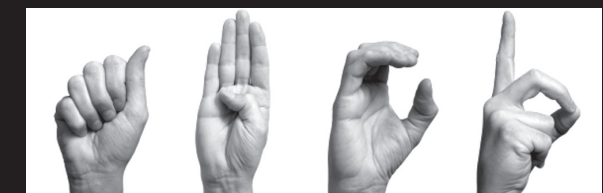

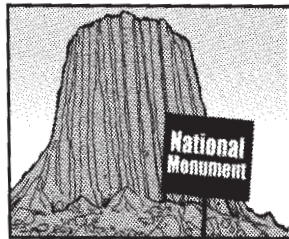

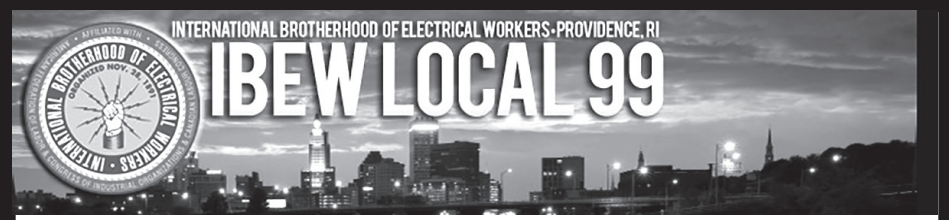

You've seen the way he yells at his own kid ... a 7 year old who has no clue how to play goalie and likely never will at the rate he's going. But you rationalize the situation. The coach is making a sacrifice for the kids. After all, you couldn't do it this year.

My kid is concerned that we won't find the field. Relax, I said, you just look for the group that has the same color shirt as you. Besides, we're early ... there's still time for a little extra advice.
 "Be aggressive," I tell my son. "OK, Dag," he replies. Then he pauses. Something is wrong.
 "Dag?"
 "Yes, son?"
 "What does 'aggressive' mean?"
 I explained to him that it meant putting the ball in the back of the net whenever he had a clear shot, but I am interrupted by another parent. Her kid is in blue ... not the red my kid is clad in.
 "Excuse me ... but I think we're playing you today. Do you know where the field is?"
 "You'll find it," my kid says. "Just look for the colors."
 He looks at the other kid and offers more advice.
 "Hey ... be aggressive."
 In a world where there are too many rules, it's always fun to remember this about sports ... don't ever over-think it and always enjoy yourself. The uniforms will get dirty and the cuts and scrapes will come, but the memories will last a lifetime.

Rotisserie Chicken With Taste of Morocco

I love using rotisserie chickens in my recipes when I'm pressed for time. Rotisserie chickens are reasonably priced, convenient, come seasoned in a variety of ways and can be transformed into a multitude of quick and easy main-dish meals. Best of all, if you purchase a plain, roasted chicken, you can use the bones to make a rich, homemade chicken stock or enhance the flavors of pre-packaged stocks or broths, so nothing goes to waste.

Most rotisserie chickens are large enough to serve at least four people as a main course. Or, you can pull the meat from the bones and use it in recipes that call for pre-cooked chicken. Shredded chicken can be used in recipes from salads, sandwiches and soups to enchiladas or chicken pot pies.

Using a pre-cooked chicken lets you explore new and unusual recipes that would ordinarily take a lot of time

to prepare. This recipe for Speedy Mediterranean Chicken is ready in just 30 minutes and imparts all the exotic spices and flavors of the traditional recipe. A rotisserie chicken seasoned with lemon pepper is perfect for this dish.

The flavors used in this recipe are reminiscent of an exotic Moroccan tagine. A tagine is both a type of heavy clay pot with a domed lid and the dish that is cooked in it. Tagines typically are found in the North African cuisines of Morocco. Most Moroccan tagines combine lamb, chicken or beef with a variety of ingredients and seasonings, including citrus fruits, nuts, honey and pungent spices.

This recipe blends spicy salsa and curry powder, and adds a hint of sweetness by incorporating honey and raisins with spectacular results. Toasting the curry powder in the oil

first gives this dish an authentic taste and brings out the flavors of the spice. Serve with hot cooked couscous or rice to make the most of the savory sauce that envelops the chicken.

SPEEDY MEDITERRANEAN CHICKEN

- 1 tablespoon olive or vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons curry powder
- 1 jar (16 ounces) chunky salsa
- 1/2 cup sliced green olives
- 1/4 cup golden raisins
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1 deli rotisserie chicken (2 to 2 1/2 pounds), cut into 6 to 8 pieces, skin removed if desired

1. In 12-inch nonstick skillet, heat oil over medium heat. Stir in curry powder. Cook over medium heat 1 minute, stirring constantly.
 2. Stir in remaining ingredients except chicken. Add chicken; turn to coat.
 3. Cover; cook over medium-high heat 5 to 6 minutes, turning chicken occasionally until sauce is bubbly and chicken is thoroughly heated. Makes 4 servings.



THE HISTORY CHANNEL

• On **March 17, 1762**, in New York City, the first parade honoring the Catholic feast day of St. Patrick, patron saint of Ireland, is held by Irish soldiers serving in the British army.

• On **March 16, 1802**, the United States Military Academy — the first military school in the United States, also known as West Point — is founded by Congress. West Point was the site of a Revolutionary-era fort that Patriot General Benedict Arnold agreed to surrender to the British in exchange for 6,000 pounds. However, the plot was uncovered and Arnold fled to the British for protection.

• On **March 12, 1903**, the New York Highlanders join baseball's American League, changing its name to the New York Yankees in 1913.

• On **March 18, 1942**, the War Relocation Authority is created to "Take all people of Japanese descent into custody," as well as some Germans and Italians, and put them in internment camps. One Japanese American, Gordon Hirabayashi, fought internment all the way to the Supreme Court, which ruled against him.

• On **March 14, 1950**, the FBI institutes the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list in an effort to publicize particularly dangerous fugitives. Only eight women have appeared on the Most Wanted list.

• On **March 13, 1965**, Eric Clapton leaves the Yardbirds. The English guitarist, singer and songwriter was enough of a purist to quit when the band drifted from the blues toward experimental pop with its 1965 hit "For Your Love."

• On **March 15, 1970**, Boston Bruin Bobby Orr becomes the first defenseman in NHL history to score 100 points in a season. Orr was a young phenomenon, signed by the Boston Bruins to a "C" form at the age of 12. His contract included \$900 worth of stucco for his family's home and a secondhand car.

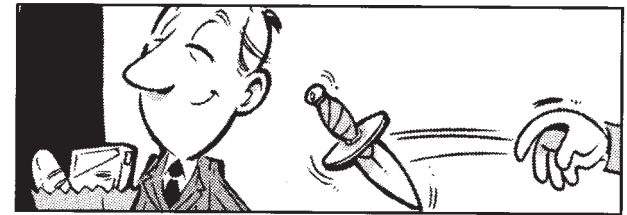

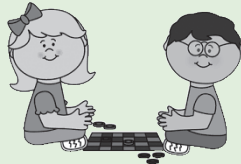

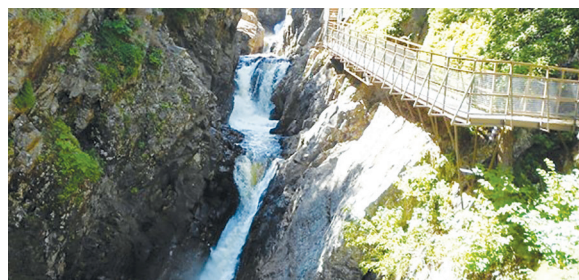

Jealousy Disrupts Doggie Household

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My two dogs, "Jake" and "Albie," are normally real sweethearts. But over the past few months they have been increasingly nasty to one another. Jake is five years older than Albie, who the shelter told me is about four years old. If Albie sees Jake lying in the sunny corner of the kitchen, he growls and barks. Jake will growl and bark right back. Last week they came very close to fighting. What can I do to stop this once and for all?
— *Gerry in Las Cruces, New Mexico*

DEAR GERRY: Dust off your dog-training manual — you're going to need it. Basic commands like "sit," "stay," "quiet" and "leave it" are very helpful in defusing a situation between two housemate dogs.

Sometimes dogs exhibit jealous behavior for no apparent reason; other times something has changed in the household, and therefore the overall dynamic — a new roommate, new pet or new baby; shifting the furniture around; or even decorating for the holidays. Whatever the cause, you must re-establish order. Your dogs need to know that no matter what else has changed, you're still head of the house.

Make sure that you show no favoritism. When it's time for treats, both dogs get treats (and only if they're both sitting calmly). When one is curled up in his doggie bed, the other should be, too. Take them for longer walks to burn off more energy, and work with them on basic commands.

What if this doesn't stop their behavior? You will need to separate them into different rooms if a verbal "leave it" command doesn't work. If their behavior worsens, contact a pet trainer.

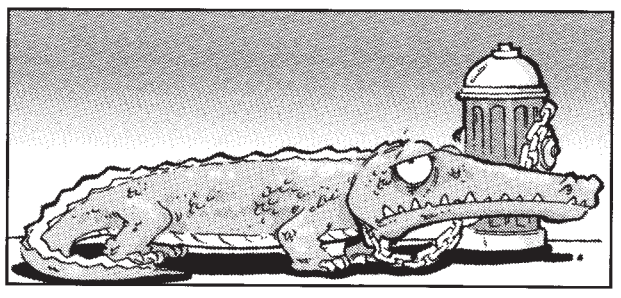


