How to Keep Your Teeth Healthy

Tooth decay (cavities) is one of the most common chronic conditions of childhood in the United States. Untreated tooth decay causes pain and infections that may lead to eating, speaking

playing, and learning difficulties. Tooth decay and other oral diseases that can affect children are preventable.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), dental sealants and fluoride have the potential to nearly eliminate tooth decay in school-age children. The American Dental Association (ADA) recommends that children visit the dentist within 6 months of getting his/her first tooth or by their first birthday. At this visit, the dentist will explain proper brushing and flossing techniques (you need to floss once your baby has two teeth that touch) and conduct a modified exam while your baby sits on your lap.

To help prevent tooth decay, it is important to follow these tips:

- ✗ Brush your teeth at least twice a day with fluoride toothpaste.
- ✗ Change your toothbrush every three to four months.
- ✗ Floss daily.

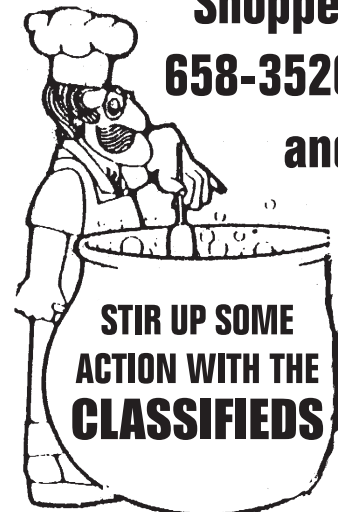

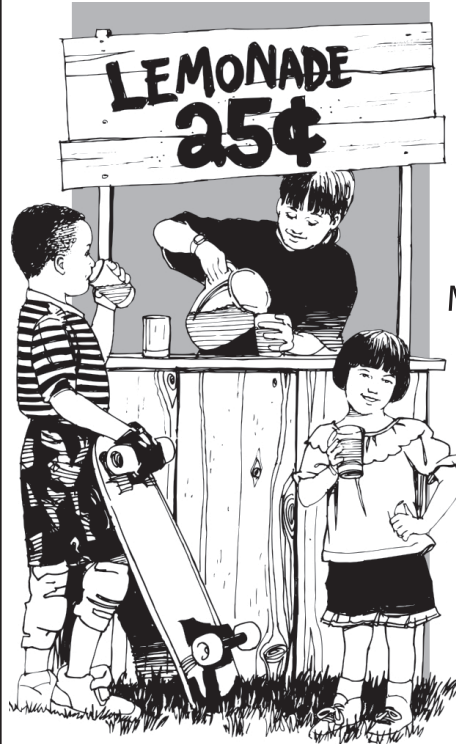
