

My boyfriend and I were buying gasoline for his pickup truck and a lawnmower. When we pulled up to get gas we were on the wrong side and he started pumping gas into a 5 gallon container while I turned the truck around. As I did so, a lady came up and blocked me from pulling in but we were there first and as my boyfriend was already pumping gas, we wouldn't let her pull in either. They got into an argument and a deputy sheriff told my boyfriend to move his truck and he argued with the officer who eventually handcuffed him and took him to jail. We were there first. Is this legal?

McKala, Florence, AL

Sure it is legal. The deputy had a gun and a badge and those guys are

going to win arguments every time. The real problem is that your boyfriend's day was interrupted and he had to be bailed out of jail when all he had to do was be a gentleman and be patient.

Certainly no law dictates who gets to pump gas when two people pull up at the same time, but if the police officer perceived an argument as a breach of the peace then he was obligated to solve the problem. If he ordered your boyfriend to move his truck and he refused, the outcome of that refusal is disobeying a police officer's order and that results in an arrest and a trip to jail. Not much fun there.

Certainly police officers can and do make mistakes but those mistakes are best corrected in the courtroom. An apology would probably go a long way by the time you get to court. Resisting arrest is never a good idea because police officers are trained to win physical confrontations. They prosecute people who engage in such conduct so they don't do it again.

While a police officer's order should be followed remember that you do not have to give into their requests to search your vehicle or home and you do not have to talk to them without a lawyer present. You are absolutely entitled to refuse to be interviewed by a police officer and you do not have to consent to a search. If you have done something wrong or you have contraband in your home or car you would be far better served to refuse to talk about the matter or consent to the search. I have a tremendous amount of respect for police officers but if you notice when they have a legal issues, they always demand that their rights be respected. They never talk without a lawyer, take a breathalyzer or consent to a search. They have seen the results too many times of people who think they can outsmart a trained investigator.

Hire a lawyer, go to court and be polite. If you do you may be able to have these charges dismissed with the payment of court costs. Typically, a prosecutor will listen to a police officer's recommendation.



Please Review your Pay **Check Withholdings** Yearly to Avoid Tax Debt

Many of our clients come to see us after they have visited their accountant or tax preparer, believing they were going to receive a nice refund only to find out they owe Uncle Sam money instead. Not only did they think "I have money coming", they frequently have borrowed thinking

"I can pay this right back with my refund". So now, they are doubly in trouble with both a loan to pay back as well as a tax bill. What? I encourage you to fix the problem now so you will courier not have this issue next year. not have this issue next year.

Egg Hunt We are at the beginning of March so you have 10 months to fix and thus avoid this problem from happening again next year. The amount of taxes you withhold is a personal choice, so you can adjust the amount at any time.

One way to do it is through the IRS form titled, Form W-4 also known as the Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate. You can complete the form and submit it to your employer. Your employer then uses the form to calculate the amount of federal income tax to be withheld from your pay. Let them do the hard math.

Typically, if you follow the instructions on the Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate (Form W-4), you will come out in great shape. It will keep you from owing a tax debt each year. On the flipside, if you are getting a large refund each year, it will adjust your monthly taxes down, giving you

more money each pay period throughout the year so you and the IRS are square at the end of the year. For example, if you are receiving \$4,800 each year as a refund, then it will adjust your paycheck and you will pay less taxes and put \$400 more in your pocket each month.

If you have more than one job, make sure your Form W-4 is correctly filled out and submitted to that employer as well.

Another way to adjust your taxes if you owe a tax bill is to immediately go visit your payroll department and ask them to take out an additional amount each month. What extra amount do you tell them to take out you might ask? Just look at the amount you owe from your tax return and divide by 10 (or the number of remaining months in the year). If you owe \$1,000, ask your employer to take out an additional \$100 per month for the balance of this year starting immediately.

ccording to a recent survey, a majority of military family members do not feel that they belong in their local civilian communities. This means that less than half of military families who live in our neighborhoods, shop at our malls, attend our places of worship feel at home with us.

Why is this the case? Perhaps it is because of one of the staples of military life—regular mandated relocation. Members of our military often have little to no say in where they live or how often they move, something they do an estimated ten times more than civilian families. Nevertheless, they choose to sacrifice their desires and expectations for the good of our country.

Anyone who has moved will readily admit that it is rarely an easy task. Along with the logistics of relocating from one area of the country to another, families grapple with leaving friends, schools,

and communities they are familiar with for the unknown.

Additionally, even though military families move, on average, once every three years, the effects of compulsory relocation are felt yearly.

Morgan Kistler, a mother of three and wife to a member of the Coast Guard, quickly learned that during those three to four years when your family is planted, everyone else around you is



Medicare Minute

"Annual Wellness Visit"

Medicare wants you to be as healthy as possible. Because of this, Medicare offers you the opportunity to receive many of your preventive screenings and tests at no out-of-pocket cost to you. If you are in the first 12 months of starting your Part B, these benefits are called "Welcome to Medicare" visits. If you have had Part B for more than 12 months, they're called "Wellness" visits. There are, however, a couple of rules that must be followed for you to receive these benefits at no cost.

The first thing to know is, you only receive one "Wellness" visit per year. If you go to a specialist, and they code your visit as a "Wellness" visit, you cannot go to your primary care physician and receive another "Wellness" visit. It is your responsibility to know how your visit is coded. If you do not want a visit to a specialist or primary care physician coded as a "Wellness" visit you must speak up.

The second, and maybe the most important, thing to know is; for a visit to be coded as a "Wellness" visit it must be for **preventive services only.** Your "Medicare and You Handbook" states; "If you doctor or other health care provider performs additional tests or services during the same visit that aren't covered under this preventive benefit, you may have to pay coinsurance, and the Part B **deductible may apply."** In other words, if you are having a medical issue and go to your doctor and discuss this issue, you probably will not be able to use your "Wellness" visit and must pay your copay or coinsurance. "Wellness" visits are for preventive screenings and tests only!!

If you go to your primary care physician or specialist, and they "break the news" to you that a visit is not eligible to be coded as "Wellness", please be patient with your provider. It's not that they do not want to help you; it's that Medicare will not approve it.







not. Every family repeats the painful season of goodbyes, regardless of whether they are the ones leaving.

Clearly, military families face struggles that many families do not. Here in Alabama, we host roughly 8,700 active duty members of our nation's military and their families.

In a state that rightfully respects and reveres our military, one would expect our laws to reflect an intentional attempt to ease the burden of relocation these families. Unfortunately, there are sections of our code in which that is not true.

If we want to ease the burden of relocation military families, Alabama should reform its occupational licensing

In the survey cited previously, 77% of military spouses said that having two incomes is vitally important to their family's well-being. However, 52% of those same spouses did not earn any income. A good portion of the blame for this disparity lies in the difficulties of getting state-sanctioned licenses to work.

When military families move, the occupational licenses of spouses do not always transfer. Many states require spouses with licenses from other states to jump through a variety of hoops and pay a collection of fees. This is a process that takes a considerable amount of time and discourages entry into the workforce.

Alabama lawmakers are considering legislation this session that would require licensing boards to recognize professional licenses of military spouses from other states, assuming the licensing criteria is similar or greater than Alabama requirements.

military For spouses license whose state does not meet Alabama requirements, boards would be required to provide temporary licenses and allow spouses to work while they complete the requirements for full licensure.

Furthermore, military families would not bear the burden of licensing fees.

As entering the workforce inherently increases connection and interaction with the community, these are meaningful changes that should be supported by all who back our military.

Although we cannot remove every challenge military families face, we must eradicate the state's contribution to these challenges. Eliminating barriers and making it less complicated for spouses to enter the civilian Alabama workforce will promote greater integration. This will help military families feel like they belong to their communities, even if for only a short time.

Dear Dave.

I have \$100,000 in student loan debt. Since the amount is so large, is there a special place in your Baby Steps plan for it?

Dear Julie,

The fact that it's a large amount of student loan debt doesn't change anything. Baby Step 2 is where you pay off all debt except for your home.

I hope you have a nice, large income with which to fight that big, nasty pile of student loan debt. Believe it or not, I've seen even worse situations. I've talked to people who went \$200,000 into debt for a four-year degree in a field where they'll make \$50,000. That kind of thinking and behavior is ridiculous, but it's out there.

Whatever you do, don't let this student loan debt hang around for years and years. You've got to get focused and intense about getting control of your money. That means living on a strict, basics-only monthly budget. After that, start throwing every nickel and dime you can scrape together and save toward those student loans as fast as possible.

Your income is your largest wealth-building tool, Julie. You can't save, and plan for the future, when all your money is flying out the door to pay back debt!

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER

Dear Dave,

I have a credit card that I haven't made a payment on in almost two years. The debt has been sold a couple of times,

and now a collector is saying I owe \$1,200. The original amount was \$500. I'd like to work something out, but I can't afford \$1,200. What should I do?

Dear Luanne,

Luanne

They're asking for \$1,200 because they've added things like interest and late fees. They want to make as much money as possible on an old debt they bought for pennies on the dollar.

If you can afford \$500 right now, ask if they'll accept a one-time payment to settle the account. Get it in writing if they accept the offer, and don't give them a penny until after you get a copy of the written agreement. Once you have the agreement in hand, send them a money order or cashier's check for \$500. Do not, under any circumstances, give them electronic access to your bank accounts.

You waited too long to take of your obligation, Luanne. That made things more difficult and more stressful than necessary. I'm glad you decided to do the right thing, and clean up your mess, though. Better late than never!

Sales Contract

Most REALTORS in the Shoals Area use the Real Estate Sales Contract provided by the Shoals Area Association of REALTORS. It is common throughout the Real Estate Industry for Brokers of Real Estate Companies to adopt and use forms provided by the local and state associations.

Members of such associations typically will form committees to study forms used in day to day operations, and together with the advice of an Attorney will usually come up with a form that fits the marketplace. Agents will then use these forms as advised by their Qualifying Broker

The Real Estate Sales Contract used in most transactions in our market consists of eight pages and twenty-seven paragraphs, which cover everything from how much the sales price will be to when it will close and what type of financing, if any, the buyer will obtain.

When buying or selling a piece of real estate, it is imperative to use some form of a sales contract. Lenders almost always require a contract, signed by both the buyer and the seller because it clearly explains all terms of the agreement.

Most people think that agreeing on the sales price is the only part of a sales contract, however there are many other terms that both parties have to agree on in order for it to become a fully executable document.

Terms of a typical contract will usually include:

-Purchase Price

-How much Earnest Money is being held

-When it will close

 -When the buyer will take possession of the property
 A sales contract can also have contingencies,

A sales contract can also have contingencies, or things that must happen or the buyer must be satisfied with in order to close. **Those may include:**

The buyer obtaining a loan
A home inspection
An appraisal
Lender required repairs
Survey

A Wood Infestation Inspection Report (aka Termite Letter)

Clear Title work/ Title Insurance Policy
There is also usually a "catch all" paragraph
located at the end of the sales contract that would
specify any additional terms such as whether the
sale is contingent upon the sale of another home,
or whether the buyer wants to ask the seller to
leave a playground set, etc...

If you're buying or selling real estate, be sure you're using a sales contract so that everyone is on the same page on all terms of the agreement. A good friend once told me "The best way to avoid a misunderstanding is to have a good understanding" -mr






