

SNOWY OWL ADVENTURE

Recently I was invited to join my friend who traps and bands snowy owls. The bird, however, forgot to show up. My friend headed farther south to check on a report of another owl (which he successfully trapped and banded) and I headed east to check on another reported owl.

Actually we have had a good number of snowy owls in our general area this winter and I have had the good fortune of being able to photograph a number of them, a couple under very good conditions. Just like eagles, I can never get enough shots of these beautiful birds.

After leaving my owl-trapping friend and striking out on my own, there wasn't much success until I headed down a road never traveled before. Suddenly a snowy flew up on a power pole right next to me as I drove by! I went down the road and then came back slowly as not to disturb him, but he apparently had moved on already. The nerve of this owl teasing me like this!

An adjacent cross road was near by and a ton of geese and some swans were feeding in a field north of it so the decision was made to just park and wait to see what kind of sunset we were going to get and if some swans or geese could be "captured" flying across it. While waiting the owl was spotted way out in a hedgerow in a tree snag which was guite high and covered with grape vines. With no real opportunity to photograph him my time was spent watching him through the spotting scope. Eventually he flew down to the ground after something. When he again perched he chose a tall thin tree and landed on the very top on a very flimsy branch. There he fought for balance as the branch bowed and swung around but he finally managed to get stabilized. I thought it kind of funny that he would chose such a flimsy perch. Very untypical of a snowy.

The sky was getting great with those after-sunset colors and I concentrated on that and the birds leaving the field heading back to their roosts.

So I didn't get any snowy owl shots, but I did get a great collection of sunset images, some with geese flying across. The next evening I thought, "What the heck, maybe that owl will be near the road tonight and some shots could be gotten," so off I went. Just before getting near my turnoff to the road where all the action had been the night before, there he was on a pole next to the highway! Turning around I headed back slowly and in stages moving closer to him all the while watching his reaction to me and other cars going by. He seems indifferent to me and the other vehicles and eventually I was parked right across the road from him and the sun was behind me! A number of shots were taken and then I just sat back and continued my surveillance hoping for something "different" to happen such as his catching a mouse and returning to his perch to eat it!

I called a friend who lived nearby and told him of the bird and he and his wife came right down to get a magnificent look before leaving me alone with the bird again. The sun was setting fast and he wasn't finding anything to catch, so he headed down the road a short distance that gave him a better "listening and watching" post.

Orleans County, New York NOTICE OF FILING OF PRELIMINARY SCOPING STATEMENT

Heritage Wind LLC (the Applicant), a subsidiary of Apex Clean Energy Holdings, Inc. (Apex), is proposing to submit an Application to construct the Heritage Wind Energy Facility ("Facility"), a wind powered major electric generating facility, under Article 10 of the Public Service Law (PSL). This notice announces that on or about March 12, 2018 the Heritage Wind will file a Preliminary Scoping Statement (PSS), pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1000.5, which is designed to gather input from the public and interested agencies on the scope and methodology of studies to be conducted in support of the Application, which will be filed at a later date. The filing of the PSS will start a 21-day public comment period on the scope and methodology of the studies proposed.

The proposed Facility will provide up to 200 megawatt (MW) in wind powered renewable energy, and will be located in the Town of Barre, Orleans County, New York. A point of interconnection substation will be placed in the Town of Barre, along the existing National Grid Lockport-Mortimer 115 kV power line, to deliver electricity generated by the Facility to the New York State electric grid. The Facility will include wind turbines, access roads, electrical collection lines, a collection substation, wind measurement towers, temporary construction staging and storage areas, and an operations and maintenance building.

The purpose of the proposed Facility, and the goals of Heritage Wind LLC, are to generate wind-powered energy that will provide a significant source of renewable electricity to the New York State power grid. Current State policies call for the significant expansion of wind powered electric generating facilities, as part of New York's renewable energy goals, carbon emissions reduction targets, and strategy for combating climate change. These State policy goals are set forth in New York's historic Clean Energy Standard, and forward-looking Reforming Energy Vision and 2015 State Energy Plans. The Facility would also provide significant benefit to the local community through temporary and permanent employment, payments to local landowners, and purchase of local goods and services. Additionally, economic benefits are expected to accrue to host tax jurisdictions and a payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT) will be sought with the Town, the local school district and the County.

The PSS filing marks the beginning of a formal public scoping process. The document will, among other things, will describe and identify: the environmental setting in the Facility area, potential environmental and health impacts from construction and operation of the Facility, proposed benefits of the Facility, proposed studies (including pre-construction studies and post-construction monitoring for potential impacts to avian and bat species), proposed measures to minimize environmental impacts, reasonable alternatives, other required permits/authorizations, and other relevant information to be assessed. The PSS will also provide a preliminary scope of an environmental impact analysis containing a discussion of potentially significant adverse environmental and health impacts relating to the construction and operation of the Facility, including potential impacts to land use in the Facility area; public health and safety; terrestrial ecology, including avian and bat species, and wetlands; water resources and aquatic ecology; communications, transportation, and utilities; cultural, historical and recreational resources; visual, including potential for shadow flicker; sound; electromagnetic fields; and impacts on the statewide electrical system.

Within 21 days after filing of the PSS, any person, agency or municipality may submit comments on the PSS by serving such comments on the Applicant and filing a copy with the Secretary of the Department of Public Service at the addresses provided below. The Applicant will prepare a summary of the material comments and its reply thereto within 21 days after the closing of the comment period. The scoping process is overseen and mediated by a Hearing Examiner designated by the DPS. The Hearing Examiner will schedule a pre-application meeting, which will commence the stipulations negotiation process and will allow for the discussion and award of intervenor funding. Additional notice of the pre-application meeting will be published by the Examiners.

Further, upon filing of the PSS, Heritage Wind LLC will provide \$70,000 (as calculated pursuant to PSL 163(4)(a)) to the intervenor fund, to be disbursed by the Siting Board to municipalities and other local parties to help pay expenses, including attorneys and consultants, associated with participating in the Article 10 process during the pre-application review phase. Fifty percent (50%) of these intervenor funds are reserved for municipalities. Additional intervenor funds will be made available for the Application/Hearing phase. Following the filing of the PSS, the Hearing Examiner or the Secretary will issue a notice of availability of pre-application intervenor funds providing a schedule and related information describing how interested members of the public may apply for pre-application funds, and a schedule for making such requests.

No less than 90 days after the filing of the PSS, the Applicant will submit an Article 10 Application. Building on the scoping process and any stipulations agreed to by the parties, the Application will include the studies developed in support of the Facility, a description of the Facility, an evaluation of environmental and health impacts, a summary of public involvement activities, an evaluation of reasonable and available alternative locations, a statement of applicable local substantive standards, an electric interconnection study including general design study and SRIS, security and emergency plans, statement demonstrating compliance with the most recent State Energy Plan, a plan for decommissioning and removal of the Facility at the end of its useful life, and other information The Application will also contain the information set forth in 16 NYCRR 1001, Exhibits 1-41 unless otherwise waived by the Siting Board.

Once an Application is filed and determined by the Siting Board to be complete, the Siting Board will schedule a public hearing on the Application. The Siting Board will also issue a notice of availability of application-phase intervenor funds that are available to be used by parties to participate in formal review of the Application. A pre-hearing conference will be scheduled by the Hearing Examiner to identify intervenors, award intervenor funds, identify issues for the hearing, and establish a case schedule. Additional hearings regarding the application and project impact assessments will be scheduled by the Hearing Examiner as needed. After hearings, the stakeholders may brief their positions and the Hearing Examiner will issue a recommended decision upon which the Siting Board will base its decision. Article 10 requires that all proceedings on the Application, including a final decision by the Siting Board must be completed within 12 months of when the Application is determined to be complete.



Make a Great Impression with Dessert

Entrées might be the focal point of a meal, but dessert provides the final impression people will have after sitting down to break bread together. Home cooks who want their guests to leave the dinner table patting their bellies in appreciation of a fine dessert can try the following recipe for "Espresso-Chocolate Chip Angel Food Cake" from Emily Luchetti's "Classic Stars Desserts" (Chronicle Books).

Espresso-Chocolate Chip Angel Food Cake

Serves 10 to 12

 $2\ {\rm teaspoons}\ {\rm instant}\ {\rm espresso}\ {\rm powder}$

1 1/3 cups cake flour, sifted

1/8 teaspoon kosher salt

1 3/4 cups (about 12 large) egg whites

1 teaspoon cream of tartar

13/4 cups granulated sugar

1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 1/4 teaspoons freshly squeezed lemon juice

3/4 cup bittersweet chocolate chips, coarsely chopped

Preheat the oven to 350 F. Have ready an ungreased 10-inch nonstick angel food cake pan.

Sift together the espresso powder and flour onto a piece of parchment paper or into a bowl. Add the salt and set aside.

Put the egg whites in the large bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the whip attachment and whip on medium speed until frothy. Add the cream of tartar, increase the speed to high and continue whipping while slowly pouring in the sugar until the whites are firm and satiny, about 3 minutes.

Reduce the speed to low, add the vanilla and lemon juice and then add the dry ingredients. When the flour mixture is almost completely incorporated, remove the bowl from the mixer stand and fold in the chocolate chips with a spatula. Make sure that the chips are spread evenly throughout the batter and that the flour mixture is evenly incorporated. But be careful not to overmix, or you will deflate the batter and the cake will not rise fully in the oven.

Cut through the batter a few times with a table knife to break up any air pockets. Bake until a skewer inserted into the center comes out clean, 40 to 45 minutes. Invert the cake and let cool completely upside down in the pan. (If the pan does not have feet, balance the inverted pan on the neck of a bottle or rest the edge of the pan rim on 3 or 4 ramekins.)

To unmold the cake, run a long knife around the inside edge of the pan. Then, holding the center tube, free the cake from the pan sides. Slip a knife between the cake and the bottom of the pan to loosen the cake and gently flip the cake over, letting it fall onto a platter. (If the pan does not have a removable bottom, release the sides with the knife, then place a platter on top of the cake. Gently invert the platter and the cake together. Lift off the pan.) To server, cut into slices with a serrated knife, using a gentle sawing motion.

Planning ahead: The cake may be made a day in advance. Wrap in plastic wrap and store at room temperature.


