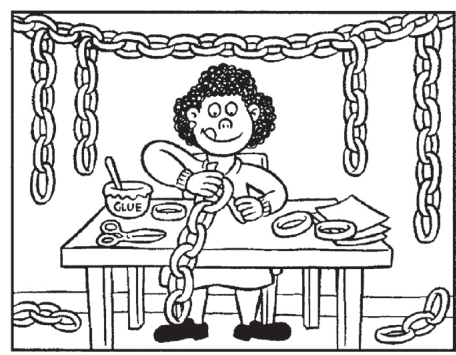

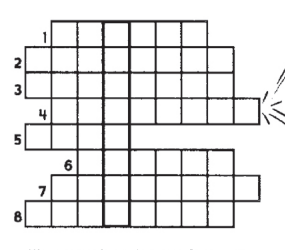



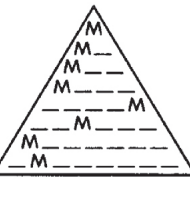

Q. We've just been given a set of silverware that we were told is 100-plus years old. It belonged to a friend of my husband's grandmother who gave it to his mother about 1910. It's a service for eight and pieces are marked "Lake Betty Silver Plate" on the backs. All are in excellent condition in a leather, velvet-lined case. We are wondering if the set has any value, other than sentimental.

A. Your silver-plated flatware is not as old as you think it is. The pattern name is Lady Betty and was introduced by International Silver Co. of Meriden, Connecticut, in 1940. The company was formed when some independent silver makers merged in 1898. Silver plating by electricity began (in the U.S.) in 1847, earlier in England. By the 1880s, more than 40 firms, mostly centered near Meriden, made simple to elaborate silver-plated tableware until the 1980s. Silver-plated items generally have a modest value unless they are either very fancy or very rare. Your flatware is not worth much — under \$100 — and places that buy silver to melt are looking for sterling silver, not silver plate.

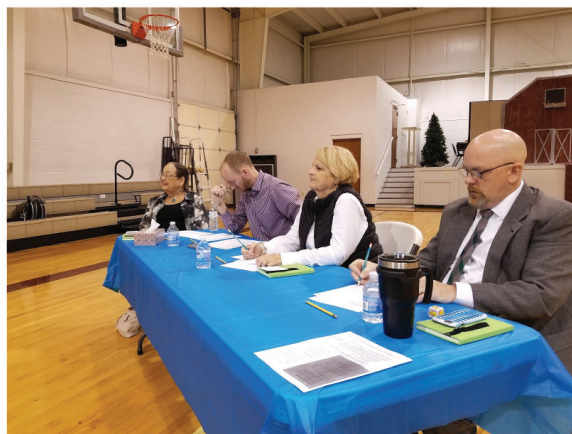

"Random Observations About Preachers"

I have been preaching since I was twelve years old, and a bit of quick math tells me that, at forty-seven years old, that makes for thirty-five years. This is to say, that, I have been around preachers for a very long time. Perhaps it is because of the stress of the ministry, but my take is that preachers can and often are some of the (to quote the Southern colloquialism) squirreliest people around.

Here, for your enjoyment (and your prayer list) are some of my observations on preachers.

One: Many preachers do an amazing job of studying, preparing, and presenting accurate, solid, well thought-out Biblical messages. Others twist the Bible so badly that it appears to be doing extreme Yoga, minus the stretchy pants.

Two: A preacher is a person with the very difficult task of standing in front of people all the time and talking while everyone else listens, being heard and being seen, while being tasked with not having people notice him, but instead having everyone notice the one of whom he is speaking, whom they cannot see with their eyes or hear with their ears.

Cletus and Lurlene into a frenzy demanding that the preacher speak to them immediately about how other children are (supposedly) mistreating little Lulu.

Four: The ministry has such high highs and such low lows in such near proximity to each other that the term "roller coaster" is not dramatic enough to describe it. So, if you happen to ever hear a preacher humming "You Can Take This Job and Shove It," do not panic. In fifteen minutes he will probably be humming "Victory In Jesus."

Five: Every preacher I have ever known has had to deal with someone going to the hospital for an emergency or for a surgery and not telling him, then blowing up at him for not coming to the emergency or surgery that he did not know about. Preachers do not have ESP. If they did, they would vote against many people's request for membership before they ever get the chance to do something that ridiculous.

Six: Every preacher I have ever known has had to deal with people who are always full of life and vitality Monday through Friday for work, and also for play on Saturday, yet somehow sick every single Sunday. Eight: Some preachers are faithful and stable. Others bounce from church to church so often that, no matter their actual name, I call them "Reverend Mcboingboing."

Nine: An old preacher still in the ministry is a glorious thing. It is a sign that someone had enough composure to go for decades and decades without killing anyone who desperately needed it, or at least was superb at hiding the bodies.

Ten: I am blessed beyond measure as a pastor. I say this in all sincerity; my church family is amazing, and they make me glad to serve them. But I have learned that the greatest joys of the ministry are reserved for those who dig in at one place and stay faithful for many years. If I had bailed out in the first five years, I would have missed the incomparable heavenly blessings that did not come till years eighteen, nineteen, and beyond.

One of the shortest verses in the Bible sums it up. In 1 Thessalonians 5:25, Paul said these four words: "Brethren, pray for us."



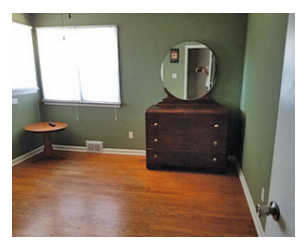

**SOUTHERN BANANA CAKE
(MOIST & FLUFFY)**



INGREDIENTS

- 1 1/2 cups bananas, mashed (about 3 large bananas)
- 2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 12 tablespoons butter (1 1/2 sticks), room temperature
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 1/4 cup brown sugar, packed
- 3 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 cups buttermilk

REAL CREAM CHEESE FROSTING

- 4 (8 oz) packs cream cheese, softened at room temperature
- 16 tablespoons butter, softened at room temperature
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 4 cups powdered sugar, sifted

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 275 F. Generously grease and lightly flour 3 (9 inch) round cake pans. Set aside. In a small bowl combine bananas and lemon juice. Set aside. In a medium bowl, whisk together flour, baking soda and salt. Set aside. In a large bowl, cream together butter, granulated sugar, brown sugar, eggs & vanilla extract. Mix the dry ingredients into the wet ingredients, alternating with the buttermilk. Fold in bananas. Pour batter evenly into the prepared pans. Bake for 35-40 minutes (check on it at the 35 minute mark) When moist crumbs cling to toothpick inserted into center, remove from oven and let cool in pans until pans are warm to the touch. (do NOT over cook. The cake continues to cook as it cools) Very carefully remove cake from pans and allow to cool completely on cooling rack. Stack and frost layers with cream cheese frosting and sprinkle with pecans if desired. Serve. Store frosted cake covered tightly in fridge.

*To make frosting: Cream together cream cheese and butter. Mix in vanilla extract. Gradually mix in powdered sugar until creamy. Refrigerate until firm.

* Volunteer at a few Stand Downs in your area. Same goes for any local veterans wheelchair, adaptive sports or senior games.

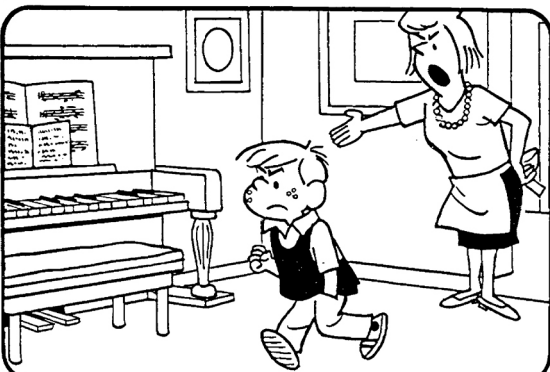
* Start now to collect toys for children of veterans for the holiday season. Then take a veteran's family under your wing and have your company or church group sponsor them with food and gifts.

* Can you drive a vet getting treatment to the nearest veterans medical center? Call Volunteer Services at the center and ask if you can help.

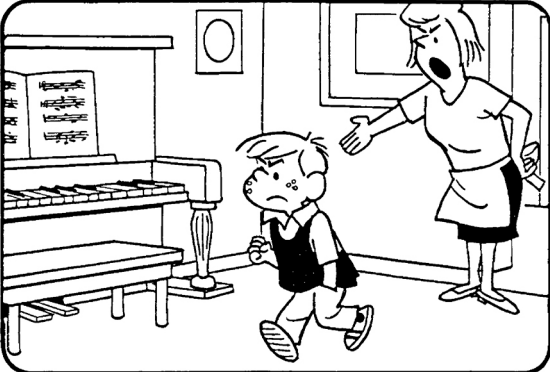
