

#### Retiring After Nearly 48 Years in Business

Dr. Donald B. Munger, or 'Doc' as he prefers, has been a prominent leader in the community for almost half a century. And now, after almost forty eight years as a dentist on Main Street, he has chosen to retire and move on to the next chapter of his life.

Having grown up in York, his roots are here. After graduation from high school, he did his undergrad at the University of Buffalo and then went on to graduate from the University of Pennsylvania Dental School on May 21, 1962. He was a dentist at the age of 25.

After college, Doc joined the United States Army and after eight years of active service, he returned to the area. He took over the practice previously run by Dr. Orlando and opened up shop at 128 Main Street on April 1, 1970. His office still resides there to this day.




Doc served his country as a member of the United States Army from 1962-1970 and achieved the rank of Colonel in the US Army Medical Dental Corps when he retired in 1997. In 1967 he married his first wife Rosita, whom he met while serving in Germany. They returned to Mount Morris, purchased a home in Groveland and raised two sons Mark and Eric, along with a number of long-haired dachshunds. Sadly, his wife Rosita passed away in 2010 after an illness.

He is now the proud grandfather of two boys, both Eagle Scouts who reside with their parents in San Diego, California. In 2014, Doc remarried Millicent Thompson and they reside in Groveland.

Doc is an avid hunter and has taken trophies from all over the world.

When asked about his dental team, he beams with pride. While hygienists come and go, the core of his dental family has remained. Diane Utberg, a neighbor and babysitter for his two sons, has been part of the family since 1972. Marcia Bell from Perry, joined the dental family in 1981, and Sue Swanson from Mount Morris, has been an intergral part of the dental family for over 20 years.

Doc has been an active member of local civic organizations since his early days in Mount Morris, when Ignatius Scorsone convinced him to join the Rotary Club. Doc later became the Rotary Club President from 1978-79 and has had a direct hand in many of the projects Rotary has developed over the years. Some



of those projects include the installation of a monument and an American Flag Pole near the Mills Mansion, restoration of Christmas lights to downtown Mount Morris, placement of trees and benches along Main and Chapel Streets, and the ever popular Sunday in the Park festivals.

He became a member of the American Legion in 1978, the VFW in 1979 and remains an active member in both organizations to this day.

His tenure in the Geneseo Masonic Lodge began in 1972. He became the Master Mason from 2012-14 and later became the District Deputy Grand Master of the Livingston County Masons in 2012.

Last, but not least, he was instrumental in the creation of the Veterans Memorial Park at the south end of the village featuring cemetery crosses in the same tradition as those he witnessed in the cemeteries at Normandy. The crosses represent every war the US has fought in up til Vietnam. At the memorial, the ground features bricks with engrave donor names. He feels this memorial is one of the best he has ever seen and is proud to have been a part of its creation.
